CARDINALS NOTES

- Adam Wainwright made his second start of the season, first against the Brewers in 2018 and 31st career start (38th app.) vs. the Brewers (15-9)...his 15 wins vs. MIL are the most of any active pitcher against the Brewers and T15th all-time...surpassed 1,900 career innings with two outs in the 5th inning...27th career game in which he has allowed multiple home runs (last: 7/17/17 at NYM).
- Francisco Pena recorded his first hit as a member of the Cardinals with a single in the 5th inning. His last MLB hit was 6/4/17 vs. BOS (Blaine Boyer).
- Harrison Bader recorded his first hit of the season with a single to centerfield in the 5th inning (exit speed: 112 MPH).
- Tommy Pham hit his 7th career home run vs. MIL and recorded his 15th career RBI...the seven home runs are a person high and the 15 RBI tied his most (Cincinnati).
- There was a crew chief challenge on Tommy Pham's double in the 9th inning. Call overturned to home run (Time: 3:18).
- Marcell Ozuna has hit safely in 10 straight games (16-44, .364) with a single in the 9th inning...his 10-game hitting streak will lead or be tied for 1st in MLB at the end of today...has hit safely in his last eight straight games vs. MIL.

BREWERS NOTES

- Junior Guerra made his first start of the season and fifth career start vs. Cardinals (2-2)...pitched 5.1 innings allowing just one run, his first outing of 5.0 or more innings with one run or less since 5/31/17 at NYM in which he fired 6.0 scoreless innings, also his last win...his last start was at Busch Stadium (9/30/17) as he pitched 2.1 innings and exited with a no decision, the Brewers lost 7-6.
- Hernan Perez collected his first hit, home run and RBI of the season with a solo shot off Adam Wainwright in the 2nd inning...was his first career home run off the Cardinals.
- Domingo Santana has hit safely in his last nine games vs. STL (16-34, .471)...has back-to-back multi-hit games for the first time this season.
- Jett Bandy doubled in the 5th inning, his first hit since 3/31 at SD.
- Dan Jennings recorded his first Major League hit with a double to left off Adam Wainwright in the 7th inning.
- Josh Hader has struck out three or more batters in each of his five relief appearance this season...surrendered his first home run of the season and 5th career (all 5 have come vs. RH batters).
- Matt Albers recorded his first save of the season (last: 5/14/17 vs. PHI w/WSH - Game 2 of DH).
- The Brewers are 10-4 in their last 14 games at Busch Stadium.
