TRIBE HEADLINES

» The Tribe holds a 33-15 record against the A.L. Central this season, posting a 2.65 ERA (127ER/432.0IP) that ranks as the lowest intradivisional mark in MLB.

» The Indians offense has scored 10-or-more runs 14 times this season, most in the American League (2nd in MLB)...they have also slugged 157 home runs, 2nd-most in MLB (NYY - 177).

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** has driven in an MLB-best 31 RBI in the 1st inning this season and ranks 3rd in the A.L. with 83 total RBI...he continues to lead the A.L. in extra-base hits (65), home runs (33 - T1st), and stolen bases (26 - T1st).

» **EDWIN ENCARNACION** became the third member of the Tribe to reach 25 homers this season, joining **Ramírez** and **FRANCISCO LINDOR** as the fastest trio in Tribe history to all reach 25...Encarnacion is one of two players in MLB (with LAA's **Mike Trout**) to hit at least 25 homers in each of the last seven seasons...he ranks 3rd in the A.L. in home RBI (48) and T8th in home runs at home (14).

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians reached a new high-water mark of 13 games above .500, as they blanked the Twins 10-0 in the opener of this four-game set at Progressive Field.

» **EDWIN ENCARNACION** (1-4) led the Tribe offense with four RBI, including a 7th-inning hit three-run homer for his 25th longball of the season...the Indians hit four homers overall on the night, including a two-run shot from **BRANDON GUYER** (#6), as well as solo homers from **YONDER ALONSO** (#19) and **JASON KIPNIS** (#11).

» **TREVOR BAUER** earned his 11th win, holding the Twins to three hits over 6.0 scoreless innings...Bauer notched his A.L.-best (tied with Boston's **Chris Sale**) 10th start with double-digit strikeouts, fanning 11 to bring his season total to 206 punchouts (2nd in A.L.).

» **Bauer** became the 11th different pitcher in Indians franchise history to record a 200-strikeout season...needing just 156.0 innings to achieve the feat, he became the 2nd-fastest in Tribe history to reach the milestone (**COREY KLUBER**, 147.0IP in 2017)...Bauer now sports a 1.87 home ERA (2nd-lowest in A.L.) and a 1.97 ERA vs. the A.L. Central.

» **ADAM CIMBER**, **OLIVER PÉREZ** (2K) and **DAN OTERO** each worked 1.0 perfect frame to preserve the Tribe's 12th shutout of the season.

TWIN BILLING

» The Indians are playing their fifth of six series against the Minnesota Twins, as well as their second here at Progressive Field.

» In their first matchup at Progressive Field from June 15-17, Minnesota won two of the three games...overall, the Indians own a 6-7 record vs. the Twins this season, going 2-2 at Progressive Field, 1-1 in Puerto Rico and 3-4 at Target Field.

CENTRAL COMMAND

» Cleveland has gone 33-15 against the A.L. Central, with a record of 10-3-2 in series play...the Indians' .688 intradivisional winning percentage ranks 2nd in the A.L. and MLB (Boston - .725)...the Tribe has gone 19-4 in divisional home games and 14-11 on the road...Cleveland has won eight straight divisional home games and eight of its last 10 divisional road games (since June 14).

» In 48 games vs. the A.L. Central, Tribe pitchers own a 2.65 ERA (127ER/432.0IP), marking the lowest intradivisional ERA in MLB...seven of the Tribe's 12 shutouts (T1st in MLB with PIT) have come against the A.L. Central, and the Indians have allowed three-or-fewer runs in 34 intradivisional games (going 30-4 in those contests).

STRONG STARTERS

» Cleveland starting pitchers have combined for a 3.40 ERA this season, the 2nd-lowest mark in the American League (Houston - 3.00) and 3rd-lowest in MLB (Los Angeles-NL - 3.35).

» **TREVOR BAUER's** outing last night was the 22nd double-digit strikeout performance by a Tribe pitcher, 2nd-most in MLB (Houston - 23)...it marked the club's 20th start of 5.0-or-more shutout innings, 2nd-most in MLB (Boston - 23)...Cleveland's 70 quality starts this season are also 2nd-most in the Majors (Houston - 78).

