WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost six of the last eight games and 15 of the last 21 as they continue a season-long, 10-game trip tonight at Houston.
- Reynaldo López is scheduled to start for the White Sox, who are a season-high 27 games under .500.
- The Sox are 2-5 on this trip, losing last night's series opener at the Astros and two out of three at both Texas and Cincinnati.
- Following this four-game series at Minute Maid Park, the White Sox will return to Guaranteed Rate Field for a five-game, six-day homestand vs. St. Louis (7/10-11) and Kansas City (7/13-15).
- The Sox went 4-3 on their last homestand vs. Oakland (2-2) and Minnesota (2-1) and 0-3 on their last trip to Cleveland.

TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

- Chicago is 2-8 in its last nine road games (outscored 77-44).
- The White Sox have hit 19 home runs in the last 13 games after hitting just six in the previous 16 contests.
- The Sox have lost four straight games vs. Houston and six of the last seven ... they have scored three runs or less in all seven contests, and one or less four times.
- Reynaldo López is 2-1 with a 2.63 ERA (7 ER/24.0 IP), 22 strikeouts and a .222 opp. average in his last four road starts.
- Avisail García has hit six home runs over his last 10 games ... he has hit safely in 14 of his last 15 games, batting .354 (23-65) with three doubles, two triples, six home runs, 10 RBI, a 1.112 OPS and six multihit efforts.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- Yuli Gurriel hit a game-ending, RBI single in the bottom of the ninth off Joakim Soria to cap Houston's 4-3, comeback win.
- Chicago entered the bottom of the ninth up 3-2 but the Astros recorded two walks and two singles to set up Gurriel's heroics.
- The White Sox erased a two-run deficit in the sixth on Omar Narváez's solo homer and Yolmer Sánchez's RBI double ... Leury García gave the Sox the lead with a solo homer in the eighth.
- Carlos Rodón received a ND (2 ER/6.0 IP; 6 BB, 6 SO) and allowed a two-run home run to José Altuve ... Soria (BS, 3; L, 0-3) had his 15-game scoreless streak snapped.
- Narváez recorded the White Sox only multihit effort ... the Sox went 0-3 with RISP and left two runners on base.

ON THE MEND

- Chicago today sent OF Nicky Delmonico on a rehab assignment to Class AA Birmingham ... Barons play at 6:15 p.m. CT.
- Delmonico has been on the disabled list since 5/19 with a fractured third metacarpal on his right hand ... he suffered the injury after being hit by a Matt Moore pitch on 5/18 vs. Texas.

SEEING FUTURE STARS

- Class AA Birmingham RHP Dylan Cease (U.S. Team) and OF Luis Basabe (World Team) have been selected to play in the All-Star Futures Game on 7/15 at Nationals Park (3 p.m. CT).
- Cease is 9-2 with a 3.13 ERA (29 ER/83.1 IP) and 96 strikeouts over 15 starts between Class A Winston-Salem and Birmingham.
- Basabe is hitting .246/.346/.450 with 12 doubles, seven triples, nine homers and 32 RBI in 71 games with the Dash and Barons.
- Former White Sox manager Jerry Manuel will serve as the bench coach for the World Team.

WELCOME TO THE (MiLB) SHOW

- INF Nick Madrigal last night made his professional debut with the Arizona Rookie League White Sox, going 0-1 with two HBP.
- The White Sox yesterday signed Madrigal, their first-round pick to a minor-league contract with a \$6,411,400 signing bonus.
- Madrigal helped lead Oregon State to the 2018 national title.

HE'S ON FIRE ... AVI-OUSLY

- Avisail García last night had his 14-game hitting streak snapped ... the streak was the longest of his career, tied for the sixth-longest in MLB in 2018 and the longest by a White Sox in a season since Tim Anderson from 9/9-24/17 (15 games).
- He is 15-37 (.405) with three doubles, two triples, four homers and six RBI in his last eight games, and 20-59 (.339) with six home runs and nine RBI in 14 games since returning from the DL.

HOMER HAPPY

- The White Sox have hit 11 homers in the last six games and 19 in the last 13 ... Daniel Palka and Avisail García have combined to hit six of the Sox last nine home runs since Monday.
- Palka's home runs were estimated at 428, 448 and 432 feet, and García's at 376, 414 and 431 feet (MLB Statcast).
- Palka is tied for seventh in MLB with an average distance of 421 feet per homer this season ... he ranks third among rookies in the AL and is tied for fourth in MLB with 10 homers this season.

