TRIBE TOP THREE

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** went 4-for-4 in yesterday's 6-2 victory, with two homers and two doubles, and extended his hit streak to a career high-tying 13 games...his 15 extra-base hits and eight homers in May lead all Major League hitters.

» **COREY KLUBER** will start today's rubber game vs. Kansas City...owns a 7-2 record and 1.41 ERA in nine career starts vs. the Royals at Progressive Field...has won his last eight decisions against an A.L. Central opponent, dating back to June 9, 2017, posting a 1.43 ERA (14ER/88.1IP) in that span.

» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** is 5-for-9 (.555) with a grand slam, a double, six RBI and four runs scored in two games in the 2nd spot in the batting order...is also batting .391 at Progressive Field this year.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» Powered by an historic performance by **FRANCISCO LINDOR**, the Indians defeated the Royals 6-2 yesterday afternoon to level this series at one game apiece.

» **Lindor** went 4-for-4 with two doubles, two home runs, four runs scored and two RBI, becoming the first Indians leadoff hitter with four extra-base hits in a game since **Tito Francona** did so on July 3, 1964 at Chicago-AL...marked Lindor's 4th career multi-homer game and 2nd this season, as well as his 3rd career game with four hits...four runs scored also set a new career high for him...became the 3rd MLB hitter in 2018 with four extra-base hits in a game, alongside Colorado's **DJ LeMahieu** on April 12 at Washington & Chicago-NL's **Willson Contreras** on May 11 vs. Chicago-AL.

» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** went 3-for-4 and recorded his 12th multi-hit game of the season in his second game in the second spot in the batting order...Brantley had a double and drove in two of the Tribe's six runs on the afternoon.

» **YONDER ALONSO** and **EDWIN ENCARNACION** each chipped in an RBI-single to support the Indians offensive effort.

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** put together another strong outing, earning his 3rd win of the season and holding the Royals to two runs on eight hits in 7.2 innings of work...struck out five batters and did not walk any, retiring 15 of his final 18 batters faced...improved to a perfect 4-0 with a 2.17 ERA (9ER/37.1IP) in seven games (six starts) against the Royals.

DR. SMOOTH WILL SEE YOU NOW

» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** recorded his 12th multi-hit game and 4th game with three-plus hits yesterday, and is batting .555 (5-for-9) with a grand slam, a double, six RBI and four runs scored in two games in the second spot in the batting order.

» Overall, Brantley is hitting .342 (38-111) this season, which leads the Tribe, ranks 3rd in the American League and 5th among all qualified Major League hitters...is also 6-12 with a homer and seven RBI in his last three games, spanning the first two contests on this homestand and the series finale in Milwaukee.

» Brantley's primary production has come at Progressive Field, where his .391 (27-69) batting average is 2nd in A.L. and his 19 home RBI are 4th in the A.L. and T5th in MLB.

» Since April 17, Brantley's batting average has not dropped below .300 and he leads all active Indians with a .356 (32-90) batting average and 20 RBI in that span.

ROYAL ROUNDUP

» The Indians and Royals are squaring off this weekend in the second of six series between the clubs...nine of the 19 games are scheduled to be played here at Progressive Field...Cleveland and Kansas City have split the first four contests in the season series.

» The clubs previously met this season in a three-game series in Cleveland from April 6-8, with the Tribe taking two of the three contests...the Indians won the home opener, 3-2, and lost the April 7 game, 1-0...on April 8, the Indians won in walk-off fashion, as a two-run homer by **YAN GOMES** gave Cleveland a 3-1 victory.

» Cleveland has posted a 15-9 (.625) record against the Royals since the start of 2017, as well as a mark of 58-42 (.580) since **Terry Francona** became Tribe manager in 2013...the two clubs have combined to win each of the last three A.L. Central titles.

