NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees finished their nine-game homestand with a 7-2 record...are 19-3 in their last 22 games...have won seven consecutive series (since 4/19)...at 28-12, are tied with Boston for the Majors' best record and first place in the AL East...have matched the 1994 season for their second-best record through 40 games, over the last 60 seasons since 1959 (went 31-9 to start 1998)...are 16G above .500, tying a season high watermark...are 1-1 in rubber games in 2018...improved to 17-3 outside the AL East.
 - The 2-hour, 45-minute delay at the start of the game was the Yankees' longest pre-game weather delay since 6/29/17 at Chicago-AL (2:50), and their longest at Yankee Stadium since 8/22/13 vs. Toronto (3:32)...was their ninth game affected by weather this season (4 postponed, 3 pre-game delays, 2 in-game delays).
- **RHP Luis Severino** (6.0IP, 5H, 1ER, 2BB, 7K) started and earned his sixth win...entered the day tied for the AL lead with five wins...lowered his 2018 ERA to 2.14 (59.0IP, 14ER).
 - Is undefeated in his last six starts, posting a 4-0 mark with a 1.54 ERA (41.0IP, 25H, 7ER, 7BB, 50K, 2HR)...has recorded six consecutive quality starts, matching the longest QS streak by a Yankee since 2015 (also Severino, 6QS, 8/17-9/15).
 - Is 4-0 with a 1.67 ERA (32.1IP, 20H, 6ER, 6BB, 39K, 1HR) in five starts at home this season...the Yankees have won his last nine regular season starts in the Bronx (since 9/3/17).
- **DH Giancarlo Stanton** (4-for-4, 1R, 1 double, 1HR, 3RBI) matched a season high with 4H (second time, also 4-for-4 on 4/23 vs. Minnesota), his sixth career game with at least 4H...is the seventh Yankee since 1908 to go 4-for-4 or better twice in the team's first 40 games of a season, the first since Alfonso Soriano in 2001...the Yankees are 8-1 when he has multiple RBI...in his last 11G (since 5/2), is hitting .342/.444/.842 (13-for-38) with 8R, 4 doubles, 5HR, 11RBI and 6BB...has raised his season BA to .252, highest since the end of play on 4/12 (.259).
 - Hit his 10th HR of the season, a solo shot in the fifth...has 999 career hits, including 499 extra-base hits (211 doubles, 11 triples, 277HR)...reached double digits in home runs for the ninth consecutive season (2010-18).
 - Along with **Aaron Judge** (11HR), **Gary Sánchez** (10HR) and **Didi Gregorius** (10HR), are the first quartet of teammates in Yankees history to hit at least 10HR in the team's first 40 games of a season...prior to this year, no three Yankees had even done it in the same year...are the first team with four players with at least 10HR through 40 team games since the 2003 Texas Rangers (Juan González-13, Carl Everett-13, Alex Rodriguez-11, Rafael Palmeiro-10).
- **RF Aaron Judge** (2-for-4, 2R, 1 double, 1RBI, 1BB) has 14RBI during his seven-game RBI streak, tying a career best (7G, 9/24-30/17)...is tied with Atlanta's Nick Markakis and Oakland's Jed Lowrie for the longest in the Majors this season...has hit safely in seven straight games...his throwing error in the fifth was only the Yankees' second error in their last 13G since 4/30.
 - Hit .353/.488/.794 (12-for-34) with 8R, 3 doubles, 4HR, 16RBI and 9BB in 9G on the homestand...7 of his 12 hits were XBHs.
- **LF Brett Gardner** (2-for-5, 1R) has scored runs in a season-best five straight games (scored in just one of his previous 8G).
- **CF Aaron Hicks** (1-for-4, 2RBI) had an RBI single in the first and a run-scoring fielder's choice in the seventh...was only his second multi-RBI game in his last 23G since 4/17.
- **3B Miguel Andújar** (2-for-4, 1R, 1SB) has hit safely in six straight games...stole his first base of the season (second career).
- **2B Ronald Torreyes** (1-for-4) doubled in the fourth and has hit safely in 12-of-14 starts this season.
- **Yankees relievers** extended their hitless streak to 8.0 innings before Mark Canha's solo HR in the ninth.
- The Yankees and A's wore pink accented uniforms and equipment in honor of Mother's Day.
- In a pregame ceremony, the Yankees presented a check for \$10,000 to the ALS Therapy Development Institute in memory of Gretchen Piscotty (mother of A's outfielder Stephen Piscotty), who passed away last Sunday night due to ALS...the Yankees encourage fans to donate to the ALSTDI at www.youcaring.org/piscotty.
- In their 25th home gate of 2018, the Yankees crossed the 1 million mark in total home attendance (1,006,777).

OAKLAND ATHLETICS NOTES

- Oakland fell to 1-2 on their 10-game road trip...lost their second consecutive series at Yankee Stadium (1-2 in 2017)...fell to 15-22 at the current Yankee Stadium...are now 8-12 on the road this season.
- **LHP Brett Anderson** (5.0IP, 8H, 4ER, 2BB, 4K, 1HR, 1WP) had his six-start road unbeaten streak snapped (4/24/17-5/2/18)...has allowed 1HR in three straight starts, tied for the longest streak since allowing at least 1HR in four straight starts from 5/15-30/2009...fell to 0-6 with a 6.86 ERA (40.2IP, 31ER) in eight career starts vs. the Yankees...his six career losses vs. the Yankees are his most against any team...is now 0-3 with a 4.50 ERA (28.0IP, 14ER) in five career starts at Yankee Stadium...used 33 pitches in the first inning, the most of any inning since using 34 pitches in the third inning on 8/31/15 (with Los Angeles-NL vs. San Francisco).
- **Oakland batters** hit .188 (6-for-32) with runners in scoring position in the three-game series...went 1-for-5 today, 2-for-11 on Sat., and 3-for-16 on Fri....in total, Oakland left 25 men on base in three games.
- **2B Jed Lowrie** (2-for-4, 1RBI, 2K) drove in a run for the fourth straight game...has recorded at least 1RBI in 23 games this season, most in the Majors...was his team-leading 17th multi-hit game...came into today tied for the second-most multi-hit games in the Majors.
- **RF Mark Canha** (1-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 1RBI) hit his sixth home run of the season and first since 5/2 at Seattle (32AB)...has hit 5-of-6HR on the road this season.
- **SS Marcet Semien** (2-for-5) hit .400 (6-for-15) with 2R, 1 double, 4RBI, 1BB and 1K in the three-game series.
- **RHP Santiago Casilla** (2.0IP, 2H, 1ER, 2BB, 2K) had his four-game scoreless streak snapped (since 5/3/18 – 6.0IP over the streak)...allowed just his second extra-base hit of the season in the seventh to Stanton (double)...tied a career high with 44 pitches (also on 7/20/2009 vs. Minnesota).