» Tribe starters rank 2nd in MLB with 727 strikeouts this season and have issued just 172 walks (T4th-fewest in MLB)...the rotation's 4.23 K/BB ratio leads MLB.

» **MV Scappers (Short-A): 29-19, 1st (+1.5G)** » **8/6: L, 3-4 (10) vs. State College** » **Today: 7:05 vs. State College**
Reigning NYPL Player of the Month Hosea Nelson hit a solo homer...Simeon Lucas and Tyler Freeman each doubled.

COOKIE SEEING DOUBLE

» Right-hander **CARLOS CARRASCO** is set to make his second straight start against the Twins...earned the win after tossing 7.1 shutout innings on August 1 at Target Field, allowing just four hits and striking out 10 batters in the Tribe's 2-0 victory.

» Carrasco has gone 5-0 in six appearances (five starts) since returning from the Disabled List on July 6, posting a 1.99 ERA (7ER/31.2IP) in that span with 42 strikeouts and just four walks.

» Despite missing three weeks with injury, Carrasco enters play tonight with 138 strikeouts, T11th in the American League...his rate of 10.1 strikeouts per 9.0 innings ranks 7th in the A.L.

» Carrasco currently ranks 4th in the American League with 13 wins, while he ranks 4th in K/BB ratio (5.31) and T7th in walks per 9.0 innings (1.9).

» **In three starts since the All-Star break, Carrasco has gone 2-0 with a 1.33 ERA (3ER/20.1IP), tied for the 5th-lowest second-half ERA in MLB (min. 20.0IP).**

PARROT SIGHTING

» **EDWIN ENCARNACION** belted his 25th homer of the season last night and drove in four runs, bringing his season total to 80 RBI (4th in American League).

» Encarnacion has now hit 25-or-more home runs in each of the last seven seasons (since 2012), joining LAA's **Mike Trout** as the only players in MLB to do so.

» The trio of Encarnacion, **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** (33HR) and **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (27HR) is the fastest in Indians history (111 team games) to all reach 25 longballs...they rank T6th among the fastest trios in American League history to achieve the feat, as well as the fastest since the 2006 White Sox did so in just 98 games (**Jim Thome**, **Paul Konerko** and **Jermaine Dye**).

» Encarnacion has done the bulk of his damage at Progressive Field this season, ranking 3rd in the American league in home RBI (48) and T8th in home runs at home (14).

JOSÉ CAN YOU SWING

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** opened the scoring last night with a 1st-inning sacrifice fly, bringing his season total to 83 RBI (3rd in A.L.).

» **Ramírez has driven in an MLB-best 31 RBI in the 1st inning this season, 12 more than any other A.L. player...**he also ranks 2nd in the American League with 51 home RBI.

» He enters play tonight among A.L. leaders in several other categories, including extra-base hits (65 - 1st), stolen bases (26 - T1st), total bases (256 - 2nd), walks (74 - 2nd), on-base percentage (.410 - 3rd), slugging percentage (.629 - 3rd), runs scored (78 - 5th), and home batting average (.315 - 9th).

HOME IS WHERE THE HITTERS ARE

» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** is batting .338 (71-210) at Progressive Field this season, the 6th-highest home batting average in the American League...he also ranks T3rd in the A.L. in home hits (69), 5th in home RBI (43) and T5th in home multi-hit games (21).

» **JASON KIPNIS** is batting .324 (22-68) over his past 22 home games (since June 16) with six homers, three doubles, 13 RBI and 12 runs scored.

» **YONDER ALONSO** has hit 10 of his 19 home runs this season at Progressive Field...he has hit a team-high six home runs since the All-Star Break, T6th-most in the American League.

SCORE TACTICS

» Yesterday, the Indians scored 10-or-more runs for the 14th time this season, the most in the American League and 2nd-most in MLB (CHC - 15)...the Tribe has scored 330 runs at home (5.79 per game), the most in Major League Baseball.

» Last night's contest was the Tribe's eighth this season hitting four-or-more home runs, 2nd-most in the A.L. (NYY - 10)...Cleveland has slugged 157 total homers, 2nd-most in MLB (NYY - 177).

