

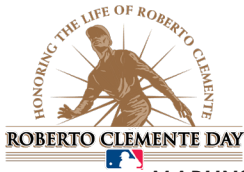

### FISH BITES

Miami concludes the second series of this six-game homestand with the finale of this three-game set against the Philadelphia Phillies tonight at 7:10 p.m. RHP **Sandy Alcantara** is making just his second career start tonight, his first career appearance against the Phillies. Philadelphia is countering with RHP Nick Pivetta, who in six career starts against Miami has gone 2-1 with a 5.83 ERA; is 1-0 with a 1.54 ERA in two starts against the Marlins this season. The Marlins began their current homestand by dropping two of three to the Toronto Blue Jays. Miami returned a week ago tomorrow following a two-game sweep at the hands of the Boston Red Sox. Prior to that series, the Marlins split a six-game homestand against the Yankees (1-1) and Braves (2-2). **Programming note:** the Marlins will have four remaining games moved to 610AM WIOD; September 8 vs. Pittsburgh, Sept. 15 vs. Philadelphia, Sept. 22 vs. Cincinnati, and Sept. 29 vs. Mets.

### LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

Miami found itself down four runs before even stepping to the plate, eventually falling to the Philadelphia Phillies, 4-9. In the bottom of the first, **J.T. Realmuto** stroked a two-out solo home run, his 19th of the season, to right field. The Marlins didn't score until the fifth, when **Starlin Castro** drove in a run with a single to center, and **Derek Dietrich** knocked in a run with a groundout to first. Realmuto homered again in the eighth, marking his fifth career multi-home run game, to round out the scoring for Miami. **Rafael Ortega**, Castro, and Realmuto had two hits each in the top three spots in the order, and **Miguel Rojas** also added a two-hit game from the seventh spot. **Trevor Richards** was touched for six runs and four hits, while walking four and striking out two, over 1.1 innings.

### ROBERTO CLEMENTE DAY

Major League Baseball yesterday announced the Club nominees for the 2018 Roberto Clemente Award, given annually to recognize those players who best represent the game of Baseball through extraordinary character, community involvement, philanthropy and positive contributions, both on and off the field. **Martin Prado** is the Marlins nominee and will be recognized in a pregame ceremony prior to tonight's game. Starting today, fans can vote for the overall winner of the Roberto Clemente Award via a dedicated website. The site will feature bios of each of the nominees and will allow fans to vote from Roberto Clemente Day on Wednesday, September 5th, until Tuesday, September 18th. The winner of the fan vote will count as one vote among those cast by the blue ribbon panel. ### VS. PHILADELPHIA

Miami trails the season series, 6-9, however they guaranteed a home season series win, its first against Philadelphia since going 6-3 in 2014. The Marlins are 112-104 overall in South Florida (34-30 at Marlins Park), yet trail the all-time series, 193-238.

### UP NEXT

Following tomorrow's off-day, the Marlins will open a three-game set in the Steel City beginning Friday at 7:05 p.m. Miami trails the 2018 series, 1-2, following a three-game series at Marlins Park from April 13-15. The Marlins are 36-61 in Pittsburgh, and trail the all-time series, 90-102.

### CATCH & HIT

**J.T. Realmuto** hit his 19th and 20th home runs of the season last night, extending his single-season career high, while also extending his current hitting streak to eight games. His 17 home runs as a catcher rank as the second-most by a Marlins backstop in Club history, two behind Charles Johnson's 19 in 1997. His 59 RBI when behind the plate are the fourth-most in a single season in Marlins history, behind Ivan Rodriguez (82 in 2003) and Johnson (69 in 2001 and 63 in 1997). Realmuto ranks second among qualified MLB catchers in slugging percentage (.501), behind Wilson Ramos (.502); is tied for second in home runs with Yadier Molina, behind Yasmani Grandal (22); and ranks third in RBI this season, behind Grandal (62) and Molina (61).

### MPH

**Sandy Alcantara** is making his second career start this evening and first since being recalled by Miami on September 1. He made his first career start on June 29 vs. the Mets, earning the win after limiting New York to one run and three hits, while walking five and striking out two, over 5.0 innings. His win was the first of two consecutive wins by Marlins rookies making their first career MLB start; **Pablo López** beat Jacob deGrom and the Mets the following night. The pair became the first set of teammates to earn wins in their first career starts in consecutive days since April 9-10, 2012, when Yu Darvish and Neftali Feliz each made their first career starts with the Rangers. The last National League team to have such a duo was the Reds on April 15-16, 1967 with Gary Nolan and Mel Queen. - Stats LLC

### PUTTING IT TOGETHER

Over their last 19 home games since July 28, the Marlins have posted a 3.05 ERA (177.0 ip/60 er) to mark the third-lowest ERA among National League staffs (seventh in MLB) at home in that span. They have limited opponents to a .214 average against, tops in the NL and third in the Majors. Starters have allowed three-or-fewer runs 16 times, including 12 starts of two-or-less runs allowed, and posted a 2.81 ERA (105.2/33), while the bullpen has allowed 27 earned runs over 71.1 innings pitched for a 3.41 ERA.

