**NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES**

- The Yankees have dropped two straight games for just the fourth time this season, first since 4/8 vs. Baltimore/4/10 at Boston (have not lost three in a row in 2018)...lost by more than 1R for the first time since 4/20 vs. Toronto (L, 8-5)...are 5-2 on their nine-game homestand...are still 17-3 in their last 20 games...are 18-3 when scoring in at least 5R this season.
  - Fell to 9-4 in series openers (6-2 at home).
  - Are 11-21 in their last 32 games against the A's...have lost 11 of their last 17 home games vs. Oakland.
- **Yankees pitchers** allowed 10 runs, their second-highest total this season (L, 14-1 on 4/10 at Boston)...their 10ER were their most since 9/8/17 at Texas (11ER)...gave up 4HR, tying a season high (also 4/6 vs. Baltimore)...have permitted 9HR in their last 3G after 9HR in their previous 15G.
- **Yankees batters** were held without a double for the second straight game after collecting at least one double in 30 consecutive games.
- **RF Aaron Judge** (1-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 4RBI, 1BB) hit a three-run HR in the fifth...collected a season-high 4RBI, his most since a career-high 6RBI on 9/14/17 vs. Baltimore...has RBI in each of his last 5G (11RBI)...is hitting .360/.500/.800 (9-for-25) with 5R, 2 doubles, 3HR, 13RBI and 7BB in 7G on the homestand...overtook Gregorius (31RBI) and Sánchez (29RBI) for the team RBI lead.
  - With his 66th HR in his 220th career game, is the second-fastest to the number in Major League history (Rudy York-66HR in first 216G).
- **2B Gleyber Torres** (1-for-3, 1SH) extended his hitting streak to nine games with his third career HR, a solo shot in the third...at 21 years, 149 days old today, is the youngest Yankee since Mickey Mantle (10G, 6/24-7/3[G1]/52, ending at age 20y-257d) to tally a hitting streak of at least 9G...is the youngest Yankee ever to hit at least 3HR in his first 19G.
- **LF Brett Gardner** (1-for-2, 1R) drew a season-high 3BB.
- **RHP Sonny Gray** (5.0IP, 9H, 5ER, 3BB, 2K, 2HR) started and took his third loss...marked his third time allowing at least 5ER in eight starts this season...gave up a season-high 9H and 2HR...has taken three of the Yankees rotation's six losses this season, including their only two losses since 4/19 (also 4/30 at Houston).
  - His 5ER were the most allowed by a Yankees starter since 4/20 vs. Toronto (Gray: 3.1IP, 5ER)...snapped a streak of 19 starts with 4R-or-fewer.
- **RHP David Hale** (3.0IP, 4H, 2ER, 0BB, 2K, 2HR, 1HP) made his first appearance since returning to the Yankees on 5/1...had not pitched in a game since 4/27 w/ Minnesota vs. Cincinnati (3.0IP, 4ER).
- **INF Brandon Drury** (blurred vision) hit a second-inning grand slam off Minnesota prospect Stephen Gonsalves in Game Two of a doubleheader for Triple-A Scranton-WB; was 0-for-3 with 1BB in Game One...**1B Greg Bird** (right ankle surgery) went 1-for-2 with 1R, 1RBI and 2BB in his second rehab game with Single-A Tampa, playing seven innings at first base...**OF Billy McKinney** (left shoulder sprain) went 1-for-3 with 1R, 3RBI and 2BB, and played the entire game at DH for Tampa.

## OAKLAND ATHLETICS NOTES

- The Athletics are 1-0 to start their 10-game road trip (three games at Yankee Stadium, three at Fenway Park and four at Rogers Centre)...are 14-9 over their last 23 games since 4/15 after starting the year 5-10...improved to 2-4 following an off day.
  - Are 6-1 against the AL East this season (3-0 vs. Baltimore, 2-1 vs. Boston, 1-0 vs. the Yankees), outscoring opponents 30-18...have posted a 2.05 ERA (66.0IP, 15ER) with 72K and just 16BB in seven games vs. AL East opposition this season.
  - Have won five straight games against the Yankees dating back to 6/15/17, their longest winning streak against the Yankees since going 6-0 from 5/5/13-6/4/14...are 15-20 at the current Yankee Stadium.
- **RHP Kendall Graveman** (6.0IP, 3H, 4R/1ER, 2BB, 4K, 2HR) earned his first win of the season...has posted quality starts in each of his last two outings with the A's after failing to toss more than 5.0 innings in any of his first five starts of the season (10.07 ERA)...has allowed at least 1HR in six of his seven starts this season...was recalled from Triple-A Nashville prior to the game.
  - Over their last 12 games, **Oakland starters** have gone just 2-7 with a 4.59 ERA (64.2IP, 33ER).
- **Oakland batters** scored at least 10R for the fourth time this season and first since 4/18 vs. Chicago-AL (12R)...hit 4HR, their second-most in a game in 2018 (5HR on 4/6 at Los Angeles-AL)...have hit at least 4HR against the Yankees eight times since moving to Oakland in 1968, with seven of those games taking place in the Bronx (including each of the last six).
  - Have scored 67R in the seventh inning or later this season, including 4R in those innings tonight.
- **CF Dustin Fowler** (1-for-5, 1R) collected his first Major League hit with a fourth-inning single to right field off Sonny Gray, whom he was traded for in July 2017...was selected by the Yankees in the 18<sup>th</sup> round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft...according to *Elias*, became the second player this season to record his first career hit *against* the team that drafted him, joining Atlanta's LHP Jesse Biddle, who doubled for his first hit on 4/29 at Philadelphia...is the first player drafted by the Yankees to get his first Major League hit against the Yankees since Justin Turner on 9/11/09 w/ Baltimore (Turner was drafted by the Yankees in 2005, but did not sign)...scored the first run of his career in the ninth.
- **SS Marcus Semien** (2-for-6, 1R, 1 double, 4RBI) tied his career high in RBI (eighth time, second of the season – 4/11 at Los Angeles-NL).
- **DH Khris Davis** (1-for-5, solo HR) hit his 10<sup>th</sup> home run of the season...has reached double digits in homers in each of his six Major League seasons (since 2013)...entering tonight, only three players had hit at least 10HR each season since 2013 – Mike Trout, Manny Machado and Bryce Harper.
- **2B Jed Lowrie** (3-for-6, 2RBI) hit his seventh road home run of the season (in 18 road games)...entered the day tied for fifth in the AL in road homers.
