



# SAN DIEGO PADRES 2018 GAME NOTES

**ON SATURDAY, IN THE PARK:** The Padres fell 7-2 last night to the Los Angeles Dodgers, dropping their penultimate game of 2018 in Chavez Ravine...starter **Jacob Nix** was saddled with the loss (now 2-4) in his first-career appearance vs. LAD, working just 2.1 innings of 6-hit and 6-run ball with 2 home runs...**Hunter Renfroe** homered for the second time in as many games, and it marked his 25th homer of the season (one shy of his career high of 26, set last season)...it was the 100th game this season in which the Padres recorded at least one homer.

**RECORD HUNTER:** **Hunter Renfroe** homered last night for his team-leading 25th time this season, and he's now 1 HR shy of matching his career high, set last season...his 8 HR in September tie for the Major League lead this month (also NYM's Michael Conforto and CWS's Daniel Palka), and his 17 HR since the beginning of August lead the majors (hit 9 in August)...Renfroe has hit .312/.348/.615 in his career against the Dodgers.

**GOIN' FOR THE SERIES:** If the Padres win today, it'll mark the Friars first series victory over the Dodgers @ Dodger Stadium since April 29-May 1, 2016 (took 2 of 3 games)...the Padres are 7-11 in rubber games this year as they aim to claim the series today vs. their Southern California foe.

**THEY DO MORE THAN CATCH:** Padres catchers this season have combined to hit 21 HR, tied with STL for the most of any NL catchers and trailing just LAD's 26 catcher HR.

**DAYMAN, FIGHTER OF THE NIGHTMAN:** The Padres have won their last 3 day games, owning a team .333 OBP and .509 SLG in those last 3 day games...the last day game the Padres played vs. LAD was against **Hyun-Jin Ryu** on August 26 @ LAD...Robbie Erlin was saddled with the loss in the game, as the Padres fell 7-3 in Chavez Ravine.

**SOUTHPAW SUNDAY:** LHP **Joey Lucchesi** goes head-to-head with LHP **Hyun-Jin Ryu** in the Padres final game vs. LAD this season...Lucchesi will be making his 1st appearance @ Dodger Stadium and is in search of his 1st-career win against LAD, owning an 0-2 record with a 5.00 ERA (5 er, 9 ip) in 2 starts...he's allowed 3-or-fewer runs in each of his last 5 starts, going 2-1 with a 3.58 ERA, 10.41 so/9 ip and 2.28 bb/9 ip.

**GRAB SOME PINE:** SD relievers have the most strikeouts of any relief crew in the NL this year (680), and their 10.19 so/9 ip ties with MIL for the most...SD starters have 644 strikeouts, the fewest in the NL in '18.

**GROUNDER GAMES:** SD has a 47.1 ground ball percentage at the plate this season, ranking 2nd-highest behind MIA's 48.3 %...the Dodgers, meanwhile, have a 40.8 grounder percentage, the 2nd-lowest in the majors, ahead of just OAK's 40.0 %.

**THEY'RE SWINGIN' FOR THE FENCES:** The Dodgers have logged just 79 infield hits and 5 bunt hits this season...their 79 infield hits are the fewest in the majors and their 5 bunt hits are the fewest in the NL (4th in the majors)...their 1,348 fly balls in '18 are the 2nd-most of any NL crew (behind NYM's 1,353)...the Padres, in comparison, have 127 infield hits, 17 bunt hits and 1,091 fly balls.

**@ LAD:** With a 2-6 record so far this season @ Dodger Stadium, SD hopes to eclipse its win total on the road against LAD in '17 (2-8)...among all stadiums at which the Padres played at least 5 games this season, their average of 2.60 runs/game at the plate is the lowest and their 7.24 ERA on the mound is the highest.

**A LOOK AHEAD:** The Padres will head to San Francisco following today's game to take on the Giants in the Friars' last road series of the 2018 campaign...the Padres have a 2-5 record @ AT&T Park this season, following last year's 6-4 record.

## STARTING PITCHER NOTES

**#37 LHP Joey Lucchesi (8-8, 3.74)**

**IT'S JOEY TIME:** 25-year-old **Joey Lucchesi** is set to make the 25th start of his career and third against the Los Angeles Dodgers today...it will be his first career start at Dodger Stadium and he will be in search of his first career win against the Dodgers....the rookie southpaw is in search of his 3rd win in his last 5 starts, having gone 2-1 with a 3.58 ERA since August 29.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the Padres' 5-4 defeat on 9/18 vs. SF, tossing 5.0 IP of three-run ball while striking out eight and walking one.

- Is now 2-7 with a 4.39 ERA in his 13 career starts against NL West foes.

