TRIBE TOP THREE

» The Indians look to avoid being swept in a series of three-or-more games for the first time in 2018...has not happened to the Tribe since dropping three at Oakland from July 14-16, 2017.
» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** extended his hitting streak to eight games with a solo homer yesterday...ties for the longest streak by an Indians batter this season.
» **MIKE CLEVINGER** carries a 0.00 road ERA (0ER/14.1IP) into this afternoon's start.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians scored first, but New York-AL used a four-run 5th inning (on just one hit) to secure the lead and take a 5-2 victory at Yankee Stadium.
» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** kept his torrid stretch at the plate intact, opening the scoring with a solo homer in the top of the 5th inning...marked Lindor's eighth longball of the season, tied for 3rd-most on the team...the Tribe shortstop committed a pair of errors on a Ronald Torreyes ground ball in the bottom of the 5th that allowed two runs to score.
» **TREVOR BAUER** took the loss after allowing four runs (two earned) over 6.0 innings on just two hits with three walks and eight strikeouts...**Bauer retired each of the first 13 batters he faced before issuing three walks and a single in a 42-pitch 5th inning...**...despite the loss, Bauer extended his personal streak to six consecutive quality starts.
» **BRADLEY ZIMMER** was 1-for-3 with a double...left the game in the bottom of the 8th inning with a left shoulder contusion after colliding with the center-field wall attempting to catch an Austin Romine double...he is currently listed as day-to-day.

START SPREADIN' THE NEWS

» The Indians conclude their three-game set at New York-AL this afternoon in the first matchups between the clubs this season...the Yankees will head to Progressive Field for a four-game set from July 12-15.
» **Cleveland posted a record of 5-2 against New York-AL in 2017, winning all three games at Yankee Stadium including a double-header sweep on August 30...**...in a rivalry dating back to 1903, the Indians have gone 867-1100-12 (.441) in 1,979 regular-season contests against the Yankees...Tribe is also 9-5 in its last 14 games at Yankee Stadium.
» The two teams both qualified for the 2017 Postseason and faced off in the ALDS...after Cleveland won both of the first two games at Progressive Field, including a dramatic 9-8 Game 2 win in 13 innings, the Yankees won the final three contests to take the series, three games to two.

STARTED FROM THE BULLPEN

» The Indians announced yesterday that they have acquired **RHP OLIVER DRAKE** from the Milwaukee Brewers for cash considerations...he is expected to report to the Major League club in the coming days.
» The 31-year-old alumnus of the United States Naval Academy made 11 relief appearances for the Brewers in 2018, posting a mark of 1-0 with a 6.39 ERA (9ER/12.2IP).
» The right-hander was initially drafted by Baltimore in the 43rd round of the 2008 First-Year Player Draft and made his Major League debut for the Orioles in 2015...appeared in three seasons for Baltimore before being traded to Milwaukee on April 13, 2017.
» In parts of four seasons at the Major League level, Drake has gone 5-5 in 102 appearances with a 4.49 ERA (51ER/102.1IP)...has struck out 10.1 batters per-9.0 innings in his career.

ALLEN RECALLED

» Cleveland also recalled **OF GREG ALLEN** prior to this afternoon's contest and optioned **RHP BEN TAYLOR** to Columbus.
» Allen was previously with the Indians as the 26th man for the Puerto Rico series (April 17 & 18), appearing in both games and going 0-for-1 with a strikeout...is hitting .260 (19-73) in 21 games at Columbus this season with eight doubles and six stolen bases.
» Taylor made three relief appearances for Cleveland, making his Indians debut on May 2 vs. Texas...has gone 0-0 with a 2.70 ERA (1ER/3.1IP), working 2.0 innings (2H, 1ER, 3K) in yesterday's loss.

52 MIKE RHP CLEVINGER (2-0, 2.56 ERA)

TODAY'S START

The 27-year-old right-hander is scheduled to start this afternoon's series finale at New York-AL...will mark his 51st career appearance and 38th career start, as well as seventh start of the season, and pitches today on regular four days' rest.

» LAST TIME OUT: Made his last start on May 1 vs. the Texas Rangers at Progressive Field...did not factor into the decision, tossing 6.2 innings and allowing three runs on seven hits (one home run), with one walk and a season-high seven strikeouts.

