HERE'S THE STORY

- ♦ The D-backs are 8-6 vs. Rockies this season (5-3 @ Coors Field).
- ♦ Arizona is 13-6 in its last 19 games at Coors Field, including 9 straight wins from June 21, 2017-July 10, 2018.
- ♦ 17 of the D-backs' last 22 games have been decided by 3 runs or fewer: 1 run - 10 times; 2 runs - 4 times; 3 runs - 3 times.
- ♦ The D-backs' 3.62 ERA ranks third in the Majors behind the Astros (3.10) and Dodgers (3.47).
- ♦ **Patrick Corbin**, who will reach the 30-start mark for the third time, is 3-1 with a 1.88 ERA (8 ER in 38.1 IP), .188 opponent average and 49 strikeouts in his last 6 starts since Aug. 8.
- ♦ **Paul Goldschmidt** has reached base safely in a club-record 47 straight road games since May 27, hitting .394 (71-for-180) with 15 doubles, 1 triple, 15 homers, 38 RBI and 29 walks.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

- ♦ The D-backs won @ Rockies, 6-3.
- ♦ **Zack Greinke** (14-9) earned the win, allowing 3 runs in 6.2 innings... **Yoshihisa Hirano** earned his first career save.
- ♦ **Ketel Marte** went 2-for-4 with a triple and tied a career high with 4 RBI (also: July 20, 2018 @ Rockies)... **David Peralta** hit a 2-run home run (27).

ROCKY MOUNTAIN HIGH? THAT JOHN DENVER WAS FULL OF IT

- ♦ In 111 all-time, regular-season meetings between the D-backs and Rockies in September or later, Arizona is 64-47 (.577), including 16-5 (.762) in 21 meetings since 2015.

DOWN THE STRETCH WE GO

- ♦ The D-backs have 17 games remaining (9 home/8 away) and their opponents' combined .541 winning pct. is higher than the Rockies (.514) and Dodgers (.489) [source: ESPN.com].
 - 11 games vs. NL West foes: 5 vs. Rockies (2 on road/3 @ home), 3 vs. Padres (on road), 3 vs. Dodgers (@ home).
 - 7 games vs. first place teams from other divisions: 3 vs. Astros (on road), 3 vs. Cubs (@ home).
- ♦ Entering last Thursday's game, the D-backs next 17 games were against teams currently in first place: ATL, COL, HOU, CHC and COL...per Elias Sports Bureau, if each team leads their respective divisions at the time of those games, the 17-game streak vs. first-place teams would be a Major League record...the current record is 14 by the 1993 Orioles and 1996 Tigers.

LIFE ON THE ROAD

- ♦ The D-backs' .548 road winning pct. (40-33) is fifth in the NL behind the Braves (.595, 44-30), Cardinals (.560, 42-33), Dodgers (.557, 39-31) and Rockies (.556, 40-32).
- ♦ Among NL teams on the road, D-backs pitchers have allowed the second-fewest runs (273), the second-lowest ERA (3.64), rank third in strikeouts (638) and fifth in opp. average (.237).

PITCHING IN

- ♦ The D-backs' 3.62 ERA ranks third in the Majors behind the Astros (3.10) and Dodgers (3.47)...their .236 opp. average is tied with the Brewers for sixth in the Majors behind the Astros (.218), Rays (.230), Braves (.231), Dodgers (.234) and Yankees (.235).
