#### TODAY IN YANKEES HISTORY

**Oct. 6, 1947:** Joe Page allows only one hit in 5.0 innings of relief as the Yankees earn a 5-2 win over the Dodgers in Game 7 of the World Series, marking the 11th championship in franchise history.

**Oct. 6, 1926:** Babe Ruth goes 3-for-3 with 3HR, 4R, 4RBI and 2BB during the Yankees' 10-5 win over the Cardinals in Game 4 of the World Series. Ruth remains one of only four players in MLB history to hit 3HR in a World Series game.

#### TOMORROW IN YANKEES HISTORY

**Oct. 7, 1952:** Mickey Mantle and Gene Woodling each go 2-for-4 with a homer and Billy Martin makes a running catch on a bases-loaded, two-out popup in the seventh inning, as the Yankees earn a 4-2 victory over the Dodgers in Game 7 of the World Series at Ebbets Field. It marks the Yankees' fourth consecutive championship and 15th overall.

**Oct. 7, 1950:** Yogi Berra homers and Whitey Ford allows 0ER in 8.2IP, as the Yankees secure their second consecutive World Series title and 13th overall by defeating the Phillies, 5-2, in Game 4.

**ON TO THE NEXT ONE:** The Yankees are down, one game to none, in their best-of-five ALDS vs. Boston...will play Game 2 at Boston tonight...are 1-1 in their 54th postseason in club history.  
▶ Marks their 20th appearance in the ALDS, their 19th in 24 postseasons since the playoffs were expanded to eight teams in 1995 (for full list, see p. 145 of Yankees' 2018 Postseason Media Guide or p. 326 of 2018 Media Guide)...are 12-7 in 19 series in the ALDS.

**BOUNCING BACK:** The Yankees have advanced in six of the seven ALDS in which they lost the opener (advanced in 1996, 2000-01, '03-04, '17; did not in 2007)...have won 2-of-3 ALDS after losing Game 1 on the road...have gone 4-3 in ALDS Game 2 after losing Game 1.  
▶ Have fallen behind, 0-2, in the ALDS three times, advancing in 2001 vs. Oakland (in 5G) and 2017 vs. Cleveland (in 5G) and losing in 2007 vs. Cleveland (in 4G).

**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The Yankees lost Game 1 of the ALDS on Friday at Boston, 5-4...trailing, 5-0, after three innings before scoring the game's final 4R...loaded the bases in both the sixth (2R) and seventh (1R)...**LHP J.A. Happ** (2.0IP, 4H, 5ER, 1BB, 2K, 1HR) started and took the loss, his first since 7/12 at Boston (snapped his 12-start unbeaten streak)...**RF Aaron Judge** (3-for-5) hit a solo HR in the ninth...**1B Luke Voit** (2-for-5) has 2RBI in each of his two postseason games...**Yankees relievers** combined to throw 6.0 scoreless innings (4H, 2BB, 5K).

**SEEING RED:** The ALDS marks only the fourth time that the Yankees will face the Red Sox in a postseason series (won 1999 ALCS, won 2003 ALCS, lost 2004 ALCS)...the Yankees are 11-9 in 20 postseason games (6-4 at home, 5-5 in Boston).  
▶ Is the first postseason meeting of 100-win teams prior to the World Series since 1977, when the Yankees defeated Kansas City in the ALCS...is the second consecutive postseason with a matchup of 100-win teams, following the 2017 World Series between Houston and Los Angeles-NL.  
▶ Have lost five consecutive postseason games vs. Boston (since 2004 ALCS Game 1), tied for their second-longest postseason losing streak vs. a single opponent (eight straight vs. New York Giants, 1921-23; five straight vs. Detroit, 2011-12).

**THE HUNDREDS:** With a 100-62 (.617) mark, the Yankees recorded the 20th 100-win season in franchise history...are responsible for 20 of the 104 seasons in which a Major League team reached 100 wins...marked their highest win total since going 103-59 in 2009.  
▶ With Boston (108-54, .667) and Houston (103-59, .636), marked the first time in Major League history that one league had three 100-win teams.

**HOT HAND LUKE:** **1B Luke Voit** has collected 2RBI in each of his first two postseason games (ALDS G1, AL WCG)...is the third Yankee to recorded multiple RBI in each of his first 2G in the postseason, joining Ben Chapman and Bill Dickey (both in 1932 World Series Games 1-2).  
▶ Has multiple RBI in three straight and five of his last 6G (regular and postseason)...has at least 1RBI in seven straight games and 11-of-13, batting .404 (21-for-52) with 13R, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 7HR, 20RBI and 4BB in that span.  
▶ Made his Yankees debut on 8/2 and hit .333/.405/.689 (44-for-132) with 28R, 5 doubles, 14HR, 33RBI and 15BB in 39 regular season games...his 1.095 OPS was the third-highest by Yankee in a single season since 1962 (min. 100AB), trailing Oscar Gamble (1.187 in 1979) and Glenallen Hill (1.112 in 2000).

