TRIBE HEADLINES

» **COREY KLUBER** enters play tonight with the 3rd-lowest home ERA (2.24) in the American League...he also owns a 2.12 ERA (12ER/51.0IP) in seven starts against the A.L. West, marking the 4th-lowest ERA against the division this season (min. 40.0IP).

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** has driven in 47 of his 79 RBI at home this season, 2nd-most in the American League...his 64 extra-base hits and 32 home runs (T1st) are tops in the Major Leagues.

» Recent acquisition **LEONYS MARTIN** has hit safely in each of his first two games as a member of the Indians...he enters tonight on an active five-game hit streak (.389, HR, 2 RBI, 3R).

» The Indians currently rank 2nd in the American League this season in stolen bases (84), hits (971) and team batting average (.259)...they also sit T2nd in the A.L. with 151 home runs.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians fell, 7-4, in the opener of this three-game set vs. Los Angeles-AL...after the Angels plated four runs in the top of the 8th inning, Cleveland scored once in the bottom of the 9th, but their rally fell short with the tying run in the on-deck circle.

» The Tribe scored two runs in the bottom of the 1st inning on an RBI-double by **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** (1-5) and an RBI-single by **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** (1-4).

» In his first home game as a member of the Indians, **LEONYS MARTIN** went 2-for-3 and drove in a pair of runs...Martin gave the Indians a 3-2 lead with an RBI-single in the bottom of the 2nd inning, then closed the deficit to 7-4 with a solo homer in the bottom of the 9th, his 10th longball of the season.

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs (all via home runs by **Shohei Ohtani**) on five hits over 6.0 innings of work (0BB, 6K)...Clevinger retired 11 of the final 12 batters he faced, while logging his second career start with no walks allowed (also May 12, 2018 vs. Kansas City)...marked Clevinger's 13th quality start of the season.

» **ANDREW MILLER** made his first Major League appearance since May 25, working a scoreless inning (1BB, 1K) in his return from the Disabled List (right knee inflammation).

NEW KID IN TOWN

» **LEONYS MARTIN** has hit safely in each of his two games for Cleveland since his July 31 acquisition from Detroit for **INF Willi Castro**...he is batting .600 (3-5) in those two contests with a homer, two RBI and two runs scored.

» Last night's solo homer marked Martin's 10th homer of the season...marks the second time he has reached that milestone in his eight-season MLB career, along with a career-high 15 longballs with Seattle in 2016.

» Including his final three games with Detroit, Martin enters tonight on a five-game hit streak, batting .389 (7-18) in that span...his nine outfield assists this season are tied with Seattle's **Mitch Haniger** for the most in the American League.

EARN YOUR WINGS

» The Indians are playing their second and final series of the season with the Angels in this weekend's three-game set.

» The clubs previously met from April 2-4 at Angel Stadium, with Los Angeles-AL taking two of three...Cleveland won 6-0 in the opener, but fell 13-2 and 3-2 (13 innings) in the other two games.

» The Indians own an all-time record of 315-328 (.490) against the Angels, including a mark of 23-13 (.639) since **Terry Francona** became Tribe manager in 2013...dating back to June 12, 2016, Cleveland has won 12 of its last 15 games vs. Los Angeles-AL.

STRONG STARTERS

» Cleveland starting pitchers have combined for a 3.47 ERA this season, the 2nd-lowest mark in the American League (Houston - 3.02) and 3rd-lowest in MLB (Los Angeles-NL - 3.31).

» **MIKE CLEVINGER**'s outing last night was the 68th quality start by Indians pitching, 2nd-most in MLB (Houston - 77)...Tribe starters also own 21 starts with 10-or-more strikeouts (2nd in MLB, Houston - 23) and 12 starts of 7.0-or-more scoreless innings (most in MLB).

» Tribe starters rank 2nd in MLB with 702 strikeouts this season and have issued just 167 walks (4th-fewest in MLB)...the rotation's 4.20 K/BB ratio is 2nd-best in MLB (Los Angeles-NL - 4.22).

