TRIBE HEADLINES

» Cleveland enters this afternoon with a 26-10 record in series finales this year...the club has won each of its last five finales, outscoring opponents 38-7 in those contests.

» Tribe starting pitchers have combined for a 3.43 ERA this season, the 3rd-lowest in MLB (2nd in A.L.)...this includes a 3.50 ERA at Progressive Field, the 3rd-lowest home starting pitcher ERA in the A.L.

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** enters play today tied for the A.L. lead with 26 stolen bases this season (T2nd in MLB)...he continues to lead the A.L. in extra-base hits (64), while ranking 2nd in home runs (32).

» Recent acquisition **LEONYS MARTIN** has hit safely in each of his first three games with the Indians...he enters tonight on an active season-long six-game hit streak (.381, 2HR, 3RBI, 4R).

» **SHANE BIEBER** is due to face Los Angeles-AL for the first time in his career this afternoon...also makes his sixth home start of the season, owning a 3-2 record and 4.94 ERA (15ER/27.1IP) in his five prior outings at Progressive Field.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians leveled this series at 1-1 with a 3-0 shutout win last night...marked the club's 11th shutout of the season, which is tied with three other clubs for the 2nd-most in the Majors this year.

» **COREY KLUBER** tossed his seventh career complete-game shutout, holding the Halos to three hits and one walk, with seven strikeouts...marked Kluber's second complete game of the season (T1st in MLB), as well as the second CGSO by an Indians hurler this year (**MIKE CLEVINGER** - April 21 at BAL)...Kluber threw 98 pitches in the game, the fewest in a 9.0-inning CGSO this season.

» Cleveland's first hit of the night came in the 6th, a go-ahead solo homer off the bat of **LEONYS MARTIN** (1-3)...Martin has homered in consecutive games for the fourth time in his career (second this season), and is batting .500 (4-8) in an Indians uniform.

» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** (1-2) singled in the Tribe's second run in the bottom of the 6th inning...Brantley is batting .338 (69-204) at home this season, the 6th-best mark in the American League.

NEW KID IN TOWN

» **LEONYS MARTIN** has hit safely in each of his three games for Cleveland since his July 31 acquisition from Detroit for **INF Willi Castro**...he is batting .500 (4-8) in those three contests with two homers, three RBI and three runs scored.

» With last night's solo shot, Martin has now homered in consecutive games for the fourth time in his career, as well as the second time this season, after also doing so on April 25 in both games of a doubleheader at Pittsburgh (with Detroit).

» Including his final three games with Detroit, Martin enters tonight on a season-long six-game hit streak, batting .381 (8-21) with four runs scored, two homers and three RBI in that span...his nine outfield assists this season are tied with Seattle's **Mitch Haniger** for the most in the American League.

EARN YOUR WINGS

» The Indians are playing their second and final series of the season with the Angels in this weekend's three-game set.

» The clubs previously met from April 2-4 at Angel Stadium, with Los Angeles-AL taking two of three contests.

» The Indians own an all-time record of 316-328 (.491) against the Angels, including a mark of 24-13 (.649) since **Terry Francona** became Tribe manager in 2013...dating back to June 12, 2016, Cleveland has won 13 of its last 16 games vs. Los Angeles-AL.

STRONG STARTERS

» Cleveland starting pitchers have combined for a 3.43 ERA this season, the 2nd-lowest mark in the American League (Houston - 3.00) and 3rd-lowest in MLB (Los Angeles-NL - 3.35).

» **COREY KLUBER's** complete-game shutout last night marked the Tribe's MLB-leading fifth complete game of the season (next closest clubs have three)...marked the club's 45th start of 7.0-or-more innings, also the most in the Majors.

» Tribe starters rank 2nd in MLB with 709 strikeouts this season and have issued just 168 walks (4th-fewest in MLB)...the rotation's 4.22 K/BB ratio leads MLB, just ahead of Los Angeles-NL (4.19).

OUR SHANE MAN

» Right-handed rookie **SHANE BIEBER** is due to take the mound for his 10th career start in this afternoon's series finale...will face the Angels for the first time in his career today.

