**ROAD TRIPPIN' REDBIRDS:** The Cardinals continue their nine-game/10-day road trip through Pittsburgh (2-1), Miami (0-1) and Kansas City with the second game of a three-game series in Miami. This nine-game stretch ties the Cardinals' longest road trip of the season (July 2-11: ARI, SF, CWS). St. Louis is 10-9 post All-Star Break and 11-9 under interim manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The Cardinals enter today in 3rd place in the NL Central, 7.5 games out of first place and 4.5 games out of the second Wild Card position.

**KEEP IT ROLLING:** The Cardinals are one of nine MLB teams with four wins this month...St. Louis has had a winning record in August the last seven seasons (2011-17). Sunday marked the Cardinals season-best third consecutive winning series (vs. Cubs, vs. Rockies, at Pirates). The last time the Cardinals won three straight series was from Aug. 31-Sept. 10, 2017 at San Francisco (3-1), at San Diego (3-1), and vs. Pittsburgh (3-0).

**ROSS ACTIVATED; BREBBIA OPTIONED:** The Cardinals announced that they activated right-handed pitcher **Tyson Ross** today and that they had optioned right-handed pitcher **John Brebbia** to Memphis (AAA) following last night's game. Ross, 31, who was claimed off waivers from San Diego on Sunday, is expected to join the St. Louis bullpen. Overall this season, the former 2014 NL All-Star and nine-year veteran right-hander has gone 6-9 with a 4.45 ERA (123.1 IP) and 107 strikeouts in 22 starts. Ross has limited opposing batters to a .240 average against (112-466), including a .177 mark (38-215) against right-handed hitters that ranks as the 4th-lowest among all qualified Major League pitchers.

**YOUNG BIRDS:** With his first game appearance, García, will become the seventh Cardinal to make his MLB debut this season, joining **Jordan Hicks**, **Yairo Muñoz**, **Tyler O'Neill**, **Austin Gomber**, **Daniel Ponce de Leon**, and **Dakota Hudson**. St. Louis' seven MLB debuts are tied with Colorado for 5th most in the NL (the Mets have the most with 11).

**SECRET SALSA:** Reigning NL Player of the Month and Player of the Week **Matt Carpenter** co-leads the National League with a career-high 29 home runs (Colorado's **Nolan Arenado**)...Carpenter also leads Major League Baseball with 19 home runs on the road (**Khris Davis**, 17) in addition to 25 solo blasts (**Mike Trout**, 22), which are T7th most in Cardinals single-season history (**Mark McGwire**, 35, 1999).

**SELECT COMPANY:** With his next home run, **Matt Carpenter** will become the 15th Cardinals left-handed hitter to whack 30 in a single season and the first since **Jim Edmonds** (42) in 2004...Carpenter will also be the first MLB player this season and 13th different Cardinal in franchise history (31st occurrence) to hit at least 30 home runs and 30 doubles in a season...the last Cardinal with 30 homers and 30 doubles was **Albert Pujols** in 2010 (42 HRs, 39 2Bs), who reached the milestone in 10 consecutive seasons (2001-10).

**CARPENTER WINS ANOTHER NL PLAYER OF THE WEEK AWARD:** **Matt Carpenter** slashed .423/.543/.962 with seven runs, 11 hits, two doubles, four home runs, seven RBI, eight walks and a stolen base across seven games to claim his second NL Player of the Week Award this season (also July 22nd), and the fourth of his career. Among his NL counterparts, Carpenter ranked 1st in total bases (25), T1st first in home runs and walks, 2nd in on-base and slugging, T2nd in hits and extra-base hits (6), T3rd in RBI, T4th in runs; and 7th in batting average.

**ALL THE TOOLS:** With a single yesterday, Carpenter extended his on-base streak to 25 games (July 8-present), longest active on-base streak in the Majors, T10th longest in MLB this season, and one game shy of his career high (26 G, Sept. 18, 2014-April 28, 2015). Over that red-hot stretch, he is slashing .371/.491/.888 with 33 hits, seven doubles, 13 home runs, 21 walks and 23 RBI.

**WHAT A RELIEF:** Since July 27, eight Cardinals relievers have combined to lead the National League in ERA (1.50), wins (4), average against (.176) innings pitched (42.0), and baserunners/9.0 IP (8.79). co-lead in WHIP (0.98), and rank 2nd in strikeouts (36).

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** Since the All-Star Break, the Cardinals have hit a NL-leading 35 doubles in their 19 games...over that span, six two-baggers from **Yadier Molina** and **Yairo Muñoz** rank T8th-most in the NL. The Cardinals (164, 29th) and Marlins (159, 30th) have hit the fewest doubles in MLB this season, despite **Matt Carpenter's** NL-leading 33.

#### MIAMI CONNECTIONS

**Marcell Ozuna** spent parts of five seasons in a Marlins uniform (2013-17) where he was a two-time NL All-Star (2016-17)...won the 2017 National League Silver Slugger and Rawlings Gold Glove awards...originally signed with the Marlins as a non-drafted free agent (Feb. 15, 2008)...became a Cardinal via trade with the Marlins this offseason, exchanged for pitchers **Daniel Castano**, **Zac Gallen**, and **Sandy Alcántara** and outfielder **Magneuris Sierra** (December 14, 2017).

