**RED HOT REDBIRDS:** The Cardinals are 28-16 post All-Star Break and 29-16 under manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15. The Cardinals and Oakland have the most wins in MLB since the All-Star Break (28), while St. Louis .636 winning percentage ranks 3rd in MLB, over that period. St. Louis has won 18-of-their-last-25 games overall, including a season-best eight-game winning streak from August 7-15. Entering July 15, the Cardinals had T9th-most wins in the National League (47) and currently have the T3rd-most wins (77) in the N.L.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The Cardinals are at 15 games over .500 entering play today and currently reside in 3rd place in the NL Central, 5.5 games out of first place and hold the 2nd spot in the NL Wild Card standings, trailing Milwaukee by 1.5 games. The Cardinals currently carry the T3rd-best record in the National League and have 3 games remaining against a team ahead of them in the standings, the Chicago Cubs.

**MOLINA NOMINATED FOR ROBERTO CLEMENTE AWARD:** Catcher **Yadier Molina** today was been named the Cardinals 2018 nominee for the prestigious Roberto Clemente Award, which recognizes a player from each MLB Club who best represents the game of Baseball through extraordinary character, community involvement, philanthropy and positive contributions, both on and off the field. It is the most prominent individual player award bestowed by MLB. Previous Cardinals to win the Roberto Clemente Award include **Carlos Beltran** (2013), **Albert Pujols** (2008), **Ozzie Smith** (1995) and **Lou Brock** (1975).

**WAINWRIGHT TO BE ACTIVATED AND START MONDAY:** **Adam Wainwright** is scheduled to be activated from the 60-day disabled list and start for the Cardinals in Monday's homestand opener against the Pirates. The 37-year-old and former three-time National League All-Star has hurled 17.0 scoreless innings over six rehab starts at three different minor league levels, most recently throwing five shutout innings and striking out seven for Memphis (AAA) last Saturday. Wainwright has missed the last 100 games with right elbow inflammation, last appearing for St. Louis on May 13 at San Diego.

**EXTRA, EXTRA:** The Cardinals have played 15 extra-inning games this season (7-8 record), T6th-most in the NL and most since 16 in the 2015 season (8-8 record). This season, St. Louis has played back-to-back extra-inning games on three occasions this season. The last time the Cardinals played consecutive extra-inning games on three occasions was 2006, when the club played extra-inning affairs (all wins) in three in a row against the Astros (July 8-9) and Dodgers (July 13), sandwiched around the All-Star Break.

**POSTCARDS:** Three Cardinals full season minor league affiliates begin postseason play, as the Cardinals organization finished with an overall record of 492-402 and .550 winning percentage that ranked 3rd behind Tampa Bay (.604) and Houston (.562). Tonight, the defending Florida State co-champion **Palm Beach Cardinals** (High-A) begin a best-of-three series with the Fort Myers Miracle (Twins) in Fort Myers in the FSL Semifinals. On Wednesday, the defending PCL Champion **Memphis Redbirds** (AAA) travel to Oklahoma City to face the Dodgers for the first two games of the best-of-five PCL Semifinals, while the **Peoria Chiefs** (A) host the Quad City River Bandits (Astros) in the first game of a best-of-three Midwest League Quarterfinals.

**DANCING IN SEPTEMBER:** Since the turn of the decade in 2010, the Cardinals have posted a stretch of winning Septembers, going 135-99 (.577) in the month, trailing only Cleveland (137-99, .581) and Washington (136-98, .581).

**WITHIN STRIKING DISTANCE:** Cardinals outfielder **José Martínez** ranks T4th in the NL batting title race with a .309 batting average. **Scouter Gennett** of the Reds currently leads the Senior Circuit with a .320 average. The last Cardinal to lead the NL in batting was **Albert Pujols** (.359) in 2003. Martínez's .312 career batting average ranks 17th in Cardinals history among players with 800 or more PA.

**MOLINA MILESTONES:** Cardinals catcher **Yadier Molina** passed **Lance Parrish** for 12th all-time in games played with 1,819 on Sunday, and needs 10 starts at catcher to tie **Brad Ausmus** (1,766) for 10th all-time among catchers in MLB history. The veteran backstop needs one hit to tie **Bob Boone** for 13th place among catchers in hits (1,838).