» Will be pitching today on extended five days' rest after his last start on July 30 at Minnesota (ND, 6.1IP, 6H, 4R/3ER, 2BB, 7K).

» Bieber has allowed two-or-fewer walks in each of his nine starts, which is tied with **Eric Raich** (9GS, May 24-July 4, 1975) for the 2nd-longest streak by an Indians starting pitcher to begin his career in the *Baseball Reference Play Index era (1908-)*, behind **CODY ANDERSON's** 12-game run from June 21-Sept. 13, 2015.

» This afternoon will mark Bieber's sixth start of the season at Progressive Field...owns a 3-2 record and 4.94 ERA (15ER/27.1IP) in his five prior home starts.

» Bieber has made three starts in series finales this season, compiling a 2-1 record and 3.06 ERA (6ER/17.2IP) in those outings.

FINISH STRONG

» The Indians enter play today with a 26-10 record in series finales, including a 15-3 mark in home finales...Tribe is also 6-4 in rubber games (3-1 at home)...Cleveland's .722 winning percentage in finales is 2nd-best in the A.L. (Boston - .771).

» Tribe starting pitchers have excelled in series finales, posting a 23-4 record with a 2.26 ERA (61ER/242.2IP), including wins in 15 of their last 17 decisions.

» Cleveland has won each of its last five series finales overall, as well as each of the last four finales at Progressive Field, outscoring opponents 38-7 in those contests...club shut out Minnesota 2-0 on August 1 in its most recent finale effort.

JOSÉ CAN YOU SWING (AND STEAL)

» Reigning American League Player of the Month **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** went 1-for-4 with his 26th stolen base of the season last night, and is now tied with Seattle's **Dee Gordon** for the A.L. lead in steals (T2nd in MLB behind Washington's **Trea Turner** - 30).

» Ramírez remains the MLB leader with 64 extra-base hits and ranks 2nd in the Majors with 32 home runs, behind Boston's **J.D. Martínez** (33).

» He also ranks among American League leaders in total bases (252 - 2nd), walks (70 - 2nd), on-base percentage (.406 - 3rd), slugging percentage (.624 - T3rd), RBI (79 - 3rd), at-bats per RBI (5.1 - T5th), at-bats per home-run (12.6 - 5th), home batting average (.315 - 9th) and overall batting average (.300 - 10th).

FRANKIE KEEPS SCORING

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** went 1-for-3 last night with a double, a walk and a run scored...marked his MLB-leading 94th run of the season...he led the Majors in runs for both May (27) and July (26).

» He remains on pace to score 140 runs this season, which would match **Earl Averill's** franchise record of 140 in 1931...his 94 runs scored through 109 team games are the most by an Indians hitter since **Roberto Alomar** had 95 after 109 games in 1999.

» Lindor's double last night was his 35th of the year (T2nd in A.L. & MLB), and he enters play today among the A.L. top 10 in a variety of other categories, including extra-base hits (63 - 2nd), multi-hit games (42 - T2nd), total bases (246 - 3rd), hits (128 - 5th), OPS (.932 - 6th), home runs (27 - 6th) and RBI (67 - T8th).

BALANCED ATTACK

» The Indians team offense remains among American League leaders in a number of categories...the Tribe currently ranks 2nd in the A.L. in team batting average (.258), stolen bases (85), and home runs (152), while clocking in 3rd in hits (975), slugging percentage (.443) and OPS (.771).

» The club also ranks 4th in the A.L. in runs scored (556) and extra-base hits (380), as well as 5th with 214 doubles.

BOLSTERED BULLPEN

» The Indians bullpen has been improved in the second half of the season, posting a 3.49 ERA (15ER/38.2IP) since the All-Star break, which ranks 2nd-lowest in the A.L. (6th-lowest in MLB).

