FISH BITES

The Marlins continue a seven-game road trip with the opener of this four-game series against the Philadelphia Phillies tonight at 7:05 p.m. RHP **Pablo López**, making his sixth career start, is facing the Phillies for the first time in his career. Philadelphia is countering with RHP Nick Pivetta, who in five career starts against the Marlins has gone 2-1 with a 6.56 ERA (23.1 ip/17 er). The Marlins concluded a 3-3 homestand Sunday, splitting a two-game series with the Braves and a four-game set against the Nationals. The current road swing began with Miami dropping two games to the Atlanta Braves, with the final game being postponed due to weather. Tonight's game continues a stretch of 12 straight games (3-5) against NL East opponents. Miami plays 36 of their remaining 52 games (71%) against division foes.

TUESDAY NIGHT'S RECAP

The Marlins and Braves endured a 1:27 delay to begin their game Tuesday night, and after falling behind early, Miami wasn't able rebound in an 11-6 loss to Atlanta. Trailing 3-0 after three innings, Miami cut the deficit to one after an RBI single by **JT Riddle** and an RBI double from **Magneuris Sierra**. The Marlins added another run in the fifth on **J.T. Realmuto's** 14th home run of the season, and two in the sixth on an RBI single by Sierra and a sac fly by **Justin Bour**. The highlight of the night was when **Isaac Galloway**, who had his contract selected earlier in the day, arrived at the ballpark in the middle innings and made his Major League debut in the seventh inning in left field. With one out in the ninth, Galloway singled to short in his first plate appearance and came around to score on a **Brian Anderson** double. Sierra tied a career high with three hits, while Anderson and Riddle added two apiece.

SCHEDULE UPDATE

Last night's postponed game in Atlanta has been rescheduled as part of a split doubleheader on August 13 at SunTrust Park. Game one will start at 1:35 p.m., and game two will be at the regularly scheduled 7:35 p.m. FOX Sports Florida will televise both games.

AT LONG LAST

According to research by the *Elias Sports Bureau*, **Isaac Galloway**, who has appeared in 947 career minor league games, had the most career minor league games played by a Marlin at the time of his Major League debut since Brian Daubach, who had 965 when he debuted on September 10, 1998.

- With his debut Tuesday night, Galloway became the sixth-oldest player (28 years, 294 days) to make his MLB debut with the Marlins. Joe Strong was the oldest at 37 years, 245 days when he made his debut on May 11, 2000. Current coach Ed Lucas was second oldest at 31.009 when he debuted on May 30, 2013. The list continues with Chuck Smith (30.236 on June 13, 2000), Joe Dillon (29.289 on May 18, 2005) and Tommy Phelps (29.027 on March 31, 2003). - *Stats LLC*
- He became the 197th player (73rd position player) to make his MLB debut with the Marlins and the 35th to record his first Major League hit in his first plate appearance. - *Stats LLC*

RUN ALONG, ROOKIE

Adding to what has already been a breakout season, **Brian Anderson** is continuing to be one of the main contributors to Miami's offense. He has accounted for 15.0% of the Marlins run total, which is the fifth-highest percentage by a rookie in the last 50 years. Mike Trout accounted for 16.8% of the Angels team run total in 2012, while Hanley Ramirez owned 15.7% of the Marlins total in 2006. Ron Gant had 15.3% of Atlanta's runs in 1988, and Ryne Sandberg accounted for 15.2% of the Cubs total in 1982. - *Stats LLC*

HISTORY REPEATS ITSELF

Miami began the season with just a .225 team average over its first 28 road games, which ranked 27th in the Majors. Over their last 24 road games since June 1, the Marlins have hit at a .273 clip to rank third in the Majors behind Atlanta (.276) and Oakland (.273). Since 2014, Miami leads the Majors in road average with a .261 mark, ahead of Houston (.259) and Kansas City (.256).

MAKING ADJUSTMENTS

When facing a pitcher for the third time in a game, the Marlins have hit .308, which leads the National League and ranks second in the Majors to only Boston (.328). The .308 average when facing a pitcher for the third time would go down as the highest in Franchise history, as the current best is a .307 mark in 2001. - *Stats LLC*

ROAD WELL TRAVELED

The Marlins have two of the best road hitters in the National League in **Derek Dietrich** and **J.T. Realmuto**, who are both tied for 12th with identical .316 averages. Dietrich has hit in 10 of his last 13 road contests, batting .413 (19x46) with four doubles, five home runs, and nine RBI in that span. He has scored 35 runs in visiting ballparks this season, tied for eighth in the NL, while his .394 OBP is 12th and .540 SLG ranks 10th. Realmuto has hit in 13 of his last 15 road games with an average of .344 (22x64), seven doubles, three home runs, and 14 RBI. The All-Star catcher ranks four with a SLG of .575, 17th in runs with 33, and 19th with an OBP of .377.

FLIPPING THE M

Since June 5, the Marlins have gone 26-24, and have won nine of 16 series in that span (two splits), including consecutive series wins against then-first-place Milwaukee and Philadelphia to end the first half. Miami opened the season 20-39, and dropped a season-high six straight games just prior to this current stretch.

PROVING HIS WORTH

In his final game before the break, **Brian Anderson** recorded his sixth three-hit game of the season to run his season hit total to 109. His hit total prior to the break tied Rocco Baldelli for the second-most by a Major League rookie since 2003, behind only Hideki Matsui (114 in 2003). He is the only Marlins rookie in franchise history to record 100+ hits prior to the break.