Miguel Eladio was 1-for-2 with an RBI...2018 draft pick Adam Scott threw 3.0 scoreless innings in his Single-A debut.

» **MV Scrappers (Short-A): 28-17, 1st (+2.5G)** » 8/3: L, 2-8 at Batavia » Today: 7:05 at Batavia
José Fermín went 2-for-5 with a triple and an RBI...starter Shane McCarthy tossed 3.0 scoreless innings (0BB, 2K).

KLUBER DAY

» Right-hander **COREY KLUBER** is set to make his third start of the second half in tonight's contest vs. Los Angeles-AL.

» Kluber last pitched on July 29 at Detroit, earning the win after holding the Tigers to one run on five hits over 7.1 strong innings of work (1BB, 5K).

» Has made one previous start against the Angels this season, which came on April 4 at Angel Stadium...did not factor into the decision in the Tribe's 13-inning loss, allowing two runs on just three hits over 7.0 innings of work (2BB, 6K)...in six career starts vs. Los Angeles-AL, Kluber has gone 2-2 with a 3.99 ERA (17ER/38.1IP).

» In seven starts against A.L. West opponents this season, Kluber has gone 3-1 with a 2.12 ERA (12ER/51.0IP), marking the 4th-lowest ERA against the division this season (min. 40.0IP).

» Kluber will also be making his 13th start at Progressive Field this season, where he holds a record of 7-3 with a 2.24 ERA (20ER/80.1IP)...he enters play today with the 3rd-lowest home ERA in the American League.

» On the season, Kluber currently ranks among A.L. leaders with 13 wins (T2nd), 145.0 innings pitched (3rd), a 2.79 ERA (6th), a .219 opponent batting average (9th) and 139 strikeouts (T9th).

JOSÉ CAN YOU SWING

» Reigning American League Player of the Month **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** drove in his team-high 79th run of the season last night with an RBI-single...he enters play tonight ranked 3rd in the A.L. in RBI behind Boston's **J.D. Martínez** (90) and Oakland's **Khris Davis** (84).

» 47 of his 79 RBI have come at Progressive Field, the 2nd-most home RBI in the A.L....with an RBI tonight, he would become the fastest Tribe player to reach 80 RBI since **Travis Hafner** (96 team games) in 2006.

» Ramírez enters play tonight with an MLB-best 64 extra-base hits, while he is tied with Boston's **J.D. Martínez** for the Major League lead in home runs (32)...he also ranks among American League leaders in total bases (251 - 2nd), walks (70 - 2nd), stolen bases (25 - T2nd), on-base percentage (.408 - 3rd), slugging percentage (.628 - 3rd), runs scored (77 - 5th), doubles (29 - T9th) and batting average (.300 - 10th).

FRANKIE KEEPS SCORING

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** led off last night's game with a walk and came around to score his MLB-leading 93rd run of the season...he led the Majors in runs for both May (27) and July (26).

» He remains on pace to score 140 runs this season, which would match **Earl Averill**'s franchise record of 140 in 1931.

» Lindor enters play tonight among the A.L. top 10 in a variety of other categories, including extra-base hits (62), multi-hit games (42 - T2nd), total bases (244 - 3rd), doubles (34 - 3rd), hits (127 - 5th), OPS (.930 - 7th), home runs (27 - 7th) and RBI (67 - T8th).

BRANTLEY'S RIGHT AT HOME

» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** plated the Indians' first run last night with a 1st-inning RBI-double, his 27th two-base hit of the year.

» 42 of Brantley's 58 RBI this season (72.4%) have come at Progressive Field and he currently ranks T5th in the American League in home RBI...he also enters play today with a .337 (68-202) batting average at home, the 6th-highest clip in the A.L.

BALANCED ATTACK

» The Indians team offense remains among American League leaders in a number of categories...the Tribe currently ranks 2nd in the A.L. in team batting average (.259), stolen bases (84), hits (971) and home runs (151, T2nd).

» The club also ranks 3rd in the A.L. this season in team OPS (.773) and runs scored (553)...the Indians rank 4th with 378 extra-base hits and T4th with 213 doubles.