» **Over their past 10 appearances, Tribe relievers have combined for a 2.25 ERA (7ER/28.0IP), including seven collective scoreless outings in that span.**

TODAY'S START

» The 23-year-old rookie is set to make his 10th career start in this afternoon's series finale vs. Los Angeles-AL...will mark his first career appearance against the Angels.
 » Will be pitching this afternoon on extended five days' rest after making his last start on July 30 at Minnesota...did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs (three earned) on six hits, with two walks and seven strikeouts in 6.1 innings...marked his fourth career quality start.
 » Bieber is due to face the Angels for the first time in his career...has made one prior start against an A.L. West opponent, taking the loss vs. Oakland on July 8 (6.0IP, 8H, 4R/ER, 1HR, 1BB, 7K).
 » Is due to make his sixth home start of the year this afternoon...owns a 3-2 record and 4.94 ERA (15ER/27.1IP) in his five prior home outings...took the loss in his most recent start at Progressive Field on July 24 vs. Pittsburgh (1.2IP, 7H, 7R/ER, 2HR, 2K).
 » Bieber has allowed 10 walks in his eight Major League starts this season (51.1IP)...his 1.75 BB/9 is the lowest among American League rookie pitchers and 2nd-lowest in MLB (min. 40.0IP), trailing Pittsburgh reliever Edgar Santana (1.46)...Bieber's 1.75 BB/9 also leads all MLB rookie starting pitchers (min. 40.0IP).
 » Has posted a 5.10 SO/BB ratio, the top mark among MLB rookie starting pitchers (min. 40.0IP) and 3rd-best by any rookie pitcher, behind Pittsburgh's Santana (5.63) and Richard Rodriguez (5.30).
 » He has also allowed two-or-fewer walks in each of his first nine career starts, which is tied with Eric Rauch (9GS, May 24-July 4, 1975) for the 2nd-longest streak by an Indians starting pitcher to begin his career in the *Baseball Reference Play Index era (1908-)*, behind CODY ANDERSON (12GS, June 21-September 13, 2015).
 » Bieber has struck out 51 batters in his first nine career starts, which is the 3rd-most in Cleveland franchise history, behind Herb Score (82) and DANNY SALAZAR (57).

2018 CLEVELAND RECAP

» Earned his fifth win on July 13, marking the first Indians pitcher with five wins in his first seven career starts since CC Sabathia did so in 2001.
 » Won his fourth career game on July 3 at Kansas City, becoming the third Tribe pitcher in the *Baseball Reference Play Index era (1908-)* with four wins in his first five career starts, joining John Farrell (1987) and Scott Lewis (2008-09).
 » On June 22 vs. Detroit, Bieber became the sixth Indians pitcher since 1908 to record a start with 7.0-or-more shutout innings and four-or-fewer hits allowed within his first three career starts, and the first since Scott Lewis did so on September 10, 2008 at Baltimore...at 23.022 years old marked the youngest pitcher in franchise history to achieve that feat, surpassing Ray Benge (23.157), who did so on Sept. 26, 1925 at Philadelphia.
 » Bieber fanned a career-high nine Tigers hitters in the outing, becoming the first Indians pitcher since Luis Tiant in 1964 with six-or-more strikeouts in each of his first three career appearances...his 22 strikeouts combined across his first three career starts tied him with DANNY SALAZAR (also 22) for the 3rd-most strikeouts in a pitcher's first three career appearances in Indians franchise history.
 » Earned his first career win on June 17 vs. Minnesota...allowed one run on 11 hits in 5.2 innings, with one walk...fanned seven batters, becoming the fourth pitcher in Indians franchise history to strike out six-or-more batters in each of his first two career starts and first since DANNY SALAZAR did so in his first two appearances from July 11 - August 7, 2013.
 » Made his Major League debut against the Twins at Target Field on May 31...did not factor into the decision in the Tribe's 9-8 win (5.2IP, 8H, 4R/ER, 2HR, 1BB, 6K)...struck out six batters, including his first career batter faced (Brian Dozier), marking the most punchouts in a Tribe pitcher's first Major League start since SALAZAR fanned seven in his MLB debut on July 11, 2013 vs. Toronto.
 » Bieber became the first pitcher in Indians franchise history to make his Major League debut on his birthday, as well as the second player after outfielder Dave Clark on September 3, 1986 at Toronto.

