TRIBE HEADLINES

» Cleveland has won each of its last eight games against the A.L. Central (26-13 overall), their longest divisional win streak since a run of 15 straight wins from August 25-September 14, 2017 (Cleveland's longest since divisional realignment in 1994).

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** leads MLB with seven home runs since June 22, including two streaks of homers in three straight games... he leads MLB with 50 extra-base hits, the most by a Tribe batter through 83 team games since **Jim Thome's** 52 at this point in 1998.

» **SHANE BIEBER** is 3-0 with a 0.96 ERA (2ER/18.2IP) during his second stint at the MLB level (three starts)...his 27 strikeouts through four career outings are 3rd-most in club history (**Herb Score**: 40, **DANNY SALAZAR**: 29).

TITO KEEPS WINNING

» Last night's victory marked Tribe manager **TERRY FRANCONA's** 500th win at the helm of the Indians...he currently ranks 6th in franchise history in managerial wins (**Eric Wedge** is 5th with 561) and 3rd with a .561 winning percentage (**Ossie Vitt** is 2nd at .570).
» Francona needed just 891 games to reach the milestone, ranking 2nd-fastest among the six Tribe skipper with 500 wins (**Al López** did so in 799 games)...**STL's Mike Matheny** (890 games) was the last manager in MLB to reach 500 wins with a single team faster.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians won their eighth straight game against A.L. Central opponents, opening their series at Kansas City with a 9-3 victory.

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** hit two home runs and recorded a career-high seven RBI, belting a 4th-inning grand slam and a 6th-inning three-run shot...marked the most RBI by a Tribe hitter since **Brandon Moss** also played seven on April 24, 2015 at Detroit.

» **RAJAI DAVIS** went 3-for-3 with a double and three runs scored... **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** was 2-for-4 with a pair of doubles.

» **COREY KLUBER** worked his 16th quality start of the season (T1st in MLB with WSH's **Max Scherzer**), holding the Royals to three runs on seven hits over 6.0 innings of work (0BB, 5K)...**Kluber** improved to 7-1 this season against the A.L. Central with a 1.68 ERA (10ER/53.2IP)...the Tribe bullpen tossed 3.0 shutout frames, with **DAN OTERO**, **GEORGE KONTOS** and **MARC RZEPczynski** each throwing 1.0 scoreless inning.

ROYAL WELCOME

» The Indians are in Kansas City this week for their first of three trips this season to Kauffman Stadium.

» Cleveland has gone 5-2 thus far against the Royals, taking two of three games in a pair of series at Progressive Field (April 6-8, May 11-13)...the Indians went 12-7 against Kansas City in their 2017 slate, including a record of 5-4 at Kauffman Stadium.

» In a rivalry that dates back to 1969, the Indians own an all-time record of 363-330 (.524) vs. the Royals, as well as a 60-42 (.588) mark since **Terry Francona** became Tribe manager in 2013.

CENTRAL FOCUS

» Cleveland has gone 26-13 against the A.L. Central, with a record of 7-3-2 in completed series...the Indians' .667 intradivisional winning percentage ranks 3rd in the A.L. and MLB...the Tribe has gone 18-4 in divisional home games and 8-9 on the road.

» The Indians have allowed three-or-fewer runs in 27 of their 39 divisional contests this season, including each of their last eight...the Tribe owns a 24-3 record across those 27 games.

» In 39 intradivisional games, Tribe pitchers have posted a 2.86 ERA (112ER/352.2IP), marking the 2nd-lowest intradivisional ERA in the American League and the 3rd-lowest in MLB.

GRAND ENTRANCE

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR's** 4th-inning grand slam marked the 2nd of his Major League career (also April 5, 2017 at Texas) and the seventh by an Indians batter this season...after leading the Majors with seven grand slams in Spring Training, the Tribe's seven slams in the regular season rank T2nd with Boston (Cincinnati has nine).

» Marks the Tribe's most grand slams in a season since 2010, when the club also belted seven...Cleveland's seven grand slams in the first half of the season are their most since hitting eight before the All-Star Break in 2006 (finished that season with 14).

MINOR LEAGUE REPORT

» **Columbus (AAA): 43-39, 3rd (-3.0 G)**

Nellie Rodríguez went 1-for-2 with a three-run homer & three walks...Drew Maggi and Yandy Díaz each had three hits.

