WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost four of the last five games, six of 10 and 13 of 18 as they continue a six-game, seven-day homestand tonight vs. the Minnesota Twins.
- RHP Carson Fulmer, who has allowed just two earned runs in his last two starts (13.0 IP), is scheduled to start for Chicago.
- The Sox 9-20 (.310) mark is the fourth-worst in MLB ahead of Kansas City (9-22), Baltimore (8-23) and Cincinnati (7-24).
- The White Sox went 3-4 on their last trip, losing both games in St. Louis after winning three of five at Kansas City ... five of the seven games were decided by three runs or less.
- Following this four-game set vs. the Twins and an off day Monday, the Sox will conclude the homestand next Tuesday and Wednesday vs. the Pirates ... the club will then take a five-game trip to Wrigley Field (5/11-13) and Pittsburgh (5/15-16).
- The White Sox went 1-5 on their last homestand vs. Houston (0-3) and Seattle (1-2) from 4/20-25.

TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

- Chicago is off to its worst 29-game start since 1978 (also 9-20) ... the last time the club started with a 9-21 record was 1950.
- The White Sox 3-10 (.231) home record is the second-worst in the major leagues ahead of Cincinnati (3-12) ... they are looking to win consecutive home games for the first time since 9/27-28/17.
- Each of the Sox last four games have been one-run contests.
- Chicago has lost four of the last five games, six of the last nine and 10 of the last 15 vs. Minnesota.
- Carson Fulmer is 2-0 with a 1.38 ERA (2 ER/13.0 IP), .156 opponents average (7-45) and 0.85 WHIP in his last two starts.
- Daniel Palka is 7-16 (.438) with two doubles, one triple, two home runs and seven RBI over his last five games.

ROSTER MOVES

- The White Sox recalled LHP Jace Fry from Class AAA Charlotte and optioned RHP Juan Minaya to Charlotte.
- Fry owns a 1.35 ERA (1 ER/6.2 IP) and .125 opponents average (3-24) with 11 strikeouts and zero walks with the Knights this season ... he is limiting right-handers to a .077 average (1-13) and lefties to a .182 mark (2-11).
- Fry made 11 appearances with the Sox in 2017.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- Trayce Thompson hit a game-ending, solo home run off Addison Reed in the bottom of the ninth inning to cap the White Sox 6-5, comeback win over Minnesota.
- The Twins held an early 5-1 lead before the Sox scored two runs in the fourth and single runs in the fifth and sixth ... Matt Davidson recorded a game-tying double in the sixth.
- Starter Reynaldo López received a no decision after allowing five runs (four earned) on six hits with two walks and zero strikeouts in 6.2 IP ... he retired nine of the final 10 Twins he faced.
- Four Chicago relievers combined to allow just one hit over 2.1 scoreless IP ... Nate Jones (0.2 IP) earned his second win.
- Daniel Palka connected on his second home run.

TRAYCE AT THE BUZZER

- Trayce Thompson last night connected on his third career game-ending home run, and first for the White Sox this season ... three of his five hits with the Sox in 2018 are home runs.
- He previously hit walkoff shots on 5/10/16 vs. the Mets (pinch hitter) and 6/7/16 vs. Colorado with the Los Angeles Dodgers.
- His brother, Golden State Warriors guard Klay Thompson, is 1-7 (14.3 percent) on shots to take the lead in the final seven seconds of regulation or overtime ... his only career game-winning buzzer-beater came on 3/4/14 vs. Indiana.

PUT AWAY THE SUITCASE

- The White Sox currently are in a stretch playing 17 of 19 games in Chicago, including 14 at Guaranteed Rate Field, from 5/3-24.
- Following this six-game homestand vs. Minnesota and Pittsburgh, the Sox will play three games at Wrigley Field (5/11-13) and four-game series vs. Texas (5/17-20) and Baltimore (5/21-24).
- The club's only road games are at the Pirates from 5/15-16.
- Chicago has been outscored, 69-40, at Guaranteed Rate Field.

MINOR-LEAGUE MOMENTS

- Class AAA Charlotte RHP Donn Roach received a ND last night at Columbus despite allowing two runs on six hits in 7.0 IP.
- Roach has allowed two runs or less in five of his six outings, and has worked at least 6.0 IP in all six starts.
- Class A Winston-Salem LF Luis Basabe and DH Micker Adolfo both homered in last night's 5-3 win vs. Lynchburg ... Drew Hasler, son of Sox bullpen coach Curt Hasler, earned the win.
- Adolfo leads the Carolina League with six home runs, and Basabe is tied for second with five.