» Currently ranks T1st in the American League with a 0.00 road ERA, as well as 2nd with a 0.55 day ERA.

» Has one career regular season appearance against the Yankees, a relief appearance on August 6, 2017 (1.0IP, 2H, 1HR, 3R/ER, 1BB, 1K)...also appeared in relief against New York-AL in the 2017 ALDS, going a combined 0-0 with a 13.50 ERA (2ER/1.1IP) across Game 2 and Game 4.

» Over his last 14 appearances (10 starts), dating back to August 26, 2017, has gone 8-1 with a 1.89 ERA (15ER/71.2IP)...in that span, has allowed one or zero runs in 11 of those 14 appearances, with the exceptions being his starts on April 13 vs. Toronto (4ER), April 26 vs. Seattle (4ER) and his last start on May 1 vs. Texas (3ER).

VS. NEW YORK-AL | A.L. EAST

» Tonight will mark Clevinger's first career start and second career regular season appearance against New York-AL.

» Last faced the Yankees in the regular season on August 6, 2017...tossed the 7th inning of the Indians 8-1 loss at Progressive Field, allowing three runs on two hits (one home run), with one walk and one strikeout in 1.0 inning.

» Also appeared in relief against the Yankees in the 2017 ALDS...tossed 0.2 innings in Game 2, allowing two runs on one hit (one home run), with two walks and two strikeouts...came into Game 4 in relief as well, allowing one unearned run on one hit, with two walks and a strikeout in 0.2 innings.

» Has 11 career outings and eight career starts against the American League East division...owns a 5-1 record and 4.40 ERA (22ER/45.0IP) in those outings.

» Has made two starts against the A.L. East this season, on April 13 vs. Toronto and April 20 at Baltimore...tossed his first career complete-game shutout on April 20 at Baltimore...is 1-0 with a 2.77 ERA (4ER/13.0IP) combined in those starts.

ON THE ROAD

» Both of Clevinger's wins this season have come on the road, where he is 2-0 and has not allowed a run in 14.1 innings combined across the two starts...this includes 5.1 shutout innings on April 2 at Los Angeles-AL and his complete-game shutout on April 20 at Baltimore.

» Has won his last four road starts, dating back to the second game of the Indians doubleheader at Detroit on September 1, 2017...is 4-0 with a 0.34 ERA (1ER/26.1IP) during that span.

» In 2017, went 7-3 with a 2.45 ERA (17ER/62.1IP) in 12 games (11 starts) on the road...owns a 9-5 career road mark and 3.59 ERA in 22 appearances (17 starts).

COMPLETE CLEVINGER

» Clevinger tossed his first career complete-game shutout on April 21 at Baltimore on April 21...held the Orioles to two hits and two walks, with three strikeouts.

» His two hits allowed in the game marking the fewest such hits in a complete-game shutout by an Indians starting pitcher since Carlos Carrasco allowed one hit in a CGSO at Kansas City on September 25, 2015 (9.0IP, 2BB, 15K).

» Set a new career-high in innings pitched for the second time this season, after breaking his previous career best with 7.1 innings pitched on April 8 vs. Kansas City.

SUNSHINE IN SPRING

» Clevinger went 2-0 with a 3.79 ERA (8ER/19.0IP) in six Cactus League starts (12H, 4HR, 4BB, 25K).

» His 25 strikeouts marked a new Spring Training career best, and ranked T2nd on the Tribe (with Corey Kluber) and T4th in the Cactus League, as well as T7th in MLB...his six starts ranked T3rd among Arizona-based pitchers and T5th in MLB.

2017 HIGHLIGHTS

» Posted career-highs in nearly every pitching category in 2017, including wins (12), strikeouts (137), ERA (3.11), innings pitched (121.2), games (27) and games started (21)...overall, went 12-6 with a 3.11 ERA (42ER/121.2IP) in 27 games (21 starts) at the Major League level.

» His 3.11 ERA ranked 8th among American League starting pitchers with at least 100.0 innings, and his .211 average against ranked 5th...also finished 4th on the Tribe in wins.