» **Akron (AA): 47-36, 1st (+2.5 G)**

Bobby Bradley (2-4, 2B, 3B, 2RBI) is batting .333 (10-30) over his past seven games with four homers and 12 RBI.

» **Lynchburg (High-A): 37-42 (2nd Half: 8-4)** » 7/2: W, 10-1 at Frederick

Ernie Clement went 5-for-5 with a double and two runs scored...the Hillcats slugged a season-high five home runs.

» **Lake County (A): 33-49 (2nd Half: 4-8)** » 7/2: L, 1-2 vs. Dayton

Kirk McCarty took a hard-luck loss, allowing just one run on four hits over 7.0 strong innings (0BB, 7K).

» **MV Scappers (Short-A): 12-4, 1st (+2.0G)** » 7/2: W, 9-7 at State College

Tyler Freeman went 3-for-4 with a triple and four runs scored, including a go-ahead steal of home in the 6th inning.

FRANKIE'S MONSTER MASH

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** enjoyed a historic performance last night, going 2-for-4 with two homers and seven RBI...matched the club record for RBI by a shortstop, tying **Chico Carrasquel's** seven RBI on April 26, 1956 at KCA (RBI became an official stat in 1920).

» Lindor also became just the fourth player in franchise history to hit a grand slam and a three-run homer in the same game, joining **Pat Seerey** (7/13/1945 at New York-AL), **Vic Wertz** (9/14/1957 at Boston) and **Manny Ramirez** (9/24/1999 at Toronto).

» Last night's contest continued Lindor's successes against Kansas City, as he is now a career .343 (71-207) hitter in 54 games vs. the Royals with 17 homers, 17 doubles and 54 RBI (the most of any MLB player vs. Kansas City since 2015).

» Has already collected four multi-homer games this season, tied with Baltimore's **Manny Machado** for the most in MLB...he now ranks T3rd in MLB with 23 homers and T8th in the A.L. with 55 RBI.

» 22 of Lindor's 23 home runs this season have come from the leadoff spot in the batting order, the most in MLB...he also leads Major League Baseball with 73 runs scored, the most by a Tribe batter through 83 team games since **Kenny Lofton** and **Roberto Alomar** both had 78 at this juncture of the 1999 season.

» Including the final two games of the Oakland series, Lindor has homered in three consecutive games, tying his longest streak of the season (also June 22-24)...the last Tribe player with multiple three-game homer streaks in a single season was **Travis Hafner**, who had four in 2006...**Lindor's seven homers since June 22** are the most in MLB (no other player has more than five).

THE SHANE EVENT

» **SHANE BIEBER** carries a 3-0 record into his first career start and appearance vs. the Kansas City Royals.

» He is starting on extended five days' rest after making his last start on June 27 at St. Louis...**earned the win after holding the Cardinals to one run on six hits over 6.0 strong innings of work (1BB, 5K)**...also helped his own cause at the plate, logging his first career hit with a double in just his second-ever professional at-bat.

» After taking a no-decision in his Major League debut on May 31 at Minnesota (5.2IP, 9H, 4R/ER), **Bieber has gone 3-0 with a 0.96 ERA (2ER/18.2IP) in his second stint at the big-league level.**

» **Bieber has fanned 27 batters across his first four career appearances, the 3rd-most in Indians franchise history (Herb Score - 40, DANNY SALAZAR - 29)**...with five strikeouts tonight, Bieber would join **Score** (first 10) as the only players in club history to fan at least five batters in each of their first five career appearances.

» On the season, MLB batters are hitting .289 off Bieber, but he has been particularly stingy with runners in scoring position...opposing hitters are batting just .208 (5-24) with RISP, collecting just one extra-base hit against 10 strikeouts.

J-RAM JAM

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** recorded his 10th game with multiple extra-base hits last night, going 2-for-4 with a pair of doubles...brings his total to 49 extra-base hits on the season, 2nd-most in MLB behind teammate **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (50).

» **Ramírez and Lindor's 99 extra-base hits are the most by a duo in club history through 83 team games and most in MLB since 2004, when Boston's David Ortiz (55) & Manny Ramirez (51) had 106.**

» **He continues to lead the team with 24 home runs (T2nd in MLB)**...with 12 games left before the All-Star break, he and Lindor's 47 combined first-half homers already rank T2nd by a duo in franchise history...they trail the 2001 club, which saw **Jim Thome** (26) and **Juan González** (23) combine for 49 home runs.

