TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Diamondbacks play the rubber game of this three-game series...San Francisco has gone 4-1 on this six-game homestand, sweeping the Phillies this past weekend and going 1-1 against Arizona...the Giants enter the series finale having won five of their last six games...the Diamondbacks have won six of their last eight.

INSIDE THE SERIES: The Giants have lost each of their last five series against the Diamondbacks dating back to last season...a win today and SF would earn their first series win over Arizona since taking two of three Aug. 4-6, 2017.

TODAY'S GAME ON FACEBOOK: Today's Giants-Diamondbacks game will stream live on Facebook Watch...the broadcast crew for today's game will be Rich Waltz (pvp); Mike Krukow, Eric Byrnes (analysts); Ashley Adamson (in-game reporter).

ON THE MOUND: RHP Chris Stratton enters today's outing having won his last four starts, blanking the Phillies over 6.0 innings in his most recent outing Friday...he had his best curveball of the season in that start against the Phillies as they were 1-for-9 with five strikeouts in at-bats ending with one (*Baseball Info Solutions*). Stratton is 1-1 with a 2.63 ERA (7er, 24.0ip) in four career starts against Arizona.

STARTING STRONG: No Giants starter has given up more than two runs in any of the club's last five games, during which the Giants have outscored the opposition 24-7.

STAT OF THE DAY: The Giants rank second in MLB in line drive percentage (23%)...they have two players in the top five: **Brandon Belt** (31%) and **Brandon Crawford** (30%) (*Baseball Info Solutions*).

ON DECK: Following this series against Arizona the Giants will embark on their fourth consecutive three-city road trip with stops in Washington, Miami and Los Angeles-NL...beginning Friday, the Giants will play 17-straight games, matching their longest stretch of the season without an off day.

FIVE IS THE KEY: The Diamondbacks are 19-0 when scoring at least five runs this season...they're the only unbeaten team in MLB...the Giants are 20-3 (*Baseball Info Solutions*).

ON THE SHORES OF McCOVEY COVE: The Giants have won six of their last seven home games and 12 of their last 17...San Francisco has lost just one home series this season and that came against the D-Backs, April 9-11.

CRAWFORD SINCE MAY 1: Beginning May 1, Crawford has hit safely in all but four of his last 32 games, batting a MLB-best .424 (50-for-118) with 12 doubles, five homers and 23 RBI...he's raised his batting average by 133 points from .189 to his current .322 mark, which ranks as the sixth-best in the National League.

SCORE AT LEAST FOUR: The Giants are 27-6 (.818) this season when they score four-or-more runs in a game...over their last 33 games, the Giants are 16-3 when scoring four-or-more runs compared to 1-14 otherwise.

IN THE BULLPEN: Giants relievers the last six games have combined to allow two runs (one earned) on 10 hits, four walks and 25 strikeouts in 20.0 innings pitched (0.45 ERA).

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#34 RHP Chris Stratton
6-2, 211, 27 years old (August 22, 1990)
7-3 Record, 4.50 ERA

- The 27-year-old right-hander is making his 13th start of the season...the Giants are 9-3 in his outings this year, going 5-1 at home and 4-2 on the road.
- His seven wins are tied with Philadelphia's Aaron Nola, Atlanta's Sean Newcomb and St. Louis' Michael Wacha for the second-most in the NL (WSH's Max Scherzer has 10).
- Enters today's start on a four-game personal winning streak, going 4-0 with a 4.29 ERA (10er, 21.0ip) in his last four outings...this is the longest winning streak of his career.
- The Giants tend to perform better when Stratton starts, as they are 9-3 (.700) with him on the hill this year...the only Giants starter with a higher team winning pct. in his starts is **Johnny Cueto** (.800, 4-1).
- Last pitched Friday versus Philadelphia and twirled 6.0-shutout innings with four hits allowed and seven strikeouts in the Giants' 4-0 victory...marked his second start this season of 6.0-or-more innings and no runs allowed.
- Stratton has a run-support average of 6.47 this season compared to 4.65 by all other Giants pitchers.
- Faces the Diamondbacks for the fifth time in his career (second time in 2018)...is 1-1 with a 2.63 ERA (7er, 24.0ip) in four starts, with the Giants going 3-1 in those games...has allowed three runs or fewer in all four outings...limited Arizona to one run on five hits in 7.0 innings the last time he faced them April 18 at Chase Field, a 4-3 Giants win.
- Has allowed eight home runs in his last seven starts (33.0ip) after not allowing a homer in his first five starts this season (31.0ip).
- Of his 28 walks allowed this season, eight have scored (28.6%)
- Has a 6.00 ERA (8er, 12.0ip) in the 1st inning.
- Left-handed batters are hitting .341 off him in his last seven games with 12 extra base hits...in his first five starts this year, lefties were hitting just .140 (8-for-57) off him.
- Missed four days on the Paternity List (April 25-29) when he flew home to Mississippi where he was able to meet his wife, Martha Kate for the birth of their second child, Mary Bennett Stratton, born April 25.
