### Doubles

2B Ozzie Albies collected his National League-leading 19th double of the season on Wednesday, moving one spot ahead of teammates 1B Freddie Freeman and OF Nick Markakis.

Since the franchise moved to Atlanta in 1966, no Braves player has ever led the league in doubles.

Coincidentally, however, a Braves player led the N.L. in doubles in each of the club's final two years in Milwaukee. Lee Maye had 44 in 1964 and Hank Aaron had 40 in 1965.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Braves and Dodgers open a three-game set tonight with the first meeting between the clubs this season...Los Angeles will visit SunTrust Park, July 26-29, for four game to complete the teams' season series .

*A* The Braves have lost 10 of their last 13 games here, dating to the start of the 2014 season...When factoring in postseason play, the Braves have lost 12 of 15 at Dodger Stadium, as the club dropped game 3 and game 4 of the 2013 Division Series here...Including those two playoff games, the Braves have been outscored 83-54 over this skid.

*A* The last time the Braves took a series at Dodger Stadium was April 23-25, 2012, when Atlanta won two-of-three games.

*A* RHP Brandon McCarthy the previous three seasons with the Dodgers, coming to Atlanta in a December five-player trade that sent OF Matt Kemp to Los Angeles...For his career, McCarthy is 8-3 at Dodger Stadium with a 4.04 ERA (48 ER/107.0 IP) in 22 games, 20 starts.

*A* RHP Walker Buehler has never faced Atlanta...He has allowed just four total runs in four home starts this season.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Braves are set for their 35th road game this season, which is tied for the second most in baseball with Colorado and one behind the lead of Tampa Bay...By Sunday, the Braves will have played the most road games in the majors, as both the Rockies and Rays are home this weekend.

*A* The Braves are 20-14 (.588) away from SunTrust Park this season, the fourth-best road record in the National League.

*A* The Braves have not finished with a winning record on the road since 2012, when they went 46-35...From 2013 through last season, the Braves compiled the seventh-worst road record in the majors at 174-230 (.431).

*A* The Braves have hit 47 of their of their 73 home runs on the road this season, or 64% of their total...That percentage is the most in the National League and the third highest in baseball...Only Oakland (71%) and Tampa Bay (67%) hit a higher percentage of their home runs away from their home park.

*A* Following this series, the Braves return to Atlanta to begin a homestand on Tuesday, June 12... They will then play 12 of their next 14 games at SunTrust Park.

**CULBERSON:** Since OF Ronald Acuña Jr. went to the 10-day disabled list on May 28, UTIL Charlie Culberson, who the Braves acquired in that five-player December trade with Los Angeles, is hitting .367 (11-for-30) with two game-ending home runs and nine RBI...He has hit in eight of the nine games.

**LINEUP:** The Braves used their 41st different batting order (excluding the pitcher) on Wednesday, hitting Dansby Swanson second for just the second time this season...The club's 41 different starting lineups are the second fewest in the major leagues, trailing only the 39 Pittsburgh has used.

*A* The Braves used 95 different lineups last season... That total is the fourth highest in Atlanta franchise history, trailing the 111 they used in 2016 and the 116 they employed in 2015...They also used 101 different combinations in 1984.

**DRAFT:** The Braves concluded the 2018 First-Year Player Draft on Wednesday, using 34 of their 39 picks on collegiate players...After selecting RHP Carter Stewart from Eau Gallie High School in Melbourne, Fla., with their first choice, the Braves used 34 of their next 35 picks on collegiate players...Atlanta chose RHP Victor Vodnik from Rialto High School in Rialto, Calif., in the 14th round, before taking three high schoolers with their final three picks.

*A* The Braves' final selection of the day was C Micky Mangan from Pinecrest Academy in Cumming, Ga. Mangan, son of Braves Field Director Ed Mangan, hit .322 with a .450 on-base percentage for the Paladins this season.