» **Ramírez** (55 RBI), **Lindor** (55) and **EDWIN ENCARNACION** (57) have combined for 167 RBI this season, tied with Boston (**Martínez, Benintendi, Devers**) and Colorado (**Arenado, Story, Desmond**) for the most of any trio of teammates in MLB.

STARTING STRONG

» **Tribe starting pitchers rank 2nd in the American League (4th in MLB) with a combined 3.41 ERA this season**...the club's 54 quality starts this season rank 2nd in MLB (Houston - 62).

» **Indians starters have also struck out 532 batters (2nd-most in MLB) against just 125 walks (3rd-fewest in MLB)**, good for a collective 4.256 K/BB ratio that is 2nd-best in MLB (LAD - 4.264).

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

1994: The Cleveland Indians retire **Larry Doby's** #14 in a pregame ceremony before their 10-9 walk-off win vs. Minnesota...Doby became the first African-American player in the American League when he made his debut for the Tribe on July 5, 1947 vs. Chicago-AL...he appeared in two World Series and spent 10 of his 13 MLB seasons in an Indians uniform...Doby was elected to the Baseball Hall of Fame by the Veterans Committee in 1998.

TONIGHT'S START

» The 23-year-old rookie is set to make his fifth career Major League start tonight in the middle tilt of this three-game set in Kansas City...will also mark his first career start and appearance vs. the Royals.
 » Will be pitching tonight on extended five days' rest after notching his third career win in his last start on June 27 at St. Louis...allowed just one run on six hits, with one walk and five strikeouts.
 » He will make his first career start vs. Kansas City tonight...three of his five career starts so far have come against the A.L. Central (DET & MIN), and he has compiled a 2-0 record and 2.45 ERA (5ER/18.1IP) in those outings.
 » **Bieber has 27 strikeouts across his first four career appearances, which is the 3rd-highest total in Indians franchise history, trailing Herb Score (40) and DANNY SALAZAR (29)**...should he strike out five-or-more batters tonight, he will have the 2nd-most punchouts through a pitcher's first five career appearances, behind **Score (50)**.

2018 CLEVELAND RECAP

» After allowing four runs in his MLB debut on May 31, **Bieber has surrendered one-or-fewer runs in each of his last three starts, posting a 3-0 record and 0.96 ERA (2ER/18.2IP) since June 17.**
 » On June 22 vs. Detroit, **Bieber became the sixth Indians pitcher since 1908 to record a start with 7.0-or-more shutout innings and four-or-fewer hits allowed within his first three career starts, and the first since Scott Lewis did so on September 10, 2008 at Baltimore...** at 23.022 years old marked the youngest pitcher in franchise history to achieve that feat, surpassing **Ray Benge (23.157)**, who did so on Sept. 26, 1925 at Philadelphia.
 » Bieber fanned nine Tigers hitters in the outing, **becoming the first Indians pitcher since Luis Tiant in 1964 with six-or-more strikeouts in his first three career appearances...** his 22 strikeouts combined across his first three career starts are tied with **DANNY SALAZAR (also 22)** for the 3rd-most strikeouts in a pitcher's first three career appearances in Indians franchise history.
 » **Earned his first career win on June 17 vs. Minnesota...** allowed one run on 11 hits in 5.2 innings, with one walk...fanned a then-career high seven batters, **becoming the fourth pitcher in Indians franchise history to strike out six-or-more batters in each of his first two career starts** and first since **DANNY SALAZAR** did so in his first two appearances from July 11 – August 7, 2013...his 13 strikeouts combined across his first two career starts also mark the most since Salazar's 17 punchouts in 2013.
 » His start also marked the 19th in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-) to allow 10-or-more hits and one-or-fewer runs in less than 6.0 innings of work, as well as the first since teammate **CARLOS CARRASCO** on September 2, 2014 vs. Detroit.
 » **Made his Major League debut against the Twins at Target Field on May 31...** did not factor into the decision in the Tribe's 9-8 win (5.2IP, 8H, 4R/ER, 2HR, 1BB, 6K)...struck out six batters, including his first career batter faced (**Brian Dozier**), marking the most punchouts in a Tribe pitcher's first Major League start since **SALAZAR** fanned seven in his MLB debut on July 11, 2013 vs. Toronto.
 » **Bieber became the first pitcher in Indians franchise history to make his Major League debut on his birthday**, as well as the second player after outfielder **Dave Clark** on September 3, 1986 at Toronto.