BOLSTERED BULLPEN

» The Indians bullpen has been improved in the second half of the season, posting a 3.49 ERA (15ER/38.2IP) since the All-Star break which ranks 2nd-lowest in the A.L. (8th-lowest in MLB).

» Over their past 10 games, Tribe relievers have combined for a 2.25 ERA (7ER/28.0IP), including seven collective scoreless outings in that span.

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

1929: Trailing 6-5 with two outs in the bottom of the 9th, the Indians score nine runs to stun the Yankees, 14-6, in Game 2 of their doubleheader at Yankee Stadium...after five consecutive singles gave the Tribe a 12-6 advantage, Hall of Famer **Joe Sewell** belted a two-run homer to punctuate the memorable inning...at the time, Cleveland's nine runs matched the American League record for runs scored in the 9th inning.

TONIGHT'S START VS. LOS ANGELES-AL

» Kluber is scheduled to make his 23rd start of the season in tonight's game vs. the Los Angeles Angels...will mark his 191st career appearance (186th start).
 » Will be pitching tonight on extended five days' rest after making his last outing in July 29 at Detroit...held the Tigers to one run on five hits, with one walk and five strikeouts across 7.1 innings, earning his 13th win of the season.
 » Kluber is due to face Los Angeles-AL for the second time this season...did not factor into the decision on April 4 in Anaheim, holding the Angels to two runs on three hits (one home run), with two walks and six strikeouts over 7.0 innings as the Tribe eventually fell 3-2 in 13 innings.
 » He has recorded quality starts in 18 of his 22 outings this season...**entering tonight, his 18 quality starts rank T3rd in MLB with teammate TREVOR BAUER and New York-NL's Jacob DeGrom**, behind Washington's **Max Scherzer** (20) and Houston's **Justin Verlander** (19).
 » Has also tossed 7.0-or-more innings in 14 starts this season, the 2nd-most among Major League starting pitchers, behind New York-NL's **Jacob DeGrom** (15).
 » Kluber enters play tonight among the American League pitching leaders in walks-per-9.0IP (1.2, 1st), innings pitched (145.0, 3rd), opponent on-base percentage (.246, 3rd), wins (13, T3rd), home ERA (2.24, 3rd), ERA (6th, 2.79) and opponent batting average (.219, 9th).

VS. LOS ANGELES-AL | A.L. WEST

» Kluber is due to face the Angels for the second time this season...owns a career 2-2 mark and 3.99 ERA (17ER/38.1IP) in six starts vs. Los Angeles-AL.
 » Last faced the Angels on April 4 at Angel Stadium...did not factor into the decision in the Tribe's 3-2, 13-inning loss...allowed just two runs on three hits (one home run), with two walks and six strikeouts in 7.0 innings.
 » **Kluber has allowed three-or-fewer runs in each of his last four starts vs. Los Angeles-AL, dating back to August 29, 2015**...has compiled a 2-0 record and 2.89 ERA (9ER/28.0IP) with 23 strikeouts in those outings, and the Tribe has won three of the four contests.
 » He has faced Los Angeles-AL twice at Progressive Field, owning a 1-0 mark and 3.75 ERA (5ER/12.0IP) in the two starts, both Indians victories...last started vs. the Angels at home on August 11, 2016 (W, 6.0IP, 4H, 3R/ER, 2HR, 2BB, 3K).
 » Tonight will mark Kluber's eighth start of the season against an opponent from the A.L. West division...has compiled a 3-1 record and 2.12 ERA (12ER/51.0IP) in his seven prior starts...his **2.12 ERA vs. the West is the 4th-lowest by any pitcher against that division this season (min. 40.0IP)**, as well as the **2nd-lowest by a pitcher from a non-A.L. West team (TB's Blake Snell - 1.20 ERA)**.

AT PROGRESSIVE FIELD

» Tonight marks Kluber's 12th home start of the season...is 7-3 with a 2.24 ERA (20ER/80.1IP) in his home outings and enters tonight's game 3rd in the American League in home ERA, as well as T3rd in the A.L. in wins at home.
 » **He has recorded a quality start in nine of his 12 home starts, which is tied with six others for the 3rd-most such starts in MLB, trailing Washington's Max Scherzer (11) and New York-NL's Jacob DeGrom (10)**.

