### SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Tyson Ross** tossed his 11th quality start of the season tonight, which entered the game tied for the eighth-most in the National League...the Padres are 8-3 when he has a quality outing and 11-8 overall in his starts.
  - Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in nine of his 10 career starts vs. the Dodgers while receiving one run of support or less in eight of those 10 outings.
  - His 3.32 run support average (runs scored while he's in the game) entered the day as the fourth-lowest among qualifying NL starters, while his 40 total runs of support entered the day as the sixth-fewest among ML starters (min. 100.0 IP).
- **Wil Myers** has reached base safely in six straight games, batting .417 (10-for-24) with six homers, nine RBI, four walks and a .500 OBP in that time...has gone 18-for-48 (.375) over his last 13 games with four doubles, one triple, seven homers, 16 RBI and a .938 slugging percentage.
  - Recorded his fourth multi-hit performance over his last eight games and his second three-hit game in that time (also, July 7 at ARI).
  - Tallied two doubles tonight, his second such game of the season (also, April 23 at COL).
- **Austin Hedges** has hit safely over his last seven starts (.417, 10-for-24)...is hitting .400 (10-for-25) over eight games in July.
- **Jose Pirela** has hit in six of his last nine games vs. LAD since May 5, batting .367 (11-for-30) with three doubles.

### LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Dodgers have won eight of 11 games played in July and 35 of their last 51 games since May 24...their .676 winning percentage since the start of June entered the day as the best in the National League in that time.
- With the win, the Dodgers have secured the series-victory over the Padres and have won nine of their last 13 contests vs. the Friars.
- **Ross Stripling** earned his second-consecutive winning decision and his eighth of the season...has pitched to a 4-2 record in seven starts on the road with a 2.19 ERA (9 ER, 37.0 IP) with 42 strikeouts against four walks.
- **Matt Kemp** has gone 5-for-11 as a pinch-hitter this season with five RBI and is hitting .441 (30-for-68) with RISP...in 13 games this year vs. San Diego, is hitting .435 (20-for-46) with eight runs, one double, four homers and 15 RBI.
- **Joc Pederson** snapped an 0-for-20 slump with a double in the sixth inning...logged his first multi-hit game since July 1 vs. COL.
- **Kenley Jansen** recorded his 26<sup>th</sup> save on the season, which ranks first in the NL.
