MARINERS NOTES:

- The Mariners have won 4 of their last 5 games...are 3-1 at Safeco Field this season.
- The Mariners are now 10-26 when playing on Friday, the 13th during the regular season...are 1-1 in games on Friday, the 13th during the postseason.
- **Mitch Haniger's** 3-run home run in the 7th inning marked the Mariners 3rd go-ahead home run in the 7th inning and later this season (also: Dee Gordon, 4/1 vs. CLE, 7th inning and Kyle Seager, 4/11 at KC, 8th inning).
- **Mitch Haniger** (12 RBI) and **Kyle Seager** (10 RBI) each have at least 10 RBI...marks the 8th time in club history that a duo of Mariners have reached the 10-RBI plateau in the club's first 11 games of a season (last: 2007: Richie Sexton, 11 RBI, and Adrian Beltre, 10 RBI).
- **Kyle Seager** (3x4, R, 2B, RBI) recorded his 216th career double in the bottom of the 1st inning, tying Raúl Ibañez for 5th-most doubles in club history...the RBI-double also marked Seager's 535th career RBI, tying Bret Boone for 8th-most RBI as a Mariner.
 - Recorded his first 3-hit game of the season...has recorded multi-hit games in 3 of his last 5 games.
- **Daniel Vogelbach** (1x4, R, HR, 2 RBI) hit his first career home run, a 2-run homer, in the bottom of the 7th inning.
- **Mitch Haniger** (2x4, R, HR, 4 RBI) hit his 3rd home run of the season, a go-ahead, 3-run home run, in the bottom of the 7th inning...matched his career-high with 4 RBI (4x, last: 8/19/17 at TB).
 - Leads the Mariners with 12 RBI.
- **Dee Gordon** (1x5, 2B) doubled in the bottom of the 2nd and has now hit safely in each of his 11 games this season...dating back to Sept. 26, 2017, Gordon has hit safely in 17 consecutive games, batting .342 (25x73) with 14 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run, 3 RBI, 2 walks and 9 stolen bases during that span.
 - His 11-game hitting streak is 3rd-longest in club history to start a season, trailing only Joey Cora (16, 3/31-4/17/98) and Bruce Bochte (14, 4/6-21/79).
- **Robinson Canó** (1x1, 2 R, 3 BB) has reached base safely in each of his 11 games this season, including 10 games with at least 1 hit...matches his longest streak of reaching base safely via a hit, walk or HBP to start a season (also: 2017).
 - Drew at least 3 walks for the 9th time in his career (last: 5/5/17 vs. TEX)...career-high is 4 walks (6/22/13 vs. TB w/NYY).
- **Edwin Díaz** recorded his 5th save of the season...entered the day ranked T2nd in the AL (also: Craig Kimbrel).
- **Mike Leake** has recorded 8 consecutive starts of at least 5.0 innings pitched and 3 or fewer runs allowed (9/1/17-c), tied with Charlie Morton (8/27/17-c) for the 2nd-longest active streak.

ATHLETICS NOTES:

- Oakland is now 19-25 in games played on Friday, the 13th...are 4-1 against the Mariners on Friday, the 13th.
- **Matt Chapman** (2x4, R, HR, RBI) hit his 5th home run of the season in the top of the 6th...entered the day tied for 3rd in the American League in home runs (also: Brian Dozier).
 - Talled his 8th multi-hit game of the season...entered the day tied for tops in the AL (also: Andrelton Simmons and Albert Pujols).
- **Marcus Semien** (0x4, BB) had his 9-game hitting streak snapped...during the streak, he hit .256 (10x39) with 6 runs, 3 doubles, 1 home run and 8 RBI in 9 games...the 9-game hitting streak matched his career-high (also: 6/23-7/1/16 and 8/4-14/15).
- **Khris Davis** (2x4, 2 R, 2 HR, 3 RBI) recorded his 16th career multi-homer game (last: 8/25/17 vs. TEX)...marked his 15th and 16th career home runs against the Mariners since 2016, most of any player during that span.
 - is 7-for-his-last-14 with 4 runs, 1 double, 3 home runs and 5 RBI.
- **Andrew Triggs** has worked at least 5.0 innings while allowing 2 or fewer runs in each of his 3 starts this season.

OAKLAND MANAGER BOB MELVIN:

On Chris Hatcher:

"Velocity was good. Movement was pretty good. He just threw a cutter that backed up to the middle of the plate, actually middle-in. He was trying to go corner, to off the plate away."

On the frustration of giving up the lead with two outs in the 7th:

"Yeah, no doubt. We felt pretty good where we were, once we scored the 3rd run. Felt good with the guys we were bringing in the game to try to close it out."

On what he saw in Coulombe's match-up with Canó:

"He's not trying to give him anything to pull. He didn't want to give in, certainly 3-2, with him. That's their hottest guy at this point. [It was a] cutter off the plate for ball four."
