**TONIGHT'S GAME:** In tonight's series finale, the Giants will try to avoid being swept for the third time this season and the first time by the Rockies since they were swept in a four-game set from June 15-18, 2017 here at Coors...over the first two games of this series, SF is batting just .175 (11-for-63) and has scored only three runs.

**ROSTER MOVES:** Following last night's game, **RHP Pierce Johnson** was optioned to triple-A Sacramento...**IF Kelby Tomlinson** was recalled from triple-A Sacramento prior to tonight's game.

**TRYING FOR A WINNING TRIP:** San Francisco is 3-2 over their first five games of this six-game road trip against Arizona (3-0) and Colorado (0-2)...with a win tonight the Giants could secure their first winning road trip since posting a 4-2 record from June 30-July 6, 2017 at Pittsburgh (3-0) and Detroit (1-2).

**INSIDE THE SERIES:** The Giants have struggled at Coors Field having dropped 14 of their last 16 games here, dating back to Sept. 7, 2016.

**HAPPY FOURTH OF JULY:** The Giants are 23-38-1 (win-lost-tie) on the Fourth of July in SF-era history (since 1958)...they are 13-19 at home and have posted a 10-19-1 record on the road.

**ON THE MOUND: LHP Andrew Suárez** has posted a 2-0 record with a 2.62 ERA (10er, 34.1ip) over his last six starts...faced the Rockies here at Coors on May 28 and allowed four runs (three earned) on five hits in three innings of work in the Giants 6-5 loss to Colorado...he'll opposed LHP Tyler Anderson, who pitched 8.0-scoreless innings against the Dodgers last Friday.

**GIANTS PITCHING:** Despite posting a 6.48 ERA (18er, 25.0ip) over their last three games, Giants pitchers own a 3.04 ERA (95er, 281.2ip) since June 1, which ranks as the third-lowest ERA in the Majors during that stretch behind the New York Yankees (2.67 ERA) and Tampa Bay Rays (2.92 ERA).

**AT COORS FIELD: C Buster Posey** has hit safely in 30 of his last 33 games here at Coors Field...Posey owns the third-highest batting average here among active players (min. 120 PA), hitting .378 (93-for-246) with 13 home runs and 49 RBI in 65 games...despite going hitless in his last two games, **IF Joe Panik** is hitting .415 (44-for-106) with 10 doubles, three home runs and 15 RBI in 28 career games...**IF Brandon Belt** has also enjoyed success here, batting .324 (56-for-173) with 10 homers and 29 RBI in 50 career games.

**GETTING AHEAD:** The Giants are 29-15 when scoring first and 16-27 in games their opponent scores first.

**ROAD WOES:** The Giants have posted a .404 (19-28) road winning percentage, which ranks as the second-lowest figure in the National League behind Miami (17-26, .395)...San Francisco has dropped 20 of their last 30 road contests.

**ON DECK:** Following tonight's game in Colorado, the Giants will travel home for an 11-day, 10-game homestand leading up to the All-Star break that will feature St. Louis (July 5-8), Chicago-NL (July 9-11) and Oakland (July 13-15).

**Shawn Estes** held the Rockies to one hit in 8.2 innings as San Francisco blanked Colorado, 4-0...Quinton McCracken hit a single for the Rockies' lone hit off Estes, who fanned 11 and walked just two batters...**Rod Beck** entered the ninth to record the last out.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#59 LHP Andrew Suárez**  
**6-0, 187, 25 years old (September 11, 1992)**  
**3-4 Record, 4.18 ERA**

- The 25-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 14th career Major League start...has gone 3-4 with a 4.18 ERA (33er, 71.0ip) in 13 outings, with the Giants going 5-8 in those games.
- Earned the win in the Giants' 2-1 victory at Arizona on June 29...allowed one run on seven hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 6.0 innings...surpassed the 100-pitch mark for the first time in his career.
- Has well as of late, posting a 2.35 ERA (6er, 23.0ip) over his last four starts.
- Has struck out 66 batters while issuing just 15 walks in his first 13 career Major League starts...ranks sixth among NL rookies in strikeouts.
- **LHP Andrew Suarez** became the first Giants pitcher to begin his career with 13 starts of two walks or fewer since 1913...the last MLB pitcher to begin his career with at least 13 starts of two walks or fewer was Pittsburgh's Trevor Williams who had 15 consecutive such starts to begin his career from 2016-2017 (Stats, LLC).
- Opponents have 17 hits in 53 at-bats (.321) off him with runners in scoring position...is holding opponents to a .100 average (2-for-20) with RISP and two outs.
- Has received three or fewer runs of support in eight of his 13 starts.
- Has a 5.35 ERA (20er, 33.2ip) in seven starts on the road compared to a 3.13 ERA (13er, 37.1ip) in six starts at home.
- Opponents are 14-for-34 (.412) off him on the first pitch of an at-bat.
- Lefties are hitting .183 (13-for-71) off him and are just 4-for-their-last-30 (.133).
- Faced the Rockies at Coors Field on May 28...received a no decision after allowing four runs (three earned) on five hits over 5.0 innings in the Giants' 5-6 loss.
- Has been recalled twice from triple-A Sacramento, first on April 11 to make a spot start and again on May 1 as the Giants needed an extra starter due to a doubleheader April 28...with **RHP Johnny Cueto** being placed on the disabled list May 1, Suárez slid into the Giants' starting rotation.
- Was selected in the second round of the 2015 MLB Draft by San Francisco (No. 61 overall).

**NOTES:** Is scheduled to return from his rehab assignment and be reinstated from the DL to make his sixth start of the season...was placed on the DL on May 1 with right elbow inflammation...saw Dr. James Andrews on May 7 and was diagnosed with an elbow sprain...missed the Giants last 60 games...made his first rehab start with triple-A Sacramento Saturday, June 23 and tossed 3.2-scoreless innings, allowing one hit with four strikeouts (threw 48 pitches, 33 strikes)...made his second rehab start with triple-A Sacramento last Friday and tossed 4.0-scoreless innings, allowing four hits and one walk with six strikeouts (69 pitches, 44 strikes)...the Giants are 4-1 in his starts this year and 41-21 (.661) overall since he joined the team in 2016.
