Mama's Boys

The Brewers enter this afternoon's game with an all-time record of 32-19 (.627) on Mother's Day, best in the majors..... conversely, the team is 19-32 (.373) on Father's Day, the second-worst mark in the majors behind Texas (21-38, .356).

Rocky Mountain High

The Brewers are 10-5 over their last 15 games at Coors Field and won 3 of the last 4 series in Denver entering this series.....a victory today gives the team 3 straight series wins at Coors Field.

A Show About Nothing

Through 40 games, the Brewers have been shut out 8 times, including last night.....the team was shut out 8 times all of last season.

It's Like Night and Day

The Brewers are 19-8 (.704) in night games this season, the best winning percentage in the Major Leagues.....the team has gone 4-9 (.308) in day games, which ranks 25th in the majors.

Close Encounters

The Brewers are 10-4 in 1-run games this season.....their 10 wins in 1-run games are the most in the National League and trail only Boston (11-4) in the majors.

Jeremy Spoke in Class Today

Jeremy Jeffress is unscored upon in 20 of his 21 appearances this season, posting a 0.41 ERA (22ip, 1er).....he is holding opponents to a .127 batting average (9-for-71).....he has not allowed a run in 17 consecutive outings (16.2ip).

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 13-8 on the road, going 4-2-0 in series play.....the team had a season-high 5-game road winning streak snapped last night.....the team went 40-38 on the road last season, going 13-11-2 in series play.

MANAGER: **Craig Counsell** is in his fourth season as manager of the Brewers (243-258) and third full season.....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing **Ron Roenicke**.....bio is on p. 44 of the media guide.

COACHES: Hitting coach **Darnell Coles** (4th season), pitching coach **Derek Johnson** (3rd season), coach **Jason Lane** (3rd season), bench coach **Pat Murphy** (3rd season), third base coach **Ed Sedar** (12th season, 8th as 3B coach), first base/infield coach **Carlos Subero** (3rd season) and bullpen coach **Lee Tunnell** (6th season) all returned from the 2017 staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made seven replay challenges, going 1-6.....their last challenge (lost) came on 5/11 at Colorado as a safe call at third base involving Charlie Blackmon stood.....team was 17-27 in 44 replay challenges in 2017.

TODAY'S STARTER: #51 - RHP FREDDY PERALTA (MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT)

PERALTA AT A GLANCE: Freddy Peralta, 21, will be making his Major League debut this afternoon.....Peralta was recalled from Triple-A Colorado Springs, where he was 5-1 with a 3.63 ERA in 7 starts (34.2ip, 30h, 15r, 14er, 17bb, 46k, 1hr).....his 5 wins and 46 strikeouts currently lead the Pacific Coast League.....the team went 6-1 in his starts.....opponents batted .231 (30-for-130, 1hr).....Peralta entered the 2018 season as the ninth-best prospect in the organization according to *Baseball America*.....he was acquired from Seattle, along with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki, in exchange for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15.....he was added to the 40-man roster on 11/20/17.....bio on p. 120 of the media guide

PERFECT TIMING!: Peralta will be pitching this afternoon in front of his mother (Octavia), father (Pedro) and girlfriend (Maritza), all of whom have never seen him pitch professionally.....the three were in town originally to see Peralta pitch at Triple-A Colorado Springs last night.

LAST SEASON: Peralta went 3-8 with a 2.63 ERA and 1 save in 25 games (19 starts) between Class-A Carolina and Double-A Biloxi.....he held opponents to a .178 batting average with 169 strikeouts in just 120.0 innings.....his 169 strikeouts led Brewers minor leaguers and tied for ninth in all of Minor League Baseball.....his 2.63 ERA ranked second among Brewers farmhands.....Peralta began the season at Carolina, where he went 1-3 with a 3.04 ERA in 12 games (8 starts) while holding opponents to a .189 batting average with 78 strikeouts in 56.1 innings.....he was a Carolina League All-Star.....he was transferred to Biloxi on 6/22 and went 2-5 with a 2.26 ERA and 1 save in 13 games (11 starts) while holding opponents to a .167 batting average with 91 strikeouts in 63.2 innings.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Is 18-25 with a 3.31 ERA and 3 saves in 92 games (67 starts) with the Rookie DSL Mariners (2013), Rookie Arizona Mariners (2014-15), Class-A Wisconsin (2016), Class-A Brevard County (2016), Class-A Carolina (2017), Double-A Biloxi (2017) and Triple-A Colorado Springs (2018).....he was a Midwest League All-Star in 2016 and a Carolina League All-Star in 2017.....opponents have batted .219.....he has produced 470 career strikeouts in just 400.0 innings pitched.....Peralta originally signed with Seattle as a non-drafted free agent on 4/18/13.

RHP Junior Guerra will make his seventh start.....he last started on Wednesday vs. Cleveland in a 6-2 loss (5ip, 6h, 4r, 4er, 2bb, 9k, 1hr).....he has lost his last 3 starts with a 5.63 ERA (16ip, 10er).....the team is 3-3 in his starts.....he has made 1 quality start.....opponents are batting .219 (25-for-114, 3hr).....Guerra is 0-1 with a 3.09 ERA in 2 career starts vs. Arizona, both coming last season (11.2ip, 4er).....he had no decision in a 4-2, 10-inning loss on 5/26 at Miller Park (5.2ip, 3h, 1r, 1er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 1wp) and took a 3-2 loss on 6/10 at Chase Field (6ip, 5h, 3r, 3er, 4bb, 3k, 1hr, 2wp).
