MONDAY BLUES: Last night, the Padres fell 8-2 in Game 1 of the four-game set vs. the Dodgers...the Friars have a 1-14 record in the first game of the series at home this season, and they now own a 3-7 slate against LAD in 2018.

- **Luis Perdomo** worked a season-high 7.0 IP while also tossing a season-high 111 pitches...he collected a hit off Clayton Kershaw, becoming the first Padres pitcher to do so since Tyson Ross on Aug. 21, 2014 in LA.
- **Wil Myers** homered in the ninth for his fifth round-tripper in his last three games, and **Eric Hosmer** logged his team-leading 23rd double of the season.

MOVES: Today, San Diego optioned RHP **Walker Lockett** to El Paso (AAA) and recalled OF **Franmil Reyes** from El Paso.

THINK NAVY BLUE: **Eric Lauer** earned his first career win on May 6 in Monterrey, Mexico vs. LAD (was his third career start and his first vs. LAD)...tossed 6.0-shutout innings behind five strikeouts and one walk in the Padres' 3-0 victory, and he became the first and only SD pitcher to get his first career ML win in a game played outside the US and Canada...he was the second starting pitcher ever to get such a win and the fifth pitcher (starter or reliever) to do so.

PICKOFF PAVILLION: **Eric Lauer** continues to lead the majors in pickoffs (eight)...the Padres also lead all teams in pickoffs (14)...SD has only been picked-off twice this season (as have LAD), tying for fifth-fewest of any team this year.

THE OL' SWITCHEROO: The Padres have used the third-most lineups this season (86)...only the Orioles (87) and Dodgers (89) have used more.

YOU SHALL NOT REACH BASE OFTEN: Opposing teams have accrued just a .304 OBP against Padres relievers this season, which is third-lowest mark vs. any NL relief team...the Padres bullpen has walked just 109 batters, the fewest in the NL behind WSH's 95.

GIVE AN INCH AND HE WIL HIT A MILE: **Wil Myers** has combined for five home runs in the past three games (three Saturday, one Sunday and one Monday), becoming the third Padre to ever hit five-or-more homers in a three-game span, joining Nate Colbert (1972) and Brian Giles (2007)...the Padres record for most homers over a four-game span is held by Colbert (hit seven over four games from July 30-August 1, 1972).

ESTABLISHING THE INSIDE: SD pitchers have hit 41 batters this season (third-most in the NL behind WSH's 42 and STL's 43)...the SD bullpen has hit 19 batters this season, leading the NL and ranking second in the majors (SEA's 23).

DRS: Padres fielders have a total 42 DRS (defensive runs saved), which are the third-most of any club this season behind ARI (66) and MIL (77)...total defensive runs saved indicate how many runs a player saved or hurt his team in the field compared to the average player at his position...**Freddy Galvis'** 12 DRS are tied with ATL's Dansby Swanson for the most of any shortstop this year.

PADRES ON DECK: Last night for Fort Wayne (A), **MacKenzie Gore** allowed two runs on three hits and two walks with three strikeouts in 5.0 innings...for Tri-City (A), RHP **Henry Henry** allowed one run on three hits and a walk with seven strikeouts in 5.0 innings...El Paso's (AAA) **Forrestt Allday** finished the week riding a seven-game hitting streak and was dubbed the Pacific Coast League Player of the Week...he went 18-for-30 for the week with five doubles, a triple, two home runs, four stolen bases, three walks, eight RBI and 12 runs scored.

DATE IN PADRES HISTORY: On July 10, 2007, **Jake Peavy** became the third Padres' pitcher to start an All-Star Game...relinquished one hit in a scoreless inning...Padres **Chris Young** allowed two runs in an inning and was saddled with the loss in the AL's 5-4 win in San Francisco.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#46 LHP ERIC LAUER (4-5, 4.84)

LAUER HOUR: 23-year-old **Eric Lauer** is set to make his 15th career start and second against the Los Angeles Dodgers tonight.

- Earned his first career win the first time he faced LAD in his third career start on 5/6 in Monterrey, Mexico... tossed 6.0-shutout innings behind five strikeouts and one walk in the Padres' 3-0 victory.
- Became the first and only SD pitcher to get his first career ML win in a game played outside the US and Canada...also just the second starter ever to get such a win and the fifth pitcher (starter or reliever) to do so.
- At 22 years and 337 days old on 5/6, he was the fifth-youngest pitcher in the NL to record a win this season.

LAST TIME OUT: Tossed 5.0 IP of one-run ball and earned the win on 7/5 at ARI in SD's 6-3 victory...it was his first time facing the Diamondbacks, the last of the NL West opponents to face.

- His first three career starts came at COL, at SF and vs. LAD...in his five career starts against the NL West, he is now 2-1 with a 3.96 ERA (11 ER, 25.0 IP).

JUNE BLOOM: After posting a 7.67 ERA from April-May (his first seven starts), he tallied a 2.76 mark in June (his next six outings) for a -4.91 ERA differential.

- His -4.91 ERA differential ranked first among all ML pitchers that tossed at least 25.0 IP from March-May and also at least 25.0 IP in June.
- His ERA improved -1.23 points better than the next closest pitcher (TEX's **Mike Minor**, -3.68), followed by TOR's **Marco Estrada** (-3.33), PIT's **Ivan Nova** (-3.21) and MIN's **Lance Lynn** (-3.11).

ONE TEAM, ONE DREAM: The Padres are now 4-10 when Lauer toes the rubber...his 3.63 run support average (runs scored while he's in the game) is the 11th-lowest among all NL starters (min. 14 games started).