WHITE SOX VS. HOUSTON ASTROS

- Houston leads the season series, 4-0, including a sweep from 4/20-22 at Guaranteed Rate Field ... the Astros have outscored the White Sox, 31-5, in the four games this season.
- The Sox are batting .174/.248/.281 (21-121) with three home runs, and own a 7.90 ERA (31 ER/35.1 IP) with one QS in 2018.
- The Sox have lost six of the last seven games but are 6-6 in the last 12 and 12-10 in the last 22 ... Chicago is 6-6 in the last 12 games at Minute Maid Park.
- The Sox went 4-2 in 2017, including a 3-0 mark in Chicago.
- Chicago is 29-27 all-time, going 19-14 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 10-13 in Houston (9-11 at Minute Maid Park).
- Avisail García is a career .287 hitter (25-87) with three doubles, three homers and 10 RBI in 25 career games vs. the Astros.

WINDY AND SPACE CITY CONNECTIONS

- The White Sox swept the Astros in the 2005 World Series to capture the club's first title since 1917 ... Houston TV analyst Geoff Blum hit a game-winning HR in the 14th inning of Game 3.
- Houston's first-base coach, Álex Cintrón played for the White Sox from 2006-07 ... Gary Pettis, the Astros' third-base coach, served as the Sox first-base and outfield coach from 2001-02.
- Houston RHP Chris Devenski was selected by Chicago in the 25th round of the 2011 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

WILD WILD WEST

- The White Sox are 7-14 vs. the American League West in 2018, going 5-8 at home and 1-6 on the road ... they have won six of their last 12 games after losing eight of the first nine.
- Chicago has lost six of the last seven games and 12 of 16 on the road against the division ... the club has scored four runs or less 11 times and allowed seven-plus eight times.
- The Sox are 185-168 vs. the West since 2008 (77-95 on road).

PITO STILL FIRST AT FIRST

- José Abreu led American League first basemen in fan balloting for the Major League Baseball All-Star Game at the time of yesterday's final update ... voting at MLB.com ended last night.
- Starters/reserves will be announced this Sunday on the ASG Selection Show pres. by Camping World at 6 p.m. CT on ESPN.
- He would be the sixth Sox player (11th time) to be fan-elected as a starter, joining Thomas (1994-96), Carlton Fisk (1981-82), Richie Zisk (1977), Dick Allen (1972-74) and Luis Aparicio (1970).

BARRELING BACKSTOPS

- Omar Narváez and Kevan Smith are hitting a combined .352 (46-128) with six doubles, two home runs, 15 RBI and 14 multihit efforts in 35 games since 6/1 ... they have hit safely in 30 contests.
- Narváez (1st, .393) and Smith (T2nd, .333) lead all MLB catchers in average since 6/1 (min. 60 PAs) ... Smith is tied with Atlanta's Kurt Suzuki for second.
- Narváez owns eight multihit efforts and has hit safely in 14 games since 6/1 ... Smith has hit safely in 17 of his 18 games in 2018 since being recalled from Class AAA Charlotte on 6/5.

BULLPEN BREAKDOWN

- The Sox bullpen has allowed a run in nine straight games, recording a 5.19 ERA (20 ER/34.2 IP) and .224 opp. average.
- Joakim Soria has not allowed a run in 15 of his last 16 appearances (2 ER/15.2 IP; 19 SO), going 8-9 in save chances.
- Rookie Jace Fry owns a 2.63 ERA (8 ER/27.1 IP) with 33 strikeouts and a .146 (14-96) opp. average in 27 games in 2018.
- Xavier Cedeño has allowed just one earned run over 15 relief appearances (15 SO/12.0 IP) since joining the White Sox on 6/7.

TRIPLE THE FUN

- The White Sox rank second in the major leagues this season with 27 triples (Arizona is first with 31) ... the Sox led the AL with 37 triples last season, their most since 1999 (also 37).
- Yolmer Sánchez leads MLB with nine triples in 2018 after ranking sixth last season with eight.

STOP! THIEF!

- The Sox lead MLB with 69 stolen bases in 2018... the Sox are on pace to steal 128 bases, which would be their most since 2010 (160) ... they have not led MLB in steals since 1966 (153).
- Tim Anderson ranks second in the AL with 20 steals in 2018.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- Reynaldo López (T12th, 11) and James Shields (T12th, 11) rank in the Top 15 in the American League in QS in 2018.
- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,351 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, three more than the second-place New York Mets (1,348) and 43 more than Oakland (1,308), the next-closest American League team.

LÓPEZ AT A GLANCE

- The 24-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 18th start of the season, 11th on the road and second against the Houston Astros.
- Is 2-4 with a 4.50 ERA (27 ER/ 54.0 IP) in 10 road starts this season, but has gone 2-1 with a 2.63 ERA (7 ER/24.0 IP) over his last four on the road.
- Went 3-0 with a 4.62 ERA (13 ER/25.1 IP) over his final four starts of 2017 ... made his White Sox debut on 8/11/17 vs. Kansas City, receiving a no decision after allowing two runs with six strikeouts over 6.0 IP.
- Was named the White Sox Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July 2017 after posting a 2.10 ERA (7 ER/30.0 IP) with 38 strikeouts and a .183 (20-109) opponents average over five starts.
- Was acquired from Washington with RHPs Dane Dunning and Lucas Giolito in exchange for OF Adam Eaton on 12/7/16 ... originally was signed by the Nationals as a non-drafted free agent on 6/21/12.