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

1923: In the Tribe's 22-2 rout at Washington, **Frank Brower** becomes the second player in club history to collect six hits in a nine-inning game, doing so with five singles and a double...Brower joined **Zaza Harvey** (4/25/1902 at SLB), and the feat has been since replicated by **George Burns** (6/19/1924 at DET), **Bruce Campbell** (7/2/1936 at SLB), **Jim Fridley** (4/29/1952 at PHA), **Jorge Orta** (6/15/1980 vs. MIN) and **Omar Vizquel** (8/31/2004 at NYY).

TONIGHT'S START

» The 31-year-old right-hander is set to make his fourth start of the second half in tonight's contest vs. Minnesota...is pitching on five days' rest after also facing the Twins in his last start on August 1...**earned his fifth straight win, holding Minnesota to just four hits over 7.1 shutout innings, walking none and fanning 10 in the Tribe's 2-0 victory.**

» Carrasco is making his fifth start this season against the Minnesota Twins, as well as the 19th of his career (22nd appearance)...owns a 1-2 record vs. the Twins in 2018 with a 4.66 ERA (10ER/19.1IP).

» Has gone 7-2 in 10 appearances (nine starts) at Progressive Field this season with a 4.99 ERA (27ER/48.2IP)...he also has gone 4-3 with a 2.82 ERA (17ER/54.1IP) in nine starts against A.L. Central opponents.

LAST TIME OUT | 2018 HIGHLIGHTS

» Carrasco is starting on extended five days' rest after facing the Twins in his last start on August 1 at Target Field...**earned his 13th win, holding Minnesota scoreless over 7.1 dominant innings (0BB, 10K)...Carrasco has taken the win in each of his last five decisions (one starts, one relief), as well as seven of his last eight...he currently ranks 4th in the American League with 13 wins this season.**

» Improved to 3-0 for the first time in his career as he tossed his 9th career complete game on April 11 vs. Detroit... held the Tigers to just one run on three hits over 9.0 innings, walking two and striking out six batters...took a no-decision at Estadio Hiram Bithorn against Minnesota on April 18 despite tossing 7.0 shutout innings (3H, 1BB, 7K).

» **Threw his 10th career complete game and his second of 2018 on May 9 at Milwaukee, holding the Brewers to two runs on five hits in the Tribe's 6-2 win...Carrasco struck out a season-high 14 batters, one shy of his career high and the most by any Indians pitcher this season...**...also helped his own cause at the plate, collecting an RBI-single in the 9th inning...became the first Tribe pitcher with an RBI in his own complete game since **Gaylord Perry** did so on September 22, 1972 vs. New York-AL.

» Earned his 10th win of the season on July 11 vs. Cincinnati after holding the Reds to one run on five hits over 5.0 innings of work...**struck out seven batters to reach 1,000 career punchouts, making him the 12th pitcher with 1,000 strikeouts in an Indians uniform and the 44th active MLB pitcher to reach 1,000.**

STRIKEOUTS RISING

» Carrasco has struck out 63 batters over his past eight starts, bringing his season total to 138 punchouts...he enters play tonight ranked T11th in the American League in strikeouts despite missing three weeks on the Disabled List.

» Currently ranks 7th in the American League with 10.1 strikeouts per 9.0 innings...he also is 4th in the A.L. with a 5.31 K/BB ratio and T7th in walks per 9.0 innings (1.9).

» Since the beginning of 2015, Carrasco has amassed 10.06 strikeouts-per-9.0IP, the 3rd-highest total among American League pitchers with at least 500.0 innings pitched in that span (Chris Sale, Chris Archer, **Corey Kluber** ranks 4th with 10.00 K/9.0IP).

» Carrasco also owns a 4.90 K/BB ratio since the 2015 season, which ranks 3rd-best in the A.L. in that span (min. 500.0IP) behind Chris Sale (6.27) and **Corey Kluber** (5.59).

VS. MINNESOTA | A.L. CENTRAL

» Carrasco will be making his 19th career start (22nd appearance) vs. the Minnesota Twins, as well as his fifth this season...owns a career record of 6-8 vs. Minnesota with a 3.98 ERA (45ER/101.2IP).

