



# SAN DIEGO PADRES 2018 GAME NOTES

**AND SO IT GOES:** Yesterday afternoon in Chicago, the Padres fell 5-4 in Game 2 of the four-game set, and they dropped to 1-4 on the season vs. CHC...starter **Tyson Ross** worked 5.0 innings of six-hit ball, allowing three runs (earned) with two walks and a pair of strikeouts...**Cory Spangenberg** went 2-for-2 with a double, making the first time this season in which he's recorded a multi-hit effort as a sub...**Christian Villanueva** hit his 20th homer of the season, now tying with COL's Nolan Arenado for the most round-trippers off of southpaws in 2018.

**MAKING MOVES:** Today, the Padres placed OF **Wil Myers** on the 10-day DL with a left foot contusion/bone bruise (retroactive Aug. 3) and recalled OF **Franmil Reyes** from El Paso (AAA).

**LOCKETTED IN:** Starter **Walker Lockett** is set to make his second-career start and his first on the road...he became the seventh Padre to make their ML Debut this season and the third to do so as a starting pitcher on June 1 vs. CIN...he tossed 3.2 IP of four-run ball in SD's 7-2 defeat...he relies on five pitches: Four Seamer (55.5%), Changeup (22.7%), Curve (16%), Sinker (3.4%) and Cutter (2.5%).

**VAMOS VILLANUEVA!** Yesterday, **Christian Villanueva** belted his 20th homer of the season, the most among rookies...he's chasing the Padres rookie home run record, which is held by **Hunter Renfroe** (26 homers in 2017)...his 14 homers vs. lefties tie with COL Nolan Arenado for the most this season...has slashed .324/.369/.745 vs. southpaws this season.

**THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:** Since the All-Star break, the Padres bullpen has a 1.02 WHIP (ranking second behind LAD's 0.94 WHIP)...their 5.08 SO/BB ratio ranks first, and their 0.49 HR/9 ip tie with PHI for the best mark in the majors in that time.

**GRUNDER CENTRAL:** Since the All-Star game, the Padres have a 44.1 ground ball percentage (14th highest in the majors), while the Cubs tie for the ML lead (also MIL) with a 52.2 grounder percentage...conversely, before the break, the Padres 47.9 percentage ranked second-highest in the majors (behind MIL's 49.4) and the Cubs' 44.8 mark ranked 14th highest.

**HEY KYLE!** **Travis Jankowski** owns a career .333 average vs. CHC's Kyle Hendricks (3-for-9) with a double, and **Freddy Galvis** has slashed .364/.417/.636 vs. Hendricks in his career, going 4-for-11 with three doubles.

**HURLERS AT WRIGLEY:** Since the birth of the 2017 campaign, San Diego hurlers have accrued a 3.00 ERA vs. the Cubs at Wrigley Field (14 er, 42.0 ip)...in that time, they've allowed 1.29 HR/9 ip and have held Cubs bats to a .215 opponent average.

**PADRES ON DECK:** Last night for El Paso (AAA), **Francisco Mejia** hit his first home run as a member of the Padres organization...for San Antonio (AA), LF **Josh Naylor** went 2-for-6 with a two-run homer, and C **Austin Allen** also hit a two-run homer, going 2-for-5...for Fort Wayne (A), SS **Gabriel Arias** was 2-for-4 with a solo homer, and 2B Esteury Ruiz also went 2-for-4 with three stolen bases and a run scored.

**THIS DATE IN PADRES HISTORY:** On Aug. 4, 1993, **Tony Gwynn** had a career-high, six-hit game in a 12-inning, 11-10 Padres win over San Francisco at San Diego Jack Murphy Stadium...Gwynn went 6-for-7 with two doubles and two runs scored, and he tied a Major League record with four games of five or more hits in a single season.

## STARTING PITCHER NOTES

### #62 RHP WALKER LOCKETT (0-1, 9.53 ERA)

**TIME TO LOCKETT IN:** 24-year-old RHP Walker Lockett is set to make his second career Major League start and third appearance in Game 3 of this four-game set at Wrigley Field...recalled Tuesday from triple-A El Paso.

**STATCASTED:** Lockett relies on five pitches: Four Seamer (55.5%), Changeup (22.7%), Curve (16%), Sinker (3.4%) and Cutter (2.5%).

**DEBUTS IN DIEGO:** Lockett became the seventh Padre to make their ML Debut this season and the third to do so as a starting pitcher on 6/1 vs. CIN...he tossed 3.2 IP of four-run ball in SD's 7-2 defeat.

- The full list of Padre debuts in '18 are: RHPs **Adam Cimber** and **Kazuhisa Makita**, LHPs **José Castillo**, **Eric Lauer** and **Joey Lucchesi**, INF **Javy Guerra** and OF **Franmil Reyes**.
- He was the fifth starting pitcher to make his debut with the Padres since the 2017 season (and coincidentally, all five have a last name starting with 'L')...he's the third starter to debut with SD this season, and since the '17 season's inception, Lockett joins **Dinelson Lamet**, **Kyle Lloyd**, **Joey Lucchesi** (March 30 vs. MIL) and **Eric Lauer** (April 24 at COL).

**SO FAR IN 2018:** In addition to his one start with the Padres, he made one relief appearance on 7/9 vs. LAD (2.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 2 ER, SO, BB) in SD's 8-2 loss.

- Has spent the majority of the season with El Paso, going 4-9 with a 4.92 ERA (61 ER, 112 IP) with 104 strikeouts against 27 walks in his 19 starts with the Chihuahuas.
- Has worked 6.0 innings or more in 13 of his 19 minor league starts this season.

**A SEASON AGO:** Made 10 starts for El Paso (AAA) in 2017, posting a 5-2 record and a 4.39 ERA (27 ER, 55.1 IP) before being placed on the seven-day disabled list with a lower back strain on 6/2.

- Activated from the seven-day DL on 9/6 in time for the Pacific Coast League playoffs, where he made two starts for the Chihuahuas, including 5.0-scoreless IP on 9/15 vs. Memphis to give El Paso their first win in Game 3 of the PCL championship series.
- Following the season, made six starts for the Peoria Javelinas of the Arizona Fall League...earned the victory to clinch the West Division and advance to the AFL championship behind 6.0 IP of one-run ball, allowing just three baserunners vs. Scottsdale on 11/15.
