THE TWINS: The Twins began their six-game seven-day homestand with a three-game series loss to the Indians earlier this week, losing the second and third game...tonight the Twins will begin a three-game weekend series vs. the Royals...the Twins have gone 11-4 in their last 15 home games.

TWINS SHUTOUT BY TRIBE: The Twins lost to the Indians on Wednesday afternoon by a score of 2-0, suffering their fifth shutout this season and second in their last four games...Adalberto Mejia was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching 5.0 shutout innings with one hit allowed and three walks, throwing 74 pitches...the offense recorded just five hits, two from Jorge Polanco.

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the 10th of 19 games this season...they have gone 3-6 against KC this season, going 1-5 at Kauffman Stadium and 2-1 at Target Field...they were swept in three games in their last meeting July 20-22 at Kansas City.

- ☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .333 (25-for-75) with 13 RBI in his last 18 games vs. KC.
- ☞ Tonight's starter Jake Odorizzi made his major league debut at Kauffman as a member of the Royals on September 23, 2012...he pitched in just two games for the Royals that September...he was traded to Tampa Bay along with INF Patrick Leonard, LHP Mike Montgomery and OF Wil Myers from Kansas City in exchange for RHP Wade Davis, RHP James Shields and a player to be named (INF Elliot Johnson), December 9, 2012.
- ☞ Miguel Sanó has hit safely in each of his last 17 games against the Royals, hitting .357 (25-for-70) with three doubles, one triple, six home runs, 30 RBI, 15 runs scored and a .423 on-base percentage in that span...the 17-game hit-streak is the longest of his career vs. any opponent.

MAUER AND KC: Joe Mauer is hitting .322 (245-for-762) with 45 doubles, four triples, 14 home runs, 121 RBI and a .404 on-base percentage in 204 career games against the Royals...he ranks sixth all-time in batting average against KC (minimum 500 at-bats), trailing Rod Carew (.345), Ivan Rodriguez (.337), Wade Boggs (.332), Alex Rodriguez (.329), Derek Jeter (.322).

- ☞ In his last 13 games against the Royals, he is hitting .436 (24-for-55) with a .466 on-base percentage and seven multi-hit games...he has 12 hits in 28 at-bats (.429) this season vs. KC.

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS: The Twins have gone 11-4 in their last 15 home games, dating back to June 24...since that date, their 11 wins are third most in the AL, trailing Boston (15-3) and Tampa Bay (15-4)...during this stretch, they have out-scored opponents 83-71.

- ☞ Starting pitchers have posted a 3.95 ERA (84.1 IP, 37 ER) in those 15.

THIS AND THAT:

- ☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .333 (11-for-33) with five walks and a .436 OBP in his last nine games.
- ☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .308 (37-for-120) with eight doubles, two home runs and 20 RBI in his last 29 games.
- ☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .311 (90-for-289) with 16 home runs and 51 RBI vs. RHP this season.
- ☞ Miguel Sanó has reached safely in six of his last 11 plate appearances (4 hits, 2 walks).
- ☞ Eddie Rosario ranks 12th in the AL in batting average (.2969), behind Whit Merrifield (.2972)...his average is now below .300 for the first time since May 28 (.297).

SANTANA, HOF: In a special pregame ceremony tomorrow, the Twins will induct former left-handed pitcher Johan Santana into the Twins Hall of Fame...he will become the 31st member of the Twins HOF...Santana played 12 seasons in the major leagues, including eight with the Twins from 2000-07...he finished his Twins career going 93-44 with six complete games and four shutouts while posting a 3.22 ERA (1308.2 IP, 468 ER), 364 walks and 1,381 strikeouts...he ranks fourth in Twins history in strikeouts (1,381), fourth in ERA (3.22), seventh in wins (93) and innings pitched (1,308.2), and ninth in starts (175).

HARMON KILLEBREW AWARD: Harmon Killebrew Awards for outstanding minor league community service have been announced...Triple-A Rochester's winner is right-handed pitcher Jake Reed, Double-A Chattanooga's is infielder Chris Paul, Single-A Ft. Myers representative is right-handed pitcher Tyler Wells, and Single-A Cedar Rapids is catcher David Banuelos.

ROCHESTER EXTENDED: The Rochester Red Wings and Minnesota Twins have extended their player development contract for another two years through the 2020 season...the Red Wings were the only International League team to be above .500 from 2013-17...since the partnership began in 2003, Rochester has been at least .500 in 11 of 15 seasons entering 2018...Minnesota's 25-man roster for last year's American League Wild Card Game at New York featured 22 former Wings and 13 played for Rochester during the 2017 season.

DID YOU KNOW?: Former Twins reliever Travis Bowyer is celebrating his 37th birthday today...Bowyer appeared in eight career games for the Twins, all in 2005...Bowyer, along with left-handed pitcher Scott Tyler were traded to Florida in 2005, in exchange for infielder Luis Castillo...Castillo was traded to New York-NL in 2007, in exchange for catcher Drew Butera and outfielder Dustin Martin...Drew Butera was traded to Los Angeles-NL in 2013, in exchange for left-handed pitcher Miguel Sulbaran...Sulbaran was traded to New York-AL in 2014, in exchange for infielder Eduardo Nuñez...Nuñez was traded to San Francisco in 2016, in exchange for Wednesday's starter Adalberto Mejia.

