NATIONALS NEWS

MAKE IT A DOUBLE

Following a day off on Monday, the Washington Nationals open a four-game series against the Atlanta Braves with a doubleheader on Tuesday...Today marks Washington's third doubleheader of the season (5/19 vs. LAD, 8/4 vs. CIN)...The Nationals are 8-4-20 (sweeps-swept-splits) when playing twice in a single day, and 36-28 overall in doubleheaders since baseball returned to Washington in 2005.

WELCOME, GREG!

The Washington Nationals agreed to terms with right-handed pitcher **Greg Holland** and optioned right-handed pitcher **Jimmy Cordero** to Triple-A Syracuse...Holland is 21-20 with 186 saves and a 2.93 ERA across parts of eight MLB seasons...He has recorded career marks of 11.7 SO/9.0, 3.02 SO/BB and a 1.197 WHIP.

WINNING WAYS

The Nationals enter Tuesday having won eight of their last 11 games...Over the 11-game stretch dating to July 25, Washington has outscored its opponents 76-35.

- Nationals starting pitchers have worked to a National-League best 2.48 ERA (19 ER/69.0 IP) and a .220 opp. AVG (4th-best in the N.L.) over this stretch of games.
- At the same time, Washington's offense has put together a National-League best .288/.386/.501 slash line since July 25.

SECOND HALF STATUS CHECK

Since returning from the All-Star break, Washington leads National League clubs in on-base percentage (.365), slugging percentage (.480), OPS (.844), runs scored (T1st, 92), and stolen bases (14)...They rank among National League clubs in batting average (2nd, .277), doubles (T3rd, 30), home runs (T3rd, 21) and batting average with runners in scoring position (3rd, .308).

- Washington hitters have recorded 103 strikeouts since the All-Star break, the fewest in the National League.

JUAN GOOD ROOKIE

In 11 games dating to July 25, Juan Soto is 14-for-40 (.350) with three doubles, one triple, three homers, six RBI, 11 walks and 14 runs scored...He has struck out just four times over this stretch...He has reached base safely in all 11 games, his second-longest streak of the season (12 G; 6/17-29).

- Soto leads all MLB rookies (min. 275 PA), in batting average (.310), on-base percentage (.424), slugging percentage (.556), and OPS (.980).
- Even though he was called up on May 20, he ranks among National League rookies this season in home runs (2nd, 13), walks (2nd, 46), runs (2nd, 48), doubles (T3rd, 16), RBI (5th, 37) and hits (6th, 72).
- Since May 15 (the first game in his game log, due to the suspended game vs. NYY), Soto ranks among all National League hitters in on-base percentage (3rd, .424), runs scored (5th, 48), batting average (9th, .310), walks (T6th, 46), slugging percentage (10th, .556) and home runs (T13th, 13).
- Among all National League hitters (min. 275 PA) in 2018, he ranks in OPS (2nd, .980), on-base percentage (2nd, .424), batting average (6th, .310) and slugging percentage (7th, .556).

THE OPPOSITE OF A DERBY SLUMP

Bryce Harper is hitting .367 (18-for-49) with six doubles, three home runs, 14 RBI, 10 walks, three stolen bases and 12 runs scored in 15 games since returning from the All-Star break.

- He ranks in the National League in OBP (4rd, .484), runs (T6th, 12), doubles (T6th, 6), OPS (6th, 1.157), batting average (T10th, .367) and SLG (10th, .673) since the All-Star break.
- Even before the All-Star break, Harper began to heat up in the form of extra-base hits...Since June 19, he ranks fourth in the National League with 14 doubles and his 21 extra-base hits are tied for eighth.
- Harper clubbed his 26th home run of the season on Thursday night...His 26 home runs are tied for third in the National League, while his 88 walks pace the league.

MURPH IS MASHING

In 21 games dating to July 8, **Daniel Murphy** is 27-for-67 (.403) with a .461 on-base percentage (27 H, 8 BB) and a .612 slugging percentage (5 2B, 3 HR)...He has struck out just six times in 76 plate appearances over this stretch.

