THE SHOW MUST GO ON: For the second-straight day in Chicago, the Padres fell 5-4 to the Cubs in the third of the four-game set, dropping to 1-5 on the season vs. CHC...starter **Walker Lockett**, making his second-career start, worked a career-high 5.0 innings on 83 pitches...he allowed five runs (earned) on nine hits with two walks, three home runs and six strikeouts...**Austin Hedges** homered for the eighth occasion this season, and **Matt Strahm**, **José Castillo** and **Phil Maton** combined for 3.0 innings of scoreless ball.

MOVES: Today, RHP **Tyson Ross** was claimed off waivers by the St. Louis Cardinals, and the Padres selected RHP **Trey Wingenter** to the ML roster (*click name for pronunciation*)...Wingenter's first appearance will be his Major League debut (he'll wear No. 58)...originally drafted by the Padres in the 17th round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft, he spent parts of four minor league seasons in the Padres system, posting a career 2.98 ERA (56 er, 169.0 ip) in 140 appearances (all in relief).

LOCKED AND LUCCHESI'D: **Joey Lucchesi** looks to rebound from his last start on July 29 vs. ARI, in which he allowed a career-high five earned runs and three homers...his 9.12 SO/9 IP rank first among Padre starters who've started at least 16 games, and his 3.27 BB/9 IP also ranks first...the rookie southpaw owns a 5.73 ERA in day games, compared to a 2.95 ERA in the night.

CHECK OUT THE NEW WHIP: Since the All-Star break, the Padres bullpen has a Major League-leading 1.01 WHIP...their 5.42 SO/BB ratio and 0.46 HR/9 both rank tops in the majors since the break...they've allowed just 12 walks as well, the fewest in the NL and third-fewest in the majors (behind SEA and DET's 10 bb).

IN THE WINDY, RISPY CITY: In the three games this series at Wrigley, the Padres have hit .300 with RISP (6-for-20) with three doubles, one homer and 11 RBI...in those three games, Padres hurlers have held the Cubs to just a .118 clip in such scenarios (2-for-17).

HI MY NAME IS AUSTIN, AND I HIT HOME RUNS: **Austin Hedges** has hit four homers in his past eight games, collecting seven RBI in the process...he's averaging a home run every 6.50 at bats, the best ratio of any player in the majors in that time (min. 30 plate appearances)...Hedges has hit four homers since the All-Star break in 39 at-bats (.615 SLG) after he hit four before the break in 135 at-bats (.376 SLG).

REPORTED TO THE DRS: The Padres have 32 defensive runs saved this season (fifth-most in the majors) and the Cubs have 40 DRS (ranked as fourth-most in baseball).

HAVE YOU MET JON?: A few Friars have seen success at the plate vs. CHC's **Jon Lester**, including **Eric Hosmer**, who has a .333 career average (6-for-18) with a home run and five walks...**Jose Pirela** has a .500 career clip (4-for-8) with a homer, and **Christian Villanueva** has gone 2-for-2 against him with one home run and a walk.

PADRES ON DECK: In his El Paso (AAA) debut on Saturday night, RHP **Jacob Nix**, the Padres' No. 14 prospect, allowed five hits with no walks and three strikeouts over 6.0 scoreless innings...for Lake Elsinore (A), RHP **Michel Baez**, the Padres' No. 7 prospect, allowed two runs on two hits and two walks in eight strikeouts over 6.0 innings...also for the Storm, CF **Edward Olivares** hit two solo homers in the contest, and 1B **Brad Zunica** also hit two homers, going 2-for-4 with three RBI...for Fort Wayne (A), LHP **Aaron Leasher** allowed two runs (one earned) on three hits and three walks with seven strikeouts over 6.0 innings.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#37 LHP JOEY LUCCHESI (5-6, 3.74)

LET'S GO FUEGO: 25-year-old **Joey Lucchesi** is set to make his 17th start of the season today and third of the second half against the Chicago Cubs...it will be his first career start and appearance against the Cubs and at Wrigley Field.

LAST TIME OUT: Allowed a career-high five runs behind a career-high three home runs allowed in 4.1 IP in the Padres' 5-4 loss on 7/20 vs. ARI.

- The D-Backs (thrice) are among the teams Lucchesi has faced multiple times this season, including the Rockies (three times), Dodgers (twice) and Mets (twice).
- In his seven starts since 7/20 after being reinstated from the 10-day DL with a right hip strain, he is 2-4 with a 4.55 ERA (15 ER, 29.2 IP), allowing two earned runs or less in five of those outings.