**PRICE CHECK:** David Price will make his first postseason start vs. the Yankees tonight...since the start of 2016, Price is 2-7 with a 7.71 ERA (58.1IP, 50ER) in 11 starts against the Yankees, allowing at least 5R seven times...over that span, **Yankees batters** are batting .335/.387/.601 (83-for-248) with 16HR.  
▶ Price went 0-3 with a 10.34 ERA (15.2IP, 18ER) and allowed 9HR in four starts vs. the Yankees this season.  
▶ **C Gary Sánchez** is 6-for-13 with 5HR in his career vs. Price.

**ALL RISE: RF Aaron Judge** set a postseason career high in hits in ALDS Game 1 at Boston, going 3-for-5 with a ninth-inning solo HR...has homered in both postseason games in 2018 after hitting just 1HR in his final 17 regular season games (since 7/23)...leads current Yankees with six career postseason home runs.  
▶ 10 of his 14 career postseason hits are extra-base hits (including eight of his last 10)...is the third Yankee to have at least 10XBH in his first 15 postseason games (Bernie Williams-12, Lou Gehrig-11)...has homered in five of his last 7G in the postseason.  
▶ Is batting .250/.364/.643 (14-for-56) with 12R, 4 doubles, 6HR, 14RBI and 10BB in 15 postseason games...his 1.006 OPS ranks ninth among active players (min. 50PA).

**ROOKIE MOVES: 2B Gleyber Torres** singled in the eighth inning of ALDS Game 1 at Boston on Friday, becoming the second-youngest player in Yankees history (21 years, 296 days) to record a postseason hit, behind Mickey Mantle (first postseason hit at 19 years old in 1951 World Series Game 2 vs. the New York Giants)...is the youngest position player to appear in a postseason game for the Yankees since INF Tom Carroll (age 19, 15d) in World Series Game 5 on 10/2/55.  
▶ **3B Miguel Andújar** has drawn 2BB through his first two postseason games after recording just 2BB in his final 22 regular season games...tied the AL rookie single-season record with 47 doubles (also Boston's Fred Lynn in 1975)...tied for second-most by any rookie, trailing only Brooklyn's Johnny Frederick (52 in 1929)...surpassed Joe DiMaggio (45 in 1936) for the Yankees rookie record...tied for the seventh-highest doubles total in Yankees history.

**BRONX BOMBERS: Yankees batters** have hit 3HR in their first 2G this postseason...broke the single-season Major League home run record with 267HR in 2018, surpassing the 1997 Mariners (264HR)...also broke the Yankees' previous club record of 245HR in 2012.  
▶ Hit 15HR over their final six regular season road games...hit 123 road HRs, second-most in the Majors to Oakland (136HR), and the third-highest total in club history (128HR in 1961, 124HR in 2003).  
▶ Were the first team in Major League history to have 12 players hit at least 10HR in the same season...five teams have had 11 players reach double-digit home runs: Detroit in 2004, Houston in 2015 and '17, Minnesota in 2016 and Toronto in 2018.

**TANAKA TIME: RHP Masahiro Tanaka** is 2-2 with a 1.44 ERA (25.0IP, 14H, 4ER, 6BB, 21K, 2HR) in four postseason starts, the second-lowest ERA in Yankees history among pitchers with at least four postseason starts (Monte Pearson-1.01).

**STANTON ISLAND: OF Giancarlo Stanton** is playing in his first postseason after 1,144 career regular season games...were second-most among active players who had never reached the postseason (Seattle's Kyle Seager-1,155G).  
▶ Homered and stole a base in his postseason debut in the AL Wild Card Game vs. Oakland...the HR had an exit velocity of 117.4 mph, the hardest-hit postseason HR of the Statcast era (since 2015)...was the first Yankee and eighth player ever to record both a HR and SB in his postseason debut.  
▶ Including both regular and postseason, is hitting .360/.410/.667 (27-for-75) with 14R, 6 doubles, 1 triple, 5HR and 17RBI in 19G vs. Boston in 2018...has eight multi-hit efforts in 10G at Fenway Park, hitting .452 (19-for-42) with 8R, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 2HR and 9RBI.  
▶ In his first season as a Yankee, tied for sixth in the Majors with 38HR, ranked seventh in the AL with 100RBI and tied for seventh in the AL with 102R...was the 12th player in franchise history to reach 38HR, 100RBI and 100R in a single season...was just the fourth to reach those totals in his first season with the club, joining Mark Teixeira in 2009 (39HR, 122RBI, 103R), Jason Giambi in 2002 (41HR, 122RBI, 120R) and Babe Ruth in 1920 (54HR, 136RBI, 158R)...his 38HR were the fifth-most by a player in his first season as a Yankee, behind Ruth, Giambi, Teixeira and Roger Maris (39HR in 1960).
