TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Blue Jays finish a two-game set tonight with the fourth and final meeting between the clubs this season...The teams split a two-game series in Toronto, June 19-20.

A Despite last night's series-opening 6-2 loss, Atlanta is 11-6 over their last 17 home games against Toronto.

A The Braves have lost six of their last seven overall, and have been outscored 43-23 over this skid... They have also lost five of seven at home, including three straight.

A RHP Mike Foltynewicz is set for his third career appearance, second start, against Toronto...The righty beat the Blue Jays, 8-4, here at SunTrust Park last May 17...He tossed 6.0 innings and allowed three runs, earned.

A RHP Sam Gaviglio is set for his first career appearance against Atlanta...The right-hander has completed 5.0 innings just once in his last five starts, going 7.0 innings on June 30 vs. Detroit.

HOMERLESS: The Braves have gone five straight games without a home run to extend the club's longest drought of the season... Before this skid, they had gone three games only once before: June 26-June 29.

A The Braves are 41-18 (.695) when they hit at least one home run this season, the seventh-best record in the majors.

A The club has gone homerless in 31 games this season, and won nine of them (9-22, .290).

A The Braves have three players with double-digit home runs already (2B Ozzie Albies, 18; 1B Freddie Freeman, 16; OF Nick Markakis, 10) and one player, 3B Johan Camargo with nine...The Braves have not had four players reach double-digit home runs prior to the All-Star break since 2013, when 2B Dan Uggla, OF Justin Upton, Freeman, and OF Jason Heyward all accomplished the feat.

ONE-RUN OR LESS: RHP Mike Foltynewicz has allowed one run or less in a National League high-tying 11 starts this season, including in eight of his last 10 turns.

A Foltynewicz is tied with Philadelphia's Aaron Nola and New York's Jacob deGrom for the National League lead...Nola tossed 7.0 shutout innings last night, while deGrom pitches tonight.

A Tampa Bay's Blake Snell leads the majors with 12 such starts.

A Despite allowing five runs, earned, over 6.0 innings in his last start, Foltynewicz owns a 1.55 ERA (10 ER/58.0 IP) over his last 10 turns, dating to May 10 at Miami.

A A first-time All-Star, Foltynewicz is fourth in the National League with a 2.37 ERA...He trails three N.L. East pitchers (deGrom, Nola, Scherzer).

ALBIES RUNS: 2B Ozzie Albies scored his 70th run of the season in the sixth inning last night, becoming the seventh player in franchise history to reach that mark prior to the All-Star break...He added his 71st in the eighth.

A Tommy Holmes set the franchise record of 76 in 1945, before Dale Murphy matched the mark in 1983.

A Prior to Albies, the last time a Braves player reached 70 by the break was 2003, when Gary Sheffield had 73 and Rafael Furcal had 72...Darrell Evans (70 in 1973) and Andruw Jones (71 in 2000) also did it.

ALBIES HITS: 2B Ozzie Albies finished 3-for-4 last night and has hit safely in 18 of his last 19 games, dating to June 17...He started his run with a pinch-hit ninth-inning double in that game, the first he did not start all season.

A The second baseman is hitting .414 (36-for-87) with 18 runs scored during this hot stretch, and has raised his batting average from .251 to .285.

0-0: The Braves are hitting .360 (163-453) when putting the first pitch of an at-bat in play this season, the second-best average in the National League...Only Chicago is better at .373 (155-for-416).

A The Braves also have the second-most plate appearances in the majors that last only one pitch at 472, two behind Cincinnati for the MLB lead.

A 2B Ozzie Albies leads the league in one-pitch plate appearances with 78, while 1B Freddie Freeman is third with 70.

A Albies is hitting .410 (32-for-78) with seven home runs when he puts the first pitch in play, while Freeman is hitting .391 (27-for-69) with four home runs and a .739 slugging percentage.

TWO-OUT RUNS: The Braves continue to lead the N.L. with 177 two-out runs, while their slash line of .269/.355/.443 in such situations leads the N.L. in all three categories.

A OF Nick Markakis (.348) and 1B Freddie Freeman (.341) are fourth and fifth in the league in two-out batting average.

LENGTH: The Braves lost last night for just the 11th time this season when their starter goes at least 6.0 innings, and the club is 30-11 (.732) in such games.

A The Braves are 3-3 when tonight's starter, Mike Foltynewicz, goes at least 6.0 innings.

DOUBLES: 2B Ozzie Albies has a N.L.-high 29 doubles this season and with one more will set the franchise record for most two-base hits prior to the All-Star break...Marcus Giles first set the mark in 2003.