**Yadier Molina** and **Carlos Martinez** represented St. Louis in the 2017 MLB All-Star Game at Marlins Park...Molina became the 7th Cardinal (14th time) to homer in an All-Star game...Martinez joined **Dizzy Dean** (1934) as the only two Cardinals with 4 strikeouts in an All-Star Game.

**Matt Carpenter** and **Bryan Holaday** were teammates in 2008 at Texas Christian University.

**Miles Mikolas** made his MLB debut vs. the Marlins in 2012 while with San Diego...graduated from nearby Jupiter (Fla.) High School and Nova Southeastern University.

**Austin Gomber** pitched Florida Atlantic University in nearby Boca Raton, Fla.

**Trevor Richards** graduated from Mater Dei Catholic High School in nearby Aviston Ill....pitched at Drury University in Springfield, Mo., where his 230 career strikeouts were second-most in program history at the time of his graduation...pitched 2015-16 seasons for the Gateway Grizzlies of the independent Frontier League.

**Brett Graves** was born in St. Charles, Mo...graduated from Francis Howell High School...named the 2011 Gatorade baseball player of the year for Missouri...originally selected by St. Louis in the 26th round of the 2011 MLB draft, but did not sign to attend the University of Missouri.

Pitcher **Kyle Barraclough** was selected by the Cardinals in the 7th round of the 2012 MLB Draft...pitched parts of four seasons in the Cardinals minor league system (2012-15)...traded by St. Louis to the Marlins for pitcher **Steve Cishek** (July 24, 2015).

Marlins VP of Scouting **Stan Meek** was selected by the Cardinals in the 15th round of the 1974 MLB Draft...played four seasons (1974-77) in the Cardinals' minor league system.

Outfielder **Magneuris Sierra** played in 22 games for St. Louis during the 2017 season...named the Cardinals 2014 Minor League Player of the Year...originally signed by the Cardinals as a non-drafted free agent (July 13, 2012).

Marlins broadcaster **Jeff Nelson** was a Cardinals non-roster invitee to 2006 Spring Training, but was released at the end of Spring Training.

Cardinals Communications Game Day Associates Supervisor **Jacob Mayer** was a 2016 Communications Intern for the Marlins.

Since 2003, the Cardinals and Marlins have shared the Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium Complex in Jupiter Fla. as their Spring Training site...RDOS is also the only stadium in the country to host four minor league teams: Jupiter Hammerheads and Palm Beach Cardinals of the High-A Florida State League, and the GCL Marlins and GCL Cardinals of the Rookie-level Gulf Coast League.

The Marlins played their first regular season game at Marlins Park against St. Louis (April 4, 2012), a 4-1 Cardinals win.

### TODAY'S GAME

- Makes his 23rd start of the season (33rd career start) and 60th career appearance.
- Has not suffered a loss since June 29 vs. ATL. Last road loss was Aug. 2, 2014 at CLE (w/TEX).
- The Palm Beach County native played high school baseball at Jupiter High School and attended college at nearby Nova Southeastern University (Davie, Fla.), makes his third career start (5th app) vs. the Marlins.
- Ranks among NL leaders in wins (11, 6th), winning pct. (.786, 2nd), ERA (2.75, 4th), innings pitched (137.1, 7th), WHIP (1.08, 6th), strikeout/walk ratio (3.88, 7th), baserunners/9 IP (10.09, 6th), fewest walks/9 IP (1.64, 2nd), HR/9 IP (0.59, 3rd), ground ball pct (51.8, 4th), OPP SLG (.329, 4th) and quality starts (15, 4th).
- Pitched 7.0 or more innings in seven starts (T8th in NL) and at least 6.0 innings in 17 of his 22 starts this season (T4th NL).
- On the road, he is 6-0 with a 3.56 ERA in 10 road starts; his six road wins are T4th-most in the NL and he is the only NL pitcher with a perfect 1.000 win percentage with six or more wins. Ranks 2nd in the National League in home ERA (2.01), trailing NYM's Jacob deGrom (1.71).
- Ranks 2nd in the NL in fewest pitches per inning (14.9), trailing Jacob deGrom (14.6).
- Limited the opposition to three runs or fewer in each of his last eight starts (2 runs or fewer in seven).

### LAST TIME OUT

- Came away with a no-decision in a 3-2 win over the Rockies in last Thursday's home-stand finale at Busch Stadium, hurling team-leading 15th quality start.
- Limited the opposition to three runs or less in eighth consecutive outings.

- Missed the All-Star Game in Washington D.C., as he returned home to Jupiter, Fla., with his wife Lauren, as they welcomed twin daughter & son on July 16.
- Selected by Major League Baseball to represent the Cardinals on the 2018 National League All-Star team...it was his first MLB All-Star nod and second recognition of his career (2010 Midwest League Mid-Season All-Star with Fort Wayne).
- Is the first Cardinals starting pitcher in franchise history to earn an All-Star nod in his first season after signing as a free agent and the only non-rookie player selected this season who didn't play in the Majors last year.
- 16 of his 46 runs (35%) allowed have come in the 4th inning (6.55 ERA).
- Sports an 11-0 record with three no-decisions (St. Louis is 14-3) when receiving two or more runs of support in a start.
- Ranks 6th in the NL with a 5.64 run support average (86 runs)...received 32 runs in last six starts.
- Has held his opposition to one walk or less in 15-of-22 starts this season (T2nd NL) with six starts of zero walks (5 of his first 6 starts of the season). Corey Kluber (CLE) leads all MLB pitchers with 18 starts with one walk or less.