2018 MILB RECAP

» This season, Bieber has compiled a 6-1 record and 1.47 ERA (13ER/79.2IP) in 13 combined starts between AA Akron and AAA Columbus.
 » Was called up to the Indians on May 31 and made seven starts for the Tribe between then and his return to the Clippers on July 14, posting a 5-1 record and 3.53 ERA (17ER/43.1IP).
 » Did not allow a run until his fourth start of the year, a career-long scoreless streak of 22.0 innings, dating back to his last start in 2017...overall this season, has recorded five scoreless starts and allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in 12 of 13 outings.
 » Has a 3-1 record with a 1.66 ERA (9ER/48.2IP) in eight starts with Columbus, with 47 strikeouts and just six walks allowed in his 48.2 innings...marks his first career action in Triple-A...from May 3 - June 6, did not walk a batter, a span of 30.1 innings.
 » Tossed a rain-shortened no-hitter on May 25 at Gwinnett, striking out seven batters and walking none in the 7.0 inning outing...the lone Gwinnett baserunner reached on an error in the bottom of the 3rd...marked the 8th no-hitter in Columbus franchise history.
 » Began the season at AA Akron, where he went a perfect 3-0 with a 1.16 ERA (4ER/31.0IP) in five starts prior to his May 3 call-up to Columbus...was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for April 5-15.
 » Named the pitcher with the Best Control in the Indians Player Development System, according to *Baseball America* at the beginning of the season...also placed on the Tribe pre-season top prospect rankings in *Baseball America* - 5th, *Baseball Prospectus* - 5th and *ESPN.Com/Keith Law* - 10th.

CAREER SNAPSHOT

» The Orange, California native was selected in the 4th Round (122nd overall) of the June, 2016 MLB Draft out of the University of California-Santa Barbara.
 » Posted a 23-12 record and 2.73 ERA (91ER/300.0IP) from 2014-16 for UC Santa Barbara, with 237 strikeouts and just 38 walks...earned several honors over the course of his college career, including being named 2015 All-Big West Second Team, 2016 Pre-season Big West Pitcher of the Year, 2016 All-Big West First Team and 2016 Rawlings Second Team All-American.
 » Made his professional debut with Short-Season Mahoning Valley in 2016, making eight starts and one relief appearance for the Scrappers...after allowing one run in his first appearance on July 22, did not surrender an earned run in his final eight outings of the year, a span of 21.0 innings...overall on the year, posted a 0-0 record and 0.38 ERA (1ER/24.0IP), with 21 strikeouts and just two walks allowed.
 » Divided the 2017 season between A Lake County, High-A Lynchburg and AA Akron, combining for a 10-5 record and 2.86 ERA (55ER/173.1IP).
 » Began the year with Lake County and earned his first career win on April 14 at Lansing, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing one run on four hits while walking none and striking out a career-best 11 batters...went 2-3 with a 3.10 ERA (10ER/29.0IP) in five starts with the Captains prior to his promotion to Lynchburg on May 5.
 » After taking a loss on June 6 at Salem, won his next four starts, a then-career long streak...went 4-0 with a 1.05 ERA (3ER/25.2IP) in those outings, with 29 strikeouts...won the Carolina League Pitcher of the Week award for June 19-25, after matching his career high 11 punchouts on June 22 vs. Frederick...overall went 6-1 with a 3.10 ERA (31ER/90.0IP) in 14 starts for the Hillcats.
 » Was called up to AA Akron on July 24 and finished the season with the RubberDucks...earned his first career Double-A win on August 4 at Reading, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing one run on six hits, with zero walks and seven strikeouts...posted a 2-1 record and 2.32 ERA (14ER/54.1IP) in nine starts for Akron.
 » In 2017, led all pitchers in the Indians organization with 173.1 innings pitched and ranked among the leaders in ERA (2.86, 2nd), strikeouts (162, 2nd) and wins (10, 14th).
