TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants will look to build on a solid homestand (5-1) when they begin a 10-game road trip tonight against the Washington Nationals...the Giants have won six of their last seven games and enter play today just 1.5 games back of the first-place Diamondbacks in the NL West.

INSIDE THE SERIES: The Giants are 13-19 (.406) overall here at Nationals Park and since the start of the 2011 season, SF has gone just 5-17 (.227) in this facility...the Giants took two of three games from the Nationals during these teams' first series of 2018 at AT&T Park, but the last time the Giants won a series in Nationals Park was in 2010.

ON THE MOUND: LHP Andrew Suárez has struck out 42 batters while issuing just eight walks in his first eight career Major League starts...his 42 strikeouts through his first eight starts are the most by a Giants pitcher since **Tim Lincecum** in 2007 (48) (*Stats, LLC*).

ROAD WOES: The Giants' 10-game trip will include series against the Nationals, Marlins and Dodgers...San Francisco is just 12-20 (.375) on the road this season, tied with the Reds for the second-lowest winning pct. in the NL...the Giants enter tonight having lost 12 of their last 15 road contests.

NO REST FOR THE WEARY: Beginning tonight, the Giants will play 17-straight games matching their longest stretch of the season without an off day...in fact, the Giants are beginning a stretch tonight in which they play in 36 of the next 38 days leading up to the All-Star Break...SF's only off days in this span are June 25 and July 12.

AGAINST STRASBURG: RHP Stephen Strasburg is 3-3 with a 3.17 ERA in nine career starts against the Giants, including one postseason start in 2014...Strasburg, who hasn't faced the Giants since 2016, has lost his last three decisions to SF...**C Buster Posey** is 9-for-23 (.391) lifetime off the Nationals' right-hander, while **IF Brandon Crawford** is 7-for-18 (.389)...**OF Andrew McCutchen** is just 3-for-22 (.136).

CRAWFORD SINCE MAY 1: Beginning May 1, Crawford has hit safely in all but four of his last 33 games, batting a MLB-best .423 (52-for-123) with 12 doubles, five homers and 24 RBI...he's raised his batting average by 135 points from .189 to his current .324 mark, which ranks as the sixth-best in the National League.

SCORE AT LEAST FOUR: The Giants are 28-6 (.824) this season when they score four-or-more runs in a game...over their last 34 games, the Giants are 17-3 when scoring four-or-more runs compared to 1-14 otherwise...SF is 21-3 (.875) when scoring at least five runs a game.

FEW RUNS: The Giants have allowed a total of just 11 runs in their last six games.

IN THE BULLPEN: Giants relievers the last seven games have combined to allow three runs (two earned) on 13 hits, eight walks and 35 strikeouts in 26.0 innings pitched (0.69 ERA).

2-4 Record, 4.74 ERA

- The 25-year-old left-hander is slated to make his ninth career Major League start...has gone 2-4 with a 4.74 ERA (23er, 43.2ip) in eight outings, with the Giants going 2-6 in those games.
- Earned the win in the Giants' 2-0 victory over the Phillies last Saturday...had the best start of his young career, as he tossed 7.0-scoreless innings, allowing just three hits and zero walks with five strikeouts.
- Had his offspeed pitches working against the Phillies...Suárez got 15 outs and allowed no hits with his curve, slider and changeup...he got four outs with his changeup after getting six with it in his first six starts (*Baseball Info Solutions*).
- Has been recalled twice from triple-A Sacramento, first on April 11 to make a spot start and again on May 1 as the Giants needed an extra starter due to a doubleheader April 28...with **RHP Johnny Cueto** being placed on the disabled list May 1, Suárez slid into the Giants' starting rotation.

Has made four starts with **Nick Hundley** catching and four with **Buster Posey** behind the plate.

- Opponents have 11 hits in 34 at-bats (.324) off him with runners in scoring position...is holding opponents to a .077 average (1-for-13) with RISP and two outs.
- Has held left-handed batters to a .188 clip (9-for-48) with 14 strikeouts...righties are hitting .305 (36-for-118) with seven home runs off him.
- Opponents are hitting just .182 (10-for-55) off his slider this year compared to a .367 average (18-for-49) off his fastball.
- Opponents are batting .324 (12-for-37) with six extra-base hits and 11 RBI off him in the 1st inning, compared to a combined .255 (33-for-129) average and 13 RBI in every other inning.