2018 MILB RECAP

» This season, Bieber has compiled a 6-1 record and 1.29 ERA (11ER/76.2IP) in 12 combined starts between AA Akron and AAA Columbus.
 » **Did not allow a run until his fourth start of the year, a career-long scoreless streak of 22.0 innings, dating back to his last start in 2017...** overall this season, has recorded five scoreless starts and allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in 11 of 12 outings.
 » Has a 3-1 record with a 1.38 ERA (7ER/45.2IP) in seven starts with Columbus, with 42 strikeouts and just five walks allowed in his 45.2 innings...marks his first career action in Triple-A...from May 3 - June 6, did not walk a batter, a span of 30.1 innings.
 » Tossed a rain-shortened no-hitter on May 25 at Gwinnett, striking out seven batters and walking none in the 7.0 inning outing...the lone Gwinnett baserunner reached on an error in the bottom of the 3rd...marked the 8th no-hitter in Columbus franchise history.
 » Began the season at AA Akron, where he went a perfect 3-0 with a 1.16 ERA (4ER/31.0IP) in five starts prior to his May 3 call-up to Columbus...was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for April 5-15.
 » Named the pitcher with the Best Control in the Indians Player Development System, according to *Baseball America* at the beginning of the season...also placed on the Tribe pre-season top prospect rankings in *Baseball America* - 5th, *Baseball Prospectus* - 5th and *ESPN.Com/Keith Law* - 10th.

AWARDS ALL AROUND

» Bieber has won three total Pitcher of the Week awards at two different levels this season, twice in the International League and once in the Eastern League.
 » Began the year with Akron and went 1-0 with zero runs allowed in his first two starts of the season (13.0IP), allowing just six hits and fanning 17 batters to earn Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honors for April 5-15...was promoted to AAA Columbus on May 3 & won the IL Pitcher of the Week honor in consecutive weeks (May 14-20 & May 21-27).
 » In 2017, was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Week for June 19-25, after matching his career high with 11 strikeouts on June 22 vs. Frederick (8.0IP, 3H, 1BB).

CAREER SNAPSHOT

» The Orange, California native was selected in the 4th Round (122nd overall) of the June, 2016 MLB Draft out of the University of California-Santa Barbara.
 » Posted a 23-12 record and 2.73 ERA (91ER/300.0IP) from 2014-16 for UC Santa Barbara, with 237 strikeouts and just 38 walks...earned several honors over the course of his college career, including being named 2015 All-Big West Second Team, 2016 Pre-season Big West Pitcher of the Year, 2016 All-Big West First Team and 2016 Rawlings Second Team All-American.
 » Made his professional debut with Short-Season Mahoning Valley in 2016, making eight starts and one relief appearance for the Scrappers...after allowing one run in his first appearance on July 22, did not surrender an earned run in his final eight outings of the year, a span of 21.0 innings...overall on the year, posted a 0-0 record and 0.38 ERA (1ER/24.0IP), with 21 strikeouts and just two walks allowed.
 » Divided the 2017 season between A Lake County, High-A Lynchburg and AA Akron, combining for a 10-5 record and 2.86 ERA (55ER/173.1IP).
 » Began the year with Lake County and earned his first career win on April 14 at Lansing, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing one run on four hits while walking none and striking out a career-best 11 batters...went 2-3 with a 3.10 ERA (10ER/29.0IP) in five starts with the Captains prior to his promotion to Lynchburg on May 5.
 » Did not factor into the decision in his first five starts with the Hillcats, posting a 3.38 ERA (12ER/32.0IP) in those outings.
 » After taking a loss on June 6 at Salem, won his next four starts, a then-career long streak...went 4-0 with a 1.05 ERA (3ER/25.2IP) in those outings, with 29 strikeouts...won the Carolina League Pitcher of the Week award for June 19-25, after matching his career high 11 punchouts on June 22 vs. Frederick...overall went 6-1 with a 3.10 ERA (31ER/90.0IP) in 14 starts for the Hillcats.
 » Was called up to AA Akron on July 24 and finished the season with the RubberDucks...earned his first career Double-A win on August 4 at Reading, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing one run on six hits, with zero walks and seven strikeouts...posted a 2-1 record and 2.32 ERA (14ER/54.1IP) in nine starts for Akron.
 » In 2017, led all pitchers in the Indians organization with 173.1 innings pitched and ranked among the organizational leaders in ERA (2.86, 2nd), strikeouts (162, 2nd) and wins (10, T4th).