WHITE SOX VS. MINNESOTA

- The season series is tied, 1-1, with 17 games remaining.
- The White Sox are hitting .167/.219/.300 with two homers, own a 3.71 ERA (7 ER/17.0 IP) and have been outscored, 9-6.
- Games from 4/13-15 were postponed (rain and snow) ... the 4/13 game was rescheduled as a straight DH on 6/5 (Game 1 at 3:10 p.m.) ... 4/14 was rescheduled as a split DH on 9/28 (1:10 p.m.; 7:10 p.m.) ... 4/15 was rescheduled for 8/20 at 6:10 p.m.
- The Sox have lost four of the last five games, 10 of the last 15, and are 12-20 in the last 32 at Target Field.
- Chicago went 7-12 vs. Minnesota in 2017 (4-6 at Guaranteed Rate Field) to fall to 3-12-2 in the last 17 season matchups.
- The White Sox trail in the all-time series, 426-474 ... they are 231-218 at home (117-99 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 195-256 on the road (36-41 at Target Field).

TWIN CITY CONNECTIONS

- Below is a breakdown of White Sox players and coaches who previously played for the Minnesota Twins:
 - ◆ LHP Héctor Santiago: Pitched for Minnesota from 2016-17.
 - ◆ OF Daniel Palka: Played in the Twins organization from 2016-17.
 - ◆ Pitching Coach Don Cooper: Pitched for the Twins from 1981-82.
 - ◆ Bullpen Catcher Mark Salas: Played for Minnesota from 1985-87.
- The following Twins previously played for the White Sox: LHP Zach Duke (2015-16), INF Eduardo Escobar (2011-12) and RHP Addison Reed (2011-13).

ONE (RUN) AND DONE

- Chicago has gone 4-9 in one-run games in 2018, the second-most in the major leagues behind Tampa Bay (5-10) ... the nine one-run losses also are the second-most in baseball.
- The White Sox have scored one run or less eight times this season, tied for the fifth-most in baseball.
- The Sox were 21-23 in one-run games in 2017.

LOOKING FOR CENTRAL COMMAND

- The White Sox are 6-6 against the American League Central in 2018 after going 33-43 (.434) last season.
- Chicago has lost eight of its last 11 games vs. the AL Central at Guaranteed Rate Field, being outscored 66-41.
- The Sox are 297-383 vs. the AL Central since 2009, posting a losing record every season except 2012 (37-35).

STOP! THIEF!

- The White Sox lead the American League and rank second in baseball with 29 stolen bases ... the club ranks seventh in the major leagues with an 80.6 (29-36) success rate.
- Tim Anderson (2nd, 9), Leury García (T6th, 5), Adam Engel (T6th, 5) and Yoán Moncada (T13th, 4) rank among AL leaders.
- The Sox are on pace to steal 162 bases this season ... by comparison, they stole 71 bases in 2017 and 77 in 2016.

WHAT A (STAT)CAST!

- A number of White Sox players rank among the MLB Statcast leaders in 2018 ... a breakdown of categories and Sox rankings:
 - ◆ Average Exit Velocity (MPH): Yoán Moncada (8th, 94.9); José Abreu (T13th, 94.5).
 - ◆ Exit Velocity on fly balls and line drives: Matt Davidson (8th, 99.6); Abreu (T9th, 99.4).
 - ◆ Individual Home Run Distance: Avisail García (2nd, 481 ft.).
 - ◆ Hard Hit Percentage: Moncada (10th, 56.9); Abreu (11th, 56.0).
 - ◆ Barrels/Fair Batted Balls: Davidson (5th, 21.7); Moncada (6th, 21.5).

LEADOFF MAN

- Yoán Moncada is hitting .280/.368/.540 (28-100) with six doubles, one triple, six home runs, 15 RBI, four stolen bases and 14 walks in 24 games as the leadoff hitter this season.
- He ranks second among AL leadoff hitters in SLG, is tied for second in HR, ranks third in OPS (.915) and tied for fourth in RBI.
- Moncada hit leadoff homers in consecutive team games on 4/26-27, becoming just the fourth White Sox to accomplish the feat, joining Adam Eaton (6/25-26/16), Alejandro De Aza (5/8-10/13) and Kenny Lofton (7/18-19/02) ... source: STATS LLC.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,326 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, four more than the second-place New York Mets (1,322) and 45 more than Oakland (1,281), the next-closest American League team.
- The Sox are 5-6 when starters make a QS this season.