### HOT CORNER IS ON FIRE

Marlins third basemen have yet to commit an error over their last 80 games, marking the longest errorless streak at third in Franchise history. Martin Prado has made 25 starts at third in that time, while Miguel Rojas has made 24 starts (27 appearances), Brian Anderson 18 starts (23 appearances), and Yadiel Rivera 13 starts (23 appearances). Miami third basemen lead the Majors in fielding percentage with a .979 mark, committing just seven miscues in 335 total chances.

### ALL AROUND ANDY

**Brian Anderson** leads all Major League rookies in games (138), at-bats (528), runs (76), average with RISP (.373), and on-base percentage (.354); ranks second in hits (143), doubles (30), walks (55), and multi-hit games (42); ranks third in RBI (58) and average (.271); is tied for third in triples (3); fourth in slugging (.396); and tied for 12th in HR (10). On the defensive side, he leads all rookie outfielders with a .994 fielding percentage, committing just one error in 176 total chances. He also owns eight outfield assists, most among all ML rookie outfielders and just four off the Major League lead held by Billy Hamilton. His five total errors this season are fifth-fewest by a NL rookie (min. 60 GS), and he is the only rookie on that list to spend significant time at two different positions (45 GS at 3B; 89 GS in RF).

Sandy Alcantara, recalled on September 1, is making his second start with Miami this season in the finale of this three-game set against Philadelphia. In 19 starts at Triple-A New Orleans, posted 6-3 record and 3.89 ERA (115.2 ip/50 er). Also had three rehab starts at Single-A Jupiter, where he had no record and a 3.97 ERA (11.1/5).

Reached 6.0-innings pitched in 12 of his 19 starts with New Orleans, including six of 7.0-or-more. Tossed season-high 8.0 innings on May 17 vs. Round Rock, limiting Express to two runs on five hits.

At the time of his most recent promotion, ranked seventh in the Pacific Coast League in ERA (3.89). Among PCL leaders, ranked second in average against (.246), third in WHIP (1.25), and fewest baserunners per 9.0 (11.67).

Had a season-high eight strikeouts in season opener on April 7 vs. Nashville (4.2 ip).

Tonight will mark his first career start and appearance against Philadelphia.

Made season debut with Miami on June 29, making his first Major League start against the Mets here at Marlins Park. Allowed just one run on three hits with five walks and two strikeouts over 5.0 innings.

The night after his debut, Pablo López made his first career Major League start and also earned a win. The pair became the first set of teammates to earn wins in their first career starts in consecutive days since April 9-10, 2012, when Yu Darvish and Neftali Feliz each made their first career starts with the Rangers. The last National League team to have such a duo was the Reds on April 15-16, 1967 with Gary Nolan and Mel Queen. - *Stats LLC*

Made one start before being placed on the 10-day disabled list with a right axillary infection on July 4 (retro to July 1). Made three rehab starts at Single-A Jupiter, allowing six runs (five earned) over 11.1 innings before being reinstated and optioned to NOLA on July 30.

Made MLB debut with St. Louis on September 3, 2017 at San Francisco (0.2 ip, 2 h, r, er, bb, so). Made eight appearances out of the bullpen, with a long outing of 2.0 innings on Sept. 29 vs. Milwaukee (h, r, er, 2 bb, 2 so).

Spent majority of 2017 season at Double-A Springfield, while also making Major League debut after a September call-up.

Established professional highs in wins (7), appearances (33), and innings pitched (133.2). At Springfield, went 7-5 with 4.31 ERA (125.1 ip/60 er) in 25 appearances (22 starts).

Finished Double-A campaign going 5-1 with 2.64 ERA (78.1/23) over final 16 appearances (13 starts).

Is making his ninth career start and 12th appearance against Pittsburgh, posting a 3-3 record and 4.24 ERA (51.0/24). Last faced the Bucs on June 10, 2017 at PNC Park, where he allowed four runs, nine hits, and a walk, while striking out three, over 4.0 innings. Tonight will be his seventh career appearances (sixth start) at PNC Park, going 2-2 with a 4.71 ERA
