ROAD TRIPPIN' REDBIRDS: The Cardinals continue their nine-game/10-day road trip through Pittsburgh, Miami, and Kansas City with today's finale of a three-game series in the Steel City. This nine-game stretch ties the Cardinals' longest road trip of the season (July 2-11: ARI, SF, CWS). St. Louis is 9-8 post All-Star Break and 10-8 under interim manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in T3rd place in the NL Central, 7.5 games out of first place and 4.5 games out of the second Wild Card position.

SECRET SALSA: Reigning NL Player of the Month **Matt Carpenter** co-leads the National League with 28 home runs (Colorado's **Nolan Arenado**). His 28 blasts tie his career high (2015), and he's three shy of becoming the 15th Cardinals left-handed hitter to whack 30 in a single season and the first since **Jim Edmonds** hit 42 in 2004. Carpenter also leads Major League Baseball with 18 home runs on the road (**Khris Davis**, 17) in addition to 24 solo blasts (**Mike Trout**, 22).

BOMBS AND DOUBLES: Yesterday marked the Major League-leading 9th time and 2nd game in a row that **Matt Carpenter** has homered and doubled in the same game this season...**Albert Pujols** holds the single-season franchise record with 12 from 2006. Carpenter has achieved the feat 27 times in his career, T11th in franchise history with **Scott Rolen**...**Stan Musial** holds the record with 77 (**Orf**).

ALL THE TOOLS: With his first-inning double yesterday, Carpenter extended his on-base streak to 23 games and tied **Willie McGee** for 20th all-time in Cardinals history with 255 career doubles. His active on-base streak of 23 games (July 8-present) is the longest active in the Majors, slashing .388/.510/.925 with 31 hits, seven doubles, 12 home runs, 20 walks and 21 RBI.

FAMILAIR FACES: **Jack Flaherty** and **Trevor Williams** face off today for the 4th time this season (St. Louis is 2-1). The last Cardinal to make at least 4 starts in a season against the same opposing starter was **Jason Marquis**, who faced Houston's **Roy Oswalt** four times in 2006. The record for most head-to-head starts in a season by a Cards pitcher vs. the same opponent is 6 by **Slim Sallee** vs. Cubs' **Hippo Vaughn** in 1915 (**Elias**).

RISP-Y BUSINESS: Over the first two games of this series, St. Louis has taken 42 at-bats with runners in scoring-position and stranded a combined 28 batters left on base. The last time the Cards had at least 28 runners left on base in back-to-back nine-inning games was July 13-14, 2013 at Chicago (28 LOB). In the opener of that three-game series, the Cardinals stranded 7 for a total of 35 runners left on base as St. Louis took two of three at Wrigley Field (**Elias**).

TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS: The Cardinals are 32-25 against the NL Central this season (18-17 on the road), with only Atlanta (33-17 vs. NL East) sporting more divisional wins in the NL. St. Louis has 51 games remaining on their schedule with 19 against NL Central opponents (CIN 3; PIT 8; CHI 3; MIL 6). Today is the club's final divisional road game until a season-ending three-game series at Wrigley Field (September 28-30).

BABY BIRDS: St. Louis' active roster has an average age of 27.0 years old, T2nd-youngest (Philadelphia) in the Majors and trailing Tampa Bay (26.0)...its starting rotation is an average of 24.8 years old. Ten current players are ages 25 or younger, while 10 players qualify as rookies: **Harrison Bader**, **Yairo Munoz**, **Jordan Hicks**, **Mike Mayers**, **Tyler O'Neill**, **Jack Flaherty**, **Austin Gomber**, **Dakota Hudson**, **Daniel Poncedeleon**, **Tyler Webb**.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (August 5, 1999): Cardinals first baseman **Mark McGwire** hits his 500th and 501st lifetime homers, and **Tony Gwynn** collects his 2,999th career hit as the Padres roll past the Cardinals, 10-3, at Busch Stadium. Both McGwire jacks came off of **Andy Ashby**.

PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

Pitcher **Carlos Martínez** was teammates with Pirates pitcher **Ivan Nova** and outfielders **Starling Marte** and **Gregory Polanco** for the Dominican Republic in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

Infielder **Paul DeJong** was originally selected by the Pirates in the 38th round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Pitching coach **Mike Maddux** signed with the Pirates in April 1995 and pitched in eight games before being released in May.

Pitcher **Miles Mikolas** spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with infielder **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh in exchange for outfielder **Alex Dickerson** (November 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers in exchange for infielder **Chris McGuinness** (December 30, 2013).

Infielder **Jedd Gyorko** was born in Morgantown, WV...played at West Virginia University (2008-10).