- When the southpaw rookie gets two-or-more runs of support from the Padres offense (happened in seven of his 14 starts), he is 4-0 with a 2.65 ERA (11 ER, 37.1 IP) and a 1.47 WHIP with just two home runs allowed... when he gets one run or less of support (seven of his 14 starts), he's 0-5 with a 7.58 ERA (25 ER, 29.2 IP) and a 2.12 WHIP with eight home runs allowed.

GET TO 5.0: Lauer has worked 5.0-or-more innings in seven consecutive starts since 6/2...his 2.63 ERA over the stretch is the ninth-lowest mark among all NL starters.

- When throwing at least 5.0 IP, he owns a 4-2 record, a 2.47 ERA (15 ER, 54.2 IP), .288 opponent average and 1.50 WHIP...when he tosses less than 5.0 innings, he has a 0-3 record, 15.32 ERA (21 ER, 12.1 IP) with a .456 opponent average and a 2.92 WHIP.

ERIC'S ARSENAL: Lauer has relied on four pitches this season: four seamer (60.5%), cutter (25.3%), curve (10.5%) and changeup (3.7%)

PICKOFF ARTISTS: Lauer's eight pickoffs lead the majors, two ahead of SEA **Marco Gonzales'** six.

- Recorded pickoffs in five straight starts from 5/22-6/13, the longest pickoff streak in SD history and tied for the second-longest in ML history with four others...**Andy Pettitte** had the longest streak (eight straight in 1997).
- **Lauer** (eight) and fellow rookie lefty **Joey Lucchesi** (three) have combined for 11 pickoffs this season...it's the most pickoffs by a Padre rookie duo in franchise history.
- The Padres 14 pickoffs lead the majors, ahead of the NYM, CHW, and ATL (each have 12).

CHECK THE SPLITS: Lauer has walked five left-handed batters this season and yielded 24 free passes to right-handed hitters...lefties have also accrued just five RBI off the southpaw, while righties have combined for 33 RBI.

WAVES OF TALENT: Lauer became just the second pitcher of the entire 2016 draft class to make their ML debut, trailing only Lucchesi, who made his big league debut on 3/30 vs. MIL.

- Only Orioles OF **Austin Hays** made it to the show quicker than Lucchesi and Lauer...Hays made his big league debut for the Orioles on September 7, 2017.

THE GOOD ONES MOVE QUICK: The Elyria, Ohio native made just 35 appearances (34 starts) prior to his MLB debut...he has posted a 3.04 ERA (58 ER, 171.2 IP) and a 9-10 record with 188 SO against 51 walks.

- In his three starts for El Paso (AAA) this season he posted a 3.00 ERA (6 ER, 18.0 IP), including a career-high-tying 10 strikeouts on April 15 vs. Las Vegas.

TOMORROW'S STARTER

JOEY'S BACK: LHP **Joey Lucchesi** is set to make his fifth start since returning from the disabled list on 6/20 with a right hip strain that forced him to miss 32 team games.

- In his first start back on 6/20 vs. OAK, lasted a career-low 1.2 IP on three hits and four runs.
- In his ensuing three starts since 6/25 at TEX, he has gone 1-1 with a 1.26 ERA (2 ER, 14.1 IP) with a .106 opponent average.

- Owns a 3.38 ERA in 19 games on the road and a 2.37 ERA in 17 games at Petco Park.
- Posted a streak of 29 consecutive appearances (37.0 IP) without allowing a home run to begin his ML career (3/29-6/17)...no other reliever has thrown more than 35.0 innings without giving up a home run this season.
- Throws a first-pitch strike 67.4 percent of the time, leading the Padres bullpen.
- His 44.1 IP leads in the SD bullpen (among relievers yet to make a start).

- Had not issued a walk in 15 straight appearances from April 23-June 23...his 0.81 BB/9 ratio as a reliever ranks fourth in MLB.
- Made two starts for the Padres in 2018...is the longest tenured pitcher who has appeared for the Padres at the big league level.

- Named to his second-consecutive All-Star roster...in the 2017 All-Star Game, he tossed a perfect 7th inning with one strikeout.
- His 24 saves tie for fourth in the majors and tie for second in the NL with LAD's Kenley Jansen (though the Padres' 34 save opportunities this season are tied for fourth-fewest in the NL).
- Since joining the Padres in 2016, he has allowed just one earned run in nine games and 11.0 IP vs. LAD (0.82 ERA).
- Since trading closer Brandon Maurer on July 24, 2017, his 42 saves in that time rank second in MLB, behind only SEA Edwin Diaz (51).
- 52.4 percent of his pitches this season have been sliders...253 of his sliders have been thrown for strikes, the highest total among major league relievers this season.

- Made his Padres debut on May 31 vs. MIA...acquired on May 27 from the Minnesota Twins along with cash and the 74th overall pick in the 2018 Draft (Competitive Balance Round B) in exchange for catcher Janigson Villalobos.

- Owns a 1.08 ERA in eight games at Petco Park this season and a 1.44 ERA in 31 career outings in Downtown San Diego.
- Missed time while on the 10-Day DL from May 13-June 20 due to a right lateral strain.

- His three earned runs allowed marked a season-high, and they're the most since he allowed three on Aug. 25, 2017 at MIA.
- Entering Saturday's game, his 0.79 ERA (3 ER, 34.0 IP) was the lowest among major league relievers this season...his current 1.53 ERA is now 13th-best among relievers in the majors.
- Returned Friday from the paternity leave list...Yates and his wife, **Ashlee**, welcomed their baby boy, **Kove Kali**, into the world on July 3.
