THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 1-1 through two games on their five-game seven-day roadtrip...after this afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel to Pittsburgh for two games in three days at PNC Park...after the roadtrip finale next Wednesday night, the Twins will travel home to begin their ninth season at Target Field with a 10-game, 11-day homestand with three against the Mariners, three against the Astros and four against the White Sox...they will continue on after that with two "home games" in Puerto Rico against the Indians.

ONE FOR THE LEFT-HAND COLUMN: The Twins beat the Orioles last night by a score of 6-2, evening the series...Kyle Gibson (1-0) was the starter and winner, pitching 6.0 no-hit innings with five walks and six strikeouts...Orioles hitters were held hitless for 7.2 innings, until a Jonathan Schoop single off Ryan Pressly in the eighth...the offense recorded nine hits, five going for extra-base hits, including homers by Miguel Sanó, Jason Castro and Max Kepler.

TWINS AND BIRDS: The Twins are 7-3 in their last 10 against the O's and 15-8 in their last 23, dating back to September of 2014.

☞ Max Kepler has hit safely in all nine career games against the Orioles, hitting .429 (15-for-35) with five doubles, one triple, three home runs, 12 RBI, five walks, a .500 OBP and a 1.386 OPS...he is hitting .381 (8-for-21) with four doubles and two homers in five career games at Camden Yards.

☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .371 (39-for-105) with a .432 on-base percentage in his last 27 games against the Orioles with multiple hits in 13 of those.

☞ Robbie Grossman is hitting .365 (19-for-52) with six doubles, nine RBI, six walks and a .431 on-base percentage in 15 career games against the Orioles...he is hitting .474 (9-for-19) with a .524 on-base percentage in six games at Camden Yards.

MINNESOTA'S GREATEST HITS: With two hits last night, Joe Mauer now needs 11 hits to reach 2,000 for his career, which would join Kirby Puckett and Rod Carew as the only players in club history to reach the mark...11 active players have reached the 2,000 hit plateau, most recently Adrian Gonzalez in August of 2017.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Twins went 24-22-6 in series play in 2017...the Twins have gone 2-1 in series play at Camden Yards dating back to 2015.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Twins went 44-37 on the road last season for a road win-percentage of .543, the fourth best in the AL, trailing Cleveland (.654), Houston (.654) and Boston (.556)...44 road wins were their most since 1991 (44-37).

HERE COMES THE SUN: The Twins went 28-33 in day games in 2017, compared to 57-44 in night games...Twins pitchers posted an ERA of 5.52 during the day and 4.02 at night...Twins batters hit .252 with 4.95 runs-per-game during the day and .265 with 5.08 runs-per-game at night.

☞ Joe Mauer hit .316 (55-for-174) in 50 day games in 2017.

NEW BLOOD: The Twins have eight new players on roster for 2018: **Zach Duke** was signed to a one-year contract December 28...**Tyler Kinley** was selected in the Rule 5 Draft...**Lance Lynn** was signed to a one-year contract March 12...**Jake Odorizzi** was acquired via trade with Tampa Bay February 17...**Addison Reed** was signed to a two-year contract January 15...**Fernando Rodney** was signed to a one-year contract (club option in '19) December 15...**Logan Morrison** was signed to a one-year contract February 25...**Ryan LaMarre** was signed to a minor league contract with an invite to spring training November 22.

WHAT DO YOU KNOW ABOUT DAZZLE?: Twins radio ace Dan Gladden hit .261 (64-for-245) with 15 doubles, three triples, four home runs, 31 RBI, 16 walks, 39 runs scored, 19 stolen bases and a .312 on-base percentage in 69 career games against the Orioles...he played 11 career games at Camden Yards, hitting .175 (7-for-40) with two walks...he had 64 hits against the O's from 1987-1993, the second most in baseball during that span, among right-handed hitting California-born outfielders, trailing only Rob Deer (66).

WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW: Info on Target Field's off-season renovations: **BAT & BARREL** - The space formerly known as the "Metropolitan Club" was improved to accommodate any fan, making it open to all fans with a game-day ticket...the most expansive renovation to date includes operable glass windows opening the space to the Target Field experience...additionally, the space features state-of-the-art video elements, Minnesota-based artist murals, and major award history on display...**EXPANDED CONCOURSE AND DRAFT 34** - The Twins unveiled plans for expanding the main concourse at the intersection of Gates 29 and 34...this renovation will expand the concourse by as much as 40 feet creating enhanced ingress and egress for fans...it will also cut down on congestion and provide fans with premium new drink rail standing-room locations...also included in the concourse renovation is a new tap wall known as **DRAFT 34**, which will feature up to 22 unique beers from across Twins Territory...the new capacity at Target Field is now **38,649** (previously - 38,885).

SPRING RECAP: In Berríos' fourth spring training with the Twins, went 2-1, 1.42 ERA (19.0 IP, 3 ER) with 16 strikeouts and six walks in six starts...in final exhibition start against Washington at Nationals Park on March 27, allowed no runs, no hits and one walk and three strikeouts in 3.0 IP.

2017 RECAP:

- Berríos started 25 games, a single-season career-high.
- In first full season, Berríos finished 14-8 with 139 strikeouts and 48 walks over 145.2 innings.
- Set career highs in wins (14), strikeouts (139), innings (145.2) and ERA (3.89)...he ranked second on Twins staff in wins, and strikeouts, and third in starts and innings pitched.
- Tied for ninth in the AL in wins.
- The youngest pitcher in baseball to record an 11-strikeouts game last year against Colorado on May 18.
- Made first career postseason appearance against New York-AL in the Wild Card Game...allowed three runs in three innings and was credited with a loss.

AGAINST BALTIMORE: Berríos is making his fourth career start against Baltimore and his second at Camden Yards...in three starts against the Orioles, Berríos is 2-0, 4.67 ERA (17.1 IP, 9 ER)...in his most recent start on July 6, 2017, Berríos allowed three earned runs in six innings with four strikeouts and no walks...also earned a win on May 24, 2017 at Baltimore, allowed three runs on four hits in 6.1 innings...Berríos has allowed six career home runs to Baltimore, the most he has allowed to any team in baseball.

ROAD WOES: In 23 career road starts, Berríos is 8-9 with a 5.65 ERA over 113.0 innings...of the 27 home runs Berríos has surrendered in his career, 19 have been at opposing ballparks...Berríos lasted more than 5.0 innings in only eight of his 17 road starts in 2017, which was an improvement from only two such outings in 2016.

OPENING ACTS: When Berríos makes his season debut: against Cleveland on April 27, 2016, Berríos surrendered five earned runs in four innings and suffered the loss in his big league debut...on May 13, 2017 against Cleveland, the righty tossed 7.2 innings, allowing only one run on two hits with four strikeouts and earned the win.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME: Berríos went 9-1, 2.41 ERA (67.1 IP, 18 ER) in 11 appearances (10 starts) at Target Field in 2017...conversely, Berríos was 5-7, 5.17 ERA (78.1 IP, 45 ER) on the road...suffered 10 consecutive road losses before winning at Detroit May 21, 2017...opponents only hit .199 against him at Target Field in 2017 with only three home runs.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME, PART 2: The Twins are playing Cleveland in a two-game series in Berríos' home country of Puerto Rico April 17 and 18...Berríos is slated to pitch in one of those two games...Berríos pitched for Team Puerto Rico in the WBC last spring, going 1-0, 8.10 ERA (6.2 IP, 6 ER) with two walks and 10 strikeouts in two games (1 start).
