CARDINALS NOTES

- Jack Flaherty** made his 14th start of the season, first against the Reds in 2018 and third career start vs. the Reds (0-1)...made two starts vs. CIN in 2017 within six days of each other and pitched the shortest start of his career (2.0 IP) on Sept. 19, 2017...last win was June 11 vs. SD, making six starts since (0-2, 4 no decisions)...was his 2nd scoreless start this season, both of 5.0 innings (6/17 vs. CHI).
- Matt Carpenter** hit his 19th career lead-off home run (two behind **Lou Brock** for the franchise mark, 21) and 4th of the season...tallied his 250th career double.
- Paul DeJong** tied his career-high with a nine-game hitting streak (9-30, .300)...has hit safely in all seven games since returning from the disabled list on July 6.
- Dexter Fowler** tallied his second multi-hit game in his last four games...has hit safely in 5-of-9 games vs. CIN this season with three multi-hit games.
- Jordan Hicks** surrendered a season-high four runs...has allowed runs in three straight games for the first time in his career (6 total runs).
- Greg Holland** made his 400th career appearance and surpassed 400 career innings in the game tonight as well.
- Bud Norris** hit two batters in a game for the 2nd time in his career (last: 5/1/14 vs. PIT w/BAL).
- The **Cardinals** have lost a season-high six straight home games...sold out their 5th straight game.

REDS NOTES

- Luis Castillo** made his 20th start of the season, third against the Cardinals in 2018 (1-2) and fourth career start vs. the Cardinals (1-3)...surpassed 100 innings for the first season in his career.
- Joey Votto** posted his 11th game with two or more RBI...drew his 14th walk of the season vs. STL, the most by any opposing player against the Cardinals...has drawn the most walks against the Cardinals of any player in 2013 & 2015 (121st career walk vs. STL).
- Scouter Gennett** has 114 hits pre-All Star Break, the most by a Reds player since **Sean Casey** had 118 in 1999...has an RBI in 3 straight games...tallied his 33rd multi-hit game of the season, ranking 4th in the National League.
- Jose Peraza** tallied a career-high five hits...tallied three or more hits in consecutive games for the first time in his career...has eight hits in his last four games (5-10, .500)...was the first Reds player with five hits since **Scouter Gennett** at COL (5/26/2018).
- Jesse Winker** tied his career-high with a nine-game hitting streak (15-30, .500) collecting a single in the 9th inning.
- Eugenio Suárez** tallied his 70 and 71st RBI, making him the 3rd Reds player with 70 RBI pre-All Star Break since 2000 joining **Brandon Phillips** with 74 in 2013 and **Ken Griffey, Jr.**, with 72 in 2000.

- 📍 **Alex Blandino** recorded his team-high 8th pinch-hit of the season.
- 📍 **Billy Hamilton** has multiple runs in 3 of his last 6 games (7 runs total).
- 📍 **The Reds** have had a player tally five hits three of their last four times vs. the Cardinals (**José Peraza** today, **Scouter Gennett** 6/6/17 vs. STL & **Steve Selsky** 9/26/16 at STL)...have scored eight or more runs in consecutive games for the 5th time this season...scored eight or more runs in consecutive games at Busch Stadium III for the first time since 7/6/11-9/2/11, and the first time ever at Busch Stadium III in consecutive days.