LAST START: Odorizzi suffered his seventh loss of the season at Boston on July 28... went 5.0 innings and allowed five runs on nine hits, one home run, one walk and five strikeouts...the nine hits allowed marked a season-high and most since July 5, 2016 vs. Los Angeles-AL (also 9)...his 1-2 record for July was his second consecutive losing month after going 0-3 in June.

AGAINST KANSAS CITY: Will make his second start of the season against the Royals and ninth of his career...his last start on July 22 at Kauffman Stadium, he did not earn the decision after going 6.0 innings and allowing two runs (one earned) on two hits... he did not allow a home run in the start and struck out eight...in his career he is 2-4 with a 4.29 ERA (42.0 IP, 20 ER) against the Royals, with 42 strikeouts and 15 walks.

ON THE FIRST PITCH: Through his 22 starts this season, Odorizzi has allowed a .488 (21-for-43) average on the first pitch against a batter...on the 0-0 count, four of the 21 hits have been home runs and seven have been doubles...his .488 average is the highest of any full season in his career.

- On the contrary, when Odorizzi gets two strikes on a batter he is holding hitters to a .190 (49-for-258) average.

QUALITY NOT QUANTITY: Over his 22 starts this season, Odorizzi has averaged just over 5.1 innings/start...of starters with at least 22 starts, his 112.0 innings ranks as the second fewest in MLB and fewest in the American League...his 19.0 pitches/inning ranks highest in MLB...he averages 4.33 pitches/batter faced which is most in MLB...though his starts have been on the short side, his 57 earned runs allowed ranks tied for seventh fewest in the American League among qualified pitchers who have started at least 22 games.

HOME AND ROAD: Has gone 3-3, 5.11 ERA (49.1 IP, 28 ER) in 10 home starts this season, compared to 1-4, 4.16 ERA (62.2 IP, 29 ER) in 12 road starts...did not factor into his last home start July 13 vs. Tampa Bay...last win at Target Field came July 8 vs. Baltimore, pitching 6.0 shutout innings in a Twins 10-1 victory.

STILL NEED HELP: In Odorizzi's 22 starts in 2018, the Twins offense has supplied 53 total runs, good for a run support average of 4.26 runs per game...his run support average is lowest on the team among starters with at least 18 starts...the 53 runs of support rank fifth fewest in baseball and second fewest in the American League among starters with at least 22 starts

FLY AWAY: In 2017 Odorizzi ranked fourth among all major league pitchers in Fly Ball Percentage (min. 140.0 IP) with a rate of 47.3%...he trailed Ariel Miranda of Seattle (52.2%), Marco Estrada of Toronto (50.3%), and Ian Kennedy of Kansas City (47.7%)... since 2014 Odorizzi has ranked in the top-10 in fly ball percentage every season: 2014 (2nd, 48.7%), 2015 (10th, 40.6%), and 2016 (9th, 44.4%)...in 2018, Odorizzi has allowed 144 fly balls, eighth most in baseball.

A BRIGHT START: Odorizzi pitched in his first career Opening Day start and first career start for the Twins...he went 6.0 innings and allowed just two hits, while not allowing a run and striking out seven...only five other times in his career has he notched seven or more strikeouts while not allowing a run in 6.0-plus innings, the first since April 8, 2015 vs. Baltimore...he became the eighth different pitcher to start Opening Day for the Twins in the last 12 seasons.

2017 RECAP:

- In his fourth full professional season, Odorizzi started 28 games and tossed 143.1 innings...with a 10-8 record, this marked his third season of a .500 or better record
- His 7.97 K/9.0 IP ranked T-2nd best in his career (other, 2015 and best, 2014 with 9.32).
- On September 23, Odorizzi recorded nine strikeouts, a season high, while allowing just one run on three hits in 6.0 innings.
- Odorizzi held right-handed batters to a .228 average and lefties to a .210 average against.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JOSÉ BERRÍOS [SEASON: 10-8, 3.56 ERA // CAREER: 27-23, 4.46 ERA]

Berrios will be making his second start of the season vs. Kansas City...is 1-0 with a 1.29 ERA (7.0 IP, 1 ER) against the Royals this season and is 1-1 with a 5.51 ERA (32.2 IP, 20 ER) against them in six career-starts...is undefeated in the division this season...in eight starts is 6-0 with a 2.25 ERA (56.0 IP, 14 ER) with 59 strikeouts and six walks...has made it through the sixth inning in each AL Central start this season including one complete game against Chicago-AL.

- Selected by Milwaukee in the first round (32nd overall) of 2008 First-Year Player Draft, traded to Kansas City in 2010, then in 2012 traded to Tampa Bay where he remained until his trade to Minnesota on February 17, 2018.
- 2017 marked his fourth straight year of at least 28 starts.
- On May 29, 2016 vs. New York-AL, retired his first 16 batters-faced, tied for third-longest perfect game bid in Rays history.
- Established career-highs in 2016 for starts (33) and innings pitched (187.2).
- In 2016 allowed 2 ER or fewer in 13 of his no-decisions, a mark reached by only one other pitcher since 1913.