AWAY FROM HOME: In his five starts away from Petco, Lucchesi has posted a 2.81 ERA and an opponent slash line of .202/.286/.298...in his 11 starts at Petco, he has posted a 4.21 ERA and a .255/.324/.469 line.

LONG BALLS OF THE RARE TYPE: Lucchesi surrendered a career-high three home runs in his last outing on 7/29 vs. ARI.

- Allowed 10 home runs across his first 10 outings from 3/30-6/20.
- Prior to his last outing, he didn't allow a home run in five consecutive starts from 6/25-7/23, one of only five pitchers to not allowed a long ball over that time (min. 23.0 IP).

SHOWING HE BELONGS: The Padres selected Lucchesi to the Major League roster to start the club's second game of the season on 3/30...he went on to allow three earned runs or fewer in eight of his first nine career outings from 3/30-5/14, posting a 3-2 record with a 3.23 ERA (17 ER, 47.1 IP) and 9.13 SO/9 IP.

- Missed 32 games from 5/14-6/20 with a right hip strain.
- Went 1-3 with a 3.60 ERA (8 ER, 20.0 IP) over his final five starts of the first half, limiting hitters to a .187 average and 9.45 SO/9 IP.
- Allowed just two total hits across his two scoreless starts on 6/25 at TEX (4.0 IP) and 6/30 vs. PIT (5.0 IP).
- Saddled with the loss in consecutive outings for the first time in his career to close out the first half on 7/6 at ARI and 7/11 vs. LAD, despite pitching to a combined 3.86 ERA and a .231 opponent average.

RANKS AMONG THE ROOKS: Among rookies who have made at least 16 starts this season, he ranks third in ERA (3.74) and fourth in opponent average (.238) and SO/9 IP (9.12).

YOU SHALL NOT REACH: Among all pitchers who have made at least 16 starts this season, Lucchesi has allowed the fifth-fewest baserunners (101) among all starters.

- His 9.12 SO/9.0 IP ratio leads the Padres staff and ranks 16th in the NL.

YOUNG AND THE RESTLESS: Lucchesi has been more effective with fewer days off between starts.

- With four days off, he has a 1.80 ERA with a .225 opponent average in seven starts...with five days off, he has a 4.26 ERA with a .207 opponent average in five starts...with six-or-more days off, he has a 7.02 ERA and a .304 opponent average in three starts.

PICK ME BABY ONE MORE TIME: Lucchesi has recorded three pickoffs and fellow rookie lefty **Eric Lauer** leads the majors with 10...their 13 combined pickoffs are the most by a Padres rookie duo in franchise history.

APPRECIATE THE HELP: His 5.49 run support average leads the Padres staff, ranks 26th among all ML pitchers and 13th among all NL arms (min. 16 games started).

THROUGH 4, UNDER 2.00: Lucchesi logged a 1.66 ERA through his first four starts with a 2-0 record...the last SD pitcher to have a sub-2.00 ERA over his first four MLB starts was **Odrisamer Despaigne** in 2014 (1.35).

FIRST IN CLASS: Made his Major League debut on 3/30 vs. MIL, becoming the first pitcher of the 2016 draft class to make it to the show...he was the second player overall drafted in 2016 to make it to the majors, following only Orioles **OF Austin Hays**...teammate **Eric Lauer** became the second pitcher of the '16 class to make his MLB debut (April 24 at COL)

- Lucchesi made just 39 minor league starts prior to his big league debut, going 11-9 with a 1.99 ERA (40 ER, 181.0 IP) and 204 SO against 36 BB.

LOOK BACK AT IT: The left-hander was named Padres Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2017 after pitching to a combined 11-7 record with a 2.20 ERA (34 ER, 139.0 IP), 148 SO against 33 BB and a .200 opponent batting average in 24 appearances (23 starts) between Lake Elsinore (A) and San Antonio (AA).

- Began the season with Lake Elsinore and earned California League Mid-Season All-Star honors, pitching to a 6-4 record with a 2.52 ERA (22 ER, 78.2 IP) and 95 SO against 19 BB.
- Promoted to San Antonio on 7/1 where he lowered his ERA, pitching to a 1.79 mark (12 ER, 60.1 IP) while
