THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 1-7 through eight games on their current nine-game roadtrip, going 1-2 against the White Sox, 0-3 against the Cubs, and 0-2 against the Brewers...today they will play the three-game series finale at Miller Park...after this series the Twins will return home for an 11-game homestand leading up to the All-Star Break, with four games against Baltimore, three against Kansas City, and four against Tampa Bay...the Twins are now 15-27 on the road and are 5-16 in their last 21 road games.

FACEBOOK UNKIND: The Twins lost yesterday afternoon by a score of 2-0 at Miller Park on Facebook Live, their third time being shut out this season...Jake Odorizzi (3-6) was the starter and loser, allowing two runs on four hits in 5.0 innings with nine strikeouts...Twins pitchers struck out 16 batters, tied for second most for the club this season, second time fanning at least 16 Brewers in 2018 (17 on May 20 at Target Field).

MAUER DOUBLES UP: Joe Mauer hit his 413th career Monday night, moving within one of tying Kirby Puckett for most in club history (since 1961):

INTERLEAGUE STRUGGLING: The Twins have gone 6-11 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-1 at Pittsburgh, 1-2 vs. Cincinnati, 3-1 vs. St. Louis, 1-4 vs. Milwaukee and 0-3 at Chicago...their 11 losses are already tied for their fourth most since IL Play began in 1997 (8-12 in 2015, 8-12 in 2013, 8-12 in 2016, 7-11 in 2000 & 9-11 in 2014).

☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .359 (37-for-103) with 10 doubles, seven home runs and 16 RBI in his last 25 games vs. NL opponents...he enters today with a 12-game hitting streak in IL Play, the ninth best in club history, Matt Lawton owning the record with 37 from 1999-2001...Joe Mauer has second-longest with 20 straight from 2013-14.

☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .319 (281-for-882) in 240 career games in IL Play, with 60 doubles, 22 home runs, 123 RBI and a .398 on-base percentage.

BAD LUCK WITH THE BORDER BATTLE: The Twins are 229-221 all-time against the Brewers (games since 1970) and have a record against them of 63-52 in Interleague Play...they have won six of their last 10 vs. Milwaukee...yesterday's loss gave the Twins their first season-series loss head-to-head since going 2-4 in 2015.

☞ Brian Dozier is hitting .324 (44-for-136) with six doubles, seven home runs, 19 RBI, 25 runs scored and a .382 on-base percentage in 33 career games vs. Milwaukee.

☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .323 (21-for-65) with six doubles, four home runs and 10 RBI in 18 career games against Milwaukee.

BREW BITS: Twins-Brewers connections...

☞ Twins Manager Paul Molitor played 15 seasons with Milwaukee from 1978-92, hitting .303 (2281-for-7520) with 405 doubles, 86 triples, 160 home runs, 790 RBI, 1275 runs scored and 412 stolen bases...on June 11, 1999, the Brewers retired Molitor's uniform number 4, during a ceremony at Milwaukee County Stadium...he was inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in 2004 and is one of two players to be depicted on their plaque with a Brewers cap, Robin Yount the other...Molitor ranks second to Yount in several all-time Brewer categories, including games (1,856), hits, doubles, triples (86) and runs; he is the all-time leader in steals.

☞ Yesterday's Twins starter Jake Odorizzi was selected by the Brewers in the first round (32nd overall) of the 2008 First-Year Player Draft...he was named Brewers minor league Pitcher of the Year in 2010...he was traded to Kansas City along with Alcides Escobar, Jeremy Jeffress and Lorenzo Cain on December 17, 2010, in exchange for Zack Greinke and Yuniesky Betancourt.

☞ Zach Duke pitched one season with the Brewers in 2014, appearing in 74 games, the second most of his career.

☞ Twins radio stud Cory Provus did play-by-play for the Brewers along with Bob Uecker from 2009-11.

☞ Twins TV stud LaTroy Hawkins pitched for the Brewers for two seasons from 2010-11, going 3-4, 3.92 ERA (64.1 IP, 28 ER) in 70 games.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1974, Bert Blyleven pitched a one-hitter for the Twins against Texas, a Toby Harrah solo home run in the third inning being his only hit allowed...it was one of six career complete game one-hitters for Blyleven and one of three as a Twin...on this day in 1988, Twins radio ace Dan Gladden went 0-for-4 with three strikeouts against the Brewers, his career-high (19 times)...in 1961, in a double header against the White Sox, Julio Becquer hit a ninth inning pinch-hit grand slam, the first-ever walk-off grand slam and pinch-hit grand slam in Twins history...in the second game, Harmon Killebrew hit his only career inside the park homer, off Cal McLish; the Twins first-ever inside-the-park home run...in 1964, Tony Oliva hit the fifth inside the park homer in Twins history, off Jim Bouton; Oliva's first of three career inside the park homers.