» Has gone 1-2 against the Twins this season with a 4.66 ERA (10ER/19.1IP)...**tossed 7.0 shutout innings on three hits in a no-decision on April 18 at Hiram Bithorn Stadium in Puerto Rico...**...took the loss on June 1 at Target Field after allowing six runs on seven hits over 3.2 innings (3BB, 2K)...also lost on June 16 at Progressive Field, departing after 1.1 innings (4H, 4R/ER) with a right elbow contusion (struck by line drive) that sent him to the Disabled List...**earned the win in his August 1 start at Target Field, walking none and striking out 10 over 7.1 shutout innings.**

» Carrasco has made nine starts against A.L. Central opponents this season, posting a 4-3 record with a 2.82 ERA (17ER/54.1IP)...he holds the 8th-lowest ERA vs. the A.L. Central (min. 30.0IP) despite trailing three of his teammates...**Corey Kluber** ranks 2nd (1.62), **Trevor Bauer** ranks 3rd (1.97) and **Mike Clevinger** ranks 7th (2.33).

THE GREEN, GREEN GRASS OF HOME

» Today will mark Carrasco's 10th start at Progressive Field this season, as well as his 11th appearance this season.

» Carrasco last pitched at Progressive Field in a relief appearance on July 15 vs. New York-AL...**earned his first relief win since July 19, 2014, tossing a scoreless inning (2K) in the Tribe's 5-2 victory...**...also earned the win in his most recent home start on July 11 vs. Cincinnati, allowing one run on five hits over 5.0 innings of work (1BB, 7K).

» In his June 6 home start vs. Milwaukee, **he earned the win after allowing one run on eight hits over 7.0 strong innings of work (1BB, 10K)...in his April 11 start here vs. Detroit, Carrasco threw the 9th complete game of his career, holding the Tigers to one run on three hits with two walks and six strikeouts...**sits 5-2 with a 5.48 ERA (26ER/42.2IP) through eight starts at Progressive Field in 2018.

» Carrasco posted a 7-4 record in Cleveland last season with a 3.99 ERA (42ER/94.2IP), compared to an 11-2 mark with a 2.65 ERA (31ER/105.1IP) on the road...has earned a career record of 30-32 with a 4.54 ERA (246ER/487.1IP) at Progressive Field.

WELCOME TO THE SECOND HALF

» Carrasco currently sits 2-0 with a 1.33 ERA (3ER/20.1IP) since the All-Star break, tied for the 5th-lowest second-half ERA in MLB (min. 20.0IP).

» Went 8-3 with a 3.12 ERA (33ER/95.1IP) in the second half in 2017...Carrasco also posted a 5-0 record with a 1.48 ERA (7ER/42.2IP) in September last season.

2017 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

» **Enjoyed the most prolific season of his career, finishing fourth in American League Cy Young voting as he set new career-highs in wins (18), starts (32), innings pitched (200.0) and strikeouts (226)...Carrasco finished in the A.L. Top 10 in wins (T1st), ERA (3.29, 6th), strikeouts (5th) and innings (8th)...joined Corey Kluber as the first teammates to accumulate 18 wins and 220 strikeouts each since Arizona's Randy Johnson & Curt Schilling in 2002 (6th duo all-time).**

» Went 5-0 with a 1.48 ERA (7ER/42.2IP) and 51 strikeouts in six September starts, finishing the season on a career-best six-decision winning streak.

» Made his Postseason debut in Game 3 of the ALDS against New York-AL after missing the 2016 playoffs...tossed 5.2 shutout innings on just three hits (3BB, 7K) but took a no decision in the Tribe's eventual 1-0 loss at Yankee Stadium.

CAREER SNAPSHOT

» Right-hander is in his 10th season with the Cleveland organization after being acquired from Philadelphia on July 29, 2009, along with INF Jason Donald, RHP Jason Knapp & C Lou Marson, in exchange for OF Ben Francisco & LHP Cliff Lee.

» Signed 4-year contract extension with Indians thru 2018 on April 7, 2015, including club options for 2019 & 2020 and could cover up to first 3 years of free agency.

» Made his major league debut September 1, 2009 as the Indians starter against the Detroit Tigers at Comerica Park...took the loss after allowing six runs on nine hits (three home runs) with three walks and three strikeouts in 3.0 innings.

» Is in his 15th professional season since signing with Philadelphia as a non-drafted free agent on Nov. 25, 2003...has appeared in parts of nine Major League seasons with Cleveland...missed the entire 2012 season after having right elbow surgery.