- Anderson recorded 101 hits over his first 92 games of the season, becoming the 142nd rookie since 1958 to record 100+ hits in 92-or-fewer games. Of those, 34 went on to win Rookie of the Year honors, including most recently Aaron Judge (2017), Corey Seager (2016), Carlos Correa (2015), José Abreu (2014), Mike Trout (2012) and Buster Posey (2010). - *Stats LLC*
- He leads all MLB rookies in games (108), at-bats (419), hits (120), multi-hit games (35), three+-hit games (7, tied), average with RISP (.398), runs (63), on-base percentage (.367), and RBI (51); ranks second in walks (43), doubles (24), average (.286), and slugging percentage (.422), is tied for third in triples (3), and tied for ninth in HR (9).
- He is on pace for 176 hits this season, which would rank as the second-most by a National League rookie since 2010, behind Corey Seager's 193 in 2016, and would tie Ryan Zimmerman for the sixth-most by a rookie since 2000. He is also on pace to score 93 runs, which would rank as the ninth-most by a rookie since 2000.

The 10 different rookies to record a win are tied with three teams for fifth-most in a single season in MLB history. The 2017 Reds, '07 Yankees, '03 Tigers and '02 Padres each had 11. - *Stats LLC*

Pablo López is making his sixth career start in the opener of this four-game series against Philadelphia. Earned the win in his Major League debut on June 30 against the Mets at Marlins Park. Tossed 6.0 innings and allowed two runs on six hits (two home runs) and an intentional walk, with five strikeouts.

The night before his debut, Sandy Alcantara made his first career Major League start and also earned a win. The pair became the first set of teammates to earn wins in their first career starts in consecutive days since April 9-10, 2012, when Yu Darvish and Neftali Feliz each made their first career starts with the Rangers. The last National League team to have such a duo was the Reds on April 15-16, 1967 with Gary Nolan and Mel Queen. - *Stats LLC*

Earned second win of season/career on July 21 at Tampa Bay. Limited Rays to two hits and one run (home run) with a walk and six strikeouts over 6.0 innings. Tied season high in innings pitched and strikeouts.

Tonight's start will mark his first career start and appearance against Philadelphia.

Has appeared as a pinch-hitter twice. In last appearance, on July 15 vs. Philadelphia, he singled, marking Miami's first pinch-hit by a pitcher since a two-run double by José Fernández on July 1, 2016 at Atlanta.

At the time of his promotion to Miami, López ranked sixth among all full season Minor League pitchers in ERA and WHIP (0.93), and 12th in average against. He led all Marlins farmhands in ERA and ranked fourth in strikeouts (66).

He has made 12 starts between Double-A Jacksonville and Triple-A New Orleans, combining on a 2-3 record, 1.44 ERA (62.1 ip/10 er), and .196 (46x235) opponents average. Did not allow more than three runs in any one start, and limited opponents to two-or-fewer eight times.

He began the season at Jacksonville, making eight starts with a 1-2 record and 0.62 ERA (43.2/3). He had a 1.6 BB/9.0 rate, while his strikeouts per 9.0 was 10.5.

Over first four starts with Jumbo Shrimp, allowed just nine hits over 19.0 scoreless innings. Allowed first run of season in fourth inning of May 13 start at Montgomery, running season-opening scoreless streak to 23.0 innings.

Took loss on May 13, allowing just one run on five hits over 7.0 innings. Didn't walk a batter while recording seven strikeouts. Jumbo Shrimp dropped each of his first seven starts of the season despite him allowing a total of just four runs (one earned).

Took loss in next start, May 18 vs. Mobile. Allowed three unearned runs and five hits over 5.2 innings while striking out a career-high 10.

Earned first win in following start, May 24 at Mississippi. Held Braves scoreless on five hits while walking none and striking out five over 6.0 innings.

Earned promotion to New Orleans on June 6 and made first career Triple-A appearance that night in a start at Las Vegas. Earned win after holding 51's to three runs (two earned) on six hits with a walk and four strikeouts over 6.0 innings.

Trevor Richards will make his 16th start of the season for Miami tomorrow night in game two of this four-game set in Philadelphia.

It will mark the third start of his rookie season against the Phillies, as he is 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA (10.0 ip/3 er) in his two previous starts. He last faced the Phils on July 14 at Marlins Park, tossing 6.0 shutout innings with four hits and two walks allowed, while striking out four. In his first appearance at Citizens Bank Park, only his second career start, surrendered three runs on six hits with three walks and two strikeouts over 4.0 innings on April 8.

In first eight starts with Miami, posted 1-4 record with 5.45 ERA (38.0 ip/23 er). Over last seven starts, has improved with 2-1 record and 2.65 ERA (37.1/11). In that time, has limited opponents to three-or-less runs six times, and two-or-fewer five times. Has allowed a total of just three runs over last four starts (22.1 ip; 1.21 ERA).

Lowered home ERA after last start to 3.05 after holding Washington scoreless on three hits over 6.0 innings on July 28. His home ERA ranks 16th in the National League among pitchers with a minimum of seven starts. Was his third start this season of 6.0+ shutout innings.

Since giving up a season high tying six runs on June 17 at Baltimore, has allowed just four runs over last three road starts for a 2.20 ERA (16.1 ip).

He went 0-2 with a 4.94 ERA (23.2/13) across five starts in his first stint with the Marlins. Tossed 7.0 shutout innings with just two hits allowed on April 14 vs. Pittsburgh, and tossed 4.2 shutout innings, with a career-high 10 strikeouts, on April 25 at the Dodgers, his final start before being optioned back to NOLA.