LAST START

- Earned his second consecutive win and fourth this season on 7/1 at Texas ... allowed two runs on seven hits over 6.1 IP ... has gone at least 6.0 IP in five of his last six starts.
- Allowed an RBI single to Rougned Odor and walked Kiner-Falefa with the bases loaded in the fourth inning ... retired 10 of the first 12 batters he faced.
- Departed with the White Sox winning, 7-2, after tossing a career-high 114 pitches (76 strikes) ... the Sox went on to win, 10-5.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

- Is making his 20th career start on the road ... has gone 6-7 with a 4.95 ERA (53 ER/96.1 IP), 82 strikeouts and a .272 (102-375) opponents average in his career.
- Owns a 2-4 record with a 4.50 ERA (27 ER/54.0 IP) in 10 road starts this season, compared to 2-1 with a 2.72 ERA (14 ER/46.1 IP), 28 strikeouts and a .194 (32-165) opp. average in seven starts at home.
- Is 2-1 with a 2.63 ERA (7 ER/24.0 IP), with 22 strikeouts and a .222 (20-90) opponents average over his last four road starts.

ROUGH TIME FOR RIGHTIES

- Is limiting right-handers to a .224 average (38-170) this season ... Brian Dozier, John Hicks, Jordy Mercer and Josh Donaldson are the only righties to homer off López this season.
- By comparison, left-handers are hitting .246 (50-203) with five home runs this season.

MAKING HISTORY

- Is the first White Sox pitcher with 6.0-plus IP, two-or-fewer hits allowed, and one-or-fewer runs allowed in each of his first two starts of the season (source: Elias).
- Became the first White Sox starting pitcher since at least 1908 to lose a game in which he threw 7.0-plus IP while allowing two or less hits and one run which was unearned (source: Baseball Reference and STATS LLC) ... the last five pitchers to accomplish this feat:

2017 REVIEW

- Made eight starts with the White Sox in his first season with the organization ... went 1-2 with a 3.56 ERA (12 ER/3.0 IP) in five starts at home and 2-1 with a 6.75 mark (13 ER/17.1 IP) over three road starts.
- Five of his seven starts were quality ... went 2-2 with a 3.15 ERA (11 ER/30.1 IP) and 16 strikeouts in those outings.
- Worked a career-high tying 7.0 IP (four runs) in a win on 9/16 at Detroit ... allowed three runs in the second inning before limiting the Tigers to one run on five hits over his final 5.0 IP.
- Suffered his first loss with the White Sox on 8/17 at Texas, allowing six runs on five hits over 4.1 IP before exiting game with soreness on his right side.
- Was placed on the disabled list on 8/19 (retro to 8/18) with a back strain ... reinstated on 9/1, made the start that night vs. Tampa Bay (L; 3 ER/6.0 IP).
- Made 22 starts with Class AAA Charlotte, going 6-7 with a 3.79 ERA (51 ER/121.0 IP) and 131 strikeouts ... allowed two earned runs or less in seven of his final eight starts from 6/29-8/6 before being promoted.
- Entered the season ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 3 Prospect in the White Sox organization and No. 31 in baseball ... was rated by MLB.com as the No. 4 Prospect in the Sox system, No. 38 in baseball and the No. 9 right-handed pitching prospect.

PERSONAL NOTES

- His grandfather sold two cows in the Dominican Republic to buy him a used glove, a pair of cleats and an aluminum bat when he started playing baseball.

VS. AMERICAN LEAGUE WEST

- Is making his seventh career start against the American League West.
- Has gone 2-2 with a 3.79 ERA (15 ER/35.2 IP), 39 strikeouts and a .205 (27-132) opponents average in six starts against the division lifetime.

VS. HOUSTON ASTROS

- Is scheduled to make his second career start vs. the Houston Astros and first at Minute Maid Park.
- Received a no decision in his only start on 4/22 at Guaranteed Rate Field, allowing one run on four hits over 5.0 IP ... kept the Astros scoreless from the first-fourth inning until allowing a sacrifice RBI to Carlos Correa.

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER

- RHP James Shields (3-9, 4.12) is scheduled to make his 19th start of the season, seventh on the road and second against the Houston Astros.
- Is 1-4 with a 5.17 ERA (22 ER/38.1 IP) and .226 (33-146) opponents average over seven games (six starts) on the road this season.
- Received his seventh no decision of the season on 7/2 at Cincinnati, allowing one run on four hits over 6.2 IP.
- Is 2-3 with a 3.19 ERA (17 ER/48.0 IP), 55 strikeouts and a .243 (43-177) opponents average in seven career starts against Houston.
- Is 26-26 with a 3.83 ERA (214 ER/502.2 IP), 457 strikeouts and a .252 (484-1917) opponents average in 76 games (75 starts) against the American League West lifetime.