**PITCHING IN:** Cardinals pitchers have an MLB-leading five home runs (**John Gant** 2, **Miles Mikolas** 2, **Carlos Martínez** 1) and have knocked in an MLB-best 20 RBI this season. Last season's Cardinals pitchers led MLB with 30 RBI and the 2016 crew finished 2nd with 31. The Cardinals have three pitchers in the Top 10 in RBI among pitchers this season (T3. **Mikolas** - 5; T7. **Gomber** & **C. Martínez** - 4).

**Tyson Ross'** younger brother, **Joe Ross**, is a pitcher for the Nationals (2015-17).

Cardinals pitcher **Brett Cecil** was born in Dunkirk, Md...graduated from DeMatha High School in nearby Hyattsville...2004 NHBSCA and Maryland Louisville Slugger Player of the Year...pitched three seasons at the University of Maryland (2005-07)...left school as the Terrapins single-season (13) and career saves (23) leader and single-season appearance leader (30).

**Matt Adams** played in 94 games for the Nationals this season before the Cardinals claimed him off waivers (August 21, 2018).

**Tyler Webb** was born in Nassawadox, Va...graduated from Northampton High School in Eastville, Va.

**John Gant** made his Major League debut against the Nationals (April 6, 2016) while with the Atlanta Braves...his first career MLB strikeout was Wilson Ramos (swinging).

Cardinals pitching coach **Mike Maddux** served in the same role with the Nationals for two seasons (2016-17)...also pitched parts of two seasons (1998-99) for the Expos.

Cardinals bullpen coach **Bryan Eversgerd** pitched in 25 games for Montreal in 1995.

**Greg Holland** appeared in 32 games for St. Louis this season.

**Max Scherzer** is a native of Chesterfield, Mo...graduated from Parkway Central (Mo.) High School...originally selected by St. Louis in the 43rd of the 2003 MLB Draft, but did not sign...pitched at the University of Missouri (2005-07).

**Mark Reynolds** played in 140 games for the Cardinals in 2015.

Cardinals Senior Special Assistant to the GM **Bob Gebhard** was a player/coach in the Montreal organization from 1974-75...coached in Montreal's system through 1986, including on the Major League coaching staff in 1982.

Nationals Bench Coach **Chip Hale** played in 132 games for Memphis (AAA) in the Cardinals organization during his final season (1998).

Nationals Pitching Coach **Derek Lilliquist** spent 16 years in the Cardinals organization, serving as St. Louis' pitching coach (2012-17), bullpen coach (2011-12), minor league pitching coordinator (2008-10), and pitching coach for Palm Beach (2004-07), Peoria (2003), and pitching coach and Johnson City (2002).

Nationals broadcaster **Bob Carpenter** worked 10 seasons with the Cardinals on both radio and television before joining Washington...graduated from nearby McBride (Mo.) High School...his sister, **Judy Carpenter-Barada**, serves as the Cardinals Director of Major League Administration.

Nationals broadcaster **Charlie Slowes** worked three years at KMOX (1984-86).

**TONIGHT'S GAME**

- Makes his 15th start of the season (22nd appearance) and 24th career Major League start (49th career appearance).
- Since August 8, ranks 7th among N.L. pitchers in opp BA (.168), 10th in ERA (1.59), T4th in wins (3) and 8th in H/9 IP (5.72).
- Has allowed one run in his last two starts (11.2 IP), a pinch-hit solo home run to Matt Holliday (COL) at Coors Field on August 25 in a no decision matching his career-high with 7.0 innings.
- Was 3-1 with a 3.06 ERA in six starts for the Cardinals in the month of August.
- Is 4-5 with 3.48 ERA (29 ER/75.0 IP) in 14 starts for St. Louis, averaging 7.7 strikeouts/9 IP (64 K).
- Is 2-0 with a 2.70 ERA in seven relief appearances (16.2 IP).
- Is limiting the opposition to a .206 BAA (70-339) this season & he sports a .209 Opp. BAA (58-277) as a starting pitcher. Opp. are hitting just .182 (323-176) at Busch Std.
- Six of the 7 HR's he's allowed this season have been hit by left-handers: Odúbel Herrera, Freddie Freeman, Pablo Sandoval, Tucker Barnhart, Ben Zobrist & Anthony Rizzo.
- Features a split-finger change-up nicknamed the "Vulcan" due to his unique four-finger grip. Has highest pct. of swing & miss (4.1) on a change-up of any Cardinals pitcher.

- Threw 5.2 scoreless IP vs. PIT allowing three hits and three walks with six strikeouts.
- Also hit his 2nd home run of the season, a solo shot as part of back-to-back jacks with Harrison Bader.
