## CHICAGO WHITE SOX (10-28) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (24-17)

May 16, 2018 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA --- GAME #42/HOME #20

LHP HECTOR SANTIAGO (0-1, 5.60 ERA) vs. RHP JAMESON TAILLON (2-3, 4.08 ERA)

**THE PIRATES...** have won six of their last seven games and seven of their last nine after dropping four in a row...Had their season-high tying five-game winning streak end Sunday after getting shut out 5-0 against San Francisco...Have gone 12-6 in their last 18 games...Also won five straight games from 4/25-29...Were 18-23 after 41 games in 2017 (18-24 after 42).

**LEADING THINGS OFF:** Last night **Adam Frazier** hit his second career leadoff home run and the third by the Pirates this season...Pittsburgh is one of six teams in the Majors with three leadoff homers this season (also Atlanta, Boston, the Chicago White Sox, Houston and Washington).

**SHOOTING BLANKS:** The Pittsburgh pitching staff recorded its Major League-leading seventh shutout of the season last night...Since the beginning of last season, Pittsburgh's 19 shutouts are the third-most in the Majors behind Cleveland (22) and the Los Angeles Dodgers (21).

**BUCS/SOX:** The Pirates have won seven straight games played against the White Sox...Pittsburgh's last loss against the Sox came on June 17, 2010, here at PNC Park when Mark Buehrle won a 5-4 decision against Ross Ohlendorf.

**ON DECK:** Pittsburgh's homestand continues tomorrow night with the first of four games against San Diego...Pittsburgh is 7-2 against the Friars in the last nine games played at PNC Park dating back to the beginning of the 2015 season.

**CENTRAL SUCCESS:** The Pirates are 25-9 in their last 34 games against teams from the American League Central dating back to June 15, 2015...Pittsburgh has posted a 9-2 record this season (4-2 at home and 5-0 on the road) against the A.L. Central...The Bucs split a two-game series here against the Twins April 2-4 and took two-of-three from the Tigers April 25-26.

**LEFTIES GALORE:** After not seeing a left-handed opposing starting pitcher for 13 straight games, the Pirates are facing a southpaw today for the third time in five games...Beginning today, the Bucs are scheduled to face a left-handed starter four times in five days...Pittsburgh has posted a 3-1 record against LHP at PNC Park this season and have gone 4-3 overall...**Elias Díaz** is batting .636 (7-for-11) against southpaws this season, **Corey Dickerson** is hitting .364 (8-for-22) and **Sean Rodríguez** has gone 6-for-17 with two home runs.

**GREGORY GOING THE EXTRA MILE:** **Gregory Polanco** has recorded an extra base hit in each of his last five games, going 8-for-20 (.400) with three doubles, two homers and four RBI...Polanco has also driven in a run in five of his last six games; the Pirates are 13-1 this year when he records an RBI.

**EXTRA EXTRA:** Last night the Pirates pounded out seven extra base hits, which was one shy of their single-game season high from May 11 vs. the Giants...Pittsburgh enters today's action tied for second among all National League teams in extra base hits (134), trailing only the Braves (143).

**AGAINST THE JUNIOR CIRCUIT:** The Pirates have played the most interleague games (11) in the Majors so far this season...During those 11 games the Pirates have gone 9-2 while scoring a total of 72 runs (average of 6.5 runs per game)...The Bucs have produced a 67-44 (.604) record against American League teams over the last six seasons (2013-2018); the best mark among all National League teams and the second-best in the Majors behind Boston (68-34; .667).

**INTERLEAGUE BELL RINGER:** In 33 career games against A.L. teams, **Josh Bell** is hitting .327 (36-for-110) with five home runs and 24 RBI...He has reached base safely in 16 of his last 17 interleague games.

**A STARLING SHINING BRIGHT:** **Starling Marte** is riding a nine-game hitting streak, going 15-for-36 (.417) with two doubles, a triple, three home runs, eight RBI and nine runs scored...Marte shares the National League lead in triples (four), is tied for fifth in hits (49) and tied for third in runs scored (30) and stolen bases (10).

**THE COMFORTS OF HOME:** The Pirates are 3-1 in a stretch that has them scheduled to play 15-of-18 games at PNC Park...The Bucs have won eight of their last nine games played at home and nine of their last eleven...Pittsburgh has posted a 13-6 home record this season; the third-best home record in the Majors and the second-best among N.L. teams.

**A RISING ROOKIE:** **Colin Moran** is hitting .400 in 19 home games and has gone 7-for-18 with seven RBI while hitting safely in six of his last seven games overall...Moran ranks first among N.L. rookies in batting (.292) and on-base percentage (.382) and second in RBI (21)...He also ranks fourth in slugging percentage (.441) and total bases (51) among N.L. rookies...In addition, Moran's 19 RBI from the seventh spot in the lineup are the most among any Major League player.

**DOING SOME YARD WORK:** The Pirates have homered 10 times in their last five games and 13 times in their last seven contests...They have gone deep 20 times in their first 12 games played this month and enter today's action tied for fourth among all National League teams with 49 long balls hit this season.

**GOING BATTY:** The Bucs are batting .310 (76-for-245) over the last seven games and .277 (182-for-656) with 27 home runs in their last 19 contests...Overall among National League teams, Pittsburgh ranks second in batting average (.262), slugging (.435) and OPS (.767) and tied for second in runs scored (208).

**GHAD KUHL:** The 25-year-old righthander will be making his ninth start of the season tomorrow night... Was in line for a win, but received a no-decision in his last start; a 6-5 Bucco victory over the Giants Saturday night (6.0ip/6h/3r/3er/4bb/6so)...Gave up one hit over 7.0 scoreless innings and struck out a career-high tying eight batters in a 9-0 win on 5/6 at Milwaukee...Has gone 3-1 in his last five starts; his only loss in that stretch came in Washington on 5/1...Is 2-0 with a 3.52 ERA (23.0ip/9er) in four starts this season at PNC Park...Spent the entire 2017 season with the Pirates and went 8-11 with a 4.35 ERA in 31 starts while pitching a professional-high 157.1 innings.

**vs. SAN DIEGO:** 1-0 with a 3.18 ERA (11.1ip/4er) in two career starts...Received a no-decision in Pittsburgh's 3-2 loss at Petco Park last year on 7/28 (5.1ip/2er) and won a 6-4 decision (6.0ip/2r) against Luis Perdomo on 8/9/16 at PNC Park.
