## Reds Notes

- **RHP Sal Romano** made his fourth start of the season and second on the road.....is now 0-2 with a 5.75 ERA (20.1ip, 13er) this season.....is now 0-4 with a 6.27 ERA (18.2ip, 13er) in 4 career starts against Milwaukee, including 0-3 with a 6.32 ERA (15.2ip, 11er) in 3 starts at Miller Park.
- **IB Joey Votto** drew his 1,000th career walk in the first inning.....came in his 1,446th game, making him the fourth-fastest NL player to reach the milestone.....joins Miguel Cabrera and Albert Pujols as the only active players, and Pete Rose as the only Reds players, to amass 1,000 career walks.
- **Votto** has reached base at least twice in each of his last 13 games against the Brewers dating back to 6/28/17.....this ties Chase Utley (7/25/12-6/17/16) and Bobby Abreu (7/6/99-7/6/00) for the third-longest streak ever against Milwaukee.....has hit safely in 16 of his last 17 games at Miller Park dating back to 8/12/16, batting .397 (23-for-58) in that span.
- **C Devin Mesoraco** left the game with a bruised right wrist.....x-rays were negative.
- **The Reds'** 3-14 record is their worst start through 17 games since 1934, when they also began the season 3-14.

## Brewers Notes

- **RHP Junior Guerra** made his second start of the season and first at home.....became the third Brewer to limit the Reds to 1 hit in a start of at least 5 innings, also Marco Estrada (8/25/13 at Cincinnati) and Victor Santos (5/4/04 at Cincinnati).....is now 1-0 with a 0.82 ERA (11ip, 1er) this season..... is now 1-1 with a 4.76 ERA (22.2ip, 12er) in 5 career appearances against Cincinnati, including 1-1 with a 4.98 ERA (21.2ip, 12er) in 4 starts.....was his first start against the Reds at Miller Park.
- **IB Eric Thames** hit his sixth home run of the season in the sixth inning, snapping an 0-for-11 streak.....5 of Thames' last 7 hits have been home runs.....was his 11th home run in 18 career games against the Reds.....was the first homer for the Brewers in 23 innings (Orlando Arcia, ninth inning, Saturday at New York-NL) and the first for the Crew at home in 28 innings (Thames, fourth inning, 4/7 vs. Chicago-NL).....the Brewers have 4 homers in their last 62 innings at home, 3 of which have been hit by Thames.
- **3B Travis Shaw** has hit safely in 16 of 18 career games against the Reds, batting .296 (21-for-71).
- **SS Orlando Arcia** has back-to-back multi-hit games for the first time since 8/8-8/9, 2017.
- **LHP Josh Hader** has recorded at least 3 strikeouts in all 7 appearances this season.....this extends his Club record (prev. 4, 3x) and ties the longest streak for any reliever in a single season since Baseball Reference data is available (1908).....this has also been done by Tom Gordon (8/11-8/31, 1991) and Tom Henke (8/14-8/29, 1989).....is the first Brewers pitcher with multiple 2-inning saves in a single season since John Axford in 2010 (2).
- **LHP Dan Jennings** is the first Brewer to earn a win on his birthday since Steve Woodard on 5/15/99 vs. Florida (Woodard did so in back-to-back years on his birthday).....is the third Brewers reliever to do this, joining Bob McClure (4/29/86 vs. Oakland) and Pete Ladd (7/17/82 vs. Chicago-AL).
- **The Brewers** recorded their first shutout win of the season.....was the Club's first shutout since 9/17/17 at Pittsburgh and first at home since 9/1/17 vs. Washington.....shut out the Reds for the first time since 9/14/16 at Cincinnati and for the first time at home since 8/28/15.....shut out the the Reds on 3 or fewer hits for the first time since 9/24/14 at Cincinnati and the first time at home since 7/9/13.
