FISH BITES

Miami continues a six-game homestand with game three of four against the Atlanta Braves tonight at 7:10 p.m. LHP **Wei-Yin WEIGH-IN Chen**, making his 21st start of the season, is facing the Braves for the ninth time in his career, going 2-2 with a 3.89 ERA; in three starts this season is 1-1 with a 5.51 ERA. Atlanta is starting RHP Anibal Sánchez, who in four career appearances and three starts against the Marlins is 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA; in his only start this season, allowed five runs (four earned) on seven hits over 5.0 innings on August 14 at SunTrust Park. Miami snapped a stretch of 6 consecutive series losses by taking two of three from the Washington Nationals this past weekend at Nationals Park. Miami continued its better play by splitting a two-game series against the New York Yankees to open the current homestand. Tonight continues a stretch that will see the Marlins play 12 of 14 games at home from August 21-September 5.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

The Marlins and Braves combined for a total of six hits in a 1-0 win for Miami. The last time Miami was involved in a game with six-or-fewer hits was on July 31, 2017 vs. Washington, when Miami had two and Washington three. Miami's first hit came in the fourth inning, when **Brian ANDY Anderson** doubled with two outs and was brought home on a **Derek DIETZ Dietrich** single to center. **Miguel MIGGY RO Rojas** collected the final hit for Miami, a single to center in the seventh. **Dan THUNDER Straily** earned the win, allowing just three hits and a walk, while striking out four, over 6.0 innings.

1 AND NONE

The Marlins secured their first 1-0 win of the season last night against the Braves. It was the third time that Miami had participated in a 1-0 decision this season, suffering losses to Pittsburgh on April 14 and Colorado on April 27, both at Marlins Park. Last night was Miami's first 1-0 win since September 20, 2016 vs. Washington, and the 34th in Club history. Miami, which was shut out by Atlanta in the opener of this series, is 6-4 this year following a shutout loss.

ALL HEART AND ALL OUT HUSTLE

Prior to tonight's game, **J.T. REAL Realmuto** will be recognized on field as the Miami Marlins 2018 Heart and Hustle Award winner. This esteemed award, given annually by the Major League Baseball Players Alumni Association (MLBPAA), honors active players who demonstrate a passion for the game of baseball and best embody the values, spirit and traditions of the game. The Heart and Hustle Award is also the only award in Major League Baseball that is voted on by former players. The final winner will be announced on November 8, 2018 at the 19th Annual Legends for Youth Dinner in New York City. This event is the primary fundraiser for the series of free Legends for Youth Baseball Clinics. These clinics impact more than 18,000 children each year at 185 clinics, allowing them the unique opportunity to interact with and learn from players who have left a lasting impact on the game of baseball.

VS. THE BRAVES

Tonight continues the second meeting between the division rivals in the last week, as Miami was swept in a four-game series at SunTrust Park from August 13-15, and marks final meeting of the 2018 season series. The Marlins snapped a seven-game losing streak to the Braves with last night's 1-0 win, and now trail the season series, 4-13. The seven straight losses to the Braves were the most since an eight-game slide from September 12, 2012-July 2, 2013.

HOME FIRES BURNING

Over their last 12 home games since July 28, the Marlins have posted a 2.61 ERA (114.0 ip/33 er) to mark the second-lowest ERA among National League staffs (fifth in MLB) at home in that span. They have limited opponents to a .208 average against, second in the NL and fourth in the Majors. Starters have allowed three-or-fewer runs 10 times, including seven starts of two-or-less runs allowed, and posted a 2.70 ERA (66.2/20), while the bullpen has allowed 13 runs over 47.1 innings pitched for a 2.47 ERA.

PROVING HIS WORTH

Brian Andy Anderson leads all Major League rookies in games (129), at-bats (498), runs (69), hits (138), average with RISP (.385), and on-base percentage (.359); ranks second in doubles (27), walks (51), multi-hit games (40), and three+-hit games (8); ranks third in RBI (54), average (.277), and slugging (.398); is tied for third in triples (3); and tied for 12th in HR (9). On the defensive side, he leads all rookie outfielders with a .994 fielding percentage, committing just one error in 176 total chances. He also owns eight outfield assists, most among all ML rookie outfielders and just three off the Major League lead held by Billy Hamilton.

- He is on pace for 171 hits this season, which would rank as the second-most by a National League rookie since 2008, behind Corey Seager's 193 in 2016, and would be 10th-most by an NL rookie since 2000.
- He recorded 109 hits before the All-Star break, tying Rocco Baldelli for the second-most by a Major League rookie since 2003, behind only Hideki Matsui (114 in 2003). He is the only Marlins rookie in franchise history to record 100+ hits prior to the break.
- Anderson recorded 101 hits over his first 92 games of the season. Since 1958, 34 rookies have recorded 100+ hits in 92-or-fewer games and went on to win Rookie of the Year honors, including most recently Aaron Judge (2017), Corey Seager (2016), Carlos Correa (2015), José Abreu (2014), Mike Trout (2012) and Buster Posey (2010). - *Stats LLC*