LAST START: Berríos suffered his sixth loss of the year on June 29 at Chicago-NL after allowing six runs on six hits and four walks with two strikeouts over 4.1 innings...this start snapped a streak of eight straight starts of 6.0+ innings, the longest of his career...the loss also snapped his three game winning streak...allowed a grand slam to Addison Russell in the fifth inning, the second of his career (last was August 12, 2017 to James McCann)...the four walks is a season high and the two strikeouts ties a season low.

AGAINST THE BREWERS: Berríos is making his first career-start against the Brewers...has faced NL Central opponents three times in his career, all this year, going 1-2 with a 6.75 ERA (14.2 IP, 11 ER) with eight walks and 12 strikeouts...has made nine career starts against the National League, is 4-5 with a 3.62 ERA (49.2 IP, 20 ER) with 19 walks and 49 strikeouts...last Interleague win was against St. Louis on May 15, allowed one run on two hits and one walk with 10 strikeouts over 7.1 innings...second straight start against a National League opponent.

WIZARD OF WHIFF: With his outing on June 7 vs. Chicago-AL, Berríos has now thrown the four most recent 10+ K, 0 run games in Twins history (April 12 vs. Chicago-AL, August 30, 2017 vs. Chicago-AL, May 18, 2017 vs. Colorado)...the last to do it before Berríos was Ervin Santana on August 30, 2015 vs. Houston...now with four games of 10+ strikeouts and 0 walks, he follows Johan Santana (8) and Bert Blyleven (6) for most such performances in Twins history...Berríos is fifth in the American League in strikeout-to-walk ratio at 4.63...four 10+ strikeout starts in 2018 and six in his career.

KEEPING 'EM OFF THE BASES: Through 17 starts in 2018, Berríos has walked 24 batters, which is tied for fourth fewest in the AL and tied for sixth fewest in baseball among starters with 17 starts...his BB/9 rate is 2.01, which is sixth best in the AL and eighth best in baseball...Berríos has also allowed 83 hits and owns a 1.00 WHIP, which is seventh best in the AL and ninth in baseball...he is one of nine qualifying pitchers in the AL with a WHIP of 1.00 or lower...opponents are only hitting .209 off of Berríos this year, 10th best in the AL among pitchers with 17 starts.

STREAKING: Since May 15, Berríos' is 5-2 with a 2.79 ERA (61.1 IP, 19 ER) with 15 walks and 71 strikeouts over his last nine starts...has lasted 6.0+ innings in eight starts of his last nine starts over that stretch...0.96 WHIP in that stretch fifth best in baseball while his 71 strikeouts are tied for fourth most in the AL and tied for sixth most in baseball...his 2.79 ERA is fourth best in the AL and eighth in baseball.

MORE FROM THE LEADERBOARD: Berríos' is leading the Twins starters in innings pitched (107.1), wins (8), strikeouts (111), quality starts (10), and WHIP (1.00), opponent batting average (.209) and has allowed the fewest walks (24) and is second in ERA (3.52)...among AL starters with at least 15 starts, has the eighth lowest opponent OBP (.266), tied for 12th in wins, 10th in strikeouts, and 14th in IP...one of only three pitchers in baseball with two complete games (SEA James Paxton, CLE Carlos Carrasco).

SOUVENIRS FROM THE ISLAND: Berríos made the start in his native Puerto Rico on April 18 vs. Cleveland...he became the just the second different Puerto Rican pitcher to start a major league game at Hiram Bithorn Stadium, the other being Javier Vazquez (4 starts)...two other pitchers appeared in relief: Pedro Feliciano (1 game) and Roberto Hernandez (3 game)...he and teammate Eddie Rosario became the first Twins Puerto Rico natives to play in Hiram Bithorn.

THE ROCKET AND LA MAQUINA: By shutting out Cleveland over 7.0 innings in his start on April 18, Berríos became the first pitcher since Roger Clemens in 1991 to throw 7.0+ shutout innings three times in their careers' first 13 games of a season...Clemens went on to lead the AL in ERA (2.62) and win the Cy Young Award.

2017 RECAP:

- Berríos started 25 games, a single-season career-high.
- In first full season, Berríos finished 14-8 with 139 strikeouts and 48 walks over 145.2 innings.
- Set career highs in wins (14), strikeouts (139), innings (145.2) and ERA (3.89)...he ranked second on Twins staff in wins, and strikeouts, and third in starts and innings pitched.
- Tied for ninth in the AL in wins.
- The youngest pitcher in baseball to record an 11-strikeout game last year against Colorado on May 18.
- Made first career postseason appearance against New York-AL in the Wild Card Game...allowed three runs in three innings and was credited with a loss.