» Dating back to August 18, 2017, the Indians have held Kansas City to two-or-fewer runs in 12 of their last 16 meetings...Cleveland has gone 12-4 in that span with a 2.06 ERA (33ER/144.0IP).

MAYDAY, MAYDAY, HE'S GETTING HITS

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** had a career game yesterday afternoon, going 4-for-4 with four runs scored, two doubles, two RBI and two home runs...set or tied career highs in runs scored, hits and extra-base hits, as well as recording his 4th career multi-homer game.

» Since the start of 2015, only two other players in MLB have had a game with two doubles, two homers and four runs scored - Chicago-NL's **Kris Bryant** on June 26, 2016 at Cincinnati and Boston's **Jackie Bradley Jr.** on August 15, 2015 vs. Seattle...in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-present), Lindor's effort yesterday is just the 40th game with those criteria.

» Lindor also extended his hit streak to 13 games, which is the longest such streak by an Indians batter this season as well as 2nd-longest active streak in MLB, behind Tampa Bay's **Wilson Ramos** (18 games)...streak ties his career-long run, set last season from July 21 - August 3...is batting .458 (27-59) during the streak with eight homers, seven doubles, 14 RBI and 18 runs scored.

» Lindor is also batting .451 (23-51) in 11 games in May, ranking 2nd in MLB in batting average while holding the monthly lead in homers (8), extra-base hits (15) and doubles (7, T1st).

» After hitting his 11th and 12th longballs yesterday, Lindor climbed up the American League leaderboard in multi-hit games (16, T1st), extra-base hits (25, 2nd), homers (12, T3rd), runs scored (33, T2nd), hits (50, T4th), total bases (99, 3rd), doubles (13, 4th) and slugging percentage (.615, 4th).

COREY ON THE HILL

» **COREY KLUBER** will start this afternoon's rubber game vs. Kansas City, marking his first outing of the year against the Royals...is 2-0 with a 0.61 ERA (1ER/14.2IP) in two starts against divisional opponents this season...also pitches today on the 3rd anniversary of his 18-strikeout game (see *This Day in Indians History* below).

» **Kluber has won his last eight decisions vs. the A.L. Central, dating back to June 9, 2017...owns a 1.43 ERA in that span.**

» He took the loss in his last outing on May 8 in Milwaukee, despite recording his 8th Quality Start of the year (6.0IP, 5H, 2HR, 3R/ER, 1BB, 4K)...his streak of eight Quality Starts to begin the season is the longest by a Tribe pitcher since **Josh Tomlin** had a streak of nine such starts in 2011.

» Last faced the Royals on September 7, 2017 at Progressive Field, earning the win after tossing 7.0 shutout innings and striking out nine batters...is 9-6 with a 2.98 ERA in 20 career starts vs. Kansas City, his lowest career ERA against an A.L. Central opponent.

» Has been nearly untouchable in intradivisional starts over the past several seasons, posting a 19-3 record and 2.32 ERA (48ER/186.0IP) in A.L. Central play since the start of 2016.

JOY DIVISION

» The Tribe is in the midst of its fourth series against a divisional opponent, having gone 8-3 in their first nine games against the A.L. Central (7-2 at Progressive Field).

» **Since July 1, 2017, the Indians have posted a 39-11 record (.780) against A.L. Central teams...**in their most recently completed divisional series, the Tribe split a two-game set with Minnesota in Puerto Rico...the draw snapped the Indians' 14-series win streak against intra-divisional opponents, which was the longest by any team in MLB's divisional era (1969-*STATS LLC*)...Cleveland has not lost a series against an A.L. Central team since being swept at home by the Minnesota Twins from June 23-25, 2017.

» With last night's win, the Tribe pitching staff continued its dominance against the A.L. Central, posting a 1.84 ERA (66ER/322.0IP) in their last 35 divisional games and allowing two-or-fewer earned runs in 27 of those contests.

» The Indians enter this series with a half-game lead in the A.L. Central over second-place Minnesota (17-18)...the Tribe has held the outright divisional lead for each of the last 22 days.

