## NATIONALS NEWS

### HE'S STREAKING

**Anthony Rendon** has reached base safely in a career-high 29 straight games dating to Aug. 21...It is the longest active streak in Major League Baseball and is the fourth-longest streak in the National League this season...**Christian Yelich** is third on the list with a 30-game streak from Aug. 11 to Sept. 15...During the streak, Rendon is hitting .345 with a .430 on-base percentage and a .595 slugging percentage.

- Rendon enters Saturday having posted at least one RBI in six straight games...His six-game streak is the longest active streak in MLB and the seventh-longest streak in the National League this season...
- **Anthony Rizzo's** eight-game streak is the longest in the NL and is tied with **Justin Upton** for the longest streak in MLB this season.
- During this streak, Rendon is 12-for-24 (.500) with one double, three homers, 12 RBI, four walks and six runs scored.
- On the season, Rendon ranks in the NL in doubles (T2nd, 40), average (6th, .305), slugging percentage (10th, .521), extra-base hits (10th, 63) and OPS (10th, .890).
- Since 2016, his 119 doubles rank second in the National League behind **Nick Markakis** (120) and are fourth in all of Major League Baseball behind **Jose Ramirez** (139), **Mookie Betts** (132) and Markakis.

### EVERYDAY TREA

**Trea Turner** has played in each of Washington's 154 games this season, making 150 starts and four appearances off the bench...The only player in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to appear in all 162 games in a season was **Ryan Zimmerman**, who started all 162 games in 2007.

- If Turner starts each of the eight games left on the schedule, he will tie **Alfonso Soriano** (158 in 2006) for second on the list behind Zimmerman's 162 starts in 2007.
- Turner enters Saturday riding a 21-game on-base streak dating to Aug. 29...It is tied for the longest streak of his career behind a 21-game run from Aug. 10 to Sept. 2, 2016.
- With one more stolen base, Turner will tie **Ian Desmond** (122) for the most stolen bases as a National (2005-pres.).

### CHASING 100-100-100

**Bryce Harper** enters Saturday with 97 runs scored, 97 RBI and 124 walks in 2018...He is looking to become the sixth player since 2014 to record at least 100 runs, RBI and walks in a season...He would join **Joey Votto** (2017), **Aaron Judge** (2017), **Mike Trout** (2016), **Paul Goldschmidt** (2015) and **Jose Bautista** (2015, 2014).

- On the season, he ranks in the National League in HR (T2nd, 34), OBP (6th, .391), runs (T5th, 97), RBI (6th, 97), XBH (11th, 62) and OPS (12th, .885).
- His 124 walks lead MLB and are one short of his career-high (124 in 2015).

### JUAN SOTO THINGS

**Juan Soto** is on pace to have one of the best seasons for a teenager in Major League Baseball history...See boxes to the right and additional note sheets about Soto's 2018 season.

### BEST OF THE BEST

Since the All-Star break, Washington's offense ranks in the National League in on-base percentage (1st, .346), batting average (1st, .262), doubles (1st, 111), stolen bases (1st, 44), runs (2nd, 303), walks (2nd, 239), OPS (2nd, .781) and slugging percentage (3rd, .432).

- Washington's second-half surge has placed them among the top five NL offenses in 2018 in on-base percentage (2nd, .331), runs (4th, 720), home runs (5th, 181), slugging percentage (5th, .413) and OPS (5th, .744).

### ALL HANDS ON DECK

The Nationals have used 53 players in 2018, tied for the third-most in the National League this season and the fourth-most in Nationals history (2005-pres...). The 2006 Nationals used 57 players, while the 2009 and 2005 Nationals each used 55.

- 31 different players have toed the rubber for Washington, the most in a season in Nationals history and tied for the fourth-most in the National League this season.

## NATIONALS HISTORY

### September 22 (6-5 on this date)

2006 – **Ryan Zimmerman**, via a third-inning RBI-single off **Orlando Hernandez**, reached the 100 RBI mark for the first time, becoming just the third NL rookie in 53 years to accomplish the feat (**Mike Piazza**, 1993, **Albert Pujols**, 2001).

## DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

**#50 - AUSTIN VOTH - RHP**

Washington's 2015 Minor League Pitcher of the Year has struck out 8.3 batters per 9.0 innings across 129 Minor League games...Was originally selected in the fifth round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Washington...Last name pronounced like "both."

**AGAINST THE METS:** Faces the Mets for the second time this season...Make his Major League debut on July 14 at Citi Field (4.1 IP, 9 H, 7 ER, HR, 3 BB, 3 SO)...Struck out the first batter he faced, Brandon Nimmo, for his first Major League strikeout.

**LAST START:** Today marks his second start of the season.

**2018 NOTES**

- Appeared out of Washington's bullpen on Sept. 14 at Atlanta (1.0 IP).
- Was recalled from Triple-A Syracuse on on Sept. 4 for his fourth Major League stint of the season.
- In his last five starts of the Triple-A season, went 2-0 with a 3.16 ERA (11 ER/31.1 IP)...Struck out 31 batters against eight walks...Held opposing batters to a .195 average (22-for-113).
- Was recalled on July 10 and eventually made his MLB debut on July 14...Pitched to a 1.62 ERA (6 ER/33.1 IP) while going 1-2 in his last five starts prior that...Has struck out 27, walked seven and surrendered just one home run.
- Went 6-8 with a 4.37 ERA and 117 strikeouts in 24 Triple-A starts...His 117 strikeouts ranked fourth among Nationals farmhands and tied for sixth in the International League...Also ranked eighth in the International League with a 1.20 WHIP.
- Tossed at least 6.0 innings in 12 of his 24 starts and 7.0 innings four times...In his four starts of 7.0 innings, pitched to a 1.29 ERA (4 ER/28.0 IP).
- Started out strong in 2018, going 2-0 with a 0.76 ERA (2 ER/23.2 IP) and 30 strikeouts against just three walks in his first five starts...Opposing batters hit .157 (13-for-83) during this stretch..

**2017 NOTES**

- Went 4-12 with a 5.94 ERA in 24 starts between three levels of Washington's system.

**2016 NOTES**

- Advanced to Triple-A Syracuse for the first time in his career.Ranked third in the International League and third in Washington's system with a 3.15 ERA.
- His 133 strikeouts were tied for the most among Nationals farmhands and tied for fifth in the International League.
- Also ranked among qualified International League pitchers in fewest hits per nine innings (1st, 7.91), fewest home runs per nine innings (3rd, 0.63), strikeouts per nine innings (3rd, 7.62) and walks/hits per innings pitched (5th, 1.24)...Matched a career-high with seven wins.

**2015 NOTES**

- Named Washington's Minor League Pitcher of the Year after leading all Nationals farmhands with 148 strikeouts and ranking third in the organization with a 2.92 ERA.
- His 148 strikeouts ranked second in all of Double-A and were tied for ninth in all of Minor League Baseball.
- Led the Eastern League in SO (148), SO/9.0 IP (8.47) and SO/BB (3.70)...Ranked among league leaders in WHIP (5th, 1.11) and ERA (8th, 2.92)