A Nick Markakis is second in the league with 28 two-base hits.

Tonight's Game

- A* Set to make his 18th start of the season and the 83rd of his career...Is his 103rd career appearance.
- A* Has fanned 114 batters in 95.0 innings on the season, and ranks fifth in the National League with 10.80 strikeouts per 9.0 innings.
- A* His 114 strikeouts before the All-Star break are tied for 13th most in Atlanta franchise history...Each of the 12 pitchers with more than him did so in at least 119.0 innings...John Smoltz fanned 149 batters in 134.0 innings before the break in 1996 to set the Atlanta franchise mark.
- A* Foltyniewicz's 10.80 strikeouts per 9.0 innings are the most in franchise history before the All-Star break, and would be the most by more than a full strikeout over a full season...John Smoltz pitched to a rate of 9.79 SO/9.0 IP in 1996.
- A* Allowed six hits and five runs in his last start, 7/6 at MIL...Was just his second start of the season allowing two or more runs...Has allowed no more than two earned runs in 15 of his 17 starts on the season.
- A* Faces the Blue Jays for just the third time in his career and makes his second career start...Is 1-0 with a 4.05 ERA (3 ER/6.2 IP) in his first two career appearances.
 - A* Made his only start against them last season, 5/17 at SunTrust Park...Allowed six his and three runs over 6.0 innings to get the win in Atlanta's 8-4 victory.

2018 Recap

- A* Held the Cardinals scoreless over 5.0 innings, 7/1 at STL...Allowed just one hit and fanned nine.
 - A* The start was his 11th of the season allowing one run or fewer, and those 11 starts have come in 17 turns on the season...The Atlanta franchise record for starts allowing no more than one run is 19, set by Greg Maddux over 34 starts in 2002.
- A* Reinstated from the 10-day disabled list, 6/25, and started vs. Cincinnati...Allowed one hit and one run over 5.0 innings.
 - A* Missed seven games with right triceps tightness.
- A* Tossed 5.0 scoreless innings, 6/12 vs. NYM, allowing just two hits while fanning six.
 - A* Threw a season-low 73 pitches before exiting the game with right triceps tightness...Was placed on the 10-day disabled list, 6/16.
- A* Threw the first shutout of his major league career, 6/1 vs. WSH...Allowed just two hits and struck out 11.
 - A* Became the seventh pitcher in Atlanta-era history to throw a two-hitter or better with double-digit strikeouts and the first since Greg Maddux fanned 14 Brewers in a two-hit, 1-0 win on May 2, 2001 at Turner Field.
- A* Was saddled with the loss, 5/21 at PHI, despite allowing one run over 6.0 innings of work...The start was his fourth against Philadelphia this season and the fourth time in which he faced Phillies starter RHP Nick Pivetta.
 - A* According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the last time two pitchers faced off for a fourth time in a team's 46th game or earlier was on 5/31/59, when Lew Burdette faced Robin Roberts in the Braves' 44th game and the Phillies' 45th game.
- A* Went 5.0 innings and allowed three hits and one unearned run, 5/15 vs. CHI...Walked a season-most five, and struck out a season-most 10.
 - A* Was the fourth double-digit strikeout game of his career, and has since tossed one more...Since he joined Atlanta in 2015, his five 10+ strikeout games are most on the pitching staff.
- A* Earned his third win of the season, 5/10 at MIA, after tossing 5.0 innings and allowing just three hits and one unearned run.
 - A* Received eight runs of support, his most on the season and his most since also getting eight runs on 6/7/17...Entered his start against Miami averaging just 2.83 runs of support per 9.0 innings over his last 14 turns, fewest in the N.L.
- A* Allowed a season-most nine hits and six runs over 5.0 innings, 5/4 vs. SF..All six runs he allowed came in the second inning.
 - A* The outing snapped a 10-start stretch in which he allowed three earned runs or fewer, the longest such stretch of his career...Went 2-5 with a 3.04 ERA during the run, which started 8/27/17...Was one of just five starters in the majors to have as long a streak of three earned runs or fewer in that span, and was the only one with a losing record -- the other four pitchers went a combined 40-5.
- A* Held the Nationals to four hits and one run over 5.1 innings, 4/4 at SunTrust Park...Walked two and fanned eight to earn his first win of the season and snap a career-worst seven-game losing streak.
 - A* Went 0-7 with a 7.34 ERA (31 ER/38.0 IP) over the spell, the longest losing streak of his career and tied for the second longest active streak in the majors at the time...The run dated to 8/11/17 at STL and spanned eight total starts.
- A* Took a no-decision in his season debut, 3/30 vs. PHI...Allowed five hits and three runs over 5.0 innings, striking out seven.