*A* The Braves signed their second-round pick, OF Greyson Jenista, yesterday.

**FREEMAN VS. LEFTIES:** 1B Freddie Freeman hit the first pitch he saw from LHP Matt Strahm Wednesday over the wall in right field for his 11th home run of the season...Freeman has hit four of his last five home runs against left-handers.

*A* For the season, Freeman is hitting .365 (31-for-85) against left-handers, the second-highest mark in baseball by a left-handed batter and percentage points behind the leader, Cincinnati's, Scott Schebler (19-for-52, .365)...Teammate Nick Markakis is fifth with a .337 (31-for-92) average.

*A* Freeman has hit six home runs against lefties, tied for the most by a left-handed batter in the majors... Texas' Nomar Mazara also has six.

**LENGTH FROM THE ROTATION:** The Braves are 22-7 this season when their starting pitcher goes at 6.0 innings, and 8-1 when they complete 7.0 innings.

*A* Today's starter, RHP Brandon McCarthy has gone at least 6.0 innings three times in 12 starts this season...The opposition is hitting .339 (19-for-56) the third time through the lineup against him.

**STOPPERS:** The Braves pitching staff owns a 2.78 ERA (70 ER/227.0 IP) in games following a loss, the second-best mark in the majors...Only Philadelphia is better at 2.52 (67 ER/239.1 IP).

*A* Brandon McCarthy is 3-1 in starts following a team loss this season.

#### Tonight's Game

- A* Set for his 13th start of the season and the 195th (253rd appearance) of his career.
- A* Makes his first start against Los Angeles since being acquired by Atlanta along with LHP Scott Kazmir, INF Charlie Culberson, INF Adrián González and cash considerations from the Dodgers in exchange for OF Matt Kemp on 12/16/17.
  - A* Appeared in 33 games and made 29 starts for the Dodgers over three seasons, 2015-17...Went 11-7 with a 4.51 ERA (78 ER/155.2 IP).
- A* Has made four career starts against the Dodgers, going 2-1 with a 4.10 ERA (12 ER/26.1 IP)...His teams are 3-1 in his four starts against Los Angeles.
  - A* Last faced them in 2014 while with Arizona, and allowed six runs in 7.0 innings to suffer his only career loss against Los Angeles.
  - A* Has only made one career start as a visitor at Dodger Stadium, 5/7/13 with the D-backs...Has pitched in 22 career games and made 20 starts at Dodger Stadium, going 8-3 with a 4.04 ERA (48 ER/107.0 IP).
- A* Has totaled 63.1 innings in 12 starts on the season, tied for seventh fewest in the majors among pitchers with at least 12 starts.
  - A* Has nine starts on the season in which he's completed 5.2 innings or fewer, tied for third most in the majors...Is averaging 5.1 innings per start.
  - A* His 83.1 pitches per game are fifth fewest in the majors among qualified starters.

