NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees went 4-2 on their six-game homestand...are 18G over .500, matching their season high (also 18G over at the close of play on 5/21)...did not reach 18G over .500 in 2017 until their 152nd game (85-67 at the close of play on 9/20/17)...reached a season-best 21G over .500 just once last season (91-70 after their 161st game on 9/30/17)...never reached 18G over at any point in 2016, '14 or '13 and maxed out at 18G over in 2015, last at 77-59 on 9/7/15.
 - Have won 10 of their last 11 series since 4/19.
 - Are 22-9 (.710) at Yankee Stadium in 2018 and 17-4 in their last 21 home games...since 8/31/17, are 36-13 in 49 regular season home games...are 14-1-1 in their last 16 home series since 8/31/17.
 - Improved to 42-26 (.618) vs. reigning AL champions since 2010, when they were the defending AL (and World Series) champions themselves.
 - Went 5-2 against Houston this season (3-1 at Houston, 2-1 at Yankee Stadium)...have outscored the Astros, 27-20...are 21-18 against the Astros since they joined the American League in 2013.
 - Are a Major League-best 14-4 this season when they face a left-hander.
 - Are 28-4 (.875) when scoring first this season, the Majors' second-best winning pct. (Boston, .889, 24-3) and second-most wins (Milwaukee, .857, 30-5) in those situations this year.
- **RHP Luis Severino** (7.0IP, 4H, 2ER, 1BB, 11K, 1HR) started and earned his eighth win of the season...retired his first 11 batters faced...his 11K tied his season high (5/8 vs. Boston) and were one shy of his career high (12K on 6/27/17 at Chicago-AL).
 - Is undefeated in his last nine starts, posting a 6-0 mark with a 1.95 ERA (60.0IP, 13ER).
 - The Yankees are 11-1 in Severino's 12 starts this season, the most team wins in a pitcher's starts in the Majors.
 - Is 5-0 with a 1.79 ERA (45.1IP, 9ER) in seven starts at home this season.
 - In two starts vs. the Astros this season, is 2-0 with a 1.13 ERA (16.0IP, 2ER).
- **LF Giancarlo Stanton** (1-for-2, 1RBI, 1BB) is 15-for-33 (.455) with 2 doubles, 5HR and 4BB vs. left-handed pitchers since 4/27, having reached base safely in 19-of-38 PA...overall, is hitting .382/.419/.855 (21-for-55) with 11XBH vs. LHP this season (3 doubles, 1 triple, 7HR)...entered tonight's game second in the Majors in HR vs. LHP and third in SLG.
- **RF Aaron Judge** (2-for-4, 1R) has back-to-back multi-hit games for the first time since 4/8-11 (3G)...is batting .349 (38-for-109) with 28R, 7 doubles, 12HR and 33RBI in 31 games at Yankee Stadium this season.
- **C Austin Romine** (1-for-2, 2R, 1BB) extended his hitting streak to a career-high nine games...is batting .462 (12-for-26) with 9R, 3 doubles, 3HR and 9RBI during that stretch.
 - Since 4/22, is 6-for-13 (.462) with 3 doubles and 1HR vs. left-handed pitchers.
- **C Gary Sánchez** (1-for-3, 1BB) snapped an 0-for-19 stretch with a go-ahead two-run single in the fifth...marked his first RBI since 5/19 at Kansas City (3RBI)...his eight-game stretch without an RBI was the second-longest of his career (10G from 8/28-9/8/16).
- **CF Aaron Hicks** (1-for-3, 1R) snapped an 0-for-16 with an RBI double in the sixth.
- Since his debut on 4/22, **2B Gleyber Torres** (1-for-4, 1R, 1 double) leads MLB rookies with a .321 BA (36-for-113), 9HR and 26RBI.
- **RHP David Robertson** (1.0IP, 1H, 2K) tossed a scoreless eighth inning.
- **LHP Aroldis Chapman** (1.0IP, 2H, 1ER, 1K) converted his 12th save of the season...snapped his 7.1 scoreless inning streak.

HOUSTON ASTROS NOTES

- The Astros fell to 3-4 on their seven-game road trip...have lost four-of-five games after winning eight-of-nine previous games...are now 5-3-1 in road series this season...finished 2-5 in the season series with the Yankees...are 7-5 in their last 12 regular season games at Yankee Stadium (since 8/25/15) and 10-12 all-time at the current Yankee Stadium...are now 19-11 on the road this season...fell to 5-8 when their starter fails to complete at least 6.0IP.
- **LHP Dallas Keuchel** (5.0IP, 7H, 4ER, 3BB, 7K, 2WP) has allowed six-or-more hits in three consecutive starts...threw a season-high 106 pitches...snapped his three-start road undefeated streak (since 4/21 at Chicago-AL)...allowed one run in the first inning, his ninth run allowed in first innings this season...allowed just nine first-inning runs in total last season.
 - In two starts vs. the Yankees this season, is 0-2 with a 5.25 ERA (12.0IP, 12H, 7ER, 3BB, 12K, 2HR, 2WP)...in his previous five regular season starts vs. the Yankees (6/25/15-5/11/17), was 4-1 with a 0.98 ERA (36.2IP, 4ER).
 - Snapped his three start winning streak at Yankee Stadium (since 8/25/15)...is now 3-2 with a 2.45 ERA (33.0IP, 9ER) in five regular season starts at Yankee Stadium.
 - Was the first time he failed to complete at least 6.0IP vs. the Yankees in the *regular season* (all previous seven *regular season* starts had been quality starts)...are the most runs given up to the Yankees in a *regular season* start (previous: 3R twice)...in eight career regular season starts vs. the Yankees is now 4-4 with a 2.22 ERA (56.2IP, 14ER).
- **Astros batters** stuck out 14 times tonight, their second-most strikeouts this season (18K on 5/27 at Cleveland)...hit .176 (9-for-51) with 2 doubles, 2HR, 15RBI and 19K with runners in scoring position in seven games vs. the Yankees.
- **2B Jose Altuve** (2-for-4, 2K) finished the road trip hitting .469/.485/.813 (15-for-32) with 8R, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 2HR, 7RBI, 1BB, 7K and 2SB in seven games...recorded multiple hits in five-of-seven games on the trip and leads the team with 21 multi-hit games this season.
 - Is batting .402 (51-for-127) on the road this season...has the highest road batting average in the AL.
- **C Max Stassi** (2-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 3RBI, 1K) tied a career high with 3RBI (also on 4/8/18 vs. San Diego)...drove in all three of Houston's runs...extended his career-long hitting streak to seven games with his fifth inning, two-run home run...is hitting .360 (9-for-25) with 6R, 3 doubles, 2HR, 7RBI, 2BB and 9K over the stretch.
- **DH Evan Gattis** (1-for-4, 1K) is hitting .294 (25-for-85) in 25 games on the road, compared to just .153 (9-for-59) in 21 games at home this season.
