THE GIANTS: Will attempt to snap a two-game losing streak as they face the Diamondbacks in the final game of this four-game series...with a win today, the Giants could secure their first winning road trip this season and the first since going 4-2 at Pittsburgh and Detroit last year from June 30-July 6...since then, the Giants have had 13 road trips finishing with a record of .500 or below.

ON THE MOUND: LHP Derek Holland has posted a 1.71 ERA (4er, 21.0ip) and a .178 opponents average over his last six outings (three starts)...he's pitched better in day games this season, going 4-1 with a 2.77 ERA in eight day games, compared to a 1-7 record with a 4.50 ERA in 16 night games.

NOTABLE MATCHUPS: LHP Robbie Ray is 3-0 with a 1.84 ERA (6er, 29.1ip) in his last five starts against the Giants...however, several Giants have had success off him over their careers, including: **OF Hunter Pence** (.438, 7-for-16, two doubles), **IF Joe Panik** (.412, 7-for-17) and **OF Andrew McCutchen** (.313, 5-for-16, one HR).

HEATING UP: C Buster Posey has reached base safely in 11 of his last 18 plate appearances (10 hits, one walk) and is batting .542 (13-for-24) with six runs, three doubles and five RBI over his last six games.

SIGH OF RELIEF: Over the Giants last eight games, San Francisco relievers have combined to allow seven runs (six earned runs) on 23 hits and six walks with 28 strikeouts in 31.0 innings pitched (1.74 ERA)...overall this season, the Giants' bullpen has posted the fourth-best ERA in the National League (3.50 ERA).

SOLID PITCHING: Despite allowing 15 runs over the last two games, beginning June 1, Giants' pitchers have posted a 3.39 ERA, which ranks as the second-best figure in the Majors over that span, behind the Boston Red Sox (3.31 ERA).

WITH THE GLOVES: The Giants turned three more double plays last night...their 118 double plays overall this season rank as the second-most in the Majors behind the Angels (119)...SF has turned 17 double plays in the last 13 games, including six over their past two contests.

ON THE MEND: RHP Hunter Strickland, who has missed the Giants last 40 games with a fractured right hand, was placed on a rehab assignment with the AZL Giants (Black) yesterday...he threw 1.0 inning, allowing one unearned run on two hits with two strikeouts at Scottsdale Stadium.

IN NEED OF CLUTCH HITS: San Francisco is hitting .204 with runners in scoring position and two-outs this season, which ranks as the lowest figure in the National League and the third-lowest in the Majors behind Texas (.188) and Baltimore (.189).

ROAD WOES: Despite posting a 9-8 record in their last 17 road games, the Giants .414 (24-34) road winning percentage still ranks as the third-lowest figure in the National League behind Miami (20-35, .364) and San Diego (23-34, .404).

JUST SCORE FOUR: The Giants are 44-13 (.772) when they score four-or-more runs in a game and are just 12-43 (.218) when they score fewer than three runs.

ON DECK: Following today's game, the Giants will travel home for a seven-day, six-game homestand against the Houston Astros (Monday-Tuesday) and Pittsburgh Pirates (Thursday-Sunday)...SF went 0-2 at Houston and 1-2 at Pittsburgh earlier this season.

This Date in Giants History: August 5, 1986

At Candelstick Park, Reds center fielder Eric Davis became the 4,000th strikeout victim of Giants left-handed pitcher Steve Carlton...the historic whiff occurred in the third inning with two runners on base and no outs.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#45 LHP Derek Holland
6-2, 215, 31 years old (October 9, 1986)
5-8 Record, 3.90 ERA

- The 31-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 21st start (25th appearance) this season...has posted a 5-8 record with a 3.90 ERA (49er, 113.0ip) over his 24 outings.
- Started the season in the Giants rotation, but was moved to the bullpen following his start on July 1 at Arizona...has moved back and forth between the bullpen and the starting rotation since then.
- Did not factor into the decision in his last start on July 30 at San Diego...threw 5.0 innings, allowing two runs on four hits and two walks in the Giants' 5-3 extra-inning victory.
- Is 2-2 with a 2.68 ERA (13er, 43.2ip) over his last eight games started.
- Has made four relief appearances and allowed two runs on five hits (one home run) with 14 strikeouts in 7.0 innings of work...has struck out 14 of the 28 batters he's faced as a reliever.
- Has struck out 57 batters over his last 45.2 innings pitched, covering his past 11 appearances (11.23 SO/9).
- Opponents are hitting .202 (17-for-84) off him with runners in scoring position and are just 5-for-their-last-39 (.128).
- Lefties are hitting just .193 (17-for-88) off him, which ranks as the 14th-lowest figure in the National League...has allowed just three extra-base hits to left-handers (all doubles).
- Has received two or less runs of support in 12 of his 20 starts this season.
- Has made three career starts against Arizona, going 0-1 with a 4.61 ERA (7er, 13.2ip).
- His only career appearance at Chase Field came on July 1...threw 3.2 innings, allowing three runs on seven hits and four walks in the Giants 9-6 victory over Arizona.
- Signed by the Giants to a minor league contract in Feb. and made the team as a non-roster invitee.