- He has hit safely in 13 of his last 15 games, going 19-for-50 (.380) with three doubles, three homers, 13 RBI, four walks and seven runs scored.
- Murphy has struck out just 13 times in 150 plate appearances this season, the fewest among MLB players with at least 150 plate appearances in 2018.

TONY IS ON A TEAR

Anthony Rendon has hit safely in 34 of his last 40 games dating back to June 15...Over the stretch, he is hitting .323 with a .365 OBP and a .604 SLG...He is tied for sixth in the National League with 25 extra-base hits (14 2B, 3B, 10 HR) and his .604 SLG is good for eighth over this stretch.

NATIONALS HISTORY

August 7 (9-4 on this date)

2007 - **Barry Bonds** became MLB's all-time home run king, hitting his 756th career long ball and moving past **Hank Aaron**, but the Nationals plated four runs in the eighth to win, 8-6, at SFG. Bonds' record-breaking fifth-inning long ball came on a 3-2 offering from **Mike Bacsik** at 8:51 pm (PT) and snapped a 4-4 tie. The Nationals spoiled the Bay Area celebration, as **Felipe Lopez's** RBI-double snapped a 6-6 tie. **Chris Schroder** earned his first MLB win. Nationals Director of Baseball Research and Development, **Sam Mondry-Cohen** watched from the Nationals' dugout as he served as a batboy in the visitors' clubhouse.

OPPONENT

ATLANTA BRAVES

Dave Martinez capped his 16-year Major League career with Atlanta in 2001, hitting .287 in 12 games...**Matt Adams** clubbed 19 home runs in 100 games for the Braves in 2017...The Braves made Nationals pitching coach **Derek Lilliquist** their first-round selection (6th overall) in the 1987 Amateur Draft.

THE SERIES

Since the start of 2015 season, the Nationals are 26-9 against the Braves at Nationals Park.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

#68 - JEFY RODRIGUEZ - RHP

Tall, hard-throwing righty was added to Washington's 40-man roster following the 2017 season...Embarked on his first Major League Spring Training in 2018...Baseball America cites him as the No. 24 prospect in Washington's Minor League system and as having the "Best Fastball" among Nationals farmhands.

AGAINST THE BRAVES: Faced the Braves in his Major League debut tossing 4.2 innings of scoreless relief, giving up four hits and two walks while striking out on three on June 3.

LAST START: Tossed 5.0 IP striking out four batters along the way while giving up six runs on eight hits...Suffered his first career loss in Washington's 6-3 loss on July 9 against the Pittsburgh Pirates.

2018 NOTES

- Was recalled on July 5 for third career Major League stint...Made two starts in his previous stint.
- Was recalled on June 19 for his second career Major League stint.
- Made his Major League debut on June 3 at Atlanta...Was called upon in the bottom of the first inning after Jeremy Hellickson left the game due to injury...Impressed with 4.2 innings of four-hit, shutout ball...Struck out three batters while issuing just two walks.
- Is 5-3 with a 3.31 ERA in 13 starts for Double-A Harrisburg...Has 72 strikeouts and a .222 opp. batting average.
- Has not allowed an earned run in his last three Double-A starts...Has allowed just four hits while striking out 21 batters.
- Has struck out a season-high nine batters twice (4/18 vs. Reading and 5/21 at Hartford).

2017 NOTES

- Went 4-3 with a 3.32 ERA in 12 games (10 starts) for Single-A Potomac.
- Left-handed batters hit just .175 with a .283 on-base percentage and a .213 slugging percentage against him (14-for-80, 3 2B, 23 SO).
- Finished the season strong, posting a 2.81 ERA (5 ER/16.0 IP) with a .196 opponent batting average (10-for-51) in his final five games/three starts.
- Improved his WHIP (1.11), hits per 9.0 IP (6.9), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (8.1), walks per 9.0 IP (3.0) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.68) during the 2017 season as compared to 2016, with all numbers proving better than his career numbers

2016 NOTES

- Made a career-high 25 starts and recorded a career-high seven wins for Single-A Hagerstown.