» Tossed a career-high 7.0 innings on May 20 at Houston, a feat he went on to replicate on August 12 at Tampa Bay...struck out nine batters on June 27 against Texas, a new career best...matched his strikeout feat again on Aug. 12 at Tampa Bay and Aug. 26 vs. Kansas City.

» Made four starts in the Tribe's historic 22-game win streak, allowing one earned run in those appearances and posting a 4-0 record and 0.38 ERA (1ER/23.2IP), while holding opposing hitters to a .186 (16-for-86) batting average...also became the first Indians pitcher since John Denny in 1981 to have three consecutive starts of 6.0-or-more scoreless innings.

» Won his final five starts of the season, marking a new career-long streak, and compiled a 5-0 record with a 0.61 ERA (2ER/29.2IP) in that span.

» Made three appearances out of the bullpen to end the season, from September 26-30 (3.2IP, 3H, 1ER, 4K).

» Began the season with Triple-A Columbus and spent three stints with the Indians (May 7-June 6, June 17, June 22-end)...ranked 5th in the International League in ERA at the time of his first recall on May 7...in seven starts with the Clippers, went 3-2 with a 2.65 ERA (10ER/34.0IP).

CAREER SNAPSHOT

» Clevinger is in his fourth season with the Indians organization...was selected in the 4th round (135th overall) by Los Angeles-AL in the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Seminole State College of Florida...acquired by the Indians in exchange for reliever Vinnie Pestano on Aug. 7, 2014...was added to Cleveland's 40-man roster on November 20, 2015.

» Was ranked as the 7th-best prospect in the Indians organization entering the 2015 & 2016 seasons by Baseball America...split 2016 between Triple-A Columbus and Cleveland, going 11-1 with a 3.00 ERA in 17 starts for the Clippers and making 17 appearances for the Tribe throughout the season...began the year 9-0 in Columbus, did not lose a game until July 18 (15th start)...tossed a scoreless inning in the Triple-A All-Star Game on July 13 (2K).

» Made his Major League debut on May 18, 2016 against Cincinnati...did not factor into the decision, tossing 5.1 innings (5H, 4R/ER, 1HR, 1BB, 5K) in the Tribe's 8-7 win over the Reds...struck out Joey Votto in the first inning for his first career MLB punchout...went 3-3 with a 5.26 ERA (31ER/53.0IP) in 17 games (10 starts) across three stints with the Indians.

» Named Tribe's organizational Pitcher of the Year in 2015...went 9-8 with a 2.73 ERA in 27 games/26 starts with Akron, tallying the 3rd-most strikeouts, the second-lowest WHIP and the 4th-lowest average against in all of Double-A (.219).

TUESDAY'S PROBABLE STARTER

RHP COREY KLUBER (5-1, 2.41 ERA)

The 32-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his eighth start of the season on Tuesday night against the Milwaukee Brewers, after an off-day tomorrow...will mark his 176th career appearance and 171st start.

» Kluber will be pitching on extended five days' rest after his last start on May 2 vs. Texas at Progressive Field...became the first American League pitcher to reach five wins in the start, holding the Rangers to three runs on six hits (three home runs), with six strikeouts.

» Has made seven consecutive Quality Starts to begin the 2018 season so far, the longest streak to open a season by an Indians pitcher since Josh Tomlin (9) and Justin Masterson (7) each did so in 2011.

» Kluber has never faced the Milwaukee Brewers in his career...owns a 12-4 record and 2.19 ERA (33ER/135.2IP) in 19 career Interleague starts...this includes a 1-2 record and 1.80 ERA (6ER/30.0IP) in four Interleague starts last season...last Interleague start came on August 8 vs. Colorado at Progressive Field, when he tossed a complete game (9.0IP, 3H, 1R/ER, 0BB, 11K).

» In 2017, Kluber became the first pitcher in Indians franchise history to win the A.L. Cy Young award twice (2014/2017) & the 19th multiple-winner in MLB since 1956...led the American League in wins (18, T1st), finished 2nd in strikeouts (265) and became the first Tribe pitcher to lead the Majors in ERA (2.25) since Mike Garcia in 1949.

» Kluber ranks 6th in Indians franchise history with 1254 career strikeouts...he is now 11 strikeouts behind 5th-place CC Sabathia (1265) and 22 strikeouts behind Early Wynn and Bob Lemon (T3rd, 1277).