PLAYERS WEEKEND

Players' Weekend is intended showcase the personalities and interests of Major League players by allowing them to select a nickname for the back of their jersey as well as wear and use uniquely colored and designed equipment including bats, spikes, batting gloves, wristbands, compression sleeves and catcher's equipment. Players are wearing specially designed uniforms created for the three games with jerseys by Majestic, caps by New Era and socks from Stance. Game-worn, Players' Weekend jerseys will be auctioned at MLB.com/auctions. All proceeds will be donated to the MLB-MLBPA Youth Development Foundation, a joint effort established in July 2015 by MLB and the MLBPA with an initial commitment of \$30 million focused on improving the caliber, effectiveness and availability of amateur baseball and softball programs across the United States and Canada.

YEAR OF THE FAN SWEEPSTAKES

The Marlins, in partnership with AutoNation, America's largest automotive retailer, will be awarding a prize of a 24-month car lease to a select fan tonight, the 22nd of 25 dates this season where a fan will drive off with a new car. The "Marlins Year of the Fan Sweepstakes, Driven by AutoNation" is open to any eligible fan in attendance at each select home date. Fans will be eligible for that date's drawing by scanning their valid, digital game ticket, stored on a mobile device, upon entry to Marlins Park prior to the end of the third inning. The 24-month car lease awarded to the winner of each game date's random drawing among all eligible entries will drive away with either a 2018 Ford Focus or 2018 Chevy Cruze.

- Wei-Yin Chen is making his 21st start of the season in game three of this four-game series against the Atlanta Braves. Has won two of his last five starts after taking four losses in previous five starts.
- Owns career 2-2 record and 3.89 ERA (44.0 ip/19 er) in eight career starts against Atlanta. Tonight will mark his fourth against the Braves this season, going 1-1 with a 5.51 ERA (16.1/10). Will be his second home start against Braves this season; earned win on July 24, holding Atlanta to three runs on five hits and three walks, with four strikeouts, over 6.0 innings.
- Has 2.05 ERA (57.0/13) in 10 home starts, compared to 9.35 (43.1/45) in 10 road starts. According to *Stats LLC*, the 7.30 difference in home/road ERA is the largest gap for any pitcher in the majors since Dallas Keuchel had an 8.15 difference (11.10 on road/2.95 at home) in 2012 (min. 15 GS at home and on road).
- Among Major League starters with a minimum of 10 home starts, his 2.05 ERA at home ranks sixth. Ryne Stanek leads with a 0.96 ERA, followed by Blake Snell (1.02), Jacob deGrom (1.59), Trevor Bauer (1.87), and Aaron Nola (2.00).
- In last home start, August 12 vs. Mets, allowed four runs (two earned) on four hits with two walks and six strikeouts over 6.0 innings. Marked only second home start of season where allowed more than three runs (also June 11 vs. SF - 4). In contrast, has allowed more than three runs in six of 10 road starts.
- Also on August 12, tossed season-high 108 pitches in 4-3 loss. His pitch total in the game was the most since throwing 111 on September 26, 2015 at Boston. Has broken 100-pitch plateau seven times dating back to the start of 2016 (46 starts). Over his first four Major League campaigns, eclipsed 100-pitch mark 54 times in 117 starts.
- Opponents are batting .219 (35x160) first time through lineup, .265 (40x151) second time through, and .347 (25x72) third time through.
- Began season on DL (left elbow strain). Made two rehab appearances at Single-A Jupiter, allowing just one run over 7.2 innings, with just one walk and 11 strikeouts. In first appearance, April 17 vs. Lakeland, allowed one run and three hits over 2.2 innings. In second start, April 22 vs. St. Lucie, tossed two-hit, 5.0-inning complete game. Struck out seven without issuing a walk.
- Made season debut on April 28 vs. Colorado, earning a win after allowing just one run on four hits (one home run), two walks, and a hit batter over 5.1 innings, with three strikeouts.

- Pablo López is making his 10th career start in the finale of the 2018 season series against the Braves. Earned the win in his Major League debut on June 30 against the Mets at Marlins Park. Tossed 6.0 innings and allowed two runs on six hits (two home runs) and an intentional walk, with five strikeouts.
- The night before his debut, Sandy Alcantara made his first career Major League start and also earned a win. The pair became the first set of teammates to earn wins in their first career starts in consecutive days since April 9-10, 2012, when Yu Darvish and Neftali Feliz each made their first career starts with the Rangers. The last National League team to have such a duo was the Reds on April 15-16, 1967 with Gary Nolan and Mel Queen. - *Stats LLC*
- Tomorrow's start will mark the second of his career/season against Atlanta. He faced the Braves in game one of the August 13 doubleheader at SunTrust Park, taking the loss after surrendering a season high six runs (five earned) on six hits and two walks, while striking out five, over 5.1 innings. Prior to that outing, had allowed eight runs in previous four starts combined, going 1-1 with 2.92 ERA (24.2 ip). In that span, walked four and struck out 19.