MOVING AROUND THE MIDWEST | ROAD TRIP PREVIEW

» After this afternoon's ballgame, the Tribe will hit the road for an eight-game, 10-day road trip to Detroit (May 14-16), Houston (May 18-20) and Chicago-NL (May 22-23), with off-days on May 17 & 21.

» The Tribe swept the Tigers in a four-game series April 9-12 at Progressive Field...Cleveland has won 11 consecutive games against Detroit, dating back to September 1, 2017.

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

Kluber tossed 8.0 innings in the Tribe's 2-0 win, allowing a single in the 3rd and walking none...according to *Elias*, became the second pitcher in MLB history to strike out 18+ batters in 8.0 innings or less, after Seattle's Randy Johnson on September 27, 1992 at Texas (8.0IP, 6H, 2R/ER, 4BB, 18K).

TODAY'S START VS. KANSAS CITY

» Reigning American League Cy Young award winner Kluber is scheduled to make his ninth start of the season in this afternoon's series finale vs. the Kansas City Royals...will mark his 177th career appearance and 172nd career start.
 » Will be pitching today on regular four days' rest after making his last start on May 8 at Milwaukee...recorded his 8th Quality Start of the season but had his five-game win streak snapped, taking the loss at Miller Park (6.0IP, 5H, 3R/ER, 2HR, 1BB, 4K).
 » Today marks his first time starting vs. Kansas City this season...last faced the Royals on September 17, 2017 at Progressive Field...faced off against Danny Duffy and earned the win as the Tribe prevailed 3-2...tossed 7.0 shutout innings (3H, 0R, 0BB, 9K)...owns a 9-6 record and 2.98 ERA (43ER/130.0IP) in 20 career starts against Kansas City.
 » **Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in each of his last 20 starts, dating back to August 1, 2017...streak is the second-longest by an Indians starter in the Baseball Reference Play Index era (1908-), after Sonny Siebert's run of 21 starts from May 9-September 10, 1965.**
 » Entering today's game ranks among the American League leaders in wins (5, T1st), innings pitched (58.1, 2nd), opponent batting average (.179, 5th), strikeouts (57, T7th), ERA (2.62, 9th).

LAST TIME OUT

» Kluber faced the Milwaukee Brewers for the first time in his career in his last outing on May 8 in Milwaukee.
 » Had his five-game win streak snapped, taking the loss despite another Quality Start...tossed 6.0 innings and allowed three runs on five hits (two home runs), with one walk and four strikeouts.
 » Recorded his eighth consecutive Quality Start of the season, extending his streak to begin the season...streak is the longest since **Josh Tomlin (9)** had a similar streak in 2011.

VS. KANSAS CITY | DIVISION RECORD

» Kluber makes his 21st career start against the Royals this afternoon...won both of his starts vs. Kansas City last season, going a perfect 2-0 with a 0.73 ERA (6ER/23.2IP).
 » In 2017 faced the Royals first on August 18 in Kansas City, holding them to one run on six hits (one home run) over 5.1 innings (1BB, 4K)...second and final outing against them came on September 7 at Progressive Field, when he tossed 7.0 shutout innings and allowed three hits while striking out nine batters.
 » Owns a career 9-6 record with a 2.98 ERA (43ER/130.0IP) across his 20 prior starts vs. Kansas City...this includes a 7-2 record and 1.41 ERA (10ER/63.2IP) in nine starts at Progressive Field.
 » Has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his last five home starts vs. the Royals, dating back to July 29, 2015, holding a 4-1 record and 1.39 ERA (5ER/32.1IP) in that span.
 » This afternoon marks his third start of the year against an A.L. Central division opponent...faced Detroit on April 9 and Minnesota in Puerto Rico on April 17...is 2-0 with a 0.61 ERA (1ER/14.2IP) across those two starts.
 » **Has won each of his last eight decisions against a divisional opponent, dating back to June 9, 2017...owns a 1.43 ERA (14ER/88.1IP) in that span.**
 » Kluber owns a 36-22 record and 3.29 ERA (196ER/536.0IP) in 83 intradivisional appearances, including 81 starts...went 8-1 with a 2.57 ERA (24ER/84.0IP) in 13 starts against A.L. Central opponents last year.
 » Since the start of 2016, Kluber has a 19-3 record and 2.32 ERA (48ER/186.0IP) against the A.L. Central...entering the 2018 season, his ERA was the second-lowest intradivisional mark in that span (min. 125.0IP).

