THE GIANTS: Begin a six-game homestand against the NL East-leading Atlanta Braves (79-64) and NL West-leading Colorado Rockies (78-64)...the Giants are 39-30 (.565) at home this year, the fourth-best home winning pct. in the NL.

INSIDE THE SERIES: The Giants swept the Braves in a three-game series in early-May, outscoring them 24-9 while recording 41 hits in those three games...their .357 team batting average against the Braves in that series is the second-highest by any team against a single opponent in MLB this season (*Stats, LLC*).

TOUGH TRIP: The Giants went 0-6 on their last road trip to Colorado (0-3) and Milwaukee (0-3)...it marked the first winless road trip for the Giants of six-or-more games since going 0-6 from June 30-July 5, 2015 at Miami (0-3) and Washington (0-3).

SNAP THIS STREAK: Entering tonight's game, the Giants have lost each of their last eight contests, their longest losing streak of the season and their longest losing skid since an eight-game streak from April 10-17, 2015...the Giants haven't lost more than nine in a row since July 23-Aug. 1, 2006 (nine games).

TONIGHT'S STARTER: RHP Dereck Rodriguez will face the Braves for the first time in his career...the 26-year-old rookie ranks fifth in the NL in ERA (2.41) among all pitchers with 15 or more starts...since the All-Star break, Rodriguez has allowed just 30 hits in 50.1 innings...according to *Stats, LLC*, no other pitcher who has thrown at least 50.0 innings has allowed fewer hits.

LAST 10: San Francisco has lost nine of their last 10 games, being outscored by a 43-31 margin...SF's only win in this span was a 7-0 victory against the New York Mets on Aug. 31...SF is hitting .202 with a .248 OBP and .353 SLG mark in the last 10 contests while the pitching staff has posted a 4.40 ERA.

BELT & THE BRAVES: IF Brandon Belt's .977 career OPS against the Braves is one of the highest by any active player in MLB...Belt is a career .284 hitter with nine doubles, two triples, 10 homers and 21 RBI in 44 games against Atlanta.

SCORE AT LEAST FOUR: San Francisco is 19-59 (.244) when scoring three runs or fewer compared to 49-17 (.742) when plating four-or-more runs.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN: The Giants have been successful in 22 of their last 25 stolen bases attempts.

RISP MANAGEMENT: SF is just 6-for-45 (.133) in hitting with runners in scoring position in their past eight contests.

At New York, the Giants trail, 3 - 0, after 7.0 innings when manager Alvin Dark sent up three consecutive Alous to bat in the 8th...pinch hitter **Jesus Alou** grounded out, pinch hitter **Matty Alou** struck out, and leadoff hitter **Felipe Alou** bounced back to pitcher Carlton Willey...**Willie McCovey's** 38th homer and **Orlando Cepeda's** 29th accounted for San Francisco's scoring in a 4-2 loss.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#57 RHP Dereck Rodriguez
6-1, 215, 26 years old (June 5, 1992)
6-2 Record, 2.41 ERA

- 26-year-old right-hander is slated to make his 16th Major League start (18th appearance)...the Giants are 9-6 overall when he takes the hill as a starter, going 5-4 at home and 4-2 on the road.
- Among NL rookie pitchers he ranks first in ERA (2.41), fourth in opponents batting average against (.211), tied for fourth in wins (6), seventh in innings pitched (97.0ip), and 10th in strikeouts (78).
- His 2.41 ERA is the fifth-lowest among all NL pitchers with at least 90.0 innings pitched.
- Has 12 quality starts in 15 outings this year...the only big league pitchers who have a higher quality start percentage are deGrom and Scherzer.
- Missed 10 games from Aug. 16-23 with a right hamstring strain, an injury he suffered Aug. 14 at Los Angeles-NL during an on field incident involving teammate **Nick Hundley** and Yasiel Puig that cleared the benches.
- Last pitched Tuesday at Colorado and did not factor into the decision in a 6-2 loss...allowed just one run (a solo HR to David Dahl) on six hits in 6.0 innings...left with the game tied at 1-1 before the bullpen got charged with four runs...marked his 12th start this year of 6.0+ innings pitched and two or fewer runs allowed.
- His nine-game streak of pitching 6.0+ innings while allowing two runs or fewer came to an end in his start Aug. 29 vs. Arizona (5.0ip, 3r)...the only other MLB rookies to do this in nine straight starts since 1958: Joe Blanton (2005) and Mike Fiers (2012) (*Elias*).
- He's the first Giants pitcher since 1900 to pitch 6+ innings and allow two or fewer runs in at least 12 of his first 15 career starts (*Elias*).
- Opponents are just 14-for-69 (.203) off him with RISP, including a .103 clip (4-for-39) in his last 11 games.
- With runners on base is holding the opposition to a .186 average against (24-for-129).
- His .201 average against right-handed batters is tied for the ninth-lowest among NL pitchers.
- Has never faced the Braves.
- Signed a minor league contract with the Giants on November 15, 2017...was invited to Major League camp as a non-roster invitee.
- Is the son of former Major League catcher and Hall of Famer, Ivan Rodriguez.
- Was drafted in the sixth round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft by the Minnesota Twins...spent his first three professional seasons as an outfielder before converting into a pitcher in 2014.
- Did not pitch above double-A last season while in the Twins organization.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: LHP ANDREW SUÁREZ

2018: 6-10, 4.33 ERA / Career: 6-10, 4.33 ERA
NOTES: The 26-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 26th career Major League start...has gone 6-10 with a 4.33 ERA (67er, 139.1ip) in 25 outings, with the Giants going 11-14 in those games...his 118 strikeouts are tied for the 11th-most by a rookie pitcher in franchise history and rank as the seventh-most in the San Francisco era...allowed a career-high three home runs (all to Trevor Story) in Wednesday's 5-3 loss at Colorado...was tagged with the loss after allowing five runs on six hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 6.0 innings...has a 3.07 ERA (25er, 73.1ip) in 12 starts at home compared to a 5.73 ERA (42er, 66.0ip) in 13 starts on the road...lefties are hitting .212 (29-for-137) off him with just seven extra-base hits (four doubles, two triples, one home run)...faced the Braves in Atlanta earlier this season and allowed one run (none earned) on seven hits over 5.1 innings...was the winning pitcher in the Giants' 4-3 victory.
