TONIGHT'S GAME: Is the first of the Reds' 2 spring games vs **Tim Hevly's Mariners**...Cin is **4-10 vs Sea** in the **Cactus League (1-1 in 2010, 1-0 in 2011, 0-2 in 2012, 0-2 in 2013, 0-2 in 2014, 1-0 in 2015, 1-1 in 2016, 0-2 in 2017, 0-0 in 2018)**...the M's won **13 of the 15** regular season meetings...the teams most recently met during the regular season in **May 2016**, a 3-game Mariners sweep at **Great American Ball Park**...see **Reds vs Mariners** on media guide **Page 332**.

POMP & CIRCUMSTANCE: In pre-game ceremonies tonight, the Reds recognized their Class AA Pensacola affiliate on its 2017 championship season...led by manager **Pat Kelly**, last year the **Blue Wahoos** earned a share of the **Southern League championship**...with a **74-66 record**, Pensacola produced a winning record in consecutive seasons for the first time in its history and qualified for the playoffs for the third straight year...earlier, today, the players and staff received their championship rings...joining the players and coaching staff on the field were owners **Quint** and **Rishy Studer** along with team president **Jonathan Griffith**.

SPRING FORWARD: Daylight Saving Time tomorrow will celebrate its **100th birthday**...in the **spring of 1918**, DST was enacted by the U.S. government as a way to save coal during **World War I** and was meant to exist only during wartime...although the practice technically ended later that same year, many regions continued to follow DST until the government put the measure back in place in **1966**...in **2007**, **Daylight Saving Time** was expanded to about **65% of the year** because it reportedly **saves energy**, **cuts down on traffic accidents** and **reduces crime**...**Hawaii** and **most of Arizona** (including **Goodyear**) do not observe DST and thus will not "spring forward" 1 hour at **2:00 a.m. local time tomorrow**, nor do the islands of **American Samoa, Guam, Puerto Rico** or **Virgin Islands**...according *USA Today*, **26 states** are considering making **Daylight Saving Time** permanent, which would require approval by Congress.

TONIGHT vs MARINERS: RHP Sal Romano will start for the Reds, to be followed by relievers LHP Wandy Peralta, RHP Raisel Iglesias, RHP Vance Worley, RHP Kevin Quackenbush, RHP David Hernandez, RHP Kevin Shackelford, RHP Zack Weiss and RHP Jackson Stephens.

TOMORROW at MARINERS: Will be the first game after **Daylight Saving Time** puts **Goodyear** 3 hours ahead of **Cincinnati**...starting pitcher LHP Brandon Finnegan will be followed by a combination of RHP Michael Lorenzen, RHP Jared Hughes, RHP Zack Weiss, RHP Jimmy Herget, RHP Kevin Shackelford, RHP Dylan Floro, LHP Kyle Crockett and RHP Tanner Rainey.

