**THE TWINS:** The Twins lost to the Blue Jays yesterday in Dunedin 13-8...Phil Hughes was the Twins starter allowing four runs on five hits, two home runs and one walk while striking out one...Ryan Pressly tossed 1.2 innings of relief with one walk and one strikeout...the Twins scored eight runs on nine hits including home runs by Ryan LaMarre and Taylor Featherston, who also hit a double...the two teams combined for nine runs in the fifth inning and the Blue Jays scored another five runs in the eighth to take the final lead...the loss snapped an eight-game spring training win-streak the Twins had over Toronto.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER:** José Berríos will be making his second start of the spring today...in his first start February 27 vs. Boston he allowed one hit with one strikeout in 1.0 inning...last spring, he made two starts, posting a 2.25 ERA (4.0 IP, 1 ER) with three walks and six strikeouts...Berríos is entering his second full season with the Twins, having combined to go 17-15, 5.07 ERA (204.0 IP, 115 ER) with 83 walks and 188 strikeouts from 2016-17 with Minnesota...Berríos started the 2017 campaign with the Rochester Red Wings where he made six starts, going 3-0, 1.13 ERA (39.2 IP, 5 ER)...he was recalled on May 13, and finished the season in Minnesota starting 25 games, going 14-8, 3.89 ERA (145.2 IP, 63 ER) with 48 walks and 139 strikeouts...Berríos was drafted by the Twins in the first round (32nd overall) in the 2012 MLB draft out of Bayamon, Puerto Rico.

**TWINS VS. PITTSBURGH:** Today marks the first of two meetings between the Twins and Pirates this spring...in spring of 2017, the Twins went 0-2 against the Pirates...the Twins were 2-1-1 against the Pirates in spring 2016...the Twins are 16-12 all-time vs. the Pirates in the regular season and will face the Pirates four times during the 2018 regular season...the first matchup against Pittsburgh in 2018 will be the Pirates' Home Opener April 2 (and April 4) and the Twins will host two at Target Field August 14-15.

**THIS AND THAT ON ADRIANZA:** Ehire Adrianza is in his ninth career spring training and second with the Twins...the Twins are his third professional organization, previously with San Francisco and Milwaukee...he played five different defensive positions last season: 29 at shortstop, 17 in leftfield, nine at second base, nine at third base and four at first base...in 2018, he set single-season career highs in games (70), hits (43), runs (30), doubles (9), triples (2), RBI (24) and walks (16).

**SPRING TRAINING IN YOUR LIVING ROOM:** FOX Sports North or FOX Sports PLUS is broadcasting 11 spring games, while the Treasure Island Baseball Network is broadcasting 25 games...WCCO Radio, the metro-area radio home of the Minnesota Twins, is broadcasting 15 games this spring...five of the telecast games will be television-radio simulcasts featuring a combination of FS North cameras, graphics and replays accompanied by play-by-play descriptions and analysis from TIBN radio announcers Cory Provus and Dan Gladden...along with Provus and Gladden, the team of announcers featured throughout Spring Training will include veteran television announcer Dick Bremer and Baseball Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven, TIBN pre and post game host Kris Atteberry and Triple-A Rochester Red Wings broadcaster Josh Whetzel...10 of the Twins Spring Training games from the CenturyLink Sports Complex are appearing on TV.

**CATCHING UP WITH CASTRO:** Jason Castro is in his 10th career spring training and second with the Twins...he was signed to a three-year contract by the Twins as a free agent on November 30, 2016...since 2013 he ranks second in the AL in games caught (534), trailing Salvador Perez (665)...during this past offseason, he changed his uniform number from 21 to 15, the number formerly worn by Glen Perkins – 15 was Castro's uniform number during his time with Houston.

**MAD MAX:** Max Kepler is in his fifth spring training with the Twins...last season he ranked third on the Twins in doubles (32)...he played 138 games (120 starts) in rightfield last season, ranking fifth most in the AL...last spring Max played in 18 games, hitting .151 (8-for-53) with four doubles...he enters 2018 as one of 43 German-born players to ever play Major League Baseball.

**THE ARCHER:** Fernando Rodney enters his 17th career spring training and first with the Twins after signing as a free agent on December 15, 2017 (one year contract with club option for 2019)...the Twins mark his ninth organization: Detroit (1999-2009), Los Angeles-AL (2010-11), Tampa Bay (2012-13), Seattle (2015), Chicago-NL (2015), Miami (2016), San Diego (2016) and Arizona (2017)...he ranks third among active saves leaders with 300, trailing only Francisco Rodriguez (437) and Huston Street (324).

**WELCOME SANCHEZ:** Anibal Sanchez is in his first season with the Twins after signing as a free agent on February 20...the Twins mark his fourth organization: Boston (2004-05), Florida/Miami (2006-11), Detroit 2012-17)...he will enter 2018 with 90 wins – 27 active pitchers have won 100-plus career games.