2015 NOTES

- Went 4-10 with a 5.42 ERA in a then career-high 23 starts between Single-A Hagerstown and short-season Single-A Auburn.

#31 - MAX SCHERZER - RHP

Polished veteran right-hander, three-time Cy Young Award Winner and five-time consecutive All-Star signed a historic seven-year contract with Washington on Jan. 21, 2015...Joined the Nationals after seven Major League seasons with the Detroit Tigers (2010-14) and Arizona Diamondbacks (2008-09)...Is one of just 10 pitchers in Major League history to take home the Cy Young Award three or more times.

AGAINST THE BRAVES: Is 2-1 with a 1.80 ERA in his four starts against Atlanta in 2018...Is 9-6 with a 3.57 ERA in 18 career starts against the Braves.
LAST START: Won his fifth straight start, tossing 6.0 innings, allowing two runs on four hits as Washington topped Cincinnati, 10-4...Struck out 10 batters while issuing just two walks...It was his fifth straight start with two walks or fewer.

2018 NOTES

- Is 3-0 with a 1.80 ERA (4 ER/20.0 IP) over his last three starts...Has struck out 28 batters while walking just four.
- Ranks among NL pitchers in strikeouts (1st, 210), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (1st, 12.22), WHIP (1st, 0.91), opp. AVG (1st, .183), opp. OBP (1st, .245), hits per 9.0 IP (1st, 5.94), wins (1st, 15), strikeout-to-walk ratio (2nd, 5.53), ERA (2nd, 2.33), opp. OPS (3rd, .580) and opp. SLG (6th, .335).
- Has tossed at least 7.0 innings in 12 starts, tied for the second-most in MLB and second-most in the National League.
- Opposing batters are hitting .143 (14-for-99) with runners in scoring position, the lowest mark in the National League.
- Recorded his 200th strikeout of the season on July 27 at MIA (Bour)...It marks his seventh consecutive 200+ strikeout season...Scherzer is the only active player in MLB with a streak this long...According to *Elias*, Scherzer's streak of seven 200+ strikeout seasons is tied for second in MLB history behind **Tom Seaver** (NYM, 9, 1968-1976), and with **Roger Clemens** (BOS, 7, 1986-1992) and **Walter Johnson** (WSH, 7, 1910-1916).
- Recorded his 1,000th strikeout w/WSH on July 2 vs. BOS, becoming the 11th pitcher in MLB history to collect at least 1,000 strikeouts with two different clubs...The list, according to *Elias*: **Jim Bunning** (DET/PHI), **Roger Clemens** (BOS/NYY), **Randy Johnson** (ARI/SEA), **Mark Langston** (ANA/SEA), **Greg Maddux** (CHI/ATL), **Mike Mussina** (BAL/NYY), **Nolan Ryan** (CAL/HOU), **CC Sabathia** (CLE/NYY), **Luis Tiant** (BOS/CLE) and **Cy Young** (BOS/CLE)
- Recorded a nine-game winning streak from (4/9-6/5) which tied the second-longest streak of his career (13 G; 4/6-7/3/13 and 9 G; 8/20/16-4/7/17)...It is the longest winning streak in Major League Baseball in 2018.
- Struck out at least 10 batters in three consecutive starts from May 6-19, tied for the third-longest streak of his career (6 G; 5/26-6/21/17).
- Did not earn the win, but struck out a season-high 15 batters on May 6 vs. PHI...It was his fifth career 15+ strikeout game...He became the first pitcher in Major League history (since 1913) to strike out at least 15 batters in no more than 6.1 IP according to Baseball-Reference.com.
- Was named National League Pitcher of the Month for April (5-0, 1.62 ERA, 57 SO, 9 BB, .165 opp. AVG) and May (4-0, 2.21 ERA, 63 SO, 10 BB).
