NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees split their four-game series with Detroit...scored at least 7R in 5-of-7 games vs. Detroit this season...went 3-4 on their seven-game homestand...are still 11-5 in their last 16G and 18-9 in their last 27G.
- Completed a stretch of 30-of-37 games against teams currently under .500 (7/26-9/2), going 22-15, including 21-9 vs. teams under .500 and 1-6 vs. teams which are .500-or-better...entering today, ranked fourth in the Majors with a 53-25 record vs. teams under .500 (now 53-26)...starting tomorrow at Oakland, will play 16 of their final 25 games against teams above .500...13 of their 16 remaining road games are against teams with winning records.
- Marked their fourth loss since 8/1 when scoring at least 7R (had just two such losses in the first four months of the season).
- CF Aaron Hicks** (1-for-3, 2R, 2BB) hit a solo HR in the first inning...has a career-high 24HR this season (408AB) after hitting just 23HR in his first two seasons as a Yankee (628AB)...drew two more walks, giving him 76BB this season and a Major League-leading 35BB since the All-Star break.
 - Reached base safely multiple times in all 4G in the series, going 5-for-14 with 6R, 2HR, 2RBI and 4BB.
- 3B Miguel Andújar** (3-for-4, 3R, 1 double, 1RBI) tied a career high with 3R (also 7/21/18 vs. the Mets and 5/29/18 vs. Houston)...doubled in the first inning, his 38th of the season...added an RBI single in the eighth and a single in the ninth.
 - His 38 doubles are the fourth-most by a Yankees rookie in a season, trailing only Joe DiMaggio (44 in 1936), Hideki Matsui (42 in 2003) and Bob Meusel (40 in 1920)...are the most by any Yankee since Robinson Canó had 41 in 2013...has 40 doubles through 131 career games, one of 16 players in Major League history to reach the mark within their first 131G.
 - Was his first multi-hit game since 8/26 at Baltimore...has 45 multi-hit games this season...was his ninth game this season with at least 3H.
 - Is batting .441 (15-for-34) with RISP in his last 24G (since 7/28-G2).
- 1B Luke Voit** (2-for-5) hit a solo HR in the fifth, his fifth HR as a Yankee...since making his Yankees debut on 8/2, is batting .333/.404/.627 (17-for-51) with 10R, 5HR, 12RBI and 6BB.
- 2B/SS Gleyber Torres** (1-for-4) hit a two-run single in the ninth...has 2RBI in four consecutive games, tied for the longest multi-RBI streak by a Yankee this season (also Romine and Gregorius) and tied for the seventh-longest such streak in Yankees history.
 - Is 6-for-12 with 13RBI with the bases loaded.
- DH Gary Sánchez** (1-for-4, 1RBI, 1BB) hit an RBI single in the first inning...marked his first hit and RBI since 7/23 at Tampa Bay.
- PH Neil Walker** (1-for-1) delivered a pinch-hit RBI single in the eighth...was the Yankees' third pinch-hit RBI of the season, fewest in the Majors...has two of the team's three pinch-hit RBI, also hitting a "walk-off" solo HR as a pinch-hitter on Tuesday vs. Chicago-AL (the other was a PH sac fly by Gardner on 4/27 at Los Angeles-AL).
- Yankees batters** hit 2HR, giving them a Major League-leading 224HR...is the eighth-highest single-season total in franchise history...are on pace to hit 264HR (the MLB record is 264HR by Seattle in 1997)...had just two base runners from the second through seventh innings.
- RHP Lance Lynn** (3.2IP, 9H, 6ER, 1BB, 6K) started and took the loss...marked his most runs allowed as a Yankee and most since a season-high 7R on 7/1 at Chicago-NL w/ Minnesota...has allowed at least 6H in each of his last four starts after permitting a total of 12H over his first three starts with the Yankees.
- RHP Sonny Gray** allowed just a solo HR in 4.0IP (4H, 1ER, 1BB, 3K, 1HR)...marked the longest of his seven career relief appearances...has a 2.70 ERA (13.1IP, 4ER) in five relief outings this season.
- LHP Stephen Tarpley** (1.0IP, 3H, 3ER, 2BB, 1K) made his Major League debut in the ninth.
