THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 4-1 through five games on their final homestand with a three-game series win over the Tigers, followed by two wins yesterday over the White Sox... tonight the Twins will play the second of three with Chicago and wrap the season up tomorrow afternoon... a win tonight would tie their longest win-streak this season (5, done twice).

2019: The Twins will open next season at home against Cleveland on March 28 in their 10th season at Target Field...the Twins will play 20 Interleague games...the home Interleague schedule includes series' against Milwaukee (May 27-28), New York (July 16-17), Atlanta (August 5-7), and Washington (September 10-12)...in addition, the Twins will make Interleague roadtrips to Philadelphia (April 5-7), New York (April 9-10), Miami (July 30-August 1) and Milwaukee (August 13-14)...the 2019 schedule features three home games in the month of March, 12 in April, 13 in May, 12 in June, 12 in July, 16 in August and 13 in September... additionally, during the months of April, May (prior to Memorial Day) and September, the Twins have moved weekday (Monday-Thursday) night games to a 6:40 pm start.

TWINS SWEEP THE DAY: The Twins beat the White Sox in both games of yesterday's doubleheader, winning game one by a score of 2-1 and game two by a score of 12-4...the Twins out-hit the Sox on the day 22-9...highlights of the day included: in game one, José Berrios became the eighth different Twin in club history with 200-plus strikeouts (finished with 202), first since Liriano in 2010 (201)...in game two, Mitch Garver went 4-for-6 with a career-high six RBI, two short of the club record...Robbie Grossman also added four hits in the second game. ☞ First doubleheader sweep for the Twins since April 17, 2014 vs. Toronto at Target Field.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the 18th of 19 games this season...the Twins are 10-7 vs. the Sox this season, 5-3 at Target Field and 5-4 at Chicago...the Twins have won 13 of their last 20 over the Sox. ☞ The Twins are 483-432 all-time against CWS, their most wins vs. any opponent (DET next - 444). ☞ Last night's win secured the season-series over Chicago for the second straight year and third time in the last four seasons. ☞ 10 wins marks the fifth time since 2013 to have double-digit win totals over CWS. ☞ Ehire Adrianza is hitting .327 (16-for-49) with five doubles, two home runs and seven RBI in 14 games vs. the Sox this season. ☞ Jorge Polanco has seven home runs and 17 RBI in his last 13 games vs. the Sox...his 29 career RBI and nine career home runs are his most vs. any opponent.

MAUER AND SOX: Joe Mauer is hitting .297 (233-for-785) with 52 doubles, 18 home runs, 104 RBI, 108 walks, 124 runs scored and a .384 on-base percentage in 210 career games against the Sox...below are his ranks among actives vs. CWS:

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1991, the Twins clinched the AL West despite a 2-1 loss against Toronto; second place Chicago helped the Twins with a 2-1 loss to Seattle that day... the Twins went on to beat Toronto in the ALCS in five games then beat Atlanta in seven games to win their second World Championship.

- ☞ Twins have gone 37-35 with Polanco in the lineup and 37-49 without him.
- ☞ Jake Cave enters today with 27 hits this month, second most in the AL among rookies, trailing Joey Wendle (29).
- ☞ Robbie Grossman is hitting .341 (30-for-88) with nine doubles, 19 walks and a .454 on-base percentage in 26 games this month... among AL players, he ranks second in walks, fourth in on-base percentage, and tied for sixth in hits and eighth in batting average.

LAST START: Gibson earned his ninth win of the year at Oakland on September 23...he allowed just one run on seven hits across 7.1 innings, struck out three and walked three...this was his longest start since July 26 at Boston when he went 8.0 innings...has limited opponents to just one-or-fewer runs nine times this season...this marked the third time this season Gibson earned a win in consecutive starts.

900 IP MARK: On September 3, he surpassed the 900 career innings pitched mark, which ranks third most on the Twins and most among players on he active roster...here's how he stacks up against his teammates with the most innings pitched:

AGAINST THE WHITE SOX: Gibson is making his fourth start against the White Sox of the season, going 0-2 with a 5.89 ERA (18.1 IP, 12 ER) with seven walks and 20 strikeouts...in his career against the Southsiders he is 6-4 with a 3.03 ERA (86.0 IP, 29 ER), 19 walks and 77 strikeouts...has not faced Chicago-AL this season at home...last win against the White Sox came on August 22, 2017 when he went 7.0 innings and allowed one run, one walk, eight strikeouts, and seven hits.

SWING AND A MISS: Thus far in 2018, Gibson has recorded 172 strikeouts through 31 starts and owns a strikeout rate of 21.4 percent and a swing-and-miss rate of 26.5 percent, 11th best in the AL...his career strikeout rate is 17.1 percent while his career swing-and-miss rate is 23.1 percent.

THAT'S KYLE WITH A K: Gibson has improved his strikeouts-per-9.0 innings rate nearly every year in his career, setting a career-high in 2017 with 6.89 K/9...through 31 starts in 2018, Gibson is striking out 8.12 batters-per-9.0 innings.

KILLING TWO BIRDS WITH ONE STONE: Gibson induced 26 double plays in 2017, ranking third in the AL...his 1.48 GDP/9 ranked fourth in baseball among pitchers who threw more than 150 innings in 2017...since 2014, Gibson has induced the most GDP in the majors with 117 and is second in GDP/9 with 1.22 (Martin Perez - 1.58...has induced 23 double plays in 2018, most on the team and tied-second most in the AL and owns a 1.04 GDP/9 rate, good for third in the AL...now has induced at least 20 GDPs in each of his last five seasons.

RISP-Y BUSINESS: Gibson has held opponents to a .199 average (30-for-151) with runners in scoring position, third best in the AL and ninth best in baseball...of those 30 hits, seven have gone for extra bases (two home runs, five doubles) and has struck out 36 batters...over his career, his opponents are hitting .259 (212-for-818) with RISP.

NEED SOME RUNS: Gibson has been given 82 runs of support this year but only has a run support average of 3.87, third lowest in the AL...in 13 of his 30 starts, he has been supported with one or fewer runs and has been given more than three runs nine times...has been given two runs or fewer in eight of his last 11 starts.

GIBBY ON TARGET: Gibson has 23 wins at Target Field, which is now the most all-time...he passed Brian Duensing for most in Target Field history after his win on July 7:

- Given 2015 Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA.
- His 2.85 ERA pre-ASG in 2015 was the fourth-lowest for a Twins starter since 1992 with a minimum of 80.0 IP (Liriano - 1.83 in 2006, Santana - 2.75 in 2007, Radke - 2.77 in 1998).
- In 2014, his first full season in the majors, became one of three pitchers in Twins history to win each of their first three games while posting a sub-1.00 ERA.
- Earned the win in his MLB debut 6/29/13 vs. KC allowing three runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings.
- Named the Twins Minor League Player of the Week for May 12, 2013 after tossing a CG SHO.
- Named an Arizona Fall League Rising star in 2012 and the AFL Player of the Week, 10/23/12.
- Selected to the 2011 Futures Game where he tossed 1.1 inning, allowing two hits.
- Named to the 2010 Eastern League Mid-Season All-Star Team.
- Named the Florida State League Pitcher of the Week, May 3, 2010.
- Selected in the first round (22nd overall) by the Twins in the 2009 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Missouri as a senior...major was communications.
- Originally selected by Philadelphia in the 36th round of the 2006 First-Year Player Draft out of Greenfield Central High School in Greenfield, IN.
- Named to the All-Big 12 honorable mention team in 2007 and 2008 and All-Big 12 First-Team in 2009 as the Tigers' Friday night starter.
