THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 2-1 through three games on their six-game homestand, winning a three-game series vs. Kansas City over the weekend...tonight they will continue the homestand with the first of three vs. the Yankees...after this series, the Twins will make their final roadtrip of the season with four at Kansas City September 13-16, three at Detroit September 17-19 and three at Oakland September 21-23.

WILLIAMS. WALK-OFF WINNER: The Twins beat the Royals yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 3-1...Chase De Jong was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching 4.0 scoreless innings with one hit allowed...Zack Littell allowed just one run in 3.1 innings of relief...the offense recorded seven hits, two from Williams Astudillo, who hit a walk-off two-run homer in the bottom of the ninth...below are a list of Twins walk-offs this season:

TWINS AND YANKEES: The Twins are playing the fifth of seven games vs. the Yankees this season...their last meeting came April 23-26 at Yankee Stadium, getting swept in four games...the Twins have lost seven straight games against the Yankees, excluding the 2017 AL Wild Card Game...in those seven games, the Twins have been out-scored 51-17 and out-hit 73-47.

- ☞ Miguel Sanó has reached base safely in 12 of 13 career games against New York...he has homered six times in those 13.
- ☞ Jake Cave was drafted by the Yankees in the 6th round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft...he played six seasons in New York's minor league system before being traded to Minnesota on March 16, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Luis Gil.
- ☞ Tyler Austin was drafted by the Yankees in the 13th round of the 2010 First-Year Player Draft...he played parts of three seasons for New York at the major league level prior to getting traded to Minnesota along with minor league right-handed pitcher Luis Rijo on July 30, in exchange for Lance Lynn.
- ☞ Zack Littell pitched part of 2017 in the Yankees system...he was acquired by the Twins at the trade deadline in 2017 along with left-handed pitcher Dietrich Enns and cash, in exchange for Jaime Garcia.
- ☞ Twins Bench Coach Derek Shelton played minor league baseball in the Yankees organization with Single-A Oneonta in 1992 and Single-A Greensboro in 1993...he was teammates with Derek Jeter, Shane Spencer and Mariano Rivers in Greensboro...Shelton managed and coached in the Yankees system at various levels from 1997-2002.
- ☞ Hitting Coach James Rowson was a hitting coach and coordinator at various levels of the Yankees system from 2006-11 and 2014-16.

MINNESOTA, NICE: The Twins have gone 41-30 at home this season, compared to 24-47 on the road...the Twins won 41 games at home last season...they have gone 22-10 at Target Field since June 24...since that date, they have the fourth best home winning percentage in the AL (.688), trailing Tampa Bay (.771), Boston (.758) and Oakland (.743).

☞ In that same span: Robbie Grossman is hitting .351 (20-for-57) and Jake Cave is hitting .314 (27-for-86) at Target Field.

THIS AND THAT: Notes from Remarkable by Inside Edge:

- ☞ Twins runners have stolen 1 base over the last 30 days (6 Games) -- fewest in MLB.
- ☞ Twins starting pitchers have walked 64 of 558 batters (11.5%) over the last 30 days -- worst in MLB; League Avg: 7.4%.
- ☞ Tyler Austin is slugging .906 (29 total bases in 32 ABs) at home over the last 30 days (9 Games) -- best in MLB among hitters with at least 37 PA's; League Avg: .437.
- ☞ Joe Mauer has a swing rate of just 4.1% (19/461) on the first pitch of at-bats this season -- lowest in MLB among hitters with at least 213 PA's; League Avg: 28.6%.
- ☞ Twins relief pitchers have allowed 48 stolen bases this season -- most in MLB.
- ☞ Joe Mauer has not swung at the first pitch in any of his last 25 PA (Mookie Betts has the longest active streak at 60)

AGAINST THE YANKEES: Gibson is making his eighth career start against New York-AL tonight...is 1-4 with a 7.71 ERA (35.0 IP, 30 ER) with 16 walks and 23 strikeouts, allowing just two home runs across his seven previous starts...

SWING AND A MISS: Thus far in 2018, Gibson has recorded 158 strikeouts through 28 starts and owns a strikeout rate of 22.0 percent and a swing-and-miss rate of 26.6 percent, 11th best in the AL...

THAT'S KYLE WITH A K: Gibson has improved his strikeouts-per-9.0 innings rate nearly every year in his career, setting a career-high in 2017 with 6.89 K/9...through 28 starts in 2018, Gibson is striking out 8.32 batters-per-9.0 innings.

KILLING TWO BIRDS WITH ONE STONE: Gibson induced 26 double plays in 2017, ranking third in the AL...his 1.48 GDP/9 ranked fourth in baseball among pitchers who threw more than 150 innings in 2017...

RISP-Y BUSINESS: Gibson has held opponents to a .201 average (27-for-134) with runners in scoring position, third best in the AL and 11th best in baseball...of those 27 hits, only five have gone for extra bases (two home runs, three doubles) and has struck out 34 batters...over his career, his opponents are hitting .261 (209-for-801) with RISP.

NEED SOME RUNS: Gibson has been given 70 runs of support this year but only has a run support average of 3.68, fourth lowest in the AL...in 12 of his 28 starts, he has been supported with one or fewer runs and has been given more than three runs eight times...

GIBBY ON TARGET: Gibson has 23 wins at Target Field, which is now the most all-time...he passed Brian Duensing for most in Target Field history after his win on July 7:

• His 2.85 ERA pre-ASG in 2015 was the fourth-lowest for a Twins starter since 1992 with a minimum of 80.0 IP (Liriano - 1.83 in 2006, Santana - 2.75 in 2007, Radke - 2.77 in 1998).
• In 2014, his first full season in the majors, became one of three pitchers in Twins history to win each of their first three games while posting a sub-1.00 ERA.
• Earned the win in his MLB debut 6/29/13 vs. KC allowing three runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings.
• Named the Twins Minor League Player of the Week for May 12, 2013 after tossing a CG SHO.
• Named an Arizona Fall League Rising star in 2012 and the AFL Player of the Week, 10/23/12.
• Selected to the 2011 Futures Game where he tossed 1.1 inning, allowing two hits.
• Named to the 2010 Eastern League Mid-Season All-Star Team.
• Named the Florida State League Pitcher of the Week, May 3, 2010.
• Selected in the first round (22nd overall) by the Twins in the 2009 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Missouri as a senior...major was communications.
