NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees improved to 2-2 on their final regular season homestand...are 2-4 in their last 6G and 8-10 in their last 18G, but are 17-12 in their last 29G and 24-16 in 40G since 8/6...are 34G over .500, 2G below their season-high watermark.
 - Are 6-8 vs. the Red Sox this season but 5-2 at Yankee Stadium...snapped their four-game losing streak vs. Boston.
 - Marked their 37th come-from-behind win this season.
- **RHP J.A. Happ** (6.0IP, 4H, 1R/0ER, 3BB, 6K, 1BK) started and did not record a decision...is undefeated in his last 10 starts, going 6-0 with a 2.34 ERA (57.2IP, 15ER) over that span.
 - Has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in each of his last 11 starts vs. Boston (since 5/15/15), going 4-1 with a 1.62 ERA (66.2IP, 12ER) in that span...is one of only three pitchers since earned runs became an official statistic in the AL in 1913 to allow 2ER-or-fewer in 11 consecutive starts vs. the Red Sox (also Bob Shawkey-14GS from 6/29/1921-4/15/1924; Gaylord Perry-11GS from 9/9/72-9/11/74).
 - Since the start of 2017, is 9-7 with a 2.25 ERA (124.0IP, 31ER) in 22 starts vs. AL East clubs
 - Is 7-4 with a 2.82 ERA (111.2IP, 35ER) in 20 career games (19 starts) vs. the Red Sox...marks his lowest ERA vs. an AL opponent (min. 5GS).
 - In three starts vs. Boston in 2018, is 0-1 with a 0.54 ERA (16.2IP, 1ER).
 - Is 6-0 with a 2.39 ERA (52.2IP, 14ER) in nine starts with the Yankees.
 - Has allowed only 1ER over his last three starts (18.0IP), posting a 0.50 ERA.
- **1B Neil Walker** (1-for-2, 1HR, 3RBI, 1BB) drove in all three runs with a go-ahead HR in the seventh inning...each of his last four home runs have given the Yankees the lead and his last three home runs have come in the seventh inning or later.
- **CF Aaron Hicks** (1-for-3, 1R, 1BB, 1SB) has reached base multiple time in three of his last four games...has 11SB this season, two shy of his career high (13SB in 2015 w/ Minnesota).
- **2B Gleyber Torres** (1-for-3, 1 double) has hit safely in each of his last 15 home games (since 8/16), batting .434/.500/.660 (23-for-53) with 9R, 3 doubles, 3HR, 12RBI, 6BB, 1HP and 1SB in those games...is the longest home hitting streak by a Yankee this season.
- **Yankees batters** have a Major League-leading 242HR, tied for the third-highest single-season total in franchise history (also hit 242HR in 2004)...are on pace to hit 261HR (the MLB record is 264HR by Seattle in 1997).
 - Have 11 players with double-digit home runs, tying the Major League record (also 2017 Houston Astros, 2016 Minnesota Twins, 2015 Houston Astros and the 2004 Detroit Tigers).
 - Have 8HR over their last 4G...hit a total of 2HR in their previous 4G.
 - Have homered in 21-of-24G since 8/24 (40HR total)...have hit 28HR in their last 14 home games (since 8/17).
- **RHP Chad Green** tossed a perfect seventh inning to earn his eighth win of the season.
- **RHP David Robertson** tossed a scoreless eighth inning (1.0IP, 1H)...has posted a 0.95 ERA (19.0IP, 2ER) over his last 17 appearances (since 8/3).
- **RHP Zach Britton** earned his sixth save of the season, second with the Yankees (1.0IP, 1R/0ER, 1BB, 1K).
- **Yankees starting pitchers** have allowed 2ER-or-fewer in nine of their last 10 starts, going 4-3 with a 2.21 ERA (53.0IP, 45H, 15R/13ER, 10BB, 49K, 4HR) over the span.

BOSTON RED SOX NOTES

- The Red Sox began their six-game, two-city road trip with a loss...snapped their three-game *road* win streak...their magic number to clinch the division remains at two...fell to 81-6 this season when leading after six innings and 69-14 when scoring first...fell to 25-12 in one-run games...are 23-28 this season when hitting OHR.
- Dropped to 8-6 vs. the Yankees this season...snapped a four-game winning streak vs. the Yankees...are 2-5 at Yankee Stadium this season...are 6-15 in their last 21 games at Yankee Stadium (since 7/17/16)...have been held to 2R-or-fewer in six of their last nine games at Yankee Stadium.
- Are now 49-27 on the road this season...are the second-most single-season road wins all-time by a Red Sox team (51-30 in 2002).
- **RHP Nathan Eovaldi** (6.0IP, 2H, 0R, 2BB, 5K, 1HP) allowed just two baserunners to reach scoring position...was his longest start since throwing 8.0IP on 8/4 vs. the Yankees...has 8BB in his last 3G/2GS.
 - In two starts vs. the Yankees this season with the Red Sox, has not allowed a run in 14.0IP (5H, 3BB, 9K, 1HP)...opponents are hitting .114 (5-for-44) off him over the stretch.
- **RF J.D. Martinez** (1-for-3, 1 triple, 1RBI, 1SF) drove in the first run of the game with his third-inning sacrifice fly...now has 123RBI this season and 16RBI in 14G vs. the Yankees this season...logged his second triple of the season in the eighth (also 4/5 vs. Tampa Bay).
- **DH Eduardo Núñez** (1-for-4, 1K) extended his hit streak to five games, hitting .375 (6-for-16) over the span.
- **1B Steve Pearce** (0-for-1, 2BB) tied a season high with 2BB (second time, also on 7/8 at Kansas City).
- **RHP Ryan Brasier** (0.2IP, 1H, 1ER, 1HR) gave up the go-ahead home run in the seventh, snapping a streak of four straight scoreless appearances (3.2IP)...was the first home run he has allowed since 8/29 vs. Miami.
- **Red Sox relievers** have a 6.53 ERA (41.1IP, 30ER) vs. the Yankees this season, compared to a 3.30 ERA (488.0IP, 179ER) vs. all other opponents.