Catcher **Francisco Pena's** father, **Tony**, was an All-Star catcher for the Pirates (1980-86)...later traded by Pittsburgh to the Cardinals for pitcher **Mike Dunne**, catcher **Mike LaValliere** and outfielder **Andy Van Slyke** (April 1, 1987.)

Catcher **Yadier Molina** (June 3, 2004), infielder **José Martínez** (September 6, 2016) and pitcher **Austin Gomber** (June 2, 2018) all made their MLB debuts against Pittsburgh.

First base coach **Oliver Marmol** was originally selected by the Pirates in the 31st round of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Pitcher **Tyler Webb** was claimed off waivers by the Pirates from the Yankees in the 2016 Rule 5 Draft...pitched in eight Spring Training games for Pittsburgh in 2017, but was returned to the Yankees before the regular season began.

Infielder **David Freese** played parts of five seasons in St. Louis (2009-13)...member of the 2011 World Series Champions...hit only walk-off home run in Cardinals WS history in Game 6...recognized as 2011 WS and NLCS MVP...selected to 2012 NL All-Star...later traded by St. Louis with RHP **Fernando Salas** to the Angels for OF **Peter Bourjos** and OF **Randal Grichuk** (November 22, 2013)...graduated from Lafayette (Mo.) High School in Wildwood.

Manager **Clint Hurdle** was selected by St. Louis from the Mets in the 1985 Rule 5 Draft and played in 86 games for the Cardinals in 1986.

Infielder **Sean Rodriguez's** father, **Johnny**, is the manager of the Springfield Cardinals (AA) of the Texas League.

Pitching Coach **Ray Searage** was selected by St. Louis in the 22nd round of the 1976 MLB Draft...later traded to the Mets for catcher **Jody Davis** in 1979...began coaching career in the Cardinals minor league system as Pitching Coach with Madison (1994), Peoria (1995-96) & Prince William (1997).

Pirates Baseball Operations Senior Advisor **Nick Leyva** was drafted by St. Louis in the 24th round in 1975...played three minor league seasons in the Cardinals system (1975-77)...managed six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (1978-83)...served as St. Louis' First Base Coach (1984-85) and Third Base Coach (1986-88).

Cardinals Baseball Information & Media Services Coordinator **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

Pirates Manager of Business Communications & Social Media **Terry Rodgers** previously worked as a Public Relations Specialist in the Cardinals Communications department (2010-11).

MLB.com Cardinals reporter **Jenifer Langosch** covered the Pirates for parts of five seasons (2007-11).

TODAY'S GAME

- Makes his 18th start of the season and 24th career appearance (23rd start) tonight.
- Faces Trevor Williams for the 4th time this season. The last Cardinal to make at least 4 starts in a season against the same opposing starter was Jason Marquis, who faced Roy Oswalt four times in 2006 (*Elias*).
- The record for most head-to-head starts in a season by a Cards pitcher vs. the same opponent is six by Slim Sallee vs. Cubs' Hippo Vaughn in 1915 (*Elias*).
- Since May 20, has struck out 97 in 14 starts, 3rd-most among NL pitchers, trailing Max Scherzer (106), Jacob deGrom (104).
- His 131 strikeouts in his first 23 career games are the most ever by a Cardinal.
- Ranks 2nd among National League rookies in batting average against (.211) and 1st in strikeouts (111), 3rd in ERA (3.49), 3rd in innings pitched (91.0) and 4th in starts (17).
- Among NL starting pitchers, ranks 7th in average against (.211), T9th in WHIP (1.13), and 4th in K/9 IP (11.06).
- Six of the eight runs allowed over his last three starts have come via home run.
- Ranks T6th among NL pitchers with eight hit batsmen, including four Cubs batters
- St. Louis is just 6-11 in his 17 starts, and lost 7 of his last 8 outings (6/22-present).
- Is 3-1 with a 2.61 ERA (9 ER/31.0 IP) in six day starts.

- Dropped his second straight start, losing a 6-3 contest to the Rockies on Tuesday at Busch Stadium.

- Received just seven runs of support in his six winless starts from 6/17-7/14.
- Recorded his 100th career strikeout on Ketel Marte (swinging) at ARI (7/3).
- Is one of just 6 pitchers in MLB history to have two or more 13+ strikeout performances in their first 17 career games: Kerry Wood (4-1998), Hideo Nomo (4-1995), Don Wilson (2-1967), Bob Turley (1953-54) & Bob Feller (2-1936).
- Finished June ranked T5th in the NL in strikeouts (37) and 6th in opponent BA (.194).
- Carried a no-hitter for first 6.1 innings on 6/22 at MIL, before allowing Jesus Aguilar solo HR. Matched his own STL rookie single-game record with 13 strikeouts
- Had a no-decision, but worked 5.0 scoreless frames to lead St. Louis to a 5-0 shutout win over the Cubs on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball on Father's Day (6/17) at Busch.