- Yankees pitchers** allowed 11R, their most since 8/10 vs. Texas (12-7 loss)...allowed 17H, tied for their second-most this season (19H on 8/2 at Boston, 17H on 6/30 vs. Boston)...allowed 5R in the fourth...have permitted 5R in an inning five times since 8/1 after doing so in just one frame from 6/1-7/31.
- OF Giancarlo Stanton** had his streak of 85 consecutive starts snapped (5/28-9/1)...was just the second Yankees game this season in which he did not play at all (also 5/28 vs. Houston).
- Manager Aaron Boone** served his one-game suspension for making contact with an umpire in Friday's game...**Bench Coach Josh Bard** served as the acting manager.
- Drew 43,721 in attendance today, their largest crowd of the homestand...with an attendance of 3,104,802 through 72 home gates, the Yankees have seen an increase of 7.0% over their mark from their first 72 home gates in 2017...are averaging an AL-best 43,122 per home gate in 2018.

DETROIT TIGERS NOTES

- The Tigers improved to 2-4 on their current three-city, nine-game road trip...improved to 36-34 when scoring first this season...went 3-4 vs. the Yankees this season.
- **LHP Matthew Boyd** (6.0IP, 5H, 3ER, 1BB, 6K, 2HR) started and earned the win...recorded his 13th quality start of the season...has tossed at least 6.0IP in each of his last five starts and seven of his last eight...his 2HR tied his season high (fifth time, last: 8/17 at Minnesota).
 - Since the All-Star break, has gone 5-4 with a 3.29 ERA (54.2IP, 20ER) in nine starts.
 - Is 1-2 with a 7.36 ERA (14.2IP, 12ER) in three career starts vs. the Yankees...today's start marked his first career appearance at Yankee Stadium.
- **Detroit batters** recorded 17H, their most in a game since they recorded a season-high 20 hits on 4/25 at Pittsburgh...the Tigers scored 5R in the fourth inning, tied for their second-most runs in an inning this season (scored 7R in the first on 7/7 vs. Texas).
 - Went 7-for-15 with RISP.
- **CF JaCoby Jones** (2-for-5, 2R, 1 double, 1 triple, 2RBI) hit safely in all four games this series, going 6-for-17 with 3R, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 2RBI and 1SB...has recorded back-to-back multi-hit games for the first time since 5/9-12 (also two games)... recorded his third triple of the season in the first inning...Detroit is now tied with Boston for the third-most triples in the American League (28).
- **RF Victor Reyes** (4-for-5, 2R, 2 doubles, 1HR, 3RBI) recorded a career-high 4H and hit his first Major League home run on a solo shot in the sixth...recorded a career-high three extra-base hits...had entered today's games with 5XBH in 81 career games...his 3RBI also tied his career high (also 3RBI on 5/31 vs. Los Angeles-AL).
 - His RBI double in the second inning snapped an 0-for-14 stretch.
- **1B Niko Goodrum** (1-for-4, 1RBI, 1BB) hit an RBI single in the first...went 7-for-16 with 3R, 2HR, 3RBI, 2BB and 1SB during the four-game series.
- **DH Nicholas Castellanos** (3-for-5, 2R, 1 double, 1HR, 2RBI) hit his 20th home run of the season on a two-run shot in the fourth...marks his second straight season with at least 20HR (26HR in 2017)...logged his team-leading 46th multi-hit game of the season...has hit safely in eight of his last 11 games, batting .356 (16-for-45) with 7R, 3 doubles, 2HR, 5RBI, 3BB and 1HP over that span.
- **2B Dawel Lugo** (3-for-5, 1R, 1RBI) became only the fourth Detroit batter since 1908 to have multiple three-hit performances in his first four Major League games and the first since Tim Corcoran in 1977 (also Fred Haney in 1922 and Hub Walker in 1931)...is hitting .412 (7-for-17) with 2R, 1 double and 1RBI in his first four Major League games.
- **2B Ronny Rodriguez** (3-for-5, 2R, 2RBI) recorded his second career three-hit game (also 3H on 7/5 vs. Texas).
- **RHP Alex Wilson** (1.0IP, 1K) tossed a scoreless seventh inning.