AT THE PLATE: Reds outfielders, whose 40 assists last season tied the White Sox for the Major League lead, already this spring have 6 assists (**Aquino 2, Elizalde, Duvall, Ervin, Kivlehan**)...**Alex Blandino** has played 2B (3g, 1gs), SS (3g) and 3B (6g)...made his only start in the 3-2 win on 3/2 at SF, played 2B...**Brandon Dixon** is tied for the team lead in both HR (3) and RBI (8)...hit safely in 4 of his last 7 apps (5-13, .385, 1 2b, 2hr, 6rbi)...made all 4 of his starts at 1B...has played 1B (7g, 4gs), 2B (1g), 3B (2g), LF (1g) and RF (1g)...**Sebastian Elizalde** has played 1B (7g, 1gs), LF (2g) and RF (1g)...had an assist from LF on 3/1 vs WSox...**Phillip Ervin** went 0-for-1 on Sun vs KC, snapping his 3-game hitting streak (3-6, .500, 2rbi)...has made 11 apps and 7 starts (3gs in LF, 2gs in CF, 2gs in RF)...on 2/28 at KC recorded 2 hits and an assist from RF...**Phil Gosselin** has played 1B (1gs), 2B (1gs), SS (4g, 1gs) and 3B (3g, 2gs)...made each of his last 3 apps at SS...produced a pair of 2-hit games (2/23 at Cle, 3/4 vs KC)...**Dilson Herrera** in Wed's 14-12 loss at WSox produced 3 hits, 2 RBI and a stolen base...has made 2 starts at 2B and 2 starts at DH...last played defense in a start at 2B on 2/26...**Rosell Herrera** is tied for the team lead in RBI (8), including 3 RBI on Mon vs LAA...has played 2B (2g), 3B (2gs), LF (2g), CF (2g) and RF (3g, 2gs)...**Patrick Kivlehan** made his first 2 starts at 1B (2/24 vs Col, 2/26 vs Ari) and his 2 most recent starts in RF (Sat at Cubs, Mon vs LAA)...also has played 3B (3g), LF (2g) and CF (1g)...had an assist from CF on 3/1 vs WSox...**Devin Mesoraco** in his last 5 apps is 4-for-10 (.400, 2 2b, 4rbi)...has made 9 starts (7gs at C, 2gs at DH)...**Nick Senzel** has played SS (5g, 2gs) and 3B (3g, 2gs)...**Darnell Sweeney** has played 2B (4g, 1gs), 3B (1g), SS (3g, 1gs), CF (1g) and RF (1gs)...**Chadwick Tromp** in the 8-7 walkoff win on 3/1 vs WSox drove in the game-ending run with a 2-out, RBI-single off Brian Clark...**Mason Williams** hit safely in 6 of his 12 apps...began the spring with a team-high 4-game hitting streak...played LF (1g), CF (10g, 2gs) and RF (2g, 1gs)...**Jesse Winker** hit safely in 6 of his 10 apps, including 3 of his last 4 apps (4-8, .500, 1 2b, 1hr, 2rbi)...has made 4 starts in LF, 1 start in RF and 3 starts at DH.

INJURY UPDATES: CF **Billy Hamilton** was scratched from Tue's starting lineup while injured during batting practice...an x-ray and MRI showed a **sprained left index finger**, but he started Thu at Col and since then hasn't been hampered by the injury...while in the dugout on 2/24 vs Col, OF **Mason Williams** was hit in the chin by a line drive foul ball, an injury that required 2 stitches but hasn't affected his playing status...x-rays were negative.

DOT, DOT, DOT...: LHP **Joe Mantiplly**, in Major League camp as a non-roster invitee, on 3/9 had "Tommy John" surgery to repair the torn ulnar collateral ligament in his left elbow...after the exhibition games started, the Reds signed to minor league contracts **LHP Oliver Pérez** (2/24) and **OF Ben Revere** (2/26)...both are in Major League spring training camp...**RHP Rookie Davis** (right hip surgery) on 3/2 went on the 60-day disabled list to make room on the 40-man roster for **LHP Jairo Labourt**, who was claimed off waivers from the Tigers and sent to minor league camp...**Labourt** came off the roster 2 days later, when on 3/4 he was claimed off waivers by the Athletics.

SPRING ROSTER: There are **54 players** remaining in camp, including disabled **RHP Rookie Davis** (60-day DL, recovering from right hip surgery)...the Reds began Major League spring training with **62 players** overall, 33 pitchers, 6 catchers, 13 infielders, 10 outfielders and 22 non-roster invitees...increased that number to **63** on 2/19 (invited to come minor league **RHP Ben Rowen**), to **64** on 2/24 (signed to a minor league contract **LHP Oliver Pérez**) and to **65** on 2/26 (signed to a minor league contract **OF Ben Revere**)...most recently, the Reds invited to Major League camp **65** (2017), **62** (2016), **64** (2015), **60** (2014), **58** (2013), **58** (2012), **54** (2011), **59** (2010), **63** (2009), **65** (2008), **58** (2007), **63** (2006), **55** (2005), **56** (2004), **64** (2003), **70** (2002), **58** (2001), **72** (2000), **54** (1999), **51** (1998), **55** (1997) and **59** (1996) players.

OUT OF OPTIONS: Players on the 40-man roster out of options include **RHP Homer Bailey** and **IF Dilson Herrera**.
