**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Giants and Rockies play game two of this three game set tonight...San Francisco is 3-1 over their first four games of this six-game road trip against Arizona (3-0) and Colorado (0-1)...with a win tonight the Giants could secure their first winning road trip since posting a 4-2 record from June 30-July 6, 2017 at Pittsburgh (3-0) and Detroit (1-2).

**WINNING WAYS:** Despite last night's loss, San Francisco has still won seven of their last nine and 10 of their past 13 contests.

**INSIDE THE SERIES:** The Giants have struggled at Coors Field having dropped 13 of their last 15 games here, dating back to Sept. 7, 2016...during that stretch the Giants have posted a 6.77 ERA (94er, 125.0ip) and have been outscored by the Rockies 106-74.

**ON THE MOUND: RHP Chris Stratton** is 1-0 with a 7.62 ERA (11er, 13.0ip) in three career starts against the Rockies...has pitched twice here at Coors Field, allowing three runs on eight hits in 7.0 innings (3.86 ERA).

**GIANTS PITCHING:** Since June 1, San Francisco pitchers have posted a 2.86 ERA (87er, 273.2ip), which ranks as the second lowest ERA in the Majors during that stretch behind only the New York Yankees (2.59 ERA).

**AT COORS FIELD: C Buster Posey** enters tonight's game with a 17-game hitting streak here at Coors Field, batting .371 (26-for-70) with 12 extra-base hits and 15 RBI during the streak...Posey owns the third-highest batting average here among active players (min. 120 PA), hitting .383 (93-for-243) with 13 home runs and 49 RBI in 65 games...**IF Joe Panik** has also enjoyed success here at Coors, hitting .431 (44-for-102) with 10 doubles, three home runs and 15 RBI in 27 career games.

**AGAINST RIGHT-HANDERS:** The Giants have won 15 of their last 18 games when facing a right-handed starter, compared to a 4-10 record in their last 14 games when they face a lefty...overall this season, SF is 27-24 against right-handed starters and 18-17 against left-handed starters.

**ROAD WOES:** Despite posting a 8-7 record in their last 15 road games, the Giants .413 (19-27) road winning percentage still ranks as the second-lowest figure in the National League behind Miami (17-26, .395).

**INTERNATIONAL SIGNINGS:** Yesterday, the Giants announced the signings of 11 International prospects, including 16-year-old **SS Marco Luciano**, who was ranked as the number two International prospect in this year's class by *Baseball America* and *MLB.com*...SF also signed **CF Jairo Pomares**, *Baseball America's* #11 International prospect and **RF Luis Matos**, who's recognized by *MLB.com* as their #27 International prospect and as the #37 International prospect by *Baseball America*.

**ON THE MEND: RHP Jeff Samardzija**, who has missed the Giants last 31 games with right shoulder tightness, made his fourth rehab appearance with Sacramento last night...he threw 6.0 innings, allowing two runs (both solo home runs) on five hits with one walk and three strikeouts.

**ON DECK:** Following this series in Colorado, the Giants will travel home for a 11-day, 10-game homestand leading up to the All-Star break that will feature St. Louis (July 5-8), Chicago-NL (July 9-11) and Oakland (July 13-15).

### This Date in Giants History: July 3, 1912

**Rube Marquard** won his nineteenth straight game of the season without a loss, defeating Brooklyn 2-1 in the first game of a doubleheader...his victory tied the major league record set by Giant pitcher **Tim Lincecum** in 1888.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#34 RHP Chris Stratton**  
**6-2, 211, 27 years old (August 22, 1990)**  
**8-5 Record, 4.45 ERA**

- The 27-year-old right-hander is making his 18th start of the season...the Giants are 11-6 in his outings this year, going 6-3 at home and 5-3 on the road.
- Is facing the Rockies for the second time in less than a week as he faced them last Thursday at AT&T Park in the Giants' 9-8 loss...lasted just 4.0 innings while allowing five runs on eight hits...threw just 64 pitches.
- Has actually pitched better away from AT&T Park this year, posting a 4-3 record with a 3.38 ERA in eight starts...has a 3.00 ERA (6er, 18.0ip) in his past three road outings...has an opponents average against of .195 on the road compared to .333 at home.
- Has faced the Rockies four times in his career, once in relief and three times as a starter...is 1-0 with a 7.62 ERA (11er, 13.0ip) in three starts...has pitched twice here at Coors Field, allowing three runs on eight hits in 7.0 innings (3.86 ERA).
- Eight of his 17 outings this season have been quality starts...the Giants are 6-2 this year when he has a quality outing.
- Opponents are hitting .371 (13-for-35) off his slider and .310 (18-for-58) off his curveball this year...last year, opponents hit just .116 off his curveball.
- The opposition is hitting .357 (10-for-28) this year with five extra base hits on his first pitch.
- Drafted by the Giants in the first round (20th overall) in the 2012 draft out of Mississippi State University... since making his MLB debut in 2016, the Giants have gone 17-10 (.629) in his starting assignments.

**2018: 3-4, 4.18 ERA / Career: 3-4, 4.18 ERA**

**NOTES:** The 25-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 14th career Major League start...has gone 3-4 with a 4.18 ERA (33er, 71.0ip) in 13 outings, with the Giants going 5-8 in those games...earned the win in the Giants' 2-1 victory at Arizona on June 29...allowed one run on seven hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 6.0 innings...surpassed the 100-pitch mark for the first time in his career...has pitched better as of late, posting a 2.35 ERA (6er, 23.0ip) over his last four starts...faced the Rockies at Coors Field on May 28...received a no decision after allowing four runs (three earned) on five hits over 5.0 innings in the Giants' 5-6 loss.