#### 2018 Recap

- A* Fourteen of the 34 earned runs he has allowed on the season (41%) came in a two-start span, 5/5 and 5/11...In his remaining 10 starts, is 5-0 with a 3.27 ERA (20 ER/55.0 IP).
- A* Allowed four hits and two runs over a season high-tying 6.0 innings in his last start, 6/2 vs. WSH...Received a no-decision after Atlanta lost 5-3 in 14 innings.
  - A* Is still winless in his career against Washington, despite a 2.18 ERA in five career starts...The Nationals are one of just four major league franchises against which he is winless (ATL - 0-2; MIL - 0-0; STL - 0-1).
- A* Beat the Phillies for the fourth time this season, 5/22 at Citizens Bank Park... Allowed four hits and one run over 5.2 innings.
  - A* McCarthy became just the 16th player over the last 110 seasons to beat a single opponent four times in his team's first 47 games...The last to do so was Pittsburgh's Vern Law in 1960, who also beat the Phillies four times.
  - A* Is the only pitcher in the majors this season to defeat a single opponent four times.
- A* Rebounded from a two-start losing streak to toss his second "quality" start of the season, 5/16 vs. CHI...Held the Cubs to five hits and one run over 6.0 innings in a no-decision.
  - A* Fanned a season-high eight batters, his most in over a calendar year...Last fanned as many when he also struck out eight on 4/17/17 vs. ARI.
- A* Went 5.0 innings, 5/11 at MIA, allowing 11 hits and six runs to take his second consecutive loss.
  - A* Allowed 14 earned runs over his last two starts, pitching to a 15.12 ERA (14 ER/8.1 IP) and pushing his season ERA to 5.58 at the time...Ended his start on 4/29 with a 3.09 ERA.
- A* Allowed a career-high eight runs over just 3.1 innings, 5/5 vs. SF, to take his first loss of the season...Surrendered 12 hits and one walk while fanning two.
  - A* Started the season 4-0 for the first time in his career...Previously opened the season 3-0 in 2009, 2015 and 2017 before dropping his next decision...Became the first Braves starter to open a season 4-0 since Williams Perez, who did so to start his 2015 campaign.
- A* Went 5.1 innings and allowed five hits and one run over 5.1 innings, 4/29 at PHI, to earn the win...Three of his first four wins this season came against Philadelphia.
- A* Earned his second win over Philadelphia after holding the Phillies to five hits and one run over 5.1 innings, 4/18...Fanned a season best six batters.
- A* Atlanta won the game 7-3, and moved to 4-0 in McCarthy's starts this season... Was the longest run of wins for the Braves to open the season in starts by one pitcher since the club also won each of Shelby Miller's first four starts in 2015.
- A* Earned the win in his Braves debut, 3/31 vs. PHI...Allowed six hits and two runs over 5.1 innings in a 15-2 Atlanta win...Only one Braves starter last season earned the win his team debut; Max Fried on 9/3 at CHI.
  - A* The win was the first of his career against the Phillies, and he is now winless against just four major league franchises...Has never defeated Milwaukee (0-0), St. Louis (0-1) or Washington (0-2), and is also winless in two career starts against Atlanta.

#### Career Recap

- A* Is in his 13th major league season with his seventh organization...Started with the Chicago White Sox (2005-06), before joining the Texas Rangers (2007-09), the Oakland Athletics (2011-12), the Arizona Diamondbacks (2013-14), the New York Yankees (2014) and the Los Angeles Dodgers (2015-16).

**Season Long Streak:** 8 games, 5/3-5/11 (11-36, .306, 3 HR)

- Has just three hits in his last 27 at-bats...His double in Monday's, 6/4, seventh inning at SD snapped a 0-for-16 hitless spell.
- Despite his current offensive slump, still leads the N.L. in extra-base hits (35), runs (51) and total bases (135)...Is tied for the lead in doubles (19), tied for third in home runs (14) and is tied for fifth in hits (70).
- Ranks tied for second in MLB with nine games with multiple extra-base hits...Is over half way to the Atlanta franchise record for most such games in a season, shared by Chipper Jones and Javy Lopez (17).
- Is hitting .361 (22-for-61) in the first inning this season...His 22 hits and 12 extra base-hits in the first inning are the most in the N.L., while his six home runs are tied for the most in the N.L.
- Set the franchise record for most extra-base hits (22) by the end of April and tied for the second most in MLB history...Broke the Atlanta record of 17 held by Dale Murphy, Chipper Jones and Justin Upton...Finished one shy of Jermaine Dye's 2000 record.
- Hit his first career grand slam, 5/10 at MIA, becoming the youngest Braves player (21 years, 123 days) to hit one since fellow Curaçao native Andruw Jones, 8/31/97 at BOS.

- Has played in 18 games with ATL, including 16 in left field with one start...Has also made one start in center.
- Hit .277 (26-for-94) in 24 games with the Stripers.