- A* Acquired by the Atlanta Braves along with RHP Andrew Thurman and INF Rio Ruiz from the Houston Astros in exchange for C/OF Evan Gattis and RHP James Hoyt on 1/14/15.

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 2 **1st Batter/Retired:** 28/20 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 6/3

- Over his last 19 appearances, has a 1.99 ERA (5 ER/22.2 IP) with a .158 (12-for-76) opponents' average.
- Tossed a scoreless ninth and 10th innings, 7/2 at NYY, to earn his second win of the season... Has gone more than 1.0 inning in nine outings this season, compiling a 0.00 ERA (19.1 IP) with 28 strikeouts.
- Earned his first career hold with a scoreless seventh inning, 6/24 vs. BAL...Became the sixth Atlanta pitcher with a hold this season.
- Right-handed batters have just nine hits in 76 at-bats (.118) against him...Lefties are hitting .333/.429/.619 with 14 hits, six walks, three doubles, three home runs and nine RBI.
- Set career highs in IP (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...MIL's Josh Hader struck out eight in 2.2 IP, 4/30/18 at CIN.

Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 11 **1st Batter/Retired:** 37/23 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 17/5

- Is one of three rookie relievers for Atlanta with at least 10 holds...No other team has more than one...Tied for second on the team with his 11 holds (A.J. Minter, 11)...Dan Winkler leads the club with 16.
- Has a 5.40 ERA (13 ER/21.2 IP) in his last 17 appearances dating to 5/21 at PHI...Pitched to a 0.69 ERA in his first 20 games of the season with just six walks...Has walked 11 over this skid.
- Tossed 3.0 perfect innings of relief, 7/5 at MIL.
- Holding batters to a .200 (16-for-80) average with men on base and has allowed just eight hits (8-for-47, .170) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .245 (23-for-94) with no one on base.

Sam Freeman • LHP • 5-11 • 180 • 31 yrs • #39

Saves/Opp: 0/3 **Holds:** 6 **1st Batter/Retired:** 43/28 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 29/8

- Is 1-3 with a 7.13 ERA (14 ER/17.2 IP) in his last 19 appearances, dating to 5/23...Surrendered 17 hits and 11 walks during the spell, including a three home runs, and has allowed at least one run in nine of those outings.
- Had a 8.49 ERA (11 ER/11.2 IP) in 12 games in June.
- Left-handed batters are hitting just 10-for-50 (.200) against him.
- Has inherited 29 runners on the season, and has stranded 21 (73%)...Inherited just 19 runners last season.
- Took the loss, 4/23 at CIN...The loss snapped a streak of 190 consecutive games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors at the time...Freeman's run, which is the third-longest in MLB history, dated to 10/3/12...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) and Peter Moylan (present) had a longer streak in MLB history.

Luiz Gohara • LHP • 6-3 • 265 • 21 yrs • #53

Saves/Opp: 1/1 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 8/6 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 2/1

- Recalled, 7/4, from Triple-A Gwinnett for his second stint on the active roster...Also up from 5/8-6/16...Opened the season on Atlanta's disabled list (left ankle sprain), before being returned from his rehab and optioned to Gwinnett on 4/27.
- In three starts with the Stripers after being optioned, went 1-1 with a 4.09 ERA (5 ER/11.0 IP)...Fanned 13... Earned his first win of the season in his last appearance, 6/30 at Charlotte (5.0 IP, 2 ER).
- His appearance on 6/4 at SD was his first since 5/23 at PHI in a 4.0-inning start...Reinstated from the Restricted List on 6/3...Was originally placed on the Bereavement/Family Medical Emergency List on 5/25.
- Earned his first professional save in his season debut (3.0 IP, 1 R/ER), 5/10 at MIA.

Luke Jackson • RHP • 6-2 • 210 • 26 yrs • #64

- Has a 1.93 ERA (2 ER/9.1 IP) over his last eight games, dating to 6/12.
- Threw a career-most 62 pitches over 3.0 innings, 7/3 at NYY...Allowed one run and struck out five.
- Earned his first win of the season with a scoreless 11th inning, 6/25 vs. CIN...Is 3-0 in his major league career.
- Earned his first career save on 6/5 at SD.
- Has fanned 18 batters in his 13.2 innings with Atlanta, and has struck out 52 batters in 35.0 combined innings (13.4 SO/9.0 IP) between the Braves and Triple-A Gwinnett.