**5 IN 5.0:** He's worked at least 5.0 innings in 5-straight starts (with a 3.58 ERA and a .260 opponent clip in that time)...Lucchesi has made 18 starts this season in which he's worked at least 5.0 innings, owning a 2.86 ERA (31 er, 97.2 ip) and an 8-4 record in those outings.

**GET TO 6.0:** He has reached the 6.0-inning mark on five occasions...in those starts, he is 4-0 with a 1.17 ERA (4 er, 30.2 ip)...the Padres are 4-1 in those starts.

**20-PLUS START CLUB:** Is one of just 20 rookies to have reached the 20-start plateau in a single season in Padres franchise history...along with fellow rookie southpaw **Eric Lauer**, its the first time the Padres have had two rookies make 20-or-more starts since 1977...it's now been done so on five occasions (also: 1969, 1972 and 1974).

- The Padres have now had a rookie reach the 20 start mark in three consecutive seasons, with **Dinelson Lamet** making 21 in 2017 and **Luis Perdomo's** 20 in 2016...prior to 2016, the last Padre rookie to make 20 starts was **Justin Germano** in 2007.
- His 24 starts are fifth-most among rookies this season

**LOOKING AHEAD:** After today, if he makes his final scheduled start he would be the seventh rookie in Padres history to make at least 26 starts with an ERA under 4.00...his 26 starts would also rank as the seventh-most by a Padres rookie in franchise history.

- The last Padres rookie to make at least 26 starts was **Matt Clement** in 1999.

**NO WALKS FOR YOU:** Lucchesi's 41 walks allowed this year are tied for the sixth-fewest of any NL hurler who has made at least 24 starts.

**AWAY FROM HOME:** Is now 3-3 with a 3.23 ERA in his nine starts away from Petco, with his only three road losses coming against the Diamondbacks at Chase Field...road opponents are slashing a line of .230/.288/.392.

- In his 15 starts at Petco, he has posted a 4.07 ERA and a .264/.333/.454 line.

**COMING UP CLUTCH:** With RISP this season, Lucchesi has a .220 opponent average (18-for-82) with four extra-base hits allowed (two double and two homers)...opponents have a .277 OBP in such scenarios.

- Opponents are hitting .179 (7-for-39) with runners in scoring position and two outs.

**PICK ME BABY ONE MORE TIME:** Joey has recorded three pickoffs and fellow rookie lefty **Eric Lauer** leads the majors with 10...their 13 combined pickoffs are the most by a Padres rookie duo in franchise history, and the Padres' 19 pickoffs are tied for the ML lead along with the Chicago White Sox and the Chicago Cubs.

**SINCE YOU'VE BEEN BACK:** In his 14 starts since being reinstated from the 10-day DL with a right hip strain on June 20, he is 5-6 with a 3.97 ERA (30 er, 68.0 ip), allowing two earned runs or less in 10 of those 14 outings while holding opposing bats to a .249 clip.

**SHOWING HE BELONGS:** The Padres selected Lucchesi to the Major League roster to start the club's second game of the season on March 30...he went on to allow three earned runs or fewer in eight of his first nine career outings from March 30-May 14, posting a 3-2 record with a 3.23 ERA (17 er, 47.1 ip) and 9.13 SO/9 IP.

- Missed 32 games from May 14-June 20 with a right hip strain, and he went 1-3 with a 3.60 ERA over his final five starts of the first half, limiting hitters to a .187 average.

### TOMORROW'S STARTER — #50 RHP Bryan Mitchell (1-3, 6.16)

**MITCHELL MONDAY:** RHP **Bryan Mitchell** tossed 5.0 IP of four-run ball in his last outing on 9/17 vs. SF and was tagged with the loss...in his three starts since being reinstated from the 10-day DL, he is 1-1 with a 3.38 ERA (6 ER, 16.0 IP) while limiting the opposition to a .250 average.

- Earned his first win as a Padre and his first since 4/2/17 while with NYY on 9/3 at ARI...tossed 5.0 IP of one-run ball, allowing just two hits in the Padres' 6-2 victory.
- Was reinstated from the DL on Sept. 1, having been placed on the 10-day DL on June 20 (retro June 17) with a right elbow impingement.

**season-high ip:** 2.2 (2x, 4/11 at COL) **current scoreless streak:** 1.0 IP (1 g)

- Has gone 1-1 in 14 career September outings with a 3.21 ERA (5 ER, 14.0 IP).
- Owns a 10.32 SO/9 and a 62.3 first-pitch strike percentage...has tallied a career high 45.1 IP, just passing his 43.0 IP in 2017.
- This year, has relied on two primary pitches this season: four seamer (62.8%) and slider (37.2%)...leads the Padres with an average spin rate of 2630 RPM (min. 200 pitches thrown).

- Has relied on five pitches this season: Sinker (45%), Slider (26.1%), Four Seamer (17.3%), Split Finger (11.5%), Curve (0.1%)