NO RISP, NO REWARD

- The White Sox rank 12th in the American League with a .214 (51-238) average with runners in scoring position this season.
- Chicago is hitting .271 (32-118) with RISP in the last 15 games, up from .158 (19-120) over their first 14 ... the Sox have been limited to two hits or less with RISP 22 times (zero hits nine times).

FULMER AT A GLANCE

- The 24-year-old makes his seventh appearance (sixth start) of the season, third start at Guaranteed Rate Field.
- Is 2-0 with a 1.38 ERA (2 ER/13.0 IP) and .156 (7-45) opponents average over his last two starts.
- Made his first career Opening Day roster.
- Was drafted by the White Sox in the first round (eighth overall) of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University.
- Led Vanderbilt to the 2014 College World Series Title ... started the deciding Game 3 of the finals against Virginia on three days rest, allowing two runs (one earned) on five hits over 5.1 IP of a no decision.
- Bio is on pages 81-82 of the 2018 White Sox media guide.

LAST START

- Earned his second consecutive win of the season on 4/28-1 at Kansas City ... tossed a career-high 7.0 scoreless IP, giving up four hits with three strikeouts ... won consecutive starts for the first time in his career.
- Retired 10 consecutive batters from the first to the fourth inning.
- Left the game with the White Sox leading, 8-0, after throwing a career-high 109 pitches (61 strikes) ... the Sox won, 8-0.

TURNING IT AROUND

- Is 2-0 with six strikeouts over his last two starts ... his 1.38 ERA (2 ER/13.0 IP) is tied for the third-lowest in the American League since 4/23.
- Was 0-1 with a 7.50 ERA (10 ER/12.0 IP) in his first four appearances (three starts)

NIGHT AND DAY

- Is 1-0 with a 3.65 ERA (5 ER/12.1 IP) and .208 (10-48) opponents average over three night appearances (two starts) this season, compared to 1-1 with a 4.97 ERA (7 ER/12.2 IP) and .280 (14-50) opponents average over three day starts.

2017 REVIEW

- Spent most of the season with Class AAA Charlotte before finishing the season in the White Sox rotation.
- Went 2-1 with a 4.34 ERA (9 ER/18.2 IP), .200 opponents average (14-70) and 16 strikeouts over five starts with the Sox ... also made two relief appearances (1-0; 1.93 ERA).
- Earned his first career win as a starter on 9/10 vs. San Francisco, allowing just one run on three hits with a career-high nine strikeouts over 6.0 IP.
- Made his second straight quality start on 9/15 at Detroit but received a no decision (1 ER/6.0 IP).
- Finished the season ranked by MLB.com as the No.9 Prospect in the White Sox system.
- Went 2-0 with a 1.56 ERA (3 ER/17.1 IP), 16 strikeouts, a 1.04 WHIP and .146 (10-61) opponents average over his final four starts of 2017.

MINOR-LEAGUE CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Went 13-19 with a 4.96 ERA (139 ER/252.0 IP) and 226 strikeouts in 55 starts over three minor-league seasons in the White Sox organization.
- Earned his first career win on 4/23/16 at Chattanooga (6.0 scoreless IP) ... struck out 10 batters on 6/9/16 vs. Mobile and again on 7/6/16 at Chattanooga.
- Entering the 2016 season, was rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 2 Prospect and Possessing the Best Curveball in the White Sox system ... was also tabbed by MLB.com as the No. 2 Prospect in the Sox system, the No. 42 in baseball and No. 9 among right-handers.

VS. MINNESOTA TWINS

- Is making his third career appearance (second start) against the Minnesota Twins ... is 0-1 with a 21.00 ERA (7 ER/3.0 IP) lifetime against the Twins.
- Suffered the loss in his only career start on 8/21-2/17 at Guaranteed Rate Field (6 ER/1.1 IP) ... allowed one run over 1.2 IP in his first career appearance on 7/31/16 at Target Field

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER

- LHP Hector Santiago (0-0, 3.48) is scheduled to make his ninth appearance and second start of the season and first at Guaranteed Rate Field.
- Did not receive the decision ... allowed two runs on five hits with three walks and five strikeouts over 4.2 IP.