2018 RECAP & HIGHLIGHTS

» Kluber was named to the 2018 American League All-Star team, but did not pitch after receiving an injection in his right knee following his July 12 start vs. New York-AL...marked his third career All-Star selection (third consecutive).
 » Kluber has recorded quality starts in 18 of his 22 outings this season...**entering tonight, his 18 quality starts rank T3rd in MLB with teammate TREVOR BAUER and New York-NL's Jacob DeGrom**, behind Washington's **Max Scherzer** (20) and Houston's **Justin Verlander** (19).
 » Had his career-long walkless innings streak snapped at 46.1 innings on June 15 vs. Minnesota, after issuing a free pass in the 4th inning...**streak marked the longest such run by a Tribe pitcher since Paul Byrd's stretch of 48.0 innings from April 26-June 6, 2007**...also had his quality start streak snapped at 14, the longest streak of quality starts to begin a season by a Tribe starting pitcher since Hall-of-Famer **Stan Coveleski** began the 1918 campaign with a string of 16 consecutive quality starts.
 » From August 3, 2017 - June 15, 2018, Kluber recorded a string of 26 starts that marked the **longest streak in American League history and tied with Philadelphia's Chris Short (also 26G from 1967-68) for the 2nd-longest such streak in the Baseball-Reference Play Index era (1908-)**, behind Chicago-NL's **Jake Arrieta** (29G from 2015-16).
 » Tossed his 16th career complete game in his first start of the year on March 29 at Seattle...**marked the first Opening Day complete-game by a Cleveland pitcher since Jake Westbrook on April 4, 2005 at Chicago-AL (1-0 loss), and the first such complete game in MLB since Clayton Kershaw threw a complete-game shutout on April 1, 2013 vs. San Francisco**...struck out eight batters, the 2nd-most by a Tribe starter on Opening Day over the last 14 seasons (2005-18), behind **Justin Masterson** (10K on April 5, 2012 vs. Toronto)...Kluber threw just 91 pitches in the game, marking the second-lowest complete-game pitch count of his career...needed just 85 pitches to shut out the Mariners on July 30, 2014 (9.0IP, 3H, 8K) in Cleveland.

2017 HIGHLIGHTS & CAREER SNAPSHOT

» **Won his second career American League Cy Young Award in 2017, becoming the first pitcher in club history to win the award multiple times, and the 19th multiple winner in MLB since 1956**.
 » Became the first Indians pitcher since Mike Garcia in 1949 to lead MLB in ERA (2.25), and ranked near the top of the A.L. leaderboard in virtually every other pitching category (see chart), including wins (18, T1st), pitcher bWAR (8.2), strikeouts (265, 2nd) and opponent batting average (.193, 141-732).
 » Won the A.L. Pitcher of the Month award three times, in June (4-0, 1.26ERA), August (5-1, 1.96 ERA) and September (5-0, 0.84 ERA), becoming the first triple winner since Houston's **Dallas Keuchel** in 2015.
 » Kluber is in his ninth season with the Cleveland organization after being acquired from the San Diego Padres on July 31, 2010 in a three-team trade that sent RHP Jake Westbrook (from Cleveland) & LHP Nicholas Greenwood (from San Diego) to the St. Louis Cardinals and moved OF Ryan Ludwick from St. Louis to San Diego.

» Signed a five-year contract extension with the Indians through 2019 on April 5, 2015...the deal includes club options for 2020 & 2021.
 » Made his MLB debut on September 1, 2011 in relief against the Oakland Athletics...made three relief appearances as a September call-up with Cleveland in 2011...has five career relief appearances, last on April 20, 2013 at Houston.
 » Kluber was originally selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 2007 June draft out of Stetson (FL) University, where he played three seasons...the Birmingham, Alabama native attended Coppell (TX) High School, located in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex.