AT PROGRESSIVE FIELD

» Makes his fourth start of the season at home this afternoon...is 3-0 with a 2.28 ERA (6ER/23.2IP) in his three home outings so far.
 » Entering today's game, ranks 10th in the American League with a 2.28 ERA at home.
 » Last season, went 10-2 with a 1.81 ERA (23ER/114.2IP) in 16 home starts...his home ERA led the American League and ranked 2nd in MLB...also marked the lowest such ERA by an Indians pitcher since Gaylord Perry's 1.77 home ERA in 1972.
 » Since the start of 2016, Kluber is 23-7 with a 2.49 ERA (69ER/249.1IP) in 35 home starts...in that time span, his win total leads MLB, while his ERA is 1st in the A.L. and T4th in MLB (min. 20 GS at home).

COMPLETE COREY

» Kluber tossed his 16th career complete game in his first start of the year on March 29 at Seattle...marked the first Opening Day complete-game by a Cleveland pitcher since **Jake Westbrook on April 4, 2005 at Chicago-AL (1-0 loss)**, and the first such complete game in MLB since Clayton Kershaw threw a complete-game shutout on April 1, 2013 vs. San Francisco.
 » Struck out eight batters, the 2nd-most by a Tribe starter on Opening Day over the last 14 seasons (2005-18), behind **Justin Masterson (10K on April 5, 2012 vs. Toronto)**.
 » Kluber threw just 91 pitches in the game, marking the second-lowest complete-game pitch count of his career...needed just 85 pitches to shut out the Mariners on July 30, 2014 (9.0IP, 3H, 8K) in Cleveland.

CAREER SNAPSHOT & 2017 HIGHLIGHTS

» **Won his second career American League Cy Young Award in 2017, becoming the first pitcher in club history to win the award multiple times, and the 19th multiple winner in MLB since 1956.**
 » Became the first Indians pitcher since Mike Garcia in 1949 to lead MLB in ERA (2.25), and ranked near the top of the A.L. leaderboard in virtually every other pitching category (see chart), including wins (18, T1st), pitcher bWAR (8.2), strikeouts (265, 2nd) and opponent batting average (.193, 141-732).
 » Won the A.L. Pitcher of the Month award three times, June (4-0, 1.26ERA), August (5-1, 1.96 ERA) and September (5-0, 0.84 ERA), becoming the first triple winner since **Houston's Dallas Keuchel in 2015.**

» Kluber is in his ninth season with the Cleveland organization after being acquired from the San Diego Padres on July 31, 2010 in a three-team trade that sent RHP Jake Westbrook (from Cleveland) & LHP Nicholas Greenwood (from San Diego) to the St. Louis Cardinals and moved OF Ryan Ludwick from St. Louis to San Diego.
 » Signed a five-year contract extension with the Indians through 2019 on April 5, 2015...the deal includes club options for 2020 & 2021.
 » Made his MLB debut on September 1, 2011 in relief against the Oakland Athletics...made three relief appearances as a September call-up with Cleveland in 2011...has five career relief appearances, last on April 20, 2013 at Houston.
 » Kluber was originally selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 2007 June draft out of Stetson (FL) University, where he played three seasons...the Birmingham, Alabama native attended Coppell (TX) High School, located in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex.
