**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 3-3 through six games on their 10-game trip, going 1-3 vs. Kansas City and 2-0 vs. Detroit...today they will continue the trip with the three-game series finale at Detroit...after today's game, they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow in the Bay Area, then play the A's in Oakland for three games over the weekend.

**TWINS TAKE ANOTHER OVER TIGERS:** The Twins beat the Tigers last night by a score of 5-3 at Comerica Park...Jake Odorizzi (7-10) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on four hits in 6.1 innings pitched...Matt Magill pitched 1.2 scoreless innings, earning his fifth hold and Trevor Hildenberger earned his seventh save...the offense recorded 10 hits, and were led by Tyler Austin, who went 2-for-4 with three RBI.

**TWINS AND TIGERS:** The Twins and Tigers are playing the 16th of 19 scheduled meetings and final game at Comerica Park...the Twins will host the Tigers from September 25-27...Twins have gone 9-6 this season, 5-2 at home and 4-4 at Comerica...a win today would give the Twins their second straight winning season at Comerica (7-3 in 2017).

☞ The Twins have gone 16-7 in their last 23 vs. Detroit.

☞ The Twins have hit 16 homers (3, 3, 4, 3, 2, 1) in their last six vs. the Tigers.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Gonsalves entered the game as a primary pitcher in the third inning against Kansas City on September 13...he did not factor into the decision after allowing one unearned run on four walks and four strikeouts over 3.0 innings...this was his first big league relief appearance and his first professional relief appearance since August 3 as a member of Triple-A Rochester, threw 5.1 innings of relief against Pawtucket...four strikeouts is a major league career high...first scoreless outing in the big leagues...first professional outing without allowing a hit since he threw 5.1 hitless innings against Birmingham as a member of Double-A Chattanooga on April 7.

**PRIMARY PITCHER:** Gonsalves is making his second appearance as a primary pitcher this year and his second in-a-row...his last appearance as a primary pitcher was September 13, did not factor into the decision after allowing one unearned run on four walks and four strikeouts over 3.0 innings...this will be Gonsalves's sixth career relief appearance...today will be the fifth time the Twins will use an opener this year...the Twins are 2-3 in games in which they use an opener.

**AGAINST THE TIGERS:** Gonsalves is making his first career appearance against Detroit...has faced Detroit minor league affiliates three times in his career, overall is 2-1 with a 5.52 ERA (16.1 IP, 10 ER) with eight walks and 19 strikeouts...last outing against a Detroit affiliate was August 9 as a member of Triple-A Rochester against Toledo, earned the win after allowing three runs on three hits and three walks with nine strikeouts over 6.0 innings.

**2018 ON THE FARM:** Gonsalves began the season in Double-A Chattanooga where he went 3-0 across four starts with a 1.77 ERA (20.1 IP, 4 ER), two home runs allowed, 10 walks and 25 strikeouts...was named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the week for the week of April 22-28...promoted to Triple-A Rochester and made his first start for the Red Wings on May 1... had three winning months in Rochester, going 4-1 in May, 2-0 in July and 2-0 in August...in July, he went 2-0 with a 0.88 ERA (30.2 IP, 3 ER) across five starts.

**KEEP 'EM COMIN':** Gonsalves became the 12th different starting pitcher the Twins have used this year (not including the three openers)...he is one of 34 different pitchers to make an appearance this year (including outfielder Ryan LaMarre, infielder Willians Asutdillo, catcher Mitch Garver and catcher Chris Gimenez), tied for third most in the AL with Oakland.

- Spent first career spring training with Twins and reassigned to minor league camp March 13; reported to Double-A Chattanooga.
- Began season on 7-day disabled list with left rotator cuff strain.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Month for June, going 4-1, 2.32 ERA (31.00 IP, 8 ER) in five starts for the Lookouts.
- Ranked third on Chattanooga staff in wins (8), innings pitched (87.1), and strikeouts, despite pitching just three months.
- Promoted to Triple-A Rochester August 7.
- Made five appearances (four starts) for Red Wings in August where he finished the season.
- Named left-handed starting pitcher on the Twins Organizational All-Star team by MiLB.com.
- Ranked fourth best prospect and best changeup in Twins system by Baseball America, entering 2018...ranked 78th best prospect in baseball by MLB.com.

## FRIDAY'S STARTER - JOSE BERRIOS, RHP (SEASON: 11-11, 3.81 ERA ; CAREER: 28-26, 4.48 ERA)

Berrios is making his 31st start of the season, is 11-11, 3.81 ERA (179.2 IP, 76 ER) with 54 walks and 185 strikeouts...last start was September 14 vs. KC, did not factor into the decision after allowing two runs on five hits and three walks with nine strikeouts over 6.0 innings...making second career start and second of the year against Oakland...only career start was August 26, suffered the loss after allowing three runs on eight hits with four strikeouts over 5.0 innings.
